THIS DATE IN GIANTS HISTORY

MAY 13, 1911

The New York Giants scored a Major League record 10 runs before the St. Louis Cardinals retired the first batter in the 1st inning. **Fred Merkle** drove in six of the Giants' 13 runs in the 1st en route to a 19-5 victory. When Giants manager **John McGraw** decided to save starting pitcher **Christy Mathewson** for another day, **Rube Marquard** entered the game in the 2nd inning and set a record for relievers (since broken) with 14 strikeouts in his 8-inning appearance.

TODAY'S GAME: Winners of three straight games and four of their last five, the Giants play the third game of this four-game series and 10-game road trip tonight here at Chavez Ravine.

- ▶ SF's three-game winning streak matches their longest this season (third time)...it's the first time the club has won three in a row since April 16-18.
- ▶ The Giants look to win four straight games for the first time since Sept. 24-28, 2025.
- ▶ Last night's win was also the first time the Giants have won consecutive games here at UNIQLO Field at Dodger Stadium since sweeping a three-game series here June 16-18, 2023.
- ▶ SF is 4-1 vs. the Dodgers this season...they are 14-23 (.378) against everyone else this year.
- ▶ Each of SF's three home runs and five of their six runs scored last night came with two outs...over their last three games, the Giants are slashing .310/.383/.595 with 10 RBI with two outs and are 15-for-45 (.333) with 17 RBI and 10 walks with runners in scoring position.

RIGHTING THE SHIP: SF's current winning streak comes on the heels of a rough stretch for the club, in which they had lost nine of their previous 11 games.

- ▶ The Giants have scored 22 runs (7.33 runs/game) with five home runs and 12 walks during their three-game winning streak.
- ▶ In the 11 games prior, they were averaging just 2.36 runs per game (26 total runs) with just six homers and 17 walks.

RAY DAY: LHP **Robbie Ray** takes the hill for SF tonight to make his ninth start of the season...the lefty will be facing LA for the 26th time in his career, his most vs. any opponent, and is 9-8 with a 3.74 ERA, 189 strikeouts and a .205 BAA over his 25 career starts.

- ▶ Ray has thrown very well here at Dodger Stadium over his career, going 4-3 with a 2.67 ERA with a .160 opposing average.
- ▶ Overall, Ray's 2.76 ERA this season is his best through eight starts since he had a 2.16 figure with the Dbacks in his first full season in 2015.

HAASE THE BOSS: Last night, **C Eric Haase** homered twice off LA's RHP Yoshinobu Yamamoto to become the first-ever Giants catcher with a multi-HR game at Dodger Stadium...prior to Haase, the last Giants player with two homers in a game here at Chavez Ravine was **David Villar** on September 7, 2022.

- ▶ It was also the first multi-homer game by a Giant this season and the seventh of Haase's career, with his most recent such game coming on July 21, 2024 at Minnesota.
- ▶ Haase's seven multi-HR games since 2021 are tied for fourth-most among primarily catchers, trailing only Cal Raleigh (21), Salvador Perez (15) and Shea Langeliers (eight).
- ▶ His second home run of the game, which came in the 5th inning, was the 50th of his career.
- ▶ Lastly, Haase became the first player to homer twice off RHP Yoshinobu Yamamoto in one game.

LEAVING THE YARD: In addition to Haase's two homers, **OF Harrison Bader** also connected in the 5th to give the Giants three home runs last night, matching their most in a game this season (third time).

- ▶ The homers by Haase and Bader marked the first back-to-back sequence for SF this season.
- ▶ The Giants have now homered in eight straight games, their longest such streak since homering in an SF-era record 18 consecutive games from August 17-September 5, 2025.
- ▶ The eight games rank as the second-longest active home run streak in MLB behind the Phillies (nine)...the Giants are 15-6 (.714) when they homer this season.

DE-FENSE: The Giants turned another double play last night to put them atop of the league with 44 this season...SF's defense has been one of their bright spots this season, with their +18 DRS ranking fourth in the Majors.

- ▶ Leading the way for SF defensively are **IF Matt Chapman** (+7 DRS), **OF Harrison Bader** (+4 DRS) and **IF Luis Arraez** (+3 DRS).
- ▶ Arraez's +8 Outs Above Average are third-best in the Majors, trailing only KC's Bobby Witt Jr. (11) and CHC's Pete Crow-Armstrong (10).

WITH THE GIANTS: The 2021 Cy Young Award winner is in his third season with the Giants and his 13th season overall in the Majors... the 2026 season marks the fifth year of a five-year, \$115 million contract he signed with Seattle in late 2021...he opted into the final two years of the contract prior to the 2025 season with SF.

