YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles beat the Mariners, 4-1, to clinch the series win...Dean Kremer returned from the Injured List and fired 5.0 scoreless innings with eight strikeouts to earn his fourth win of the year...Ryan O'Hearn was involved in all four runs scored, hitting a two-run double and scoring in the third inning and later hitting a solo homer in the fifth inning...Craig Kimbrel earned his 21st save of the year and 438th of his career, passing Francisco Rodriguez for fourth all time...The win moved the 0's a season-high-tying 24 games above .500 (also 6/20, 49-25).

SWEEP DREAMS: The 0's are in search of their sixth series sweep of the season, joining June 7-10 at Tampa Bay (4 G), May 23-26 at Chicago-AL (4 G), May 3-5 at Cincinnati (3 G), April 15-17 vs. Minnesota (3 G), and April 9-11 at Boston (3 G).

Oxage Pour of the team's previous five sweeps this season have been on the road.

Baltimore last swept Seattle in a series from August 28-30, 2017 (3 G) at Camden Yards; the last time the Birds swept the Mariners in Seattle came September 17-19, 2013 (3 G), which featured an 18-inning affair on September 18.

ALL-STAR STARTERS: MLB announced the starters for the 2024 All-Star Game as a result of the fan vote yesterday...Adley Rutschman (C) and Gunnar Henderson (SS) will start for the American League, marking the first time Baltimore will have multiple starters in a Midsummer Classic since Adam Jones and Nelson Cruz in 2014.

(b) Rutschman received 70 percent of the votes to defeat Kansas City's Salvador Perez; he's an All-Star for the second time (2023) and will be making his first starting assignment; he'll become the third 0's backstop to start an All-Star Game, along with Gus Triandos in 1958 and 1959, and Terry Kennedy in 1987; Matt Wieters was voted to start in 2014, but did not play (injury).

(b) Henderson beat Kansas City's Bobby Witt Jr. with 65 percent of the votes; this is his first career All-Star selection and is the first Orioles shortstop selected to the Midsummer Classic since Manny Machado started in 2018.

Ryan Mountcastle fell to Toronto's Vladimir Guerrero Jr. after receiving 39 percent of the votes.

Jordan Westburg was defeated by Cleveland's Jose Ramirez after getting 40 percent of the

Anthony Santander finished in third place with 26 percent of the vote behind New York-AL's Juan Soto (31%) and Cleveland's Steven Kwan (28%), and ahead of Houston's Kyle Tucker (16%); New York-AL's Aaron Judge will be a starter after receiving the most votes in the AL in Phase 1. Ryan O'Hearn finished behind Houston's Yordan Alvarez with 48 percent of the vote.

WHAT'S TRENDING: The Orioles have won six of their last seven games after dropping their previous five, the team's longest losing streak since May 13-18, 2022 (6 G)...At 55-31 (.640), the Birds own the second-best record in MLB behind the Phillies (.663, 57-29)...Since the start of 2023, Baltimore is 156-92 (.629), the best winning percentage and most wins in the majors during that time...The 0's are 239-171 (.583) since the start of 2022, the second-best record in the AL and fourth-best in MLB behind the Astros (.585, 240-170), Braves (.618, 252-156), and Dodgers (.642, 264-147).

(b) The 55 wins are tied for the fourth-most through 86 games in team history with 1977 and trailing 1969 (60), 1966 (58), and 1979 (56); three previous 0's clubs won at least 56 of their first 87 games - 1969 (60), 1966 (58), and 1979 (57).

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles lead MLB with 140 home runs, 16 more than the second-place Yankees (124) and 24 more than the Dodgers (116), who are third...The Birds homered in 22 consecutive games from June 1-23, setting a franchise record. OThe 140 homers are the most through 86 games in team history; Baltimore is the 12th MLB to 12th M

The 140 homers are the most through 86 games in team history; Baltimore is the 12th MLB team since at least 1901 with 140+ home runs in the first 86 games of a season and the first since Atlanta hit 166 last season; all such occurrences in MLB have come since 1999 with eight occurences coming since 2018.

The 0's are 47-20 this year when homering, 36-6 when hitting multiple home runs, 19-5 when hitting at least three, and 5-2 when hitting four.

