BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles continue their eight-game homestand against the Blue Jays (1-1), Guardians (1-1, 1 to play), and Reds (3 to play) tonight at Oriole Park at Camden Yards.

🦅 Last night's 9-1 win marked Baltimore's largest margin of victory over Cleveland since an 18-5 win at Camden Yards on June 6, 2021...The nine runs were its most at Camden Yards since September 3, 2024 vs. Chicago-AL (also 9 R).

🦅 The O's are one of four teams in MLB to have multiple wins by eight or more runs this season (also 12-2 at TOR, 3/27), joining the Cubs (3), White Sox (2) and Yankees (2).

🦅 The Birds drew a season-high-tying five walks (4x, last: 4/7 at AZ) yesterday and have drawn at least one walk in 95 straight games dating to July 2, 2024, the longest active streak in MLB and the longest by Baltimore since a 116-game run from June 3, 1995–April 5, 1996...**Cedric Mullins** has drawn a free pass in four straight games, one shy of his career-best five-game run from September 7-11 (G1), 2021.

🦅 Following **Jackson Holliday's** grand slam last night, the O's have hit an AL-best eight grand slams since 2024 and rank third in MLB behind the Diamondbacks (14) and Brewers (10).

🦅 With a win tonight, Baltimore would earn consecutive wins for the first time since concluding the 2024 campaign with a three-game sweep of Minnesota at Target Field and its first series victory of the year...Entering play today, the Birds are one of four teams in MLB that have yet to win back-to-back games, joining the Astros, Braves, and Rockies.

CREATING SEPARATION: Following last night's 9-1 victory, Baltimore has 13 wins of eight or more runs since 2024, ranking fourth in the majors behind New York-AL (15) and Arizona/New York-NL (both 14)...Of the 13 wins, eight have come at Camden Yards.

THE MAGIC NUMBER: The O's are 7-2 when scoring four or more runs this year and winless (0-8) when scoring three or fewer.

🦅 Since 2024, Baltimore is 87-21 (.806) when scoring four or more runs, the fourth-best winning percentage in MLB during that stretch behind San Diego (89-14, .864), Cleveland (84-15, .848), and Houston (80-19, .808)...During that same period, the Birds are 11-60 (.155) when scoring three runs or fewer, the fourth-worst mark in the majors ahead of only the White Sox (12-105, .103), Rockies (14-79, .151), and Diamondbacks (9-50, .153).

🦅 The O's have lost 18 straight games when scoring three runs or fewer dating to September 7, 2024, with their last such victory coming on September 6, 2024 vs. Tampa Bay (2-0).

LONG BALL LIVING: The Birds have hit eight homers over their last four games, tallying multi-homer performances in three of the four contests...This follows a 10-game stretch from March 30 to April 9 in which they hit an MLB-low two homers.

🦅 Tonight, Baltimore looks to homer in a fifth straight game (single-season only) for the first time since August 29–September 2, 2024 (5 G).

🦅 The O's have received eight long balls from their 7-9 hole hitters, tied with the Cubs for third most in the majors behind the Angels and Yankees (both 9 HR).

'PEN PALS: Seranthy Domínguez has thrown 7.0 scoreless innings across seven appearances to open the season, scattering one hit and six walks while striking out eight batters...He has not allowed a hit in six straight appearances, tied for the second-longest streak of his career (also 4/7-19/18), trailing his career-best seven-appearance run from May 29–June 16, 2024...The current six-game run is tied for the second-longest streak in MLB behind AZ's Shelby Miller (7G).

🦅 **Matt Bowman** owns a 1.08 ERA (1 ER/8.1 IP) with three strikeouts across seven appearances...He has not issued a walk in a career-best 13 straight appearances since September 24, 2024...The 13-outing run is the third-longest active run in MLB behind TB's Manuel Rodríguez (16 G) and STL's Phil Maton (14 G).

🦅 **Yennier Cano** has yet to allow a run across 7.1 innings, scattering four hits and one walk while fanning seven...**Bryan Baker** owns a 1.04 ERA (1 ER/8.2 IP) over nine outings.

🦅 Overall, O's relievers have allowed 0.43 home runs per 9.0 innings, the third-lowest mark in the majors behind only the Mets (0.38) and Cardinals (0.39).

ADVANCED TALK: O's batters have produced a collective 46.5 percent hard-hit rate, ranking second in the majors behind only the Yankees (47.1%).

🦅 Last night, Baltimore collected a season-high 17 hard-hit balls (95+ mph exit velocity), its most since September 25, 2024 at New York-AL (18).

🦅 **Gunnar Henderson** has recorded an exit velocity of 102+ mph on 17 of his 26 batted balls (65.4%), posting a 99.3 mph average exit velocity and 69.2 percent hard-hit rate.

