ORIOLES NOTES

- The Orioles fell to the Rangers, 5-3, in game two of the three-game set...Marked their first series loss since May 5-7 at Atlanta (1-2) and first at home since April 7-9 vs. New York-AL (1-2)...Are now 11-2-1 in their last 14 series beginning April 10...Have lost back-to-back games for the first time since May 14-15...Fall to 10-10 in day games.
- **RHP Dean Kremer** was dealt the loss in his 50th career game after allowing three runs on five hits with two walks and five strikeouts in 6.1 innings...Left the game with a runner on base, who later scored...Threw 97 pitches, 63 strikes.
- **RHP Mychal Givens** appeared in his first game at Oriole Park since August 23, 2020 vs. Boston.
- **SS Jorge Mateo** snapped an 0-for-8 skid with a single in the third inning...Swiped his 15th bag of the season and is tied for fourth in MLB for stolen bases as of the end of today's game; had gone a season-high six straight games without a steal (last: 5/19 at TOR).
- **LF Austin Hays** hit his sixth homer of the season in the seventh inning, a 411-foot blast to put the O's on the board...Has driven in six runs in his last seven games and seven in his last 10.
- **3B Ramón Urías** recorded an RBI double in the ninth, his first base hit since being reinstated from the Injured List yesterday.

RANGERS NOTES

- The Rangers defeated the Orioles, 5-3, to win their fifth straight road series...Are now 7-1-1 in their last nine series and 11-2-1 in their last 14...Have won five consecutive series away from Globe Life Field for the first time since also winning five straight from May 20 to June 19, 2016...Improved to 33-18, the team's best record through their first 51 games of a season in franchise history (since 1961)...Lead MLB with 327 runs as of the end of today's game.
- **LHP Andrew Heaney** earned his fourth victory of the campaign after allowing one run on four hits (1 HR) with one walk and three strikeouts in a season-high 7.0 innings...Marks his fourth consecutive quality start and sixth in his last seven outings...Completed 7.0 innings for the first time since August 18, 2021 vs. Boston with New York-AL; tossed at least 7.0 frames for the 23rd time in his career...Threw 95 pitches, 59 strikes.
- **C Jonah Heim** recorded his sixth multi-hit game this month and 13th of the season after hitting a pair of singles...Entering today's game, was tied for the second-most multi-hit games by a catcher in MLB this season...Snapped an 0-for-14 skid dating back to May 21.
- **SS Corey Seager** has hit safely in four consecutive games after singling in the third inning...Slashing .306/.325/.639 (11-for-36) with three doubles, three homers, seven runs scored, 14 RBI, and two walks in nine games since returning from the Injured List on May 17; despite not driving in a run, still leads MLB with 14 RBI since being reinstated from the IL through today's game.
- **3B Josh Jung** doubled in the fourth inning to extend his hitting streak to a career-high-tying 10 games (also 4/11-22)...Has recorded an extra-base hit in six straight games since May 21.
- **2B Marcus Semien** extended his season-long hitting streak to 16 games and on-base streak 24 games with a two-run single in the seventh inning...His 16-game hitting streak is the second-longest streak of his career, trailing a 17-gamer from June 4-20, 2019 with Oakland, and the second-longest active streak in MLB as of the end of today's game.
- **CF Leody Taveras** doubled in the seventh inning to extend his hitting streak to seven games...Has hit safely in 19 of 22 games this month, including nine multi-hit efforts...Is slashing .392/.449/.532 (31-for-79) in May compared to .204/.271/.315 (11-for-54) in April.
- **RF Adolis García** recorded his eighth outfield assist of the season in the second inning, extending his MLB lead through today's game...Has 34 outfield assists since the start of 2021, the most in MLB during that time.
