# San Francisco Giants (31-33) at Texas Rangers (30-33) <br> RHP Spencer Howard (0-0, 2.08) vs. LHP Andrew Heaney (2-6, 3.99)

TODAY'S GAME: The Giants and Rangers face off for game two of this three-game set this afternoon...SF took the series opener yesterday in a 5-2 victory after the offense combined to line 11 hits and five walks.

- With their 14 hits on Wednesday's game in Arizona, Giants batters now have 25 hits over their last two games...the 25 hits are their most in a two-game span since also gathering 25 hits over their two games in Pittsburgh on May 22-23.
- SF's offense recorded a total of 14 hits through their first two games of the road trip.

RANGER DANGER: The Giants are 26-16 (.619) all-time vs. the Rangers with a 194-176 (+18) run differential...according to Stats, LLC, SF is one of two teams (also LAD) to hold an all-time winning percentage greater than .600 against the Rangers

- This marks SF's second series at Globe Life Field, with the Giants splitting the two-game series June 8-9, 2021 with a 12-8 run differential.

THE FLO' SHOW: IF Wilmer Flores lined two solo homers in his first two at-bats last night...Flores, who hit a grand slam on Wednesday at Arizona, now has three homers over his last two games after homering just once over his first 50 outings this year.

- The game was Flores' ninth career multi-homer game and his first since July 18, 2023 at Cincinnati...he became the third Giant to record two homers in a game this season, joining IF Matt Chapman (March 29 at SD) and IF Thairo Estrada (April 13 at TB).
- The homers were also his first off a righty this year and just the fourth time in his career homering twice against a righthander.
- Flores enters today three hits shy of 1,000 in his career and a double short of 200 .

WHERE DO WE START?: Former Ranger RHP Spencer Howard will make his first start in a Giants uniform this afternoon...the right-hander was part of the World Series-winning Rangers team last season, appearing in three games our of Texas' bullpen.

- Howard spent parts of three seasons seasons with the Rangers from 2021-23, appearing in 21 games ( 16 starts) with Texas while posting a 2-7 record and 8.37 ERA.
- He signed a minor league deal with SF last season and was a non-roster invite to this year's camp...had his contract selected from Triple-A Sacramenot on May 28 and made two appearances out of the 'pen in a bulk innings role, combining to toss 8.2 innings, allowing two runs with seven strikeouts.
ADIÓS PELOTA: The Giants scored four of their five runs last night by way of the long ball, powered by two homers from Flores and a two-run homer by OF Michael Conforto.
- After scoring seven of their nine runs via homer on Wednesday's game at Arizona, SF has now scored 11 of its last 14 runs via homers.

HIGH FIVE: With yesterday's victory, the Giants improved to 21-3 this season when scoring at least five runs...their . 875 winning percentage when reaching the five-run threshold is third-best in the NL behind only the Phillies (31-3) and Padres


CHAPSTICK: IF Matt Chapman extended his on-base streak to 24 games after reaching base in three of his five plate appearances yesterday...the streak is tied with STL's Paul Goldschmidt for the longest active on-base streak in the National League, and tied for fourth-longest active in MLB.

- Chapman became the first Giant to reach base in 24 straight games since Andrew McCutchen also had a 24 game onbase streak in 2018 (April 18-May 14).
- The last Giant to reach base in 25 consecutive games was Eduardo Núñez, who reached base in 33 straight from May 12-July 16, 2017.
- Chapman has a slash line of $.297 / .413 / .538$ with 22 runs, 10 doubles, four home runs and 14 RBI over the streak...his 10 doubles in that span (since May 11) are tied with NYY's Aaron Judge and COL's Ezequiel Tovar for most in the Majors.

TWO CLOSE FOR CONFORT: SF's game-winning run yesterday came off the bat of Conforto, who lined his eighth homer of the season in the 7th inning to put the Giants ahead.

- Since joining SF last season, 11 of Conforto's 23 homers were go-ahead home runs...SF is $15-8$ in games where he homers and 40-14 when he record an RBI.
- Conforto is now 13-for-40 (.325) with three homers vs. lefties this season, matching his home run total off lefties from last season.
- According to Sports Info Solutions, 10 of the 13 hits have come off fastballs...he's one shy of his base hit total against fastballs for all of 2023.

TO THE LEFT, TO THE LEFT: The Giants rank ninth in the Majors in OPS vs. left-handed pitching (.745) and sixth in OBP (.329) this season...SF, however, has dropped five of its last six games against a left-handed starter and are 6-12 in such games this season

INTERLEAGUE PLAY: Last weekend's series against the Yankees kicked off a stretch of where SF will face American League teams for four of its next five series, including nine straight games starting with yesterday's contest.