NO RISP, NO REWARD: In their seven wins, the O's are batting .355 (22-for-62) with three doubles, one triple and three home runs with runners in scoring position...In their 10 losses, they own a .113 (6-for-53) RISP average with one extra-base hit.

🦅 Baltimore pitching has limited the opposition to a .216 (35-for-162) RISP average, the fourth-lowest mark in the AL and sixth in MLB.

DOWN ON THE FARM: Baltimore affiliates completed an organizational sweep yesterday...**1B Coby Mayo** went 3-for-5 with a double, home run, three RBI, three runs and one walk in Triple-A Norfolk's 15-6 win...Mayo is batting .343 (12-for-35) with four doubles, three homers and 12 RBI over his last 10 games, while his 14 RBI overall are tied for the International League lead.

🦅 **RHP Braxton Bragg** earned the win for High-A Aberdeen after throwing 7.0 scoreless innings, scattering three hits with no walks and seven strikeouts...Through three starts, Bragg has allowed only one unearned run across 16.1 innings, conceding six hits and five walks with 18 strikeouts.

THE FOREST CITY: The O's and Guardians continue their seven-game season series tonight in Baltimore...Cleveland took the 2024 season set, 4-3, winning two of three at Camden Yards from June 24-26...Baltimore is looking for a second straight home win opposite Cleveland for the first time since June 28-29, 2019.

QUICK HITS: Set to make his fourth career MLB start and first of the season against the Guardians...Is the third-ever Japanese player for the Orioles, joining right-handed relievers Shintaro Fujinami (2023) and Koji Uehara (2009-11)...Made five Grapefruit League appearances (4 GS), going 2-1 with a 3.00 ERA (5 ER/15.0 IP) on 11 hits (1 HR) and five walks with 15 strikeouts...His first four outings (10.1 IP) of the spring were scoreless...In his debut, at 35 years, 170 days, became the oldest Japanese player to make his MLB debut since New York-NL's Ken Takahashi (40-016) on May 2, 2009 at Philadelphia.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor in the decision in his Orioles home debut on April 12 vs. Toronto...Allowed three runs on eight hits (1 HR) and two walks in 4.2 innings...Exited with a runner on third, who was stranded...Did not strike out a batter for the first time this season...The three runs and eight hits marked season highs...Threw 73 pitches, 45 strikes.

- 2024 RECAP:** Spent the entire season with the Yomiuri Giants of Japan's Nippon Professional Baseball's Central League...Went 15-3 with a 1.67 ERA (29 ER/156.2 IP), 132 hits (6 HR), 16 walks, four hit batters, and 111 strikeouts in 24 games, all starts...Tossed three complete games, including one shutout...Led NPB in wins and finished second in ERA.
- 🏆 Named Central League MVP.
 - 🏆 Earned a Mitsui Golden Glove Award.
 - 🏆 Surrendered four or fewer runs in all 24 starts, three or less in 23, and one or no runs in 17; tossed six scoreless outings, including his lone complete game shutout on July 28 vs. DeNa (9.0 IP, 7 H, 8 K).

 - 🏆 Helped the Giants secure a bye to the Final Stage of the 2024 Climax Series, NPB's playoff format, with the best record in the Central League (77-59-7)...Suffered two defeats in the series as Yomiuri was eliminated against DeNa...Took the loss in Game 2 after allowing two runs on six hits and one walk with five strikeouts in 7.0 innings...Entered in the ninth inning of a tie game in winner-take-all Game 7 and surrendered one run on two hits.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Sugano compiled a 136-74 record with a 2.43 ERA (501 ER/1,857.0 IP) with 1,568 hits (142 HR), 347 walks (12 IBB), 52 hit batters, and 1,585 strikeouts in 276 career games (248 GS) with the Giants...Was a three-time Central League MVP (2014, 2020, 2024), a three-time Central League Mitsui Golden Glove Award winner (2016-18), an eight-time All-Star (2013-19, 2022), a two-time Eiji Sawamura Award honoree (2017-18), presented to the top pitcher in NPB each season, and MVP of the 2013 Central League Climax Series, the playoff format in NPB...Led the Central League in wins four times (2017-18, 2020, & 2024), ERA four times (2014, 2016-18), and strikeouts twice (2016, 2018)...Earned the triple crown in 2018 after leading NPB in wins, ERA, and strikeouts.

ON THE WORLD STAGE: Pitched for Team Japan at the 2017 World Baseball Classic, pitching to a 3.14 ERA (5 ER/14.1 IP) with one walk and 16 strikeouts in three starts...Tied for the tournament lead in strikeouts with teammate Kodai Senga...Started the semifinal game against Team USA on March 21, 2017, at Dodger Stadium, allowing one unearned run on three hits and one walk with six strikeouts in 6.0 innings.
