THE TWINS: After completing their six-game roadtrip with a record of 6-0 (3-0 at Los Angeles-AL and 3-0 at Chicago-AL), the Twins began their seven-game homestand with a 2-1 series win over the Red Sox this weekend, winning the first two...tonight, the Twins will welcome in Mitch Garver, Jorge Polanco and the Seattle Mariners for four games through Thursday. ☞ Twins have gone 6-1 in their last seven home games after starting the season 2-6 in their first eight at Target Field.

AND THE STREAK STOPS AT 12: The Twins lost to the Red Sox yesterday afternoon by a score of 9-2, ending their 12-game winning streak and losing for the first time in two weeks (6-1 loss on 4/21 vs. DET)...Joe Ryan (1-2) was the starter and loser, allowing three runs on four hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and five strikeouts, including a two-run homer allowed to Cedanne Rafaela in the fifth inning...Carlos Correa (1-for-2, 2 BB) and Max Kepler (2-for-3, BB) each reached three times...Ryan Jeffers hit his sixth home run of the season, a solo shot in the third inning...the attendance was 29,638, the highest for Minnesota since the Home Opener (35,595), April 4 vs. Cleveland.

TWINS AND MS: The Twins and Mariners are playing each other for the first of seven games this season...after this series, Minnesota will travel to Seattle for three games from June 28-30. ☞ The Twins are 7-5 in their last 12 vs. Seattle, dating back to April 10, 2022. ☞ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .324 (12-for-37) with five walks, a .419 on-base percentage, a .459 slugging percentage and an .878 OPS in 13 career games against Seattle. ☞ Carlos Correa has 109 career hits and 110 games played against the Mariners, both his most vs. any opponent...his 109 hits are sixth-most among actives and his 110 games are seventh-most. ☞ Notable individuals vs. Seattle last season: Edouard Julien went 11-for-24 (.458) with three home runs and five walks...Max Kepler went 11-for-27 (.407) with three doubles, two home runs, eight RBI and one walk...Ryan Jeffers went 4-for-11 (.364) with two walks...Willi Castro went 7-for-23 (.304) with three RBI and two walks...Kyle Farmer went 5-for-16 (.313) with a triple, a home run, two RBI and three walks.

POLO, HERMANO: Mariners infielder Jorge Polanco is visiting Target Field this week for the first time as an opponent...Polo was signed by the Twins as a 16-year-old out of the Dominican Republic in 2009 and spent 14 years of his life in the Twins organization...he played 10 seasons for the Twins from 2014-23, hitting .269 (849-for-3156) with 181 doubles, 20 triples, 112 home runs, 447 RBI, 443 runs scored, 51 stolen bases and a .780 OPS in 832 games. ☞ Polo was traded from Minnesota to Seattle on January 29, in exchange for right-handed pitchers Anthony DeSclafani, Darren Bowen and Justin Topa, and outfielder Gabriel Gonzalez. ☞ Jorge was named the starting shortstop for the AL in the 2019 All-Star Game...he also was named Most Valuable Twin and Most Improved Twin in 2021. ☞ He still ranks 17th on the Twins all-time list in RBI, 18th in home runs and extra-base hits, 19th in hits and doubles, and 22nd in runs scored. ☞ He ranks sixth in Twins history in games played at shortstop (501). ☞ He is the club's all-time leader in home runs by a switch hitter (112).

INSIDE THE LAST 13: The Twins had their 12-game winning streak snapped yesterday afternoon...it was tied for the second-longest winning streak in club history with a streak from September 19-October 3, 1980...their all-time long is 15, from June 1-16, 1991...below are hitting, starting pitcher and bullpen numbers over the last 13 games. ☞ The Twins hit .303 (139-for-458) with 37 doubles, 17 home runs, 86 runs scored (6.6 R/G), a .372 on-base percentage, a .504 slugging percentage and an .876 OPS (ranks lower right). ☞ Starters have gone 8-1, 3.58 ERA (73.0 IP, 29 ER) with 15 walks, 75 strikeouts and a .238 opponent batting average...starters allowed three earned runs-or-fewer in 10 of the 13 games and never more than four earned runs. ☞ Relievers have gone 4-0, 3.48 ERA (44.0 IP, 17 ER) with 14 walks, 49 strikeouts (10.0 K/9.0 IP) and a .213 opponent batting average.

KEPLER ON TARGET: Max Kepler enters tonight with a season-long seven-game hitting streak...his career-high is 10, done twice in 2019...since coming off the Injured List on April 22 (right knee contusion), Kepler has hit .421 (16-for-38) with three doubles, two home runs, six walks, 11 RBI, a .489 on-base percentage and a 1.147 OPS in 12 games...Kepler is moving up Target Field's leaderboards in several offensive categories:

WILLI IN THE MIDDLE OF EVERYTHING: Willi Castro went 0-for-4 yesterday afternoon against the Red Sox, snapping his career-high 10-game hitting streak...over his last 11 games, he is hitting .426 (20-for-47) with six doubles, two triples, one home run, eight RBI, a .438 on-base percentage, a .702 slugging percentage and a 1.140 OPS. ☞ In that same 11-game span (since April 24), Castro leads baseball in line drives hit with 16.