- The Giants are just 3-7 in interleague play early this season...they had only faced two American League opponents (Tampa Bay and Boston) all season prior to this stretch.


## This Date in Giants Histor

June 8, 2011 - Matt Cain tossed the 13th complete game of his career in the Giants' 3-1 win over the Washington Nationals. Cain struck out 11 batters and allowed just one earned run on five hits with a walk.

## SPENCER HOWARD RHP

Age: 27 (July 28, 1996)

Bats/Throws: R/R
Signed Through: 2024

WELCOME TO SF: Howard is making his first start in his third game since having his contract purchased by the Giants on May $28 \ldots$ He signed an MiLB contract with the Giants on September 22, 2023 and was an invite to Major League Spring Training this year.
VS. TEXAS: This will be Howard's first career game against his former team...in 10 career games at Globe Life Field (nine starts), Howard is $1-5$ with a 9.77 ERA (34er, 31.1 ip ) with 26 strikeouts.
BACK IN TOWN: Howard was originally selected by Philadelphia out of Cal Poly, San Luis Obispo in the second round of the 2017 MLB draft... after making his debut with the Phillies on August 9, 2020, Howard would later be traded alongside RHP Josh Gessner and RHP Kevin Gowdy to Texas in exchange for RHP Ian Kennedy, RHP Hans Crouse and RHP Kyle Gibson on July 30, 2021 ...Howard pitched parts of the 2021-2023 seasons with the Rangers, going $2-7$ with an 8.37 ERA, 55 strikeouts and a 1.77 WHIP in 21 games (16 starts).

LAST OUTING: Tossed 4.2 innings out of the bullpen on June 3 at Arizona, allowing two runs on four hits (one being a home run) while striking out three and walking none.
OPPORTUNITY CALLS: Howard was brought up to eat innings with injuries to starting pitchers LHP Blake Snell and RHP Keaton Winn....he has made the most of his latest Major League opportunity, posting a 2.08 ERA (2er, 8.2ip), seven strikeouts and a 1.04 WHIP in two games thus far.

LAST SEASON: Spent a good portion of 2023 on separate trips to the IL with a right lat strain and a right shoulder strain...he pitched mostly in Triple-A with the Texas and New York-AL organizations, going 1-2 with a 6.86 ERA (16er, 21.0ip), 34 strikeouts and a 1.24 WHIP...he posted a 10.80 ERA (4er, 3.1 ip ) while striking out 2 in three MLB games with Texas...he was traded from Texas to New York-AL on August 1 in exchange for cash.

TOP GUN: Howard had an illustrious Minor League career, ranking as a top-50 prospect in both 2020 and 2021 according to Baseball America (No. 27 in both 2020 and 2021) and MLB.com (No. 34 in 2020 and No. 42 in 2021)...below is a list of Howard's Minor League awards.

Issued 17 walks in 24.1 ip...his $15.2 \%$ walk rate is in the bottom $5 \%$ of the league.
Has struck out 31 batters over 24.1 innings of work (11.47 S0/9.0).
- 17 of his 31 strikeouts this year have come with his slider.

Lefties are hitting 292 (14-for-48) off him
In 13 non-save situations, he is 2-0 with a 3.46 ERA (5er, 13.0ip), eight hits allowed (two homers), 11 walks and 16 strikeouts.

## \#64 SEAN HJELLE RHP

Last Game: $6 / 5$ at ARI; W, 1.1 ip, h, r, er, hr, $k$ ( 24 pitches)

- Over his last four outings, he's thrown 6.2 innings and allowed just one run (solo HR) on two hits with four strikeouts.
- Has recorded at least five outs in 10 of his 17 games w/SF
- Since April 30, Hjelle has a 2.11 ERA (5er, 21.1ip) with 23 strikeouts
- Has a $64.4 \%$ ground ball rate this year
- Reinstated from the 15-day IL on April 19... missed SF's first 21 games with a right elbow strain he suffered early in spring.
At 6'11, he is tied for tallest pitcher in MLB history with Jon Rauch.

- Allowed all four of his inherited runners to score so far in 2024.
- Lefties are 9-for-27 (.333) off him with six RBI...righties are just $9 \times 40$.
- Has a 10.08 ERA on the road (8.1ip) and a 2.08 ERA at home (8.2ip)

Was drafted by the Rangers in the supplemental round (45th overall) in 2010 out of high school...appeared in 15 games for the Rangers at the MLB level between 2015-16 (8.50 ERA) before being dealt to Atlanta following the 2016 season.
