### VS. BLUE JAYS

The Mariners and Blue Jays meet for the first time since the M's won a 3-game series in Seattle from July 3-5...the clubs meet at Rogers Centre for the first time since last year's American League Championship Series.

**TODAY'S TILT**...the Mariners continue the 6-game road trip with the second of 3 games against the Toronto Blue Jays (0-1)...the M's will also visit the Boston Red Sox (3 G, 8/31-9/2) on the road trip...Seattle is coming off a successful 4-2 homestand against the Chicago Cubs (2-1) and Philadelphia Phillies (2-1)...today's game will be televised and streamed on **Mariners TV** with **Aaron Goldsmith** and **Ryan Rowland-Smith** on the call and **Brad Adam** serving as field reporter...the game will also be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Gary Hill Jr.** and **Angie Mentink** on the call.

**ODDS & ENDS**...the Mariners fell to the Blue Jays in last night's series opener by an 8-1 final score...despite the loss, the Mariners are 7-5 over their last 12 games (8/15-c).

- **In The Mix With Six** - The Mariners are 41-27 (.603) when their starting pitcher goes 6.0+ innings, and 23-44 (.343) when they do not.
- **Ward You Believe It? - Taylor Ward** ranks T-1st in the Majors with 94 walks this season, alongside Bryce Harper-PHI and just ahead of the next closest Yordan Alvarez-HOU (93 BB)...he also ranks T-1st in MLB in multi-walk games with 23, joining Mike Trout-LAA.

**THE RANDY RUNDOWN**...**Randy Arozarena** went 1-for-2 with a pair of walks in last night's game...in 127 games this season, Randy is batting .273 (128x469) with 85 runs, 26 doubles, 1 triple, 20 home runs, 58 RBI, 56 walks and 20 HBP, reaching base at a .372 clip and slugging .461 for an .833 OPS...Randy recorded his 6th consecutive 20+ home run and 20+ stolen base season, becoming the 11th player in MLB history with at least 6 such seasons and the 5th to do it in at least 6-consecutive seasons, joining Barry Bonds (9, 1990-98), Bobby Bonds (7, 1969-75), Bobby Abreu (7, 1999-2005) and Willie Mays (6, 1955-1960).

- **Grab the Clutch** - Over his last 16 games since Aug. 11, Randy has recorded 8 extra-base hits, including 6 home runs that have each been a game-tying or go-ahead home run...on Aug. 22 vs. CHC, Randy hit both a lead-off and walk-off home run, becoming the 7th player in MLB history to accomplish the feat...Randy's 6 game-tying or go-ahead home runs in August lead the Majors, ranking ahead of Pete Crow-Armstrong-CHC (5 HR) and Pete Alonso-BAL (5 HR).

*"[The Postseason] is what we're fighting for. We're fighting to get a playoff berth, and it's something we've been talking about since Spring Training. There are ups and downs throughout the season, but right now we're fighting together to get that spot."*

**HOLY CANNOLI, DOM!**...**Dominic Canzone** went 2-for-4 with his 20th home run of the season in last night's game, the first time he has reached the 20+ homer mark in his career...over his last 16 games since Aug. 9, Canzone is batting .313 (20x64) with 6 runs, 4 doubles, 2 home runs, 10 RBI, 6 walks, a .380 on-base percentage and slugging .469 for an .849 OPS in 71 plate appearances...he has reached base safely in 15 of those 16 games, hitting safely in 13... overall this season, 'Dom' is batting .259 (95x367) with 47 runs, 21 doubles, 1 triple, the 20 homers, 59 RBI, 37 walks and 2 stolen bases, reaching base at a .333 clip while slugging .485 (.818 OPS).

**KEEPING UP WITH KADE**...LHP **Kade Anderson**, Seattle's No. 1 prospect by *MLB Pipeline*, is set to make his 2nd career start today...Anderson made his Major League debut at T-Mobile Park on Aug. 22 against the Cubs, tossing 5.2 innings and allowing 3 runs (3 ER) on 5 hits (2 HR) and 2 walks with 5 strikeouts...over 18 starts with Double-A Arkansas prior to his selection, he went 10-1 with an outstanding 1.06 ERA (11 ER, 93.1 IP), 0.64 WHIP, and 135 strikeouts....Anderson, who was 22 years and 47 days old at the time of his debut, became the youngest player to start his MLB debut with the Mariners since RHP Taijuan Walker (21 years, 17 days) on Aug. 30, 2013 vs. HOU.

**RALEIGH ON THE RISE**...**Cal Raleigh** has reached base safely in 10 of his last 11 games (8/16-c), batting .267 (8x30) with 6 home runs, 9 RBI, 10 walks, a .465 on-base percentage and slugging .867 for a 1.317 OPS in 40 plate appearances...over his last 33 games (7/20-c), Raleigh has posted a .750 OPS with 9 homers, 23 RBI, a .320 OBP and a .431 slugging percentage...Raleigh is 2 home runs away from his fifth consecutive 20+ home run season and would become the 18th catcher (min. 50% of games at catcher in a season) in MLB history to record five or more seasons with 20+ homers, and the ninth to do it before turning 30 years old.

