BIRD WATCHING: The St. Louis Cardinals continue their longest road trip of the season today (11 games in 10 days) with a day/night double header to open a 5-game series in Cincinnati...the Cardinals won on both Sat. & Sun. in Chicago to take the weekend series at Wrigley Field and win their season series over the Cubs...this week's 5-game series in Cincinnati is the longest the two teams have played here in the Queen City since a 5-game set August 7-10, 1952 at Crosley Field...it's the 2nd double header against the Reds after a pair of rainouts Memorial Day weekend and it's the team's 3rd DH this season (0-1-1)...the Cardinals have won a season best four consecutive series (at NYY, vs. COL, vs. PHI, at CHC)...including today's games, the Cardinals have 38 games remaining in the regular season with 15 at home and 23 on the road.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis enters play today in 3rd place in the National League Central, 13.5 games behind 1st place Milwaukee; 3.0 games ahead of 4th place Pittsburgh and 3.5 games out of the final National League Wild Card position...the Cardinals are 7-3 in their last 10 games, 10-10 in last 20 and 13-17 in last 30...they are 33-34 vs. teams that are currently above .500 and 30-27 vs. the sub .500 teams.

CARDS/REDS TWINBILL TIDBITS: In **1989**, LHP **Ricky Horton** started and came away with no-decisions in three DHs over a nine-game stretch (all Game 2s), culminating on August 18 at Riverfront Stadium.

- **Sept. 7, 1993:** **Mark Whiten** went yard a franchise record 4 times with an MLB-record-tying 12 RBI in G2 of DH at Riverfront Stadium in Cincinnati.
- **Aug. 27, 2002:** **Chuck Finley** pitched a two-hit shutout to defeat the Reds 5-0 in G2 at Cinergy Field, thanks to a five-run first inning and a **Scott Rolen** 3-run HR.
- **2019 Labor Day weekend:** The Cards and Reds played back-to-back DHs that was part of 5 games for St. Louis over 49-hours.
- **2020:** After an MLB-record 17-day COVID-related layoff, the Cardinals played 11 doubleheaders over 21 days, but none against Cincinnati.
- **Sept. 17, 2022:** the Cardinals swept the Reds in a twinbill at Busch III while limiting Cincy to one unearned run over 20 combined innings, marking the first time St. Louis played more than 18 innings on one day and did not allow an earned run (since 1912) - *Elias*
- **2025**, St. Louis became just the 3rd team in the last 40 seasons (excluding 2020) to play six doubleheaders in their first 75 games, joining the 2022 Guardians (6th in Games 74-75) and 2021 Mets (6th in Games 67-68). - *Elias*
- **April 30, 2025:** the Cardinals scored 15 runs in their first doubleheader sweep in Cincinnati since June 28, 1959 at Crosley Field.
- **May 23, 2026:** Cardinals rookie **Bryan Torres** makes his MLB debut and hits his 1st career HR in Game 1; Game 2 goes to 11 innings.

ON THIS DATE: On August 17, 1937 the Cardinals beat the Reds, 8-6, in nine innings at Crosley Field...because of weather issues, the final out of the two-and-a-half-hour contest is recorded at 12:02 a.m., making it the first time a major league game had been completed after midnight...the first MLB night game was played at Crosley Field on May 24, 1935.

CINCINNATI CONNECTIONS

Terry Francona played in 86 games in 1990 with the Louisville Redbirds (AAA), including five at pitcher...his father, **Tito Francona**, played parts of two seasons (1965-66) with St. Louis...became a Cardinal via trade by Cleveland in exchange for a player to be named (Dec. 15, 1964)...originally signed by the St. Louis Browns before the 1952 season (MLB debut for Baltimore in 1956).
César Prieto made his MLB debut at Cincinnati on Aug. 29, 2025 & collected 1st MLB hit on Aug. 31 off **Emilio Pagán**.
Caleb Ferguson pitched in 26 games (one start) for the Reds this season...was born in Columbus, OH...graduated from West Jefferson High School.
Hall of Famer **Scott Rolen** played his final four seasons with the Reds (2009-12)...won the 2010 Gold glove and was a two-time All-Star (2010-11).
Reds Asst. Pitching Coach **Matt Tracy** was born in St. Louis...graduated from Christian Brothers College HS.
Justin Bruihl pitched for the Reds Triple-A Louisville affiliate in 2024.

