**METSCELLANEOUS:** The Mets fell to the Reds, 1-0, last night...The Mets are 39-9 when scoring first this season...The Mets are seeking their 19th series victory of the season... New York is 18-5-2 in 25 series this year...The Mets are in a stretch of 17 games in 17 days (3-2) to finish out the first-half...The Mets continue a quick three-game road trip against the Reds (1-1)...Following this series, the Mets head home for a four-game series against the Marlins.

**CONGRATS!:** David Peterson is set to make his return to the mound tonight...He is coming off the paternity list after his wife gave birth to a baby boy.

**PETER PAN:** David Peterson is set to make his fifth start (seventh appearance) on the road this year...He is 2-0 with a 2.17 ERA (seven earned runs/29.0 innings) with nine walks and 29 strikeouts on the road this year...Opponents are hitting .180 against him in away games...This compares to a 3-1 record with a 4.30 ERA (14 earned runs/29.1 innings) with 13 walks and 31 strikeouts and a .265 opponents average in six games at Citi Field in 2022.

**THE BUCK STARTS HERE:** Buck Showalter has recorded 1,601 career managerial wins...The win places him 22nd on the all-time win list, surpassing Tommy Lasorda...Fred Clarke is next with 1,602 wins...His 1,601 wins rank fourth among active managers.

**MEDIUM RARE:** The Mets fell to the Reds, 1-0, last night...It was their first by that score this season...Overall, the Mets have been shut out only four times this year...The Mets were blanked 13 times in 2021...The Mets pitching staff has recorded 11 shutouts this season, which is tied with the Yankees for the most in the majors.

**TO THE MAX:** Last night, Max Scherzer struck out 11 batters and did not issue a walk...It was the 28th time in his career that he struck out 10 or more batters without issuing a walk, the second most such games in MLB history...Randy Johnson holds the record with 36 such games, followed by Max Scherzer, Curt Schilling (27), Clayton Kershaw (25) and Roger Clemens (21)...Courtesy of Elias.

**MARTE PARTAY:** Starling Marte reached base safely in all four plate appearances last night...It marked the seventh time in Marte's career in which he'd reached base successfully in each of his plate appearances in a game...Over the last nine games, Starling Marte is 13-33 (.394) with four runs, three doubles, two home runs, three RBI, four walks, a steal with a .474 OBP, a .667 SLG and a 1.140 OPS...He is one double away from 250 for his career...In 50 games since May 1, Starling Marte is batting .315 (62-197) with 38 runs, 14 doubles, three triples, seven home runs, 24 RBI, 12 walks, five steals with a .363 OBP, a .523 SLG and an .886 OPS.

**RIGHT ON:** The Mets are batting .261 against right-handed pitchers this year...That is the best mark in the majors...Their .328 OBP is third in MLB...The Mets are 34-17 when facing a right-handed starting pitcher...Jeff McNeil is batting .328 against righties this year, which is sixth in the majors and third in the NL...Pete Alonso's .293 average against RHP is 11th in the NL, while his .572 SLG is ninth in The Show and fourth in the Senior Circuit.

**IT'S GREAT!:** Luis Guillorme is 5-10 (.500) with a run, a double, a home run, three RBI and a walk in three career games in Cincinnati...Mark Canha is 3-7 (.429) with two runs, a double and a walk in two games at the yard...Francisco Lindor is a lifetime .338 (24-71) hitter with 16 runs, three doubles, six home runs, 10 RBI, seven walks with a .413 OBP and a .634 SLG in 16 career games here...Ender Inciarte has hit .319 (29-91) with 12 runs, four doubles, two home runs, 14 RBI, eight walks with a .356 BP with a .429 SLG in 25 career games at the ballpark...Jeff McNeil has hit .297 (11-37) with seven runs, two doubles, two home runs, four RBI, two walks, a .333 OBP and a .514 SLG in eight games at GABP.

**NIFTY FIFTY:** New York has won 50 games this season, the second-most in the National League...Their .617 winning percentage is fourth in the majors and is the second-best in the NL...The team has posted a 50-31 record through the team's first 81 games...Only the 1986 (56-25) and the 1988 (51-29) teams posted a better record through the first 81 games of the season.

**TOTAL DOMINATION:** Since he was recalled from Triple-A, Dominic Smith has appeared in 10 games and is hitting .318 (7-22) with a run, four doubles and two RBI.

