THE TWINS: After completing their six-game roadtrip with a record of 3-3 (1-2 at Washington and 2-1 at Cleveland), the Twins began their nine-game homestand with a 1-1 split of the first two games against the Marlins...today, Minnesota will continue the homestand with the three-game series finale against Miami...starting tomorrow night, the Twins will host Milwaukee for three games over the weekend, then host Houston for three games from Monday-Wednesday. ☞ Twins have gone 2-5 in rubber games this season...their two wins were April 12 at Toronto and Sunday at Cleveland...their five losses were March 29 at Baltimore, April 5 vs. Tampa Bay, April 23 at New York-NL, April 29 vs. Seattle and May 7 at Washington. ☞ Twins are playing their 21st day game today...20 day games, entering today, are tied for fourth-most in baseball...Minnesota is 8-12 during the day.

SKI-U-BLAH: The Twins lost to former Golden Gopher Max Meyer and the Marlins last night at Target Field by a score of 9-5...Simeon Woods Richardson (0-6) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing eight runs (6 earned) on seven hits in 3.0 innings pitched...the offense recorded eight hits, two apiece from Byron Buxton, Austin Martin and Kody Clemens...Buck homered twice, including a leadoff homer...it marked his 19th career multi-homer game, good for third-most in club history (since 1961), trailing Harmon Killebrew (35) and Justin Morneau (20)...Clemens also added a homer, his fourth of the season.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Zebby Matthews and utility player Ryan Kreidler from Triple-A St. Paul. ☞ Matthews has made seven starts for the Saints this season, going 3-2, 4.72 ERA (34.1 IP, 18 ER), 11 walks, 33 strikeouts and a 1.51 WHIP...over his last three starts for St. Paul since April 26), he has gone 3-0, 2.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 4 ER), six walks, 18 strikeouts, a 1.11 WHIP and a .219 opponent batting average. ☞ Kreidler has hit .266 (25-for-94) with seven doubles, five home runs, 15 RBI, 19 walks, three stolen bases, 15 runs scored and an .889 OPS in 26 games with the Saints this season...he hit safely in eight of his 10 May contests for St. Paul, going 13-for-41 (.317) with four doubles, three home runs, 10 RBI, seven walks, a 1.051 OPS and five multi-hit games...this is Kreidler's second stint with the Twins this season, went 3-for-14 (.214) with one double, two home runs, four RBI, four walks, two runs scored and a 1.103 OPS in five games between April 11-22 (4 starts at third base and 1 in centerfield). ☞ To make room for Matthews and Kreidler on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Travis Adams and outfielder Matt Wallner to St. Paul.

FROM BEACH TO LAKE: Twins and Marlins are playing each other for the 28th time in their history today...Twins are 13-14 against the Marlins, going 7-6 in Minnesota (2-1 at Metrodome and 5-5 at Target Field) and 6-8 in Miami (2-1 at Dolphin Stadium and 4-7 at loanDepot Park). ☞ 27 games against Miami are the fewest for Minnesota against any opponent in their history.

LEAD ROLE: Buxton hit his third leadoff home run of the season last night and 23rd of his career...below are Twins (since 1961) all-time leadoff homers (left) and MLB leadoff homers since 2025 (right):

15-POINT BUCK: Byron Buxton has homered 15 times in his last 26 games (123 PA), since April 13...since that date, he leads baseball in home runs, two ahead of second-place Kyle Schwarber (13)...despite the early season homer drought, Buck's 15 home runs still rank tied for second in the AL on the entire season (tied for 3rd in MLB). ☞ Since April 21, he has not gone more than three games without hitting a home run. ☞ Over the last full calendar year - since May 14, 2025 - Buck has hit 41 home runs in 128 games...over his last 162 games (since April 1, 2025), he has hit 50 home runs. ☞ Buck is on pace to finish the season with 56 homers...single-season career-high is 35 (2025).

TWINS GO FOR THE MEATLOAF: With a win today, the Twins will earn their fifth series win of the season...they have gone 4-8-1 in series play, 2-3-1 at home and 2-5-0 on the road...season results in the right margin. >> ☞ Twins last series win over Miami was July 30-August 1, 2019 in Miami, taking two of three...their last series win over the Marlins at home was June 7-9, 2016, taking two of three. ☞ They are seeking their first series win over an NL team since taking two of three against San Diego at Target Field from August 29-31, 2025.

MAKING LEFTIES POPULAR AGAIN: Minnesota is facing a left-handed starter for the 17th time in 44 games...they have gone 5-11 against left-handed starters this season...their five wins were April 2 at Kansas City vs. Kris Bubic (5-1), April 7 vs. Detroit against Tarik Skubal (4-2), April 8 vs. Detroit against Framber Valdez (8-6), April 11 at Toronto vs. Eric Lauer (7-4) and April 13 vs. Boston against Garrett Crochet (13-6). ☞ Twins have dropped their last six when a lefty starts: April 15 against Boston vs. Connelly Early, April 17 against Cincinnati vs. Brandon Williamson, April 18 against Cincinnati vs. Andrew Abbott, April 25 at Tampa Bay vs. Shane Bieber, May 1 against Toronto vs. Patrick Corbin and May 8 at Cleveland against Parker Messick. ☞ The 17 lefty starters are tied with Philadelphia for the most any MLB team has faced this season. ☞ Since July 5, 2025, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .368 (35-for-95) with a .470 on-base percentage and a .975 OPS vs. left-handed pitching...since that date, his .470 on-base percentage and batting average both lead baseball (min. 100 PA)...his OPS ranks seventh. ☞ Austin Martin is hitting .311 (14-for-45) with 14 walks, a .475 on-base percentage and a .920 OPS vs. left-handed pitching this season...dating back to July 5 of last season, Martin ranks fourth in baseball in on-base percentage (.441) and seventh in average (.330).

