### ST. LOUIS CARDINALS HALL OF FAME WEEKEND

José Oquendo, and Max Lanier will be inducted into the Cardinals Hall of Fame on Sunday during a 10 a.m. ceremony outside Ballpark Village on the stage in Together Credit Union Plaza and recognized as part of a 1 p.m. pregame ceremony at Busch Stadium.

**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The St. Louis Cardinals and New York Mets play the third game of a four-game weekend series tonight at Busch Stadium ... St. Louis is 2-4 on its seven-game homestand against the Oakland Athletics (2-1) and New York Mets (0-2), teams with lowest (\$56.8 million) and highest (\$330.6 million) Opening Day payrolls in MLB this season ... After tomorrow's game, the Cardinals embark on a seven-day, six-game Pennsylvania road trip through Pittsburgh (Mon.-Wed) and Philadelphia (Fri.-Sun).

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** The Cardinals enter the day in 5th place in the NL Central, 12.0 games out of first and 10.0 games back in the NL Wild Card chase ... St. Louis has spent 103 of 138 days in last place on the MLB schedule (April 26-May 19, May 29-July 7 & July 28-present) ... This season is the Cardinals slowest start since 1995 when they were 51-72 (.415) after 123 games ... St. Louis needs to go 27-12 (.692) over the remaining 39 games to finish at .500.

**ZUÑIGA RECALLED:** The Cardinals recalled RHP **Guillermo Zuñiga** from Memphis (AAA) and optioned RHP **James Naile** to Memphis ... The 24-year-old right-handed Zuñiga has appeared in one game for St. Louis this season, striking out **Chad Wallach** and **Mike Trout** in 1.0 scoreless inning on May 2 ... Zuñiga is 0-2 with a 7.85 ERA (28.2 IP), five saves, and 36 strikeouts in 28 games at Memphis this season.

**WINSANITY:** **Masyn Winn** (age 21-150) last night became the 11th starting MLB shortstop since 2000 age 21.150 or younger to record a hit in his MLB debut and the 4th-youngest Cardinals starting shortstop to do so behind **Garry Templeton** (20-138) on Aug. 9, 1976, **Creepy Crespi** (20.210) on Sept. 14, 1938, and **Tommy Thevenow** (20.364) on Sept. 4, 1924.

**SWISS ARMY KNIFE:** This season, Gold Glover **Tommy Edman** has appeared defensively at shortstop (44G), center field (30G), and right field (8G), and tonight will appear in his 30th game at second base to join Pittsburgh's **Ji Hwan Bae** (44 at 2B and 44 in CF) as the only two Major Leaguers this season to have appeared in 30+ games at both second base and center field this season ... Prior to Edman, the only two Cardinals in franchise history to have done so were **Tommy Dowd** (48 at 2B and 78 in CF) in 1896 and **Joe Delahanty** (47 at 2B and 46 in CF) in 1909 ... Including Edman's 44 games at shortstop this season, Tommy has already become the **only player in MLB history to play 27 or more games at second base, shortstop, and center field in a single season.**

**THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (August 19, 2016):** Shortstop **Jedd Gyorko** became the first Cardinal to hit a home run while playing each of the four infield positions during a single season after going yard in St. Louis' come-from-behind, extra-inning 4-3 win at Philadelphia. The only two other Cardinals to have ever done so over multiple seasons during their career were **Jake Flowers** (1926-32) and **Rogers Hornsby** (1916-33)

### NEW YORK CONNECTIONS

**Steven Matz** was originally selected by the Mets in the 2nd round of the 2009 MLB Draft out of Ward Melville High School in East Setauket, NY and pitched parts of his first six seasons (2015-20) in New York...was born in Stony Brook, NY.

**Tommy Edman** doubled off **Steven Matz** for his first career MLB hit (June 14, 2019 at Citi Field).

**Adam Wainwright** (Sept. 11, 2005 at Busch II), **Brendan Donovan** (April 25, 2022 at Busch III), and **Masyn Winn** (Aug. 18, 2023 at Busch III) made MLB debuts against the Mets.

**Richie Palacios** was born in Brooklyn...2015 graduate of Berkely Carroll School in Brooklyn ...favorite professional NY teams are Giants and Brooklyn Nets...favorite athlete growing up was Derek Jeter, and attended his last Yankees home game.

Cardinals Bench Coach **Joe McEwing** played five seasons with the Mets (2000-04)... appeared in 11 games with the Mets during the 2000 postseason as the club reached the World Series...originally traded by St. Louis to New York in exchange for **Jesse Orosco** (March 18, 2000)...played college baseball at the County College of Morris in Randolph Township, NJ, where his uniform is retired.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **José Oquendo** played the first two seasons MLB career with the Mets...traded by New York with **Mark Davis** to St. Louis for **John Young** and **Angel Salazar** (April 2, 1985).

**Adam Ottavino** was selected by St. Louis in the 1st round (#30 overall) of the 2006 MLB Draft... pitched parts of six seasons in the Cardinals minor league organization (2006-11)...made his MLB debut with St. Louis in 2010.

**José Quintana** made one postseason and 12 regular season starts for the Cardinals last season... acquired at the 2022 MLB Trade Deadline with **Chris Stratton** from Pittsburgh in exchange for **Johan Oviedo** and **Malcom Nuñez**.

**Rafael Ortega** was claimed off waivers by St. Louis in 2014 and played two seasons (2014-15) in the Cardinals minor league organization.

**Sam Coonrod** was born in St. Louis...graduated from nearby Carrollton (Ill.) High School...pitched three seasons at Southern Illinois University-Carbondale (2012-14).

