REVIVING BASEBALL IN INNER CITIES (RBI)

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JAYS CARE FOUNDATION IS OFFERING THE OPPORTUNITY TO HOST THE RBI BASEBALL PROGRAM AT YOUR SCHOOL!



What is RBI?

RBI is a program offered to Toronto schools by Jays Care Foundation in partnership with Major League Baseball. It is designed to teach kids the game of baseball and give them the opportunity to represent their school, build relationships with their peers and develop a love and passion for sport.





Who is the program for?

Schools that host an RBI Program can choose whether they want to offer the program for Grades 5/6 or Grades 7/8 (Note that there are only a limited number of openings for each age group depending on where your school is located).

How often does the program run?

All RBI Programs will be lead after school twice a week for 8 weeks beginning April 15th and will culminate with a one-day championship tournament in mid-June. For Weeks 1 and 2, all program days will be practices. Beginning in Week 3, teams will participate in one practice per week as well as an organized game against a nearby school.

o Grades 7/8 RBI: Mondays and Wednesdays o Grades 5/6 RBI: Tuesdays and Thursdays

Who runs the program?

RBI is a program jointly run by each individual school and Jays Care Foundation. Each school is responsible for providing at least one teacher liaison to be present at all practices and games. For schools who require additional support, Jays Care provides an RBI head baseball coach who leads the program alongside a teacher or guidance counsellor from the school. Jays Care is also able to provide 1-2 volunteer assistant coaches (all of whom have completed a Vulnerable Sector Check).

Is there any cost to the program?

All costs associated with the RBI Program are covered by Jays Care Foundation.

As a Jays Care RBI partner, your school will receive:

- 1-3 Baseball Coaches
- Uniforms for each player
- Field bookings and permits
- Transportation to and from games
- Championship tournament with awards
- Special all-star opportunities for select players
- Tickets to a Blue Jays game for your team

As a Jays Care RBI partner, your school is responsible for:

- Providing 1-2 teachers who are present at all practices and games
- A practice facility at your school (i.e. soccer field, school yard, gym, etc.)
