POP OFF: The Giants open their 69th season in San Francisco and 144th in franchise history this evening as they kick off the 2026 season tonight versus the Yankees.

- ▶ Opening at home has been a rare occurrence for the Giants as this is the sixth time since Oracle Park opened in 2000 that SF has opened at home (2001, 2005, 2007, 2009, 2022 and today)...the 2022 opener was actually rescheduled to be at home because of the lockout (SF had originally been scheduled to open on the road).
- ▶ SF is 4-1 in its previous five Opening Days at home with its lone loss coming in 2007.
- ▶ Per *Elias*, tonight will be the second time since the Giants moved to San Francisco that they will open a season *at home and at night*...the first was against the Cubs on April, 12, 1966...before that, it last happened April 16, 1952 vs. Philadelphia at the Polo Grounds.
- ▶ Tonight also marks the second time in the last four years SF has opened with the Yankees, with the other meeting taking place in 2023 at Yankee Stadium...SF lost that game, 5-0.
- ▶ The Giants are 77-65-1 (.542) all-time on Opening Day as a franchise and 39-29 (.574) since moving to San Francisco in 1958.

TONY THE GIANT: Manager **Tony Vitello** will manage the first regular season game of his Major League career tonight after being named the 40th field manager in Giants history on October 22, 2025.

- ▶ Vitello spent the last eight years (2018-2025) as head coach of the University of Tennessee where he went 341-131 (.722), leading the Vols to a National Championship in 2024.
- ▶ The 47-year-old helped transform Tennessee baseball into a national powerhouse during his time in Knoxville, guiding the program to six NCAA regional appearances (2019, 2021-2025), five super regionals (2021-2025) and three Men's College World Series appearances (2021, 2023, 2024).

LOGAN'S WEBB: Two-time All-Star **RHP Logan Webb** takes the ball for his fifth career Opening Day start (2022, 2023, 2024, 2025 and this year).

- ▶ The 29-year-old Webb will become the fifth pitcher to make at least five Opening Day starts for the Giants in team history...he joins Hall of Famer **Juan Marichal** (10), Hall of Famer **Carl Hubbell** (six), **Larry Jansen** (five) and **Madison Bumgarner** (five).
- ▶ The five consecutive Opening Day starts will trail on Marichal (six) for the longest streak in team history...Marichal made six consecutive Opening Day starts from 1964-69.
- ▶ He's still seeking his first career win on Opening Day...in his previous four OD starts he's 0-1 with a 3.91 ERA (8er, 23.0ip) with 25 strikeouts to eight walks...the Giants are 2-2 as a team in his four Opening Day starts.
- ▶ Webb was named an All-Star for a second consecutive season in 2025 and finished the campaign leading the Majors in innings pitched (207.0) and leading the National League in strikeouts (a career-best 224) while going 15-11 in a career-high 34 starts...he finished fourth in the NL Cy Young voting and also won his first career Gold Glove.
- ▶ Facing off with Yankees LHP Max Fried (the AL Gold Glove pitcher last year), this game marks the first time in MLB history that opposing Opening Day starting pitchers have both won Gold Gloves in their career (*SportsRadar*).

IS TODAY THE DAY?: The Giants have started a different left fielder on Opening Day in each of the last 19 seasons since **Barry Bonds** last manned the position in 2006 and 2007...that tradition has a chance to end today if **OF Heliot Ramos** gets the starting nod in left field after manning that position last year on Opening Day in Cincinnati.

- ▶ The 19-year streak ties the St. Louis Browns/Baltimore Orioles' 19-year streak of also starting a different left fielder from 1937-1955 (chart to right courtesy of *Elias*) for the longest streak of consecutive Opening Days starting a different player at one position since 1900.

COACHES CORNER: Along with the hiring of **MGR Tony Vitello** came almost an entirely new coaching staff save for three members of the 2025 staff.

- ▶ Assistant Hitting Coach **Oscar Bernard**, ML Field Coordinator & Catching Coach **Alex Burg** and Quality Control Coach **Taira Uematsu** all remained from last year's staff with Burg adding the Major League Field Coordinator role to his duties.
- ▶ Joining Vitello's staff for 2026 are Bench Coach **Jayce Tingler**, Pitching Coach **Justin Meccage** (*message*), Assistant Pitching Coach **Christian Wonders**, Director of ML Pitching **Frank Anderson**, Bullpen Coach **Jesse Chavez**, Hitting Coach **Hunter Mense** (*mehns*), 3B Coach **Hector Borg**, 1B Coach **Shane Robinson** and ML Infield Coach **Ron Washington**.