I AM THE ONE WHO NACHS: Trevor Larnach has hit safely in 10 of 13 games...he has reached safely via hit or walk in 11 consecutive games, one short of his career-high of 12, done April 19-May 2, 2023...he is hitting .368 (14-for-38) with a 1.011 OPS against right-handed pitching this season — tied for third-best batting average vs. RHP in baseball (minimum of 35 plate appearances).

X GON' GIVE IT TO YA: Griffin Jax enters tonight with 7.0-consecutive scoreless innings (8 games)...14 of his 16 outings on the season have been scoreless, having allowed runs in back-to-back games on April 14 and 17...he has allowed just one home run this season, a two-run walk-off shot to Cedric Mullins on April 17 at Baltimore...additionally, Jax is the only pitcher in baseball with at least four saves and at least five holds.

TWIN WINNERS: Right-handed pitcher Zebby Matthews has been named Midwest League Pitcher of the Week and left-handed pitcher Cesar Lares has been named Florida State League Pitcher of the Week. ☞ Matthews, 23, made the start for the Kernels on Friday vs. Peoria, pitching 7.0 shutout innings, with three hits allowed, no walks and nine strikeouts...he was recently promoted to Double-A Wichita. ☞ Lares, 20, made the start for the Mighty Mussels on Wednesday at Bradenton, pitching 6.0 perfect innings with two strikeouts.

- ⚡ Making fourth MLB start of 2024 and fifth of career (sixth appearance)...last pitched April 30 at Chicago-AL, allowed two runs (1 ER) on seven hits in 3.2-inning no-decision, with two walks and two strikeouts.
- ⚡ Has never faced Seattle or any current Mariners hitters.
- ⚡ Has yet to allow a home run in 28.0 total innings (MLB and Triple-A) this season.
- ⚡ His slider, thrown 29.0 percent of the time, has held hitters to a .174 average (4-for-23), 82.6 mph average exit velocity and just four hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph).

SHORT START ON THE SOUTH SIDE: Last pitched April 30 at Chicago-AL, opposite Michael Soroka, and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 6-5 victory...allowed two runs (1 ER) on seven hits in 3.2 innings, with two walks and two strikeouts...allowed three hits in the third, including an RBI single by Eloy Jiménez that scored Tommy Pham; escaped the inning with the bases loaded...was pulled with bases loaded in the fourth after a double and back-to-back walks; Kody Funderburk entered and allowed an unearned run on a Carlos Santana error.

- ⚡ Generated three whiffs on 35 swings (8.6%)...ranks in MLB's fifth percentile with a 16.2 percent whiff rate this season.
- ⚡ Eight of 15 balls in play (53.3%) were hard-hit...the White Sox went 6-for-8 with two doubles on those swings...Woods Richardson has allowed a 43.5 percent hard-hit rate, ranking in MLB's 26th percentile.

TWO STARTS AGO: Didn't factor into the decision April 25 vs. Chicago-AL...made his first career home start and first appearance at Target Field since April 22, 2023 (relief appearance vs. Washington)...allowed two runs on seven hits, one walk and a career-high six strikeouts in 5.0 innings...the only two runs he surrendered came on a second-inning sacrifice fly by Kevin Pillar and a fourth-inning single by Paul DeJong; the single had an exit velocity of 104.5 mph, his hardest hit allowed...was relieved in the sixth inning by Cole Sands, who earned his first major league win.

- ⚡ Generated 11 whiffs on 55 swings (20%).
- ⚡ Six of 16 balls in play (37.5%) were hard-hit.

MEET THE MARINERS: Has never faced Seattle, any of its current hitters (at the MLB level) or any American League West team...is 0-1, 5.52 ERA (14.2 IP, 9 ER) with six walks and 14 strikeouts in three appearances (2 starts) when facing an opponent for the first time in his major league career.

BACK HOME: Making his second career start (third appearance) at Target Field...has posted a 3.60 ERA (5.0 IP, 2 ER) with one walk and six strikeouts at home (MLB level) this season, compared to a 1.86 ERA (9.2 IP, 2 ER) with three walks and seven strikeouts on the road...in two career appearances at Target Field, has posted a 6.52 ERA (9.2 IP, 7 ER) with four walks, 11 strikeouts, one home run allowed and a .342 (14-for-41) opponent batting average...opponents have posted a .433 batting average on balls in play vs. Woods Richardson at Target Field.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: On April 30, Chicago-AL's left-handed hitters went 2-for-6 with a walk, while its righties went 5-for-11 with two doubles, a walk and two strikeouts...through three MLB games vs. Woods Richardson this season, left-handed hitters have hit .304 (7-for-23) with a .664 OPS and 16 percent strikeout rate, while righties have hit .265 (9-for-34) with a .642 OPS and 23.7 percent strikeout rate.

- ⚡ Lefties have a 13.3 percent whiff rate and 88.5 mph average exit velocity vs. Woods Richardson, righties a 17.6 percent whiff rate and 89.6 mph average exit velocity.
- ⚡ Facing right-handed pitching this season, Seattle has hit .222 (181-for-817) with a .667 OPS and 28.7 percent strikeout rate.

