IN THE TRAINER'S ROOM: LHP Brian Fitzpatrick (left elbow), LHP DL Hall (left pectoral), RHP Logan Henderson (back), LHP Jared Koenig (left elbow), OF Brandon Lockridge (right knee), RHP Quinn Priester (right thoracic outlet), RHP Brandon Woodruff (right shoulder), LHP Rob Zastryzny (left trapezius) and LHP Angel Zerpa (left forearm) are on the injured list...Zerpa is on the 60-day IL.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy (385g, 228-157, .592) is in his third season as Brewers manager....he was voted NL Manager of the Year in 2024 and 2025....he is one of four managers ever to win Manager of the Year in consecutive seasons, joining the Braves' Bobby Cox (2004-05), Rays' Kevin Cash (2020-21) and Guardians' Stephen Vogt (2024-25)....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell....he signed a multi-year contract extension on 2/20/26.

COACHES: Returning from the 2025 staff is offense & strategy coordinator Jason Lane (11th season/1st in current role), pitching coordinator Jim Henderson (5th season/1st in current role), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (4th season/3rd in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (8th season), bullpen coach Charlie Greene (3rd season), lead hitting coach Eric Theisen (2nd season/1st in current role) and third base coach Matt Erickson (3rd season/1st in current role)....assistant pitching coach Juan Sandoval, hitting coach Guillermo Martinez, hitting coach Daniel Vogelbach and first base coach Spencer Allen are all in their first seasons on the coaching staff.

IN THE STANDINGS (72 days): The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each spot in the NL Central standings: **FIRST:** 34, **SECOND:** 10, **THIRD:** 8, **FOURTH:** 13, **FIFTH:** 7....the Brewers are currently in first place, leading the second-place Cardinals by 5.0 games, third-place Pirates by 5.5 games, fourth-place Cubs by 6.5 games and fifth-place Reds by 7.5 games.

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The Brewers are 13-5-2 in series play....the team is 8-1-2 over its last 11 series.

AT HOME: The Brewers are 21-13 at home, going 7-3-1 in series play....the team has a pair of season-high 5-game winning streaks coming from 4/30-5/12 and 5/25-6/2.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 17-10 on the road, going 6-2-1 in series play....the team is 9-2 in its last 11 road games.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 21 replay challenges this season, going 16-5....their last challenge (lost) came on 5/30 at Houston as a safe call at home plate involving Cam Smith stood.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have qualified for the postseason seven times in the last eight seasons and three seasons in a row....the team was just two games away from making the postseason in nine straight seasons (2017-25), missing out in both 2017 and 2022 by a single game....Milwaukee has won the NL Central in four of the last five seasons and three seasons in a row.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last eight full seasons (2017-25)....this does not include the shortened 2020 season....the Brewers have 801 wins since 2017, which ranks fourth in the majors behind the Dodgers (894), Astros (835) and Yankees (825).
