# San Francisco Giants (78-79) at Arizona Diamondbacks (87-70)

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Giants and Diamondbacks play the middle game of this three-game series...SF is 5-6 against ARI this season, having gone 3-4 at Oracle Park and 2-2 here at Chase Field.

- ▶ The Giants will continue to look to keep playing the role of spoiler...last week, they took two of three from the Orioles at Camden Yards before sweeping three games from the Royals at Kauffman Stadium.
- ▶ SF seeks to keep their winning streak alive as they enter tonight having matched their season-high with four wins in a row, the fifth time this year that they've won four-straight.
- ▶ The last time the Giants won more than four-straight was last season, when they won seven consecutive games from July 8-18.

**IT'S BEEN AWHILE: IF Matt Chapman** hit his first career inside-the-park home run last night off Diamondbacks' LHP Eduardo Rodriguez.

- ▶ It marked the Giants' first inside-the-park homer since **Denard Span** accomplished the feat on August 19, 2017 vs. Philadelphia.
- ▶ It was the Giants' first inside-the-park homer on the road since **Andres Torres** had one on July 4, 2010 at Colorado.
- ▶ Chapman also tripled last night to become the first Giants player with an inside-the-park homer and a triple in the same game since **Monte Irvin** on July 18, 1953.
- ▶ It was the eighth inside-the-park homer hit this season.

**3 FOR 30: IF Matt Chapman** is now just three home runs away from reaching the 30-HR plateau, something no Giants player has accomplished in 21 seasons since **Barry Bonds** hit 45 home runs in 2004.

- ▶ Chapman is slugging .698 with six home runs in his last 14 games...he's looking to become just the fifth Giants third baseman with a 30-homer campaign, joining **Jim Ray Hart, Sid Gordon, Matt Williams** and **Mel Ott**.
- ▶ **Matt Williams** is the last Giants third baseman to hit 30+ homers in a season (43 in 1994).
- ▶ Chapman has reached 27 home runs in a season for the fourth time in his career...he has ended the year with 27 home runs twice before and set a career-high in homers with 36 in 2019.

**HEATING UP:** The Giants are 8-2 (.800) on the road this month despite playing four teams with winning records (Padres, Orioles, Royals & Diamondbacks)...only San Diego (5-1) has a better road record this month.

- ▶ SF is 6-1 on their final road trip of the year, a nine-game trek at Baltimore (2-1), Kansas City (3-0) & Arizona (1-0).

**KEEP IT GOING: IF Matt Chapman** is the first Giant to have a season with at least 25 home runs and 15 stolen bases since **Hunter Pence** in 2013...he's the first Giant third baseman ever to do so and the first NL third baseman to hit those marks in a single season since the Reds' **Todd Frazier** in 2014 (*Stats, LLC*).

**STARTING STRONG:** Giants starting pitchers have limited opponents to three earned runs or fewer in each of their last 15 games, posting a 2.35 ERA (20er, 76.2ip) in that stretch.

- ▶ In fact, in the last week (since Sept. 15), Giants starters have given up a total of just eight runs in 43.1 innings (1.66 ERA) while holding opponents to a .158 average against.

**THE 200-INNING MARK:** With 198.2 innings this year, **RHP Logan Webb** should reach the 200-inning plateau for the second consecutive season...no other pitcher is within shouting distance of accomplishing that feat this year.

- ▶ The last Giants pitcher with 200+ innings pitched in back-to-back seasons was **Jeff Samardzija** (2016-17).

**WALK THE LINE:** Since taking over the closer's role on August 9, **RHP Ryan Walker** has converted all 10 of his save opportunities while allowing just three runs (2er) in 18.2 innings...he's struck out 28 and walked just four in that time while opposing hitters have batted .138 (9-for-65).

- ▶ Since the All-Star break, Walker has allowed four earned runs in 28.2 innings for a 1.26 ERA in 27 games...his 1.30 ERA since the break is the fifth-best among NL relievers.

**CONGRATS TO BRYCE!:** Top Giants prospect, **Bryce Eldridge** was named the Giants' Minor League Player of the Year by *Baseball America*.