LAST START: Earned the win in his last start on May 8 against the Pirates...threw 6.0 innings and allowed on earned run on four hits and four walks with seven strikeouts in the Giants 5-2 victory over Pittsburgh...Ray allowed three walks while striking out three in a scoreless 3rd inning...it marked just the third time since 1975 in which a Giants pitcher allowed three walks while striking out three in a single scoreless inning, joining **Jonathan Sánchez** (2nd inning, April 20, 2010 at SD) and **Barry Zito** (4th inning, July 23, 2009 at ATL).

STARTING STRONG: Has pitched at least 5.0 innings and allowed three or fewer runs in all eight of his starts this season...the last Giants to begin a season with eight consecutive such starts were both **Barry Zito** and **Tim Lincecum** in 2010 (*Stats, LLC*)... Ray's 2.76 ERA is his best through eight starts since he had a 2.16 figure with the Diamondbacks way back in 2015.

LACK OF SUPPORT: Has received one or zero runs of support in five of his eight outings...despite his 2.76 ERA, the Giants are just 4-4 over his eight starts...his 2.76 run support average is the fourth-lowest figure in the Majors.

AGAINST THE DODGERS: Will make his 26th career start against the Dodgers, the most against any team in his career...has posted a 9-8 record with a 3.74 ERA, 189 strikeouts and a .205 opponents average over his 25 career starts...has not pitched well recently against Los Angeles-NL, going 1-3 with a 6.66 ERA over his last five starts...posted a 0-2 record with a 7.36 ERA (12er, 14.2ip) in three starts against the Dodgers in 2025...however, he has thrown very well at Dodger Stadium over his career, going 4-3 with a 2.67 ERA with a .160 opponents average.

HOME VS. ROAD: Has pitched better in his five starts at home, going 3-1 with a 1.91 ERA and a .190 opponents average, compared to a 0-3 record with a 4.15 ERA in three starts on the road...has allowed just two runs over his last 17.2 innings at Oracle Park, covering his last three appearances...SF has won each of his last four starts at home and dropped all three of his starts on the road.

LEFT ON READ: Has held lefties to a .167 average (6-for-36) so far this year...over his last four games, lefties have just two hits in 19 at-bats...furthermore, lefties have yet to record an extra-base hit off Ray in their 36 at-bats against him.

RUNNERS ON: Opponents are hitting .333 off him with no one on base and no one out, compared to a .131 average with runners on base...opponents are just 4-for-22 (.182) off him with runners in scoring position and have just one hit in 12 at-bats (.083) with runners in scoring position and two outs.

- ▶ The underlying stats suggest his losing streak is not all on him, as he carries a FIP of 2.52, which is tied for seventh in the Majors amongst qualified starters.

#43 TRISTAN BECK ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball, Sweeper

Last Game: 5/9 vs. RNO; 2.1ip, 2k (23 pitches) (w/AAA)

- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento on Monday...made 13 appearances with the River Cats out of the 'pen and had a 5.40 ERA (10er, 16.2ip) with 18 strikeouts and seven walks.
- ▶ In his last two games with the River Cats last week, Beck combined to throw 4.0 scoreless with one hit, no walks and four strikeouts.
- ▶ Appeared in 31 games for SF last season, working in a bulk innings role...recorded at least four outs in 18 of the 31 games.
- ▶ Batters were 9x64 (.141) with 18 strikeouts off his sweeper in '25.
- ▶ Left-handed batters hit .202 (20x99) with 18 strikeouts off him.

#47 RYAN BORUCKI ▶ LHP

(bohr-RUCK-ee)

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Split Finger, Sweeper

Last Game: 5/10 vs. PIT; W, 2.0ip, 2bb, 1ibb, k (24 pitches)

- ▶ Threw 2.0 hitless, scoreless innings with a strikeout to get his first win as a Giant on Sunday vs. Pittsburgh.
- ▶ Has a 5.06 ERA (3er, 5.1ip) and .316 BAA over his last five games.
- ▶ Lefties are 5-for-29 (.172) with four walks and eight strikeouts vs. him...has held lefties to a .181 clip (72-for-398) in his MLB career.
- ▶ Righties, however, are 12-for-26 with five XBH (two HRs) this year.
- ▶ Signed a Major League contract with the Giants on March 21 after opting out of his minor league deal with the White Sox on March 20...was in camp with Chicago-AL as an NRI and went 2-0 with eight strikeouts and a 0.67 WHIP over 6.0 shutout innings.

