BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles dropped both games of a doubleheader yesterday in Detroit, falling 4-3 in game one and 6-2 in the nightcap...This six-game road trip concludes today with the final game in the Motor City...The Birds begin a six-game homestand tomorrow with the

- Yankees (4/28-30) and Royals (5/2-4). The O's were swept in a doubleheader for the first time since September 5, 2022 vs. Toronto...It marked the 20th time the Tigers swept the Orioles in a doubleheader, the first since September 26, 1993, and the first in Detroit since May 24, 1981.
 - In game one, the Orioles struck out 11 Tigers...Marks only the second 10+ strikeout game by 0's pitching since April 4, joining April 18 vs. Cincinnati...For the season, the Birds have fanned 181 batters, second fewest in MLB ahead of the Rockies (178).
 - Baltimore will look to avoid a series sweep for the first time since July 9-11, 2024 vs. Chicago-NL...The current 30-series sweepless streak is tied with the Padres for the longest active stretch in the majors...San Diego has lost its first two games at home to Tampa Bay this weekend and will also look to avoid a sweep today.
 - Ryan O'Hearn, Ramón Urías, and Jordan Westburg all tallied three hits in game one...It marked the second time the Orioles have had three players record three hits in a game this season, joining March 27 at Toronto (Mullins, O'Neill, & Rutschman)...The O's are one of two teams with multiple such games in the majors this year, along with the Cubs, who have done it four times.

 $\underline{\textbf{ROSTER MOVES}}\text{: The O's recalled left-handed pitcher } \textbf{Grant Wolfram} \text{ from Triple-A Norfolk}$ and optioned right-hander **Brandon Young** to the Tides between games yesterday...The club also added right-handed pitcher **Colin Selby** as the 27th man for game two and returned him to Norfolk following the game...Wolfram made his MLB debut in game two, the third Orioles player to do this season along with Tomoyuki Sugano and Young.

<u>RISPY BUSINESS</u>: Baltimore is batting .118 (6-for-51) with runners in scoring position over the last six games since April 20...For the season, the Orioles are hitting .211 (38-for-180) with runners in scoring position, fifth worst in the majors behind the Mariners (.200), Mets (.198), Rockies (.193), and White Sox (.183)...Two seasons ago in 2023, the O's led MLB by batting .287 (379-for-1322) in those situations.

NUMBER ONE SPOT: This series features four former No. 1 overall picks in Jackson Holliday (2022) and **Adley Rutschman** (2019) for the Orioles and Casey Mize (2018) and Spencer Torkelson (2020) of the Tigers.

- Game one yesterday marked the 62nd time since the MLB Draft began in 1965 that four No. 1 selections appeared in the same game, according to STATS Perform...The Orioles have been involved in five of the last six occurrences since 1999...Holliday and Rutschman joined Minnesota's Royce Lewis (2017) and Carlos Correa (2012) on September 27, 2024 at Target Field, Harold Baines (1977) and B.J. Surhoff (1985) joined Anaheim's Tim Belcher (1984) and Darin Erstad (1995) on June 17, 2000 at Oriole Park, and Baines and Surhoff joined Seattle's Ken Griffey Jr. (1987) and Alex Rodriguez (1993) on August 1 and July 30, 1999 at Safeco Field.
- Prior to last season, the last such occurrence came on August 4, 2000, with St. Louis' Andy Benes (1988) and Shawon Dunston (1982), and Atlanta's Chipper Jones (1990) and Surhoff all appearing at Busch Stadium.

CED AND DONE: Cedric Mullins ranks among AL leaders in on-base percentage (3rd, .421), walks (3rd, 19), OPS (4th, .968), and RBI (5th, 20).

**Be He is one of four MLB players leading their team in hits (24), homers (6), RBI (20), and

- walks (19), along with CHC's Kyle Tucker, NYY's Aaron Judge, and SD's Fernando Tatis Jr.
- Mullins has hit two leadoff home runs this season (4/3 vs. BOS & 4/19 vs. CIN)...He had not hit one since September 26, 2022 entering this season...His 18 career leadoff home runs rank second in Orioles history behind Brady Anderson (44).

THE MAGIC NUMBER: The O's are 9-2 when scoring at least four runs this season, though all nine of those victories have featured at least five runs...The Orioles are 1-14 when scoring three or fewer runs after two such defeats yesterday...Baltimore is 1-24 when plating three or fewer runs in a game dating back to September 7. 2024.

(83-16, 2014) Since 2024, Baltimore is 89-21 (.809) when scoring four or more runs, fourth best in the majors behind Cleveland (88-15, .854), San Diego (89-16, .848), and Houston (83-19, .814)...During that same time, the Birds are 12-66 (.154) when scoring three runs or fewer, the second-worst mark in the majors ahead of the White Sox (13-111, .105).

<u>'PEN PALS</u>: The O's bullpen ERA has risen from 2.97 (25 ER/75.2 IP) to 4.68 (51 ER/98.0 IP) since April 20..Entering that game against Cincinnati, the bullpen ranked second in the AL and fifth in MLB in ERA, before falling to 14th in the AL and 23rd in MLB entering today.

- (2) Two of three inherited runners scored yesterday...Baltimore relievers have allowed 22 percent of inherited runners to score, fifth best in the AL and seventh in MLB...Entering yesterday, the O's were third in MLB with an 18.4 inherited runners scored percent.
- Yennier Cano has yet to allow a run across 8.1 innings, scattering five hits and one walk while fanning eight.
- Bryan Baker has allowed one run on eight hits and four walks with 12 strikeouts in 11 outings...He allowed his first inherited runner to score yesterday and has stranded eight of the nine he's inherited this season.

TAKING ON THE TIGERS: The Orioles and Tigers are meeting for the first of two three-game series this weekend...The teams will play at Oriole Park from June 10-12...Detroit has won six of the last seven season series dating back to 2017 (clubs did not meet in 2020), with the lone Baltimore victory coming in 2023 (6-1). θ The O's will look to avoid being swept in a series by the Tigers for the first time since

May 13-15, 2022 (3 G) at Comerica Park.

April 27, 1968 - Baltimore-native Tom Phoebus throws the third no-hitter in Orioles history and the second by one pitcher in a 6-0 win over the Red Sox at Memorial Stadium. Phoebus walked three and struck out nine to join Hoyt Wilhelm (9/20/58), and later Jim Palmer (8/13/69) and John Means (5/5/21), as O's to throw a no-no. The club tossed combined no-hitters on April 30 (G1), 1967 vs. Detroit and July 13, 1991 at Oakland

<u>FEELING THE BURN:</u> When Kremer goes beyond 75 pitches in a start this season, opponents are slashing .565/.583/1.043 (13-for-23) on pitches 76 and later compared to a .267/.293/.477 slashline (23-for-86) on the first 75 pitches of his outings.