Riley O'Brien made his MLB debut with Cincinnati (Sept. 28, 2021 at Guaranteed Rate Field).
Bryan Torres made his MLB debut at Cincinnati on May 23, 2026 (G1)...singled off Chris Paddock for his first MLB hit and homered off Jose Franco.
Julio Rangel served as Bullpen Coach for the Reds in 2019.
Pierce Johnson pitched three seasons (2010-12) at Missouri State University...set the school's single-season record with 119 strikeouts in 2012.
Cardinals.TV broadcaster **Mark Sweeney** played outfield for both the Cardinals (1995-97) and Reds (1999).
Cardinals Hall of Famer **Vince Coleman** played in 33 games for Cincinnati in 1996.
Reds Senior Advisor **Cam Bonifay** played two minor league seasons with the Cardinals...worked for St. Louis as a professional scout and special asst.
Reds Special Asst. to the GM **John Morris** played five seasons (1986-90) with the Cardinals.

Reds President of Baseball Ops **Nick Krall** previously interned for the New Jersey Cardinals of the NY Penn League (SS).
Reds broadcaster **Jeff Brantley** pitched in 48 games for St. Louis in 1998.
Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played 13 games for the Reds in his final season (2010).
Cardinals Hall of Famer **Julían Javier** played in 44 games for the Reds during his final 1972 season.
Reds Senior Advisor **Eric Davis** played two seasons (1999-2000) for St. Louis.
Cardinals Principal Owner and Chief Executive Office **William DeWitt Jr.** was a prior owner of the Reds and shareholder of the Cincinnati Bengals...his father, **William O. DeWitt**, was a sole owner of the Reds from 1961-67.
Reds CEO **Robert Castellini**, Chairman **W. Joseph Williams Jr.** and Vice Chairman **Thomas Williams** were Cardinals investors from 1995-2006...interests were sold as a condition of their acquisition of a controlling ownership stake of the Reds.

TODAY'S GAME 1 STARTING PITCHER:

- Selected as the 27th player for today's split doubleheader.
- Making his 2nd Major League start, previously making his Major League debut at Toronto on August 1.
- Became the 8th Cardinal and 5th Cardinals pitcher to make his debut this season.
- Was the first Cards starting pitcher to make his Major League debut in Canada since **Rick Ankiel** on August 23, 1999 at Montreal's Olympic Stadium vs. the Expos.
- Cardinals 4th round draft pick out of Stanford University in 2023.
- 2024 Cardinals and Baseball America Minor League Pitcher of the Year.
- Posted a 5-3 record with a 3.13 ERA over 19 starts at Memphis (AAA), striking out 111 batters over 92.0 innings pitched and a 1.14 WHIP.
- Leads the International League in strikeouts (111), opponent BA (.170) ; ranks in the Top 10 in ERA (3.13, 2nd), games started (19, 2nd), innings pitched (92.0, 5th) and WHIP (1.14, 4th).
- Since the start of 2024, ranks 2nd in all of Minor League Baseball with 437 strikeouts, trailing only the Mets' Jonah Tong (448). Tied for the MiLB lead with 71 starts and ranks 4th in qualifying ERA (3.19).
- Led all of Minor League Baseball with 202 strikeouts in 2024; T-7th most in a single season by any Cardinals minor league pitcher (since 1962).

LAST TIME OUT: Wednesday, August 12 at Durham (AAA-Rays): ND, W, 7-3; 4.0 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 3 BB, 5 SO - 68 pitches

- Threw 68 pitches, his fewest since May 9 at Toledo in a game he allowed six runs over 1.1 innings before being removed.
- Held the opposition to one run and exited with a 5-1 lead as Memphis held on for a 7-3 win; did not qualify for the win, pitching 4.0 innings.