Mets Pitching Coach **Jeremy Hefner** pitched his final professional season (2016) in the Cardinals minor league organization.

Mets First Base Coach **Wayne Kirby** played in 98 games for Memphis (AAA) in 1998, where he was teammates with **Ron "Pop" Warner** and **Joe McEwing**...traded by St. Louis to the Mets for **Shawn Gilbert** (June 10, 1998).

Hall of Fame Manager **Joe Torre** played for and managed both the Cardinals (1969-74 & 1990-95) and Mets (1975-77 & 1977-81).

Mets Clubhouse Operations Coordinator **Scott Keltner** previously worked in the Cardinals organization in the Busch Stadium (2016-21) and AutoZone Park (2014-15) visiting clubhouses.

Cardinals Hall of Famer & Mets broadcaster **Keith Hernandez** was selected by the Cardinals in the 42nd round of the 1971 MLB Draft...played 10 seasons in St. Louis (1974-83)...won the 1979 NL MVP Award...named to two National League All-Star teams and won six Gold Gloves.

**Taylor Megill's** older brother, **Trevor Megill**, was originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign, returning to Loyola Marymount (Calif.) University.

Cardinals broadcaster **Ricky Horton** was born in nearby Poughkeepsie, N.Y....graduated from F.D. Roosevelt High School in Hyde Park.

Cardinals reporter **Jim Hayes** was born in New York City and raised in nearby Nyack, NY...graduated from SUNY-Geneseo.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jason Isringhausen** was selected by the Mets in the 44th round of the 1991 MLB Draft...pitched parts of four seasons in New York (1995-97, 1999, 2011).

Cardinals AGM/Player Dev. **Gary LaRocque** previously served as Scouting Dir., AGM & VP/ Player Dev. and Scouting with the Mets from (1998-2005)...appointed VP of Pro Scouting in 2006.

**NL Ranks:** Games Started (26, T-1st\*), Innings Pitched (147.2, 7th), Hits Allowed (160, 2nd), Walks/9 IP (1.77, 2nd), HR/9 IP (0.85, 4th).

- The 2022 N.L. All-Star & the team's Opening Day starter for 2023 is making his MLB-leading 27th start of 2023, 170th career appearance & 142nd career start.
- Has lost three-straight decisions and the Cardinals are just 3-11 in his 14 games started since June 4. He's had 5 Quality Starts in that span and logged 6.0+ IP nine times.
- Received no more than 3 runs of support in 19 of 26 starts this season, including just one run while on the mound in his first four June starts, losing 2-1, 8-4, 6-1 and 3-0.
- Received a five-game suspension and undisclosed fine from Major League Baseball for intentionally throwing at Cubs Ian Happ on July 27. Served the suspension Aug. 2-6.
- His 3.01 ERA at Busch Stadium ranks 15th in MLB in Home ERA since he joined the Cardinals in 2018.
- Came back on two days rest after throwing 3.0 perfect innings (34 pitches) vs. Washington (7/14) in a game that was suspended by weather and picked up a 6-4 win on 7/17 vs. MIA - his first home win since May 30 vs. KC.
- Has crossed the 100.0 innings threshold for the 4th time in his MLB career. Leads the Cardinals in innings pitched (147.2) and is ranked T-2nd on the team in wins (6).
- Has allowed 19 of his 72 runs in the 1st inning (6.66 ERA, .333 BA); His ERA after the opening inning is 3.73 (51 ER/123.0 IP).
- Has not allowed a homer in the 1st inning, joining **Jesus Luzardo**, **Sonny Gray**, and **Marcus Stroman** as the only four pitchers with 20 or more starts without.
- Since joining the Cardinals in 2018, Mikolas leads MLB (min. 700 IP) in fewest walks (137); **Justin Verlander** (142) is 2nd. His 1.60 walks/9 IP are T-1st with **Zack Greinke** (1.60) for the fewest in MLB.
- Hasn't committed an error since 8/2/18 vs. COL. One of two pitchers (Erick Fedde) with 100+ total chances and zero errors since 8/3/18. Ranks 9th among MLB pitchers in fielding pct. (.987) since 2018. (min. 100 TC). Was one of 10 MLB pitchers and two Cardinals (Wainwright) with a perfect 1.000 fielding pct. (31 total chances) in 2022.
- Ranks 2nd among current Cardinals behind only **Adam Wainwright** (2,640.0 IP) in most career innings pitched (779.1) as a member of the Cardinals.
- Ranks 4th among all-time Busch Stadium III leaders in ERA (3.00; min. 300 IP), 9th in all-time wins (22) & 8th in innings pitched (396.0).

**LAST TIME OUT**

- Was cruising allowing two runs over 6.0 innings before allowing two base runners to begin the 7th inning with both coming around to score. Exited leading 3-2, but did not factor in the decision.

- Making his 5th career start (6th app.) vs. the Mets with the previous four starts coming with the Cardinals and one relief appearance in 2012 with the Padres.
- Took the loss in his start earlier this season at Citi Field. Worked 6.0 innings and allowed a season-high six runs on eight hits with the big damage coming with two outs in the 1st inning on back to back run-scoring hits by Brett Baty (2-RBI double) and Tommy Pham (RBI single).
- Earned his lone win against the Mets on April 20, 2019, at Busch Stadium, allowing two runs over 8.0 innings. Faced the Mets again in 2022 at Busch Stadium and left after both he and Max Scherzer pitched 7.0 scoreless innings each for no decisions, as the Mets won late 5-2 with five runs in the 9th inning.
