# San Diego Padres (74-69) at San Francisco Giants (94-50)

TODAY'S GAME: The Giants are set to face the Padres for the second game of this four-game series...the teams are in the midst of a stretch where they will go head-to-head in 10 of SF's last 19 games to end the regular season...SF has won a season-high eight straight and 10 of their last 11 games overall entering play today.

OCTOBER BOUND: SF clinched a playoff berth last night with its 9-1 win over San Diego...the clinch was achieved in just 144 games, the earliest in franchise history according to *Elias*. (this list does not include 1904, when Giants clinched the NL pennant in fewer than 140 games and but chose not to play in the World

NL HISTORY: The Giants' 94-50 current record puts them in contention for the best record by an NL team in the divisional era...their 94 wins through their first 144 games are tied for third most in the NL since 1969...the 1975 Reds and 1986 Mets each finished the year with 108 wins, which is the best mark for any NL team since 1969...the Giants would need to go 14-4 (.778) for the rest of the season to reach that total...SF went 14-4 (.778) over an 18-game span nine times this year, most recently done last month, from August 8-28.

BEST IN THE BIGS: The Giants (94-50, .653) enter today with the best record in the Majors, just ahead of the Dodgers (92-53, .634)..the .653 winning percentage through 144 games is the club's best in the SF-era and the best by a Giants team since 1913, when they went 96-48 (.667) through their first 144 decisions.

**ON A ROLL:** SF enters today with an eight-game winning streak, their longest since 2016, when they did so twice (May 11-19 and June 11-19)...SF has scored 71 runs during the streak, their most in any eight-game span since 2000 (72) and tied for fifth-most since the franchise moved to San Francisco...the last time SF had a nine game winning streak was when they won 10 straight from May 20-31, 2004.

**HALF A DOZEN**: The Giants have scored at least six runs in each of their last eight games, matching their longest such streak in SF era (also done in 1990 and 1998)...the eight games trail only a franchise-best 15 consecutive games done in 1929, the longest such streak in MLB history since at least 1901...the last MLB team to score at least six runs in nine straight games was Houston, when they did so in 2017 (May 28-June 6).

CONNECT FOUR: Last night's four home run effort was the Giants' 14th game this season with four or more homers, second-most in MLB behind Toronto (15)...the 14 such games are a new franchise record, surpassing the 13 mark done in 1954.

GIVE ME FIVE: With IF Tommy La Stella getting his fifth homer, SF now has 17 players with at least five homer runs, most in Major League history ahead of the 2019 Mariners (16).

**FEELING 23: OF Mike Yastrzemski's** home run last night was his 23rd this season, joining **IF Brandon Belt** as the Giants' two players with at least 23 homers this year...it's the first time since 2010 that the Giants had two players hit at least 23 HRs in the same season (Aubrey Huff and Juan Uribe), and just the sixth time overall since 2000 that SF has had multiple players reach the 23-homer mark in the same season.

TATERS: SF's 217 homers overall are the most the Giants have hit in a season since mashing a franchise-best 235 homers in 2001...overall, the 217 homers are fourth-most in franchise history, four behind the 1947 New York Giants, who hit the third most (221).

#### TODAY'S STARTING PITCHING MATCHUP

RHP Jake Arrieta faces the Giants for the 12th time in his career and second this season...the veteran has gone 5-4 with a 3.98 ERA (27er, 61.0ip) in 11 starts vs. SF and has last faced the Orange & Black on June 4 with the Cubs, when he allowed six runs over 2.0 innings...Arrieta has eight losses in his last 13 starts after winning five of his first nine starts this season.

**RHP Anthony DeSclafani** gets the nod tonight for his eighth career start against the Padres...the right-hander is 1-1 with a 2.90 ERA (13er, 40.1ip) in the seven starts and has faced three times this season, going 0-1 while allowing seven runs in 16.1 innings (3.86 ERA)...SF has won eight of his 11 starts here at Oracle Park this season.