#34 JT BRUBAKER ▶ RHP

(BROO-baker)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Cutter, Changeup

Last Game: 5/11 at LAD; 1.0ip, k (12 pitches)

- ▶ In his last five outings, he has a 6.14 ERA (5er, 7.1ip) and .333 BAA (10x30)...in nine games prior, he had a 2.38 ERA (3er, 11.1ip) and .250 BAA (10x40).
- ▶ Has thrown 9.1 scoreless innings in seven appearances on the road...has a 7.71 ERA (8er, 9.1ip) in seven games at Oracle Park.
- ▶ Issued at least one walk in eight of 14 contests (5.30 BB/9.0ip).
- ▶ Right-handers are 13-for-42 (.310) with four XBHs off him while lefties are 7-for-28 (.250).

#93 MATT GAGE ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Splitter

Last Game: 5/12 at LAD; 0.1ip, k (6 pitches)

- ▶ Has surrendered three runs (two ER) in 18.0ip this year (1.00 ERA).
- ▶ Has not allowed an earned run in his last 12g (9.2ip, 4h, 1r, 6bb, 5k).
- ▶ His 1.00 ERA ranks as the fifth-lowest among NL relievers.
- ▶ Lefties are just 2-for-22 (.091) against him this season, and 19-for-105 in his career (.181).
- ▶ His 26.5% hard hit rate ranks in the top 4% of MLB.
- ▶ He's the first wearer of #93 in SF Giants history...#93 is the highest player-worn uniform number in SF-era history, passing No. 87 (worn by RHP Dan Otero in 2012).
- ▶ Originally was a 10th-round pick of the Giants in 2014 before his career journey brought him back to SF last season.

#31 SAM HENTGES ▶ LHP

(HENT-chiss)

Pitch Arsenal: Curveball, 4-Seam FB, Slider, Sinker

Last Game: 5/12 at LAD; 1.0ip, h, 2bb, 2k (32 pitches)

- ▶ Has made two appearances with SF, logging 1.1 scoreless innings with three walks and two strikeouts.
- ▶ This is his first MLB action since July 10, 2024.
- ▶ Missed the entire 2025 season while recovering from left shoulder surgery, performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache in Los Angeles on September 18, 2024...also developed some right knee soreness during his rehab and underwent arthroscopic surgery in August 2025.
- ▶ Returned from rehab and reinstated from the 15-day IL Sunday.
- ▶ In 10 rehab games between Single-A San Jose and Triple-A Sacramento, the lefty had a 1.93 ERA (2er, 9.1ip) with six walks and eight strikeouts.
- ▶ Signed one-year deal with SF on December 3, 2025.

#45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

(kill-EE-en)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 5/12 at LAD; SV, 1.1ip, k (17 pitches)

- ▶ Earned second career save last night.
- ▶ His 1.40 ERA (3er, 19.1ip) ranks as the ninth-lowest among NL relievers.
- ▶ Owns a 24.1% strikeout rate and .138 BAA (9x65) this season.
- ▶ Has a 5.59 BB/9ip...his 15.2% BB rate ranks in the bottom 7% of MLB.
- ▶ Left-handed batters are 5-for-39 (.128) with no XBH against him while right-handers are 4-for-26 (.154) with two homers.
- ▶ Returned to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite this past offseason...dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of 2025 with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.

#63 JOEL PEGUERO ▶ RHP

(jo-EL peh-GAIR-oh)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Changeup

Last Game: 5/12 at LAD; 0.2ip, hb (8 pitches)

- ▶ Activated last Tuesday after 10 rehab games with Triple-A Sacramento...missed SF's first 35 games while recovering from a left hamstring strain that also held him out of most of Spring Training.
- ▶ Has tossed 4.0 innings since returning from the IL, allowing two runs (one earned) on two hits in four games so far.
- ▶ Had a 4.82 ERA (5er, 9.1ip) with 11 strikeouts and a 0.86 WHIP in the 10 rehab outings.
- ▶ Made his MLB debut in 2025 with SF after signing with the org. prior to the season on an MiLB contract...posted a 3-1 record with a 2.42 ERA (6er, 22.1ip), 17 strikeouts and a 1.03 WHIP over 17 games.
- ▶ His sinker averaged 99.8 mph and his four-seamer 99.9 mph last season...his slider averaged 91.6 mph and accounted for 12 of his 15 strikeouts.

#67 KEATON WINN ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, 2-Seam FB, Splitter, Slider

Last Game: 5/11 at LAD; H; 1.0ip, h, k (14 pitches)

- ▶ Leads the team with nine holds, which is tied for the third-most in the Majors.
- ▶ 15 of his 19 appearances this year have been scoreless (2.45 ERA).
- ▶ Opponents are just 9-for-61 (.148) off him this year.
- ▶ Batters are just 5-for-36 (.139) with 13 K's off his splitter.
- ▶ His 84.8 mph average exit velocity ranks in the top 5% of the league while his 25.5% hard-hit rate ranks in the top 4%.
- ▶ His 1.67 xERA is third-best in the Majors behind Mason Miller (0.72) and Dylan Lee (1.64).