REINFORCEMENTS, ASSEMBLE: The Giants brought in nine players on Major League contracts this past offseason...a full chart of the newbies can be found below.

- ▶ The deal for **RHP Adrian Houser** also includes a club option for the 2028 season while the contract for **RHP Rowan Wick** contract includes a club option for the 2027 campaign.
- ▶ **LHP Ryan Borucki** was signed this past Saturday after he opted out of his minor league deal with the Chicago White Sox and joined SF on its flight home from Arizona on Saturday.
- ▶ Additionally, the Giants brought in **C Daniel Susac** in a trade with the Minnesota Twins on December 10...Susac was selected by the Twins in the Major League phase of the Rule 5 draft and must stay on the Giants' roster all season or be offered back to the team he was selected from (the A's).
- ▶ **RHP Jason Foley** (60-day IL), **LHP Sam Hentges** (15-day IL) and **RHP Rowan Wick** (60-day IL) will begin the season on the IL as they recover from surgeries performed in 2025.

FIRST CONTACT: The Giants have five players on the roster today who are experiencing their first Major League Opening Day.

- ▶ **LHP Matt Gage**, **C Daniel Susac**, **OF Jerar Encarnacion**, **OF Jared Oliva**, **RHP Caleb Kilian**.
- ▶ By far not his first Opening Day, in fact its his ninth, but this opener does mark the first in a Giants uniform for **IF Rafael Devers** after being acquired last June from Boston.

SPRING SZN: SF was 19-9-1 during Cactus League play, the second-best mark in the circuit behind only the Dodgers (20-9-2)...the Giants hit .300 as a team, best in MLB ahead of the Rockies (.284)...the club's .848 OPS in spring was third-best in the Majors behind only the Rockies (.858) and A's (.855).

- ▶ Additionally, the Giants struck out 216 times in 29 Cactus League games, which was second-fewest in MLB this Spring Training...only the Tigers (214) had fewer strikeouts...for comparison's sake, SF struck out 296 times in 31 contests during Cactus League play last year.

THE DUBBA DUBBA WBC: San Francisco had six players from its Opening Day roster participate in the WBC with **IF Luis Arraez** and **RHP José Buttó** playing for the victors Venezuela.

- ▶ The others were **OF Harrison Bader** (Israel), **OF Jung Hoo Lee** (Korea), **OF Heliot Ramos** (Puerto Rico) and **RHP Logan Webb** (USA).
- ▶ Two of SF's seven players made the WBC All-Tournament Team in Arraez and Webb.

THAT'S LIFE: A year after winning their first-ever series against the Yankees at Yankee Stadium in mid-April last year, the Giants will try and defeat the Yankees here in San Francisco for the first time since 2007 (the two clubs did not play all that often in the previous version of Interleague play).

- ▶ SF has been swept in each of its last two home series versus the Yankees in 2019 and 2024...the Giants lost each of their last six games against the Yankees here dating to April 26, 2019.
- ▶ The Giants' last victory over the Yankees here in San Francisco came June 24, 2007 (7-2)...below are the starting lineups from that game.

- ▶ SF's leadoff hitter Randy Winn is now the club's **vice president of player development**...**PBO Buster Posey** had yet to even be drafted by SF out of Florida State (he'd be drafted in 2008).
- ▶ Looking to aid in SF's efforts during this series will be **IF Rafael Devers**, who has had his fair share of plate appearances against the Yanks...Devers owns a career slash line of .270/.348/.553 (.880 OPS) with 22 doubles, 31 homers, 78 RBI and 79 runs scored in 119 career regular season games against New York.

WEBBMASTER: Enters his eighth season in a Giants uniform and is in the third year of his five-year contract extension he signed in 2023...the 29-year-old enters this season as the longest-tenured Giant on the roster after making his MLB debut on August 17, 2019 at Arizona.