**INVADER NIM:** Over his last 13 games, Brandon Nimmo is batting .315 (17-54) with seven runs, four doubles, two home runs, six RBI, two walks with a .333 OBP, a .500 SLG and an .833 OPS...He is batting .295/.389/.481 with 15 extra-base hits in 41 games on the road this year...He has safely hit in eight straight road games, batting .364 (12-33) with five runs, two doubles, two homers, six RBI, two walks with a .405 OBP and a .606 SLG in that span.

**DOMINATING DÍAZ:** Edwin Díaz, the reigning NL Reliever of the Month, has posted a 1-0 record with eight saves, a 0.66 ERA (one earned run/13.2 innings) with 10 hits, three walks and 29 strikeouts over his last 14 appearances since May 27...Overall, he has recorded 18 saves this season, the fifth-most in the majors...He leads the major leagues among relievers with 63 strikeouts...His 17.54 strikeouts per nine innings is the best in the majors...No other reliever has a K/9 rate over 16.00...He has struck out 63 of the 130 batters he faced, good for 48.5%...He is 2-1 with 18 saves, a 1.95 ERA (seven earned runs/32.1 innings), allowing 25 hits and 12 walks...The Mets are 30-3 when Díaz appears in a game this year.

**REDS-METS NOTES:** The Mets have won their last two series at Great American Ball Park... The Mets are 37-22 all-time at the ballpark...Their record at GABP is their best record at any current National League venue since the stadium opened in 2003...That is also the highest win percentage by any NL team when visiting Cincinnati over that time...Courtesy of Sportradar.

**EL JEFF-E:** Jeff McNeil ranks fourth in the majors and second in the National League with a .319 batting average...His batting average has not dropped below .300 since it was .280 on April 22...He is batting .362 (42-116) with 12 doubles, a triple, two home runs, 32 RBI with a .414 OBP and a .534 SLG with runners on base this year...His .362 average ranks ninth in the majors and sixth in the National League...McNeil is batting .342/.402/.483 on the road this year...His .342 average is sixth in the majors and third in the NL.

**ROAD TRIPPIN':** New York is 24-18 on the road this year...Their .571 road winning percentage is the sixth-best in the majors and is the fourth-best in the NL...The Mets finished the first-half of the 2021 season going 19-26 on the road...New York is batting .256/.321/.402 away from Citi Field...Their .256 road average ranks fourth in the majors.

**ADAM EXPLAINS EVERYTHING:** Adam Ottavino has allowed two runs over his last 22 appearances...He is 1-1 with a 0.87 ERA (two earned runs/22.2 innings) in that span with five walks and 18 strikeouts...Overall, he is 2-2 with a 2.67 ERA (nine earned runs/30.1 innings) with 10 walks and 35 strikeouts...In 15 road games, he is 0-1 with a 1.35 ERA (two earned runs/13.1 innings) with three walks and 14 strikeouts...Right-handed batters are hitting .149 (11-74) against him this season.

**STRIKE THAT:** The Mets have struck out 10 or more in a game 41 times this year...That is the most in the majors...Overall, the Mets rank third in the majors with 759 strikeouts this season...On the other side of the ball, the Mets have struck out 615 times this season... That is the fifth-fewest times in the majors and the second-fewest times in the Senior Circuit.

**HURTS DONUT:** The Mets have been plunked a MLB-leading 56 times this year...The Mets have been hit 290 times since the start of the 2019 season...That is first in the majors in that span...Since 2019, Mark Canha has been plunked 64 times, which is the second-most in the majors...Pete Alonso ranks sixth with 46 HBP, while Starling Marte is seventh with 45 HBP and Jeff McNeil is tied for ninth at 37 HBP.

**OUCH:** Brandon Nimmo has been hit by 49 pitches in his career...That is the second-most HBP in team history...Pete Alonso is fourth with 46 HBP...Michael Conforto is the franchise leader with 50 in his Mets career.

**MV-PETE:** Pete Alonso became the third Mets player in team history to record 60 or more RBI before the All-Star break in multiple seasons...He joins Carlos Beltran (2006 and 2008) and David Wright (2006, 2008 and 2010)...The Mets record for most RBI in the first half is 74, accomplished by David Wright in 2006.