**CAL THE BIRD HUNTER**...in 37 career games against Toronto, including the Postseason, **Cal Raleigh** is batting .267 (35x131) with 28 runs, 4 doubles, 16 homers, 31 RBI and 18 walk, reaching base at a .351 clip and slugging .661 for a 1.021 OPS...in 28 regular season games against the Blue Jays, Raleigh is batting .255 (25x98) with 18 runs, 2 doubles, 11 home runs, 24 RBI and 13 walks with a .336 on-base percentage, .612 slugging percentage and .949 OPS...Cal's .612 slugging percentage ranks 4th-highest all-time against the Jays (min. 100 PA), trailing only Russell Branyan (.783 SLG), Shohei Ohtani (.699) and Corey Seager (.615).

**NAYLOR'S SECOND HALF SURGE**...in 35 games since the All-Star Break (7/17-c), **Josh Naylor** is batting .313 (42x134) with 13 runs, 6 doubles, 2 home runs, 11 RBI, 10 walks, 7 stolen bases, a .363 OBP and slugging .403 for a .766 OPS, reaching base in 31 of those games...his .313 batting average in the 2nd half ranks 9th in the American League and T-14th in MLB among qualified hitters...he also ranks T-4th in stolen bases during that span along with José Ramírez-CLE.

**WALTER ON DECK**...tomorrow's starter, RHP **Logan Gilbert**, is 11-7 with a 3.36 ERA (58 ER, 155.1 IP), 162 strikeouts, 39 walks and a 1.024 WHIP in 26 starts this season...he is one of 10 pitchers in the American League to reach the 10+ win mark this season, ranking 6th in the AL overall.

**AS YOU MAY KNOW**...**Dominic Canzone** hit his 20th home run of the season last night, becoming the 3rd Mariners player to reach the 20 homer mark in 2026, joining **Randy Arozarena** and **Julio Rodríguez**, but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...Seattle is one of only 3 teams in the American League to have 3 players each with a 20+ home run season?...Canzone, Arozarena and Rodríguez join the Minnesota Twins (Byron Buxton, Kody Clemens and Brooks Lee) and Chicago White Sox (Colson Montgomery, Munetaka Murakami and Miguel Vargas) as the only such teams in the AL.

## ON THIS DATE IN MARINERS HISTORY - AUGUST 29

- **1982** - The Mariners' Gaylord Perry tied the Major League record shared by Walter Johnson and Cy Young, striking out 100 batters or more for the 18th time. Perry fanned three Detroit batters in the Mariners 6-2 win.
- **1990** - The Mariners sign free agent Ken Griffey Sr. (released by CIN on Aug. 18), putting father and son on the same team.
- **1996** - Mark Whiten's ninth inning grand slam off Randy Meyers beats the Orioles 9-6 in the Kingdome. Alex Rodriguez goes 5-5 raising his league leading average to .373.
- **2000** - Edgar Martinez hits a game-winning grand slam in 8th inning, his 4th of the season, setting a team record, and his 8th grand slam overall.

ABOUT KADE ANDERSON...

- The 22-year-old left-handed pitcher is set to make his 2nd career start and 1st ever start against the Blue Jays.
- Drafted by the Seattle Mariners in the 1st round (3rd overall) of the 2025 MLB First-Year Player Draft from Louisiana State University (Baton Rouge, LA)...he was the highest selection by the Mariners since catcher Mike Zunino (3rd overall in 2012).
- Spent 2 seasons at LSU (2024-25) where he was named College World Series Most Outstanding Player after helping lead the Tigers to their 8th national title in 2025...did not pitch in 2023 while recovering from Tommy John surgery.
- Was born in Slidell, LA and attended St. Paul's School in Covington (LA).

**LAST TIME OUT...**made his Major League debut on 8/22 vs. CHC, tossing 5.2 innings and allowing 3 runs (3 ER) on 5 hits (2 HR) and 2 walks with 5 strikeouts and did not factor into the decision...he threw 81 pitches including 53 strikes while inducing 11 swings and misses.

**ABOUT THE DEBUT...**became the 23rd pitcher in franchise history to throw 5.2+ innings with 3-or-fewer earned runs allowed in their MLB debut, joining current starters **Bryce Miller** (5/2/23 at OAK) and **George Kirby** (5/8/22 vs. TB), and is the 5th left-handed pitcher to do so in franchise history (last: Mike Montgomery, 6/2/2015 vs. NYY)...also became the 10th pitcher in franchise history to throw 5.0+ IP with 3-or-fewer earned runs allowed and 5+ strikeouts in their MLB debut...joins Miller, Kirby and **Matt Brash** (4/12/22 at CWS) as the most recent players to do so.