## ANTHONY DeSCLAFANI RHP

2021 RECORD: 11-6, 3.33 ERA

**TODAY'S OUTING:** 31-year-old right-hander will make his 28th start in the second game of this four-game series against the Padres...the 28 starts would be the third-most he's made in a single season in his career behind a pair of 31-start seasons in 2015 and 2019, both win Cincinnati.

**LAST START:** Did not factor in the 7-4 win against the Rockies this last Wednesday...pitched 4.1 innings, allowing seven hits and three earned runs with one walk and five strikeouts...allowed all three runs in the 5th inning before exiting the game.

**VS. PADRES:** Is set to face the Padres for the fourth time this season and eighth time in his career...he is 1-1 with a 2.90 ERA (13er, 40.1ip) in seven starts...DeSclafani is 0-1 this year with a 3.86 ERA (7er, 16.1ip) and a batting average against of .186 (11x59) with 10 strikeouts and 6 walks...DeSclafani has not been credited with a win vs. the Padres since his first start against them back on June 26, 2016 with Cincinnati.

**ON THE HOME FRONT:** Owns a 3.60 ERA (22er, 55.0ip) in 11 starts at Oracle Park this season and has held opposing hitters to a .231... however, in his last three starts here he is fashioning a 1.46 ERA (2er, 12.1ip) and a BAA of.186 (8x43)...SF is 8-3 as a team in his 11 starts this season at home.

**PUNCHOUTS:** His 137 strikeouts this season are the third-most in his career behind his 151 strikeouts in 2015 and his career-best 167 strikeouts in 2019.

**FOR HIS CAREER:** His 11 wins this season are a career high and his 3.33 ERA would be the lowest of his career over a full season...he had a 3.28 ERA in 20 starts in 2016.

**LOOKING FOR A DOZEN:** Only four Giants pitchers since 1990 have won at least 12 games in their first season with San Francisco..DeSclafani is looking to become the fifth and first since **Johnny Cueto** and **Jeff Samardzija** both did so in 2016 (*Stats, LLC*).

NL leaders, he's tied for fourth in complete games (two), tied for 12th in wins (11) and 13th in ERA (3.38).

**THE RIGHT STUFF:** DeSclafani has held right-handed batters to a .326 slugging percentage this season, the 15th-lowest mark in the NL among qualified starters...overall, DeSclafani is holding right-handed batters to a .213 (60x282) batting average against, while lefties are hitting .239 against him.

## **DICK TIDROW** 1947-2021

Senior Advisor to the President of Baseball Operations Dick Tidrow passed away unexpectedly on July 10 in Lee's Summit, M0. He was 74 years old.

A former American League Rookie Pitcher of the Year and 13-year Major League veteran, Dick Tidrow spent 28 seasons in the Giants front office. He came to the organization prior to the 1994 campaign, serving as the club's Major League scout for the American League. Throughout his tenure with the Giants, he held the titles of Special Assistant to the General Manager, Director of Player Personnel, Assistant General Manager for Player Personnel and Senior Vice President and Senior Advisor to the General Manager.

Prior to joining the Giants organization, Tidrow served as a special assignment scout with the New York Yankees from 1985 through 1993. The former right-handed pitcher, nicknamed "Dirt," enjoyed parts of 13 years in the Majors from 1972-84. He was honored as The Sporting News A.L. Rookie Pitcher of the Year as a starter with the Cleveland Indians in 1972, while also capturing pennant and World Series rings as a reliever with the Yankees in 1977 and 1978, respectively. He later pitched for the Cubs, White Sox and Mets. His lifetime numbers show a 100-94 record with 55 saves and a 3.68 ERA.

The San Francisco native graduated from Mt. Eden High School in 1965 and Chabot Junior College in 1967, both located in Hayward. Tidrow also served in the U.S. Marine Corps from 1968-71. He is survived by his wife, Mari Jo, three children— Andy, Matt and Richelle, his grandchild, Trista, and many relatives and loved ones on the West Coast and in the Midwest.