**THE GAME OF RISP:** The Mets are second in the majors with a .268 average with runners in scoring position...They rank eighth in MLB with a .341 OBP...Jeff McNeil - .379 (25-66), Tomás Nido - .333 (12-36), Pete Alonso - .311 (23-74) and Dominic Smith - .310 (9-29) are all hitting .300 or better with RISP...Alonso leads the major leagues with 51 RBI in RISP situations...He has 10 home runs with runner(s) in scoring position this year, three more than any other hitter in the majors...Jeff McNeil's .379 average with RISP is eighth in the majors.

**HE'S KEITH HERNANDEZ:** On Saturday, July 9, 2022, the Mets will retire Keith Hernandez's uniform #17 prior to the Saturday, July 9 game vs. Miami...In anticipation of the event, the Mets are counting down 17 moments of Hernandez career with the Mets at metsheritage.com...Hernandez was elected to the Mets Hall of Fame in 1997, ranks second in team history in batting average (.297) and earned six Rawlings Gold Gloves with the Mets, the most in franchise history.

### PETERSON NEWS & NOTES

**LAST START:** Faced the Texas Rangers for the first time in his career on July 1 at Citi field...The southpaw went 6.0 innings allowing three runs on five hits, including solo home runs to Marcus Semien and Nathaniel Lowe... Peterson matched a career-high 10 strikeouts and did not walk a batter for a second straight start...Peterson now has three 10-strikeout games in his career...Prior to his July 1 start, the last time he had 10 strikeouts in a game was April 14, 2021 against the Phillies at home.

**NICE TO MEET YOU:** Peterson is taking the mound against the Cincinnati Reds for the first time in his career...Peterson has faced two NL Central teams in his career, the Cubs and Brewers...Against the NL Central, Peterson owns a 1-2 record, 4.73 ERA (seven earned runs/13.1 innings) with nine strikeouts and six walks.

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN:** In six road outings this season, Peterson has an ERA of 2.17 (seven earned runs/29.0 innings), more than five earned runs lower than his 2021 road total (7.97)...He is 5-6 with a 4.61 ERA (49 earned runs/95.2 innings) in his career on the road.

**SWING AND A MISS:** Peterson has generated at least 14 swings and misses in three straight starts, causing 59 whiffs total in that span...Before this stretch, he had two starts total in his career in which he made opposing hitters swing and miss 14 or more times.

**TAKE A SEAT:** Has 25 strikeouts in his last three starts, which is the fourth-most among Mets starters through a three game span this season...Max Scherzer has the top three spots with 29, 27, and 26 strikeouts in three different three-game spans this season.

**TO THE LEFT, TO THE LEFT:** This season, Peterson has limited left-handed batters to a .176 (9-51) average...He owns the second-lowest opponents' average against lefties among southpaws age 26-or-younger (Min 50 LHB faced).

**ELECTRIC SLIDE:** This season, Peterson has held batters to .160 (12-75) average off his slider and 43 of his 60 strikeouts this season have come via the slider...Last season, opposing hitters batted .299 (20-67) off his slider... Peterson's 52.4 strikeout percentage on his slider is the second-highest in the majors (min. 50 PA) behind teammate Edwin Diaz (54.7)...His slider also ranks first in the majors in put away percentage (38.1) with the next-highest percentage at 35.2.

**WALK THIS WAY:** Peterson did not allow a walk for the second straight start...This is the third time in his career he has not allowed a free pass in a start and the first time he has done so in two consecutive games...Peterson has a total of 28 strikeouts in the

**FOUR-HIT WONDER:** The southpaw has allowed four hits or fewer in six of his 10 starts and eight of his 12 appearances overall this year...He has held the opposition to four hits or fewer in 26 of his 37 career games.

**TAKIN' CARE OF BUSINESS:** Peterson has not allowed more than four earned runs in all 10 of his starts this season...In his career, he has allowed more than three earned runs seven times in 34 career starts, and has allowed three earned runs or fewer in his remaining 27 starts.

### TOMORROW'S STARTER: RHP TREVOR WILLIAMS (1-5, 4.34 ERA)

**LAST TIME OUT:** Went 3.2 innings in his last start against the Texas Rangers on July 2 at Citi Field...Allowed five earned runs, three home runs, while striking out three batters and walking one.

**HOME SWEET HOME:** This season, Williams has made seven appearances (three starts) at Citi Field and is 1-1, with a 3.74 ERA (nine earned runs/21.2 innings) with 25 of his 42 strikeouts coming at home...In 74 career games (59 starts) at home he has a 3.69 ERA (145 earned runs/354.0 innings) with 288 strikeouts and 101 walks.