IN HIS OWN WORDS

*"I've had the opportunity to pitch in some pretty big games, and I used those games to help me through this one," Anderson said. "Obviously, there's going to be some jitters, but I feel like I controlled them pretty well and got through those pretty quick...It's just another game, and I feel like when you have that mindset, it clearly just calms the nerves a little bit."*

**LATEST DEBUTANT...**was the first player from the 2025 Draft to debut this season...is also the 6th player (4th pitcher) to debut for the Mariners this year, joining RHP Alex Hoppe (4/27 at MIN), RHP **Nick Davila** (5/3 vs. KC), RHP **Domingo González** (5/12 at HOU), INF **Colt Emerson** (5/17 vs. SD) and INF **Brock Rodden** (8/14 at HOU).

**FINAL NOTES...**at 22 years and 47 days, he was the youngest starter to debut for the Mariners since RHP Taijuan Walker (21 years, 17 days) on Aug. 30, 2013 vs. HOU and was the first lefty to start his MLB debut with the Mariners since Yusei Kikuchi on March 21, 2019 at OAK at the Tokyo Dome in Japan.

**DOMINATED IN DOUBLE-A...**across 18 career starts with Double-A Arkansas this season, he went 10-1 with a 1.06 ERA (11 ER, 93.1 IP), a 0.64 WHIP, 135 strikeouts, 13 walks and 3 quality starts while limiting batters to a .147 average...among all minor league pitchers at the time of his MLB debut (min. 80 IP), he led MiLB in ERA (1.06), strikeout-to-walk ratio (10.38), strikeout rate (40.5%), WHIP (0.64) and opponent batting average (.147).

**ALL EYES ON HIM...**is currently ranked the top pitching prospect in MLB and No. 5 overall by *MLB Pipeline*...entered the 2026 season ranked as the Mariners No. 2 prospect and top pitching prospect (*MLB Pipeline*).

**THE FUTURE IS BRIGHT...**was selected to the 2026 MLB Futures All-Star Game in Philadelphia where he made the start for the American League Team...tossed a scoreless inning in the Futures Game...was joined by Travelers teammate, Mariners No. 2 prospect and MLB No. 8 overall prospect (*MLB Pipeline*) RHP **Ryan Sloan**.

**DOWN ON THE FARM...**did not allow an earned run in 13 of his 18 Double-A starts, including each of his last 4 outings since July 24 across which he logged 20.2 consecutive scoreless innings...he allowed 2-or fewer runs over 4.0 IP in 17 of his 18 minor league starts and on July 24, recorded 5.0 perfect innings with 7 strikeouts...allowed no hits over 5.0 innings twice and allowed 3-or-fewer hits in 14 of his 18 starts...struck out 9+ batters in 7 starts, and 7+ batters in 13 of his 18 outings with Arkansas, including a career-high 11 strikeouts in just his 2nd ever start of his pro career.

**LOONEY PLATOONS...**across his 18 Double-A starts, he limited opponents to a .147 average (47x319)...limited left-handed hitters to a .170 average (17x100) with just 2 extra-base hits for a slashline of .224 / .230 / .454...was even more efficient against right-handed batters, limiting them to just a .137 average (30x219) with 98 strikeouts and a slashline of .164 / .210 / .374.

**FARM GROWN TALENT...**became the 33rd player drafted by the Mariners to make their debut as a starting pitcher with the team and is the 6th player to do so since 2018 joining **Logan Evans**, the most recent Mariners pitcher to make his debut as a starting pitcher, and the Mariners current starting rotation in **Emerson Hancock**, **Bryan Woo**, **Bryce Miller**, **George Kirby**, and **Logan Gilbert**.

**AMONG THE AWARDS...**was named Texas League Pitcher of the Week five times this season and was named Texas League Pitcher of the Month in June 2026, going 4-0 with a 0.79 ERA (2 ER, 22.2 IP), 0.62 WHIP, 32 strikeouts and 3 walks allowed in four starts...has also been named the Mariners Minor League Pitcher of the Month three times this season (April, May and June).

**"THEY PICKED A WINNER"**...before he was drafted, Anderson dominated at the college level for LSU...in 2025, he went 12-1 with a 3.18 ERA (42 ER, 119.0 IP) while leading NCAA with 180 strikeouts in 19 starts for the Tigers...he also led the team to their 8th national title that season and was named CWS Most Outstanding Player...in his Game 1 start of the MCWS against Coastal Carolina, he allowed 3 hits with 10 strikeouts in a complete game shutout, becoming the 3rd pitcher to throw a complete game since the best-of-three finals were introduced in 2003...was also named First Team ABCA/Rawlings All-American and 2025 Baseball America College Pitcher of the Year in 2025.

*"I came here to win. They picked a winner, honestly. When I was at LSU, we won, and that was the coolest moment of my life, but now I have this opportunity to play for the Mariners. Obviously, everyone's goal is to win. It's a lot easier said than done. I think that's one thing that I can really bring to the table, that I've experienced those kinds of things. I think it starts with the people that are in the locker room, I really believe that."*