2026 SEASON:

- Began the season in the Memphis (AAA) rotation.
- Struck out a season-high 10 batters over 7.0 innings in a 7-3 Redbirds win vs. Durham (7/24) the start before his MLB debut.
- Since May 28, has a 4-1 record with a 1.99 ERA and 76 strikeouts over 63.1 innings pitched (10.8 K/9 IP) including a 1.01 WHIP.
- Made four scoreless starts with three of them 6.0 innings or more with a season-high 7.0 IP, two-hitter at Gwinnett (Braves).
- Has not logged more than 93 pitches in any start (7/24 vs. Durham).
- Held his opposition to three hits or less in 15-of-21 starts.

- Threw a 156-pitch complete game in the Stanford Super Regional win against Texas on June 11, 2023, striking out 16 batters.
- Has a strong interest in cryptocurrency and before baseball wanted to pursue a career as an investment banker.
- Boasts that he's the best player at any board game and is often seen playing pub trivia at Cardinals Spring Training.
- His older sister, Remy, played soccer at Rice University (2017-18).

MATHEWS vs. CINCINNATI

- Faced Louisville (AAA) with Memphis on June 4 and pitched 6.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball with 9 strikeouts.
- Started opposite Chad Petty in that game and faced current Reds on that Bats roster (TJ Friedl, Hector Rodriguez, Jose Trevino & Michael Toglia) who went a combined 0-for-9 with 3 strikeouts.
- Also made a start vs. Louisville (3/29/25) and faced Noelvi Marte (0-3); and two against Daytona (no active players on Cincinnati roster). Reds on today's active roster are a career 0-for-12 vs. Mathews.

TONIGHT'S START:

- Making his 24th start of the season and his 85th career start (193rd career appearance); Andre has put together three consecutive 20+ start seasons with 31 in 2025 & 20 in 2024.
- Enters on a 32.0-inning homerless streak, T-16th-longest active streak in MLB.
- Looking to become the NL's 4th starter with 13-or-more wins.
- Pallante's 12 wins in his first 22 starts were the most since 2015: **Carlos Martinez** (12-3) and **Michael Wacha** (13-4).
- Makes his 6th career start in a doubleheader, going 1-1 with a 4.50 ERA (12 ER/24. IP) in the previous five. Most recently pitched Game 1 of a double dip in an 8-1 win on 5/23 at CIN (6.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R, 1 BB, 3 SO).
- Andre is the first Cardinal since **Joaquin Andujar** (1983-84) to bounce back from a 15+ loss season and win 10 or more games the very next season; Andujar lost 16 games in 1983 but then produced a 20-win season in 1984 and a 21-win season in 1985.
- Is 2-0 with a 1.80 ERA (6 ER/30.0 IP) since the All-Star Break that ranks 4th in the NL (min. 5 starts).
- Owens an 10.58 Run Support Average on the road (highest in MLB) but just 3.12 at home ... He's received 3 runs or fewer in 12 of his 14 Home starts, yet 5 runs or more in 7 of his 9 Road starts.
- Making his his 193rd career appearance to tie **Mark Littell** for 62nd all-time among Cardinals pitchers. He has joined **Adam Wainwright** (478 starts), **Carlos Martinez** (274), **Lance Lynn** (206), **Miles Mikolas** (204) and **Chris Carpenter** (198) since 2000 to reach both 193 career games pitched for St. Louis while also making 80-or-more starts.
- Is 7-0 in 9 road starts (St. Louis is 7-2), his 7 road wins are T-1st in the NL, and he joins **Jesus Lizardo** (7-0) as the only undefeated pitchers in MLB with 7+ road victories.
- Has made 9 consecutive road starts of 5.0+ IP, one shy of **Kyle Leahy's** team-high 10 straight such starts on the road.
- Leads all current Cardinals pitchers in career starts (84), wins (36), and innings pitched (590.0).**
- Began the season with 10 consecutive starts of 5.0+ IP (March 31-May 23), first Cardinal to do so since RHP **Sonny Gray** ran off 10 straight such starts to begin 2024.
- Made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for the 5th time (2022-26) most among active Cardinals.

LAST TIME OUT (Tuesday, August 11 at Busch Stadium): ND, W, 2-0; 6.0 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 3 BB, 2 SO - 97 pitches.
