FOREST RAKE: Matt Wallner has reached safely in 11 of his 13 starts this season... below are his number comparisons over his overall first 15 games played this season:

GOOD PLACE TO START: In their first 10 games of the season, the Twins starting staff went 1-5, 6.90 ERA (45.2 IP, 35 ER), with 17 walks, 42 strikeouts, a .314 opponent batting average and 11 home runs allowed...

BREAK THE BROOM: Minnesota is looking to avoid being swept today for the second time this season, the other was in three games at St. Louis to open 2025, from March 27-30.

ED START: Edouard Julien has hit safely in five-straight games, tied with Ty France for longest hit streak by a Twin this season...

- ☞ Is making his third consecutive start and the fifth in seven tries against an American League Central team.
- ☞ In three career starts against Detroit, is 1-1 with a 3.24 ERA (16.2 IP, 6 ER)...last faced the Tigers on July 2, 2024 at Target Field (ND, 5.2 IP, 4 H, 3 ER, 2 HR, 2 BB, 4 K).

LAST TIME OUT: Took the loss, his first of the season, on April 7 at Kansas City...allowed four runs on eight hits (1 HR), with four walks and six strikeouts over 5.2 innings...surrendered a sixth-inning home run to Kyle Isbel to put the Royals up 4-1...four walks allowed tied his career high, first set on June 14, 2024 vs. the Athletics at Target Field.

☞ The Royals' two first-inning doubles marked the first time Woods Richardson has allowed multiple doubles in one inning since June 20, 2024 vs. Tampa Bay.

2024 RECAP: Began the season with Triple-A St. Paul (3 GS, 0-1, 6.08 ERA, 13.1 IP)...made his first major league start of the season and secured his first career victory as the 27th man in game two of an April 13 doubleheader in Detroit (6.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R/ER, BB, 5 K)...officially joined the starting rotation on April 25 vs. Chicago-AL (5.0 IP, 7 H, 2 R/ER, BB, 6 K) and did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 6-3 win...finished 5-5 in 28 starts with a 4.17 ERA over 133.2 innings (48 BB, 117 K); Twins were 17-11 in Woods Richardson's starts.

☞ Through first four starts, he held a 1.74 ERA (20.2 IP, 17 H), walking five and striking out 21.
☞ His 2.70 ERA across eight starts in April/May led the team and ranked 15th among American League pitchers with at least five starts.

HERE TO STAY: Since joining the Twins' rotation full-time on April 25, 2024, ranks second among Twins starters (minimum 50.0 IP) in games started (29), and ranks third in innings pitched (137.1) and total pitches (2404)...is tied with Joe Ryan for the third-fewest home runs (17)...in his 29 starts since the Twins are 17-12, their best record behind a single starting pitcher (next best is 17-13 in Pablo López's starts).

AGAINST DETROIT: Has gone 1-1 in three career starts against Detroit, posting a 3.24 ERA (16.2 IP, 6 ER, 3 HR) with five walks and 12 strikeouts...last faced the Tigers on July 2, 2024 at Target Field; did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 5-3 victory...allowed three runs on four hits (2 HR), with two walks and four strikeouts...both home runs came in the fifth inning, a leadoff shot by Justyn-Henry Malloy and a two-run homer by Ryan Kreidler to put the Tigers ahead 3-2.

☞ SWR made his major league debut against the Tigers on October 2, 2022 at Comerica Park...took the 2-5 loss after allowing three runs on three hits (1 HR), with two walks and three strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work.

☞ Is making his fifth start in seven outings against an American League Central team, dating back to his September 8, 2024 start at Kansas City...in that span, is 0-2 with a 4.34 ERA (18.2 IP, 9 ER), nine walks and 19 strikeouts against divisional opponents; Twins are 1-3.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Making his first start of the season at Target Field...went 0-2 with three no-decisions in his last five home starts of 2024 (6.89 ERA, 15.2 IP, 18 H, 12 ER, 7 BB, 15 SO)...in his career, is 1-2 in 14 games (13 starts) at Target Field with a 4.63 ERA (68.0 IP, 35 ER), 28 walks and 67 strikeouts, compared to 4-5 in 18 road starts with a 4.24 ERA (85.0 IP, 40 ER), 30 walks and 69 strikeouts.