THE ARSENAL: Woods Richardson has used a four-pitch mix in his first three MLB starts this season... here is his 2024 repertoire, per Baseball Savant:

- ⚡ April 30 at Chicago-AL, all four pitches averaged season-low velocity.
- ⚡ Threw slider a season-high 32.1 percent of the time at Chicago-AL...White Sox hitters went 1-for-9 with two strikeouts against the pitch.
- ⚡ Average slider velocity is up from 83.1 mph in his lone 2023 appearance (4/22 vs. WAS).
- ⚡ 4-seamer has allowed a 94.1 mph average exit velocity and 61.1 percent hard-hit rate.

KEEPING IT IN THE BALLPARK: Has gone nine-straight starts – a 44.2-inning span – without allowing a home run, dating back to September 7, 2023 at Louisville...is one of five starting pitchers yet to allow a home run through three-or-more outings this season...has allowed two total home runs and a 1.9 percent home run rate in his 24.1-inning MLB career...has allowed multiple home runs in a game just twice in his professional career: May 11, 2023 vs. Indianapolis and August 8, 2023 vs. Louisville.

- ⚡ Pitched in Twins spring training for first time in career and was optioned to Triple-A on March 11.
- ⚡ Made two starts for St. Paul from April 9-15...was recalled by Minnesota on April 21 and made a relief appearance for Twins on April 22 vs. Washington, allowing five runs on seven hits in 4.2 innings pitched, with three walks and five strikeouts.
- ⚡ Optioned back to St. Paul on April 23.
- ⚡ Pitched a professional career-high 7.0 innings April 28 at Rochester, allowing two runs on three hits.
- ⚡ Earned first win of the season on July 2 vs. Gwinnett, his first of four-straight winning decisions.
- ⚡ Struck out a season-high seven batters July 8 at Iowa (5.0 IP).
- ⚡ Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week on September 10 after allowing one run in a 6.0-inning, five-strikeout start at Louisville.
- ⚡ Went 7-1 with a 3.03 ERA (71.1 IP, 24 ER), 35 walks, 60 strikeouts and a .205 opponent batting average in final 14 games (12 starts) from June 20-September 20.
- ⚡ Made 22 starts and three relief appearances for St. Paul...went 5-6 with a 5.21 ERA (103.2 IP, 60 ER) as a starter, and 2-0 with a 4.30 ERA (14.2 IP, 7 ER) as a reliever.
- ⚡ Ranked second on Saints staff in innings pitched (113.2) and starts (22), and third in strikeouts (96).
- ⚡ Entering 2024, ranked as 24th-best prospect in Twins organization by MLB.com and 29th-best prospect in Twins organization by Baseball America.

- Entering 2024, ranked by *Baseball America* as Minnesota's No. 29 prospect.
- In 2023, finished second on Saint Paul's staff with 113.2 innings and 22 starts.
- Was named Twins Minor League Pitcher of the Week on September 10, 2023 after allowing one run in a 6.0-inning, five-strikeout start at Louisville.
- In 2023 with Triple-A Saint Paul, went 7-1 with a 3.03 ERA (71.1 IP, 24 ER), 35 walks, 60 strikeouts and a .205 opponent batting average in his final 14 games (12 starts) from June 20-September 20.
- Made only MLB appearance of 2023 on April 22 vs. Washington, allowing five runs on seven hits in 4.2 innings of relief.
- Entering 2023, was ranked eighth-best prospect in Minnesota organization by MLB.com and 10th-best by *Baseball America*.
- Posted a 2.72 ERA with 38 walks, 118 strikeouts and a .199 opponents batting average across three levels in 2022.
- Made major league debut Oct. 2, 2022 in Detroit, allowing three runs (two earned) on three hits and taking the loss in a 5.0-inning start...at 22 years and five days, was the youngest pitcher to make big league debut in 2022.
- Reached Triple-A level for the first time in 2022, pitching 36.2 innings with a 2.21 ERA for St. Paul.
- With Wichita, was named Texas League Pitcher of the Month in April 2022, going 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA, seven walks and 18 strikeouts in 21.2 innings.
- While in Tokyo, was traded to Minnesota alongside Austin Martin in exchange for José Berríos...finished season with Double-A Wichita, posting a 6.75 ERA in four appearances.

- In 2021, participated in first MLB Spring Training as a non-roster invitee with Toronto.
- Finished 2019 with High-A Dunedin as the youngest pitcher in Florida State League, going 3-2 with a 2.54 ERA in six starts.
- In 2019, posted 4.25 ERA in 20 starts for Low-A Columbia before being dealt to Toronto in trade that sent Marcus Stroman to the Mets.
- Finished 2018 season with Rookie-Kingsport, allowing three runs on six hits with 11 strikeouts in two appearances.
- Made professional debut with GCL Mets on July 22, 2018, earning the save in a hitless, one-inning appearance.
- Selected by New York-NL in the second round of 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Kempner High School (TX).