Baltimore has an MLB-best seven players with at least 10 home runs: Gunnar Henderson (26), Anthony Santander (22), Adley Rutschman (15), Jordan Westburg (13), Colton Cowser (12), and Ryan Mountcastle and Ryan O'Hearn (11); the Padres are second with six.

Henderson and Santander are one of three duos in MLB with at least 20 homers each so far this season, along with Cleveland's José Ramírez and Josh Naylor, and New York-AL's Aaron Judge and Juan Soto; only four other teams have one player with at least 20 homers - Braves (Ozuna), Diamondbacks (Walker), Dodgers (Ohtani), and Phillies (Harper).

The Birds lead MLB with nine leadoff homers this year; Gunnar Henderson has eight of those, the most in MLB and tied for the second-most in a single season in Orioles history with Cedric Mullins (2021), trailing only Brady Anderson (12, 1996).

The O's hit 60 home runs in June, the most homers in a month in franchise history; they are the third team with at least 60 in a month in MLB history, joining the 2023 Braves, who hit 61 in June, and the 2019 Yankees, who hit 74 in August.

TOP GUNN: Gunnar Henderson had his career-best 36-game on-base streak since May 22 snapped on Sunday against Texas...The stretch was the longest by an 0's batter since **Nick Markakis'** 38-game streak from July 5 to August 18, 2009...It was the second-longest on-base streak in MLB this season behind New York-AL's Aaron Judge's 37-gamer from May 2 to June 12...For Henderson, 35 of those came as the starting shortstop, the longest such streak in team history ahead of a 30-gamer by **Cal Ripken Jr.** from June 26 to July 28, 1986.

He leads MLB with 74 runs scored this season, the most runs through the first 86 team games of a season in 0's history; the only players in club history to lead the AL in runs are **Frank Robinson** in 1966 (122) and **Cal Ripken**, **Jr.** in 1982 (121); Robinson is the only player in Orioles history to lead MLB in runs, when he tited with Atlanta's Felipe Alou.

Had a career-long 14-game hitting streak from June 6-21, the longest hitting streak by an 0's batter since **Anthony Santander** had a 16-game streak from July 16 to August 6, 2022.

SUMMER SLUGGER: Anthony Santander led MLB with 13 home runs last month, the most in June in team history...He tied with Nelson Cruz (13 in May 2014) and Frank Robinson (13 in July 1966), and finished behind Jim Gentile (15 in August 1961) for the most home runs hit in a single month by an Orioles

Santander's 83 home runs since the start of 2022 are the most by a switch hitter, third in the AL, and 11th in MLB; the only AL players to hit more in that span are Houston's Yordan Álvarez (87) and New York-AL's Aaron Judge (131). A.

MONTHLY DUES: The Orioles just finished 29 games in 30 days in June while going 17-12 (.586), the third-best record in the AL during that time...The 0's have nine consecutive winning months (min. 10 games played) since the start of 2023, the longest streak by the 0's since May 1982 through September 1983 (11), per the Elias Sports Bureau...The current stretch is the longest active streak in the majors.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Baltimore continues a six-game road trip to the West Coast tonight with the third **EXAMPLE ADAIM:** Baltimore continues a six-game road trip to the West Coast tonight with the third and final game in Seattle...The Birds complete the trip with three games in Oakland from July 5-7...The O's went 2-4 on their last road trip against the Yankees (2-1) and Astros (0-3) from June 18-23, their first losing trip since going 2-3 against the Cubs (1-2) and Rays (1-1) from June 16-21, 2023...Despite being swept in Houston, the Orioles are still a league-best 26-14 (.650) on the road this year and 78-43 (.645) away from Oriole Park since the start of 2023, the only MLB club with a road winning percentage above .600 during that time.

AGAINST SEATTLE: The 0's and Mariners are meeting for the second and final time in the regular season this week at T-Mobile Park...Baltimore has clinched a season series victory and has won four straight sets against Seattle since the start of 2023...In the last 10 meetings between the teams, eight have been decided by three or fewer runs while six games have been decided by one or two runs.

THE SKIPPER: Manager Brandon Hyde is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the 0's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He made his Postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the BBWAA AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Orioles manager to win the award...He was also voted the Sporting News American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year...Hyde's 370 wins rank fifth all-time among Orioles managers.