***FLIPS OPEN SIGN AROUND*:** Is making his fifth career Opening Day start tonight and they've all come consecutively beginning in 2022...Webb's five consecutive Opening Day starts are second-most in team history trailing only **Juan Marichal's** six straight Opening Day starts from 1964-69...Webb also becomes one of five pitchers in team history to make at least five Opening Day starts...the others are: Marichal (10), **Carl Hubbell** (six), **Larry Jansen** (five) and **Madison Bumgarner** (five)...Webb's five consecutive OD starts will also be the longest active streak in MLB (LHP Framer Valdez started each of the last four ODs for Houston but will not start for Detroit on Opening Day this year).

STARS & STRIPES: The Giants' ace suited up for USA in the World Baseball Classic and made two terrific starts in their win over Brazil plus their quarterfinal win over Canada...in the two outings, Webb was 2-0 with a 1.04 ERA (1er, 8.2ip) with five hits allowed, one walk and 11 strikeouts...Webb was one of two Giants named to the WBC All-Tournament Team (also **Luis Arraez** at 1B for champion Venezuela).

CACTUS LEAGUE: With his time at the WBC, Webb only made three Cactus League starts and was 2-0 with a 6.75 ERA (7er, 9.1ip) with 10 strikeouts to one walk...his final Cactus League outing came last Thursday versus the Rockies at Salt River Fields at Talking Stick...the righty got his pitch count up to 86 but allowed six runs on eight hits in 4.1 innings of work.

LET'S LOOK BACK: The Rocklin, CA native finished fourth in the NL Cy Young Award voting in 2025 after leading the Majors in innings pitched (207.0) and the National League in strikeouts (224) while going 15-11 with a 3.22 ERA...*the last Giant prior to Webb to lead the NL in both innings pitched and strikeouts was Bill Voiselle in 1944*...Webb garnered his second All-Star selection, eclipsed the 200-inning threshold for a third straight season, made a career-best 34 starts and set a career-high with his 224 strikeouts...you can see Webb's National League rankings from last season below.

1000GAN: With 994 career MLB strikeouts, Webb is six strikeouts away from hitting 1,000 for his career.

HE POSTS: Since 2022, no pitcher in the Majors has thrown more innings than Webb's 820.0 innings...the next closest pitcher is Detroit's Framer Valdez, who has logged 767.2 frames...Webb's 85 quality starts since 2022 are also tops in the Majors ahead of Valdez' 83...lastly, his 132 starts in that span are most in MLB ahead of the STL's Miles Mikolas and the TOR's Dylan Cease.

VS. NEW YORK-AL: Has struggled against the Yankees in his three starts against them, going 1-2 with a 5.50 ERA (11er, 18.0ip)...he defeated the Yankees last April in New York with 5.0 innings of three-run ball with four walks and five strikeouts at Yankee Stadium in SF's 5-4 win...today marks his second career Opening Day start against the Yankees...he struck out a career-best 12 on Opening Day in 2023 (also at Yankee Stadium) but surrendered four runs on four hits (two homers) in 6.0 innings in SF's 5-0 loss...former Team USA teammate Aaron Judge is 3-for-7 with a pair of homers and a double off Webb.

DO IT FOR WEBBY: The Giants were only 18-16 in Webb's 34 starts last year, which was actually an improvement over them going 16-17 in his 33 starts in 2024...since 2022, SF as a team is 67-65 in Webb's 132 starts yet his 3.22 ERA in that time is 11th-best in MLB among starters who have made at least 75 starts...his 2.94 FIP in that span is best in the National League and trails only DET's Tarik Skubal (2.51).

HELPING THE CATCHER: Webb improved his ability to keep runners in check in 2025 and limit steals...he had +5 Net Bases Prevented (a sum of advanced prevented and outs added assigned to the pitcher)...he had scores of -5 in 2024, -9 in 2023 and -4 in 2022, -1 in 2021 and -3 in 2020...from 2020-2024, Webb allowed an average of 14 stolen bases/year (72 in five seasons)...in 2025, Webb allowed nine stolen bases.

- ▶ Will embark on his third season with SF Friday afternoon in what will be the final year of his contract.
- ▶ Named an All-Star in 2025 after a terrific first half saw him go 9-3 with a 2.65 ERA (20 starts)...went 2-5 over his final 12 starts with a 5.54 ERA.
- ▶ Had a terrific spring, going 2-0 with a 1.37 ERA (3er, 19.2ip) in six starts...did not allow a hit over two starts from March 9-15 (9.0ip, 0h, 1hb, 4bb, 12k).