FAST BREAK: Twins stole two more bases last night (Bell & Martin), giving them nine over their last three games...Minnesota now has stolen 22 bases in its last 18 games, since April 25...in that span, they are tied with Miami for second-most in baseball, trailing Cleveland (29)...in those games, Minnesota is 22-for-24 in stolen base attempts. ☞ Bell stole his fifth career base in the first inning last night, swiping second base in a first-and-third double-steal attempt...marked his first steal since September 27, 2018 - 978 games between steals.

TWO WORDS: NAZ-REID TIME ADJUSTED: Due to Game 6 of the Wolves-Spurs Western Conference Semifinals across the street tomorrow night at Target Center, the Twins have shifted the start time of their home game vs. the Brewers to a 6:10 pm (CT) first pitch, rather than 7:10 pm as previously scheduled...Target Field gates will now open at 4:00 pm for the Twins pregame Friday Happy Hour, featuring \$2 beers, \$2 hot dogs, \$2 snacks and a live performance by The Johnny Holm Band.

- Zebby Matthews will make his first MLB start of the 2026 season and 26th of his career this afternoon against the Miami Marlins.
- Matthews has made seven starts for Triple-A St. Paul to begin the year, compiling a 3-2 record with a 4.72 ERA (34.1 IP, 18 ER), 11 walks and 33 strikeouts.
- Made his last start for the Twins on September 23, 2025 at Texas, earning the win in a quality start; fired 7.0 innings of one-run, four-hit ball with no walks and six strikeouts in that game.
- This afternoon will be Zebby's first time facing Miami and his seventh career start against a National League opponent.

LAST TIME OUT (TRIPLE-A): In his most recent outing with Triple-A St. Paul on May 8, Matthews earned the win and went a professional career-high 8.0 innings at Las Vegas, allowing three runs on 10 hits (2 HR), with two walks and five strikeouts...in the outing, Zebby threw an efficient 95 pitches, 66 of them being for strikes (69.5%).

GETTING HOT AT THE RIGHT TIME: With the win in Vegas, Zebby extended his win streak to three games dating back to April 26 at Indianapolis...in those three starts, Matthews has thrown 18.0 innings to the tune of a 2.00 ERA with six walks and 18 strikeouts; in comparison, Zebby was 0-2 with a 7.83 ERA (16.1 IP, 14 ER), five walks and 15 strikeouts in his first four outings for the Saints.

2026 SEASON (TRIPLE-A): Overall, Matthews has a 3-2 record for the Saints in 2026, with a 4.72 ERA (34.1 IP, 18 ER), 11 walks, 33 strikeouts, a .297 (41-for-138) BAA, nine homers allowed and a 1.51 WHIP through seven starts...Zebby leaves St. Paul leading in IP (34.1), strikeouts (33), and tied for first in wins (3).

MAJOR LEAGUE NUMBERS (CAREER): Zebby Matthews will make his 2026 season debut this afternoon; this will be Zebby's third season pitching in MLB after spending parts of 2024 and 2025 in Minneapolis.

2025 MLB RECAP: Made a career-high 16 starts for the Twins, going 5-6 with a 5.56 ERA (79.1 IP, 49 ER), 24 walks, 88 strikeouts and a 1.49 WHIP...was recalled by the Twins on May 18, 2025 and spent the majority of the summer with the club, with the exception of a stint on the injured list from June 8-July 19...from August 1 through the end of the season, finished third on the Twins with 46.0 innings pitched (Ober - 54.1, Ryan - 49.2)...wrapped up his campaign with a quality start at Texas, earning the victory by going a MLB career-high tying 7.0 innings and allowing one run on four hits (1 HR) with zero walks and six strikeouts.

2024 MLB RECAP: Made nine starts for Minnesota, from August 13, 2024 through the end of the season...went 1-4 with a 6.69 ERA (37.2 IP, 28 ER), 11 walks, 43 strikeouts and a 1.65 WHIP.

INTERLEAGUE NUMBERS: Zebby's start against the Marlins will be his seventh against an interleague opponent; through six starts he is 2-3 with a 4.34 ERA (29.0 IP, 14 ER), six walks, 29 strikeouts, a .261 (30-for-115) BAA and a 1.24 WHIP...his last two starts have both been quality starts (July 25, 2025 vs. WSH and August 29, 2025 vs. SD) and he is 2-0 with a 1.50 ERA (12.0 IP, 2 ER), zero walks and 10 strikeouts in the two start span.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Zebby has gone 3-4 with a 7.14 ERA (51.2 IP, 41 ER), 14 walks, 63 strikeouts and a .326 (72-for-221) BAA in 12 career major league starts at home, compared to 3-6, 4.96 ERA (65.1 IP, 36 ER) with 21 walks, 68 strikeouts and a .274 (73-for-266) BAA in 13 career major league starts on the road.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: Through 25 career major league starts, lefties are slashing .316/.372/.572 with 13 doubles, 17 home runs, 23 walks and 68 strikeouts, while righties are slashing .278/.313/.401 with 11 doubles, six home runs, 12 walks and 63 strikeouts against Matthews.

2026 MINORS SPLITS: Through his seven starts with St. Paul, lefties are slashing .314/.397/.627 with two doubles, one triple, four home runs, seven walks and seven strikeouts, while righties are slashing .287/.326/.552 with four doubles, two triples, five home runs, four walks and 26 strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL (2025): Zebby used a six-pitch mix while with the Twins in 2025...here are some of his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant.

His 38.5% whiff rate on his slider was the highest whiff rate of any pitch thrown by a Twin in 2025 (min. 300 pitches).