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his 18th start of the season tonight against the Mariners...Reinstated from the Paternity List on July 1; placed on the PL June 28...His 2.28 ERA is the lowest mark for an Orioles starting pitcher through his first 17 starts in a season since Mike Mussina in 1992 (2.23) and it is the second-lowest mark for a pitcher through his first 17 starts to begin an Orioles career all time, only behind Mike Cuellar in 1969 (2.19)...The Orioles are 12-5 in his starts this year...A three-time All-Star and 2021 NL Cy Young Award winner, Burnes was acquired by the Orioles from the Brewers in exchange for LHP DL Hall, INF Joey Ortiz, and a 2024 Competitive Balance Round A pick on February 1, 2024... Entering the 2024 season, he was ranked as the No. 29 overall player in MLB Network's Top 100 Right Now...He was originally selected by the Brewers in the fourth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Saint Mary's College (CA).

LAST TIME OUT: Picked up the win on June 27 vs. Texas after allowing one run on a season-high-tying nine hits (1 HR) with five strikeouts in 7.0 innings; has not issued a walk in consecutive starts for the second time this season... Burnes' six games of 7.0+ IP are tied for the sixth-most in MLB...Marked his first career outing against the Rangers; has now faced every team in MLB.

AGAINST THE MARINERS: Slated to make his third career start and second of the season against Seattle...Owns a 2-0 record with a 1.59 ERA (2 ER/11.1 IP) across his two prior outings...Earned the win in his last start against the Mariners on May 19 at Oriole Park after allowing one unearned run on six hits and one walk with a season-high-tying 11 strikeouts.

AGAINST THE AL WEST: Will be making his 10^{th} career appearance (ninth start) and sixth of the campaign against the AL West...Has made a start against every team in the division at least once this year; has gone 3-1 with a 1.97 ERA (7 ER/32.0 IP) against the AL West this season...Opponents are slashing .207/.231/.379 (24-for-116) off Burnes in 2024...Is 5-2 with a 2.74 ERA (15 ER/49.1 IP) in his first nine career games (eight starts) against the division.

HIGH QUALITY: Burnes tossed a career-high 10 consecutive quality starts from April 26 to June 16, the longest streak in the majors this year and the longest stretch by an Oriole since Jeremy Guthrie (10, 5/8-6/26/07)...Burnes' 13 quality starts on the season are tied for fourth in MLB and his 53 quality outings since the start of 2022 rank third.

NEW BEGINNINGS: Burnes began his Orioles career with 15 straight starts of at least 5.0 innings and three-or-fewer runs allowed...The 15 consecutive outings was the longest such streak to begin a pitcher's career with the Orioles alltime.

EARLY STRUGGLES: After allowing five first-inning runs across his first six starts to open the season, Burnes has not allowed one since his outing on April 26 vs. Oakland...Four of those first inning runs have come via solo home runs.

RING 'EM UP: Burnes is one of six pitchers with 200+ strikeouts in each of the last three seasons (2021-23), along with Dylan Cease, Gerrit Cole, Kevin Gausman, Aaron Nola, and Spencer Strider...His 765 strikeouts from 2020-23 were the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind Gerrit Cole (816)...He is one away from 100 on the season and 31 away from 1,000 for his career.

INNINGS EATER: The 669.1 innings consumed by Burnes since the start of 2021 rank third in MLB behind Philadelphia's Zack Wheeler (670.0) and Aaron Nola (687.0 IP)...Last season, he tossed 193.2 innings, which would have been the most by an Oriole since Chris Tillman threw 207.1 innings in 2014.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS: Burnes' 2023 campaign was highlighted by his third consecutive All-Star Game appearance...Burnes made his second straight Opening Day start for the Brewers...On July 25, he became the sixth pitcher in Brewers franchise history to notch 800 career strikeouts...He pitched to a 5-3 record with a 2.72 ERA (30 ER/99.1IP) across his final 16 starts of the season.

POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE: Burnes' NL Wild Card Series start on October 3, 2023 against the Diamondbacks marked his eighth Postseason appearance (2 GS)...In those games, he has posted a 2.84 ERA (6 ER/19.0 IP) with 11 hits, six walks, and 22 strikeouts.