- ▶ Eldridge, who was drafted 16th overall by SF in 2023, is completing his first full minor league season and spent the 2024 campaign between four minor league affiliates - San Jose (A), Eugene (A+), Richmond (AA) & Sacramento (AAA).
- ▶ Eldridge combined to hit .289 with 27 doubles, two triples, 23 home runs, 91 RBI and 59 walks in 116 games between the four levels while posting a .513 SLG, .372 OBP and .885 OPS.

**TRYING TO FINISH ABOVE .500:** The Giants will need to win four of their final five games (two at ARI, three vs. STL) to finish with a winning record (82-80) for the second time in the last eight seasons (107 wins in 2021)...SF finished last season at 79-83 (.488).

**This Date in Giants History**

**SEPTEMBER 24, 2001 - Barry Bonds** walked in his first two at-bats and then hit his 67th home run in the 7th inning to give the Giants a 2-1 win over the Dodgers at Dodger Stadium...it was Bonds' 35th homer on the road, a Major League record.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor in the decision last Thursday at Baltimore in SF's walk-off loss to the Orioles...worked 5.0 innings and gave up three runs on four hits with eight strikeouts...the right-hander needed 96 pitches in the outing and walked two.

**VS. ARIZONA:** Is slated to face the Dbacks for the 12th time in his career and second this season...spun 7.0-shutout innings with just two hits and five strikeouts last time he faced them on April 18 at Oracle Park...overall, he is 6-3 with a 2.51 ERA (19er, 68.0ip), 18 walks and 56 strikeouts in 11 career starts vs. Arizona...Webb's 2.51 ERA against the Dbacks is fourth-best among active pitchers, trailing teammate **Blake Snell** (1.99), Walker Buehler (2.07) and Kenley Jansen (2.50) (min. 50ip).

**ON THE LEADERBOARDS:** Webb leads all NL pitchers in innings this season at 198.2 and ranks second in MLB, just behind KC's Seth Lugo (204.2ip)...the right-hander also ranks among the top of the NL leaderboards in quality starts (19, T-3rd), FIP (2.97, 3rd), fWAR (4.3, 5th) and ERA (3.58, 12th).

**MR. 200:** Webb enters today just four outs shy of reaching the 200.0 inning mark this season...after leading the Majors in innings last year (216.0), Webb could be the first Giants pitcher to throw at least 200 innings in two consecutive seasons since **Jeff Samardzija** did so in 2016 and 2017.

**KEEP 'EM IN THE YARD:** Webb given up just 11 homers this season (tied for third-fewest among qualified pitchers) and has surrendered a total of six homers over his past 16 starts (99.1ip)...Webb's 0.50 HR/9ip this season would be a career-best and currently ranks as the second-best figure in the Majors, trailing only ATL's Chris Sale (0.46).

**THE SPLITS:** Below is a look at Webb's numbers within the confines of Oracle Park this year versus what he's done on the road.

**BOOTS ON THE GROUND:** Through 32 starts this year Webb owns a 56.9% ground ball rate, fourth-best in the Majors behind HOU's Framber Valdez (61.6%), ATL's Max Fried (59.5%) and PHI's Christopher Sánchez (59.1%)...he leads the Majors with 314 produced ground balls this season.

**FIRST IMPRESSIONS:** Webb has struggled in the first inning this season, allowing 19 runs on 36 hits in his 32 outings...his 5.34 ERA in the inning ranks as the sixth-highest figure among qualified NL pitchers...however, the numbers indicate Webb has been mostly unlucky in the inning...his 2.62 FIP in the inning is the fifth-best figure in NL, with his .370 BABIP ranking as the fourth-highest in MLB and second in the NL to Gomber (.422).

**DADDY LONG LEGS:** Webb has finished at least 7.0 innings on 15 different occasions so far this season, most of any pitcher in the Majors...however, the right-hander hasn't reached the 7.0-inning mark in over a month (five starts), last throwing as many innings on August 21 vs. the White Sox (8.0ip).

**THE LONG GAME:** Since the start of 2022, Webb has thrown 607.0 innings, most in the Majors in that time ahead of Aaron Nola (593.0) and Corbin Burnes (585.0).

**DOUBLE DIPPING:** Webb has induced 24 double plays this year, second-most in MLB behind Framber Valdez (31).