☞ In five career starts facing American League Central teams at Target Field, Woods Richardson is 1-1 with a 4.05 ERA (26.2 IP, 12 ER), 8 walks and 27 strikeouts...of the four home runs he has allowed in such games, three of them led off their respective innings.

PLATOON SPLITS: In his career, Woods Richardson has a .267 (66-for-247) opponent batting average against lefties with 25 walks and 55 strikeouts, compared to a .242 (82-for-339) opponent batting average against righties with 33 walks and 81 strikeouts...lefties are slugging .397 with eight home runs while righties are slugging .401 with 11 home runs.

☞ In Woods Richardson's two starts of the season, lefties are slashing .533/.556/.867 with two walks and two strikeouts, while righties are slashing .208/.296/.292 with three walks and nine strikeouts.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP JOE RYAN (2025: 1-1, 2.65 ERA // CAREER: 34-27, 3.88 ERA)

Right-hander Joe Ryan is set to start tomorrow's series opener against the New York Mets at Target Field...last started on April 9 in Kansas City, earning his first victory of the year...in 7.0 scoreless innings, gave up just two hits, struck out four, and did not walk a batter, his fourth consecutive outing without allowing a base-on-balls...has never faced the New York Mets...in 20 career Interleague starts, is 6-8 with a 5.72 ERA (102.1 IP, 65 ER), 26 home runs, 26 walks and 111 strikeouts.

CAREER NOTES

- In 2025, pitched in the Twins' season-opening rotation for the first time in his career.
- In 2024, pitched a career-high 147.0 professional innings (MiLB and MLB).
- In 2024, finished second among all rookies in Twins history (minimum of 125.0 innings pitched) in strikeouts-per-9.0-innings pitched (7.9) and swing and miss percentage (22.3%); finished fifth in opponent batting average (.246), tied for fifth in strikeouts (117), sixth in opponent OPS (.695), eighth in WHIP (1.29) and 11th in fielding independent pitching (4.04) in 2024.
- Struck out 26 batters in June 2024, the most among AL rookies and tied for fifth most among all rookies in baseball...also ranked third among AL rookies in innings pitched (26.0).
- Entered 2024 ranked by *Baseball America* as Minnesota's No. 29 prospect.
- In 2023, finished second on Saint Paul's staff with 113.2 innings and 22 starts.
- Was named Twins Minor League Pitcher of the Week on September 10, 2023 after allowing one run in a 6.0-inning, five-strikeout start at Louisville.
- In 2023 with Triple-A Saint Paul, went 7-1 with a 3.03 ERA (71.1 IP, 24 ER), 35 walks, 60 strikeouts and a .205 opponent batting average in his final 14 games (12 starts) from June 20-September 20.
- Made only MLB appearance of 2023 on April 22 vs. Washington, allowing five runs on seven hits in 4.2 innings of relief.
- Entering 2023, was ranked eighth-best prospect in Minnesota organization by MLB.com and 10th-best by *Baseball America*.
- Made major league debut Oct. 2, 2022 in Detroit, allowing three runs (two earned) on three hits and taking the loss in a 5.0-inning start...at 22 years and five days, was the youngest pitcher to make big league debut in 2022.
- Reached Triple-A level for the first time in 2022, pitching 36.2 innings with a 2.21 ERA for St. Paul.
- With Wichita, was named Texas League Pitcher of the Month in April 2022, going 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA, seven walks and 18 strikeouts in 21.2 innings.
- While in Tokyo, was traded to Minnesota alongside Austin Martin in exchange for José Berrios...finished season with Double-A Wichita, posting a 6.75 ERA in four appearances.
- Made Team USA's roster for the 2021 Tokyo Olympics but didn't appear in a game for the silver medal-winning Americans.
- In 2021, participated in first MLB Spring Training as a non-roster invitee with Toronto.
- Finished 2019 with High-A Dunedin as the youngest pitcher in Florida State League, going 3-2 with a 2.54 ERA in six starts.
- Made professional debut with GCL Mets on July 22, 2018, earning the save in a hitless, one-inning appearance.
- Selected by New York-NL in the second round of 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Kempner High School (TX).
