RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals conclude their short three-game trip to Cincinnati for the Labor Day weekend as they play the series finale at Great American Ball Park this afternoon..the Redbirds will return home to take on the Athletics on Labor Day tomorrow in a 1:15 p.m. CT contest...the Cardinals are seeking their first series sweep since June 27-29 at Cleveland and their first at Great American Ball Park since April 12-15 of 2018 when they swept a four-game series here...the Cardinals won 7-5 win in 10 innings on Friday night and posted a 4-2 win last night.

STREAKS ALIVE: The Cardinals have won three-straight for the 1st time since sweeping a June 27-29 series at Cleveland and are aiming for their first 4-game winning streak since June 17-21 when they won 5-straight.

FLIGHT PATTERN: With 25 games left in the regular season, the Cardinals opened play today in 4th place in the National League Central, 17.0 games behind first place Milwaukee and 5.5 games out of the final NL Wild Card position...the Cardinals are 20-19 vs. NL Central teams this season, including a 6-3 mark vs. the Reds (4-2 at Cincinnati).

WINNING FORMULA: The Cardinals are needing a 14-11 run over their final 25 games to finish with a winning mark, above .500...the Cardinals have had winning marks in 25 of their 31 past seasons since joining the NL Central Division in 1994 and in 23 of their 25 seasons played since 2000.

ATTENTION K-MART SHOPPERS: The Cardinals pitching staff recorded no strikeouts in last night's win, something they hadn't done since 6/24/09 at NYM...it was the 1st time they'd won a game with no strikeouts since 4/22/09 vs. NYM and their 1st time doing so against the Reds since 9/1/93 in a 7-4 win at Busch Stadium II.

WILLY C JOINS 20/20 CLUB: Willson Contreras cracked his team-leading 20th HR last night, and by doing so, reached the 20/20 club of Home Runs and Hit by Pitch for the 2nd time in his career...he had 22 HR's & 24 HBP's in 2022...Willy is now 4 HR's shy of his single-season high of 24 in 2019 with the Cubs...he's the first Cardinal to ever reach the milestone and is the 3rd active player to do so twice, along with **Pete Alonso** (2019 & 2023) & **Randy Arozarena** (2024 & 2025).

WELCOME TO THE SHOW - NOW GET IN THERE: Arriving shortly before game time on Friday, rookie call-ups **Jimmy Crooks** and **César Prieto** soon found themselves in the action; Crooks backstopped the 9th and 10th innings and **Prieto** pinch-hit in the 10th; **Crooks** was the 1st Cardinal to debut off the bench at catcher since **Iván Herrera** did so in 2022 vs. TOR; the last to do so vs. CIN was **Travis Tartamella** in 2015. (*Elias*).

MERCY ME: The Cardinals entered this weekend's series without 3B **Nolan Arenado** (right shoulder), 2025 All-Star **Brendan Donovan** (groin), OF **Victor Scott II** (left ankle), LHP **John King** (mid-back strain), 1B/OF **Alec Burleson** (right wrist) and C **Yohel Pozo** (concussion) currently on the Injured List, in addition to LHP **Zack Thompson** who has missed the entire season.

CLOSER CLUB: Last night, **Kyle Leahy** became the 9th Cardinal to record a save this season, matching the club's team-high of 9 in 2019...Leahy, Fernandez, Romero, Helsley, Maton, O'Brien, Graceffo, Granillo & Matz have all had rescues this year.

OLI & JOHNNY: With last night's win, manager **Oliver Marmol** (2022-25) is now just 2 wins shy of tying **Johnny Keane** (1961-64), who piloted the 1964 World Series Champion Cardinals, for 11th all-time among Cardinals managers at 317.

CINCINNATI CONNECTIONS

Late Reds Executive Advisor **Walt Jocketty** served as the Cardinals GM for 13 seasons (1995-2007)...during tenure, St. Louis compiled seven NL Central Division championships (1996, 2000-02, '04-06), two NL Championships ('04, '06), and one World Series Championship ('06).

Terry Francona played in 86 games in 1990 with the Louisville Redbirds (AAA), including five at pitcher...his father, **Tito Francona**, played parts of two seasons (1965-66) with St. Louis...became a Cardinal via trade by Cleveland in exchange for a player to be named (Dec. 15, 1964)...originally signed by the St. Louis Browns before the 1952 season (MLB debut for Baltimore in 1956).

Reds pitching coach **Derek Johnson** played baseball & coached at Eastern Illinois Univ. (1991-94)...coached at Southern Illinois Univ.(1995-97)...was **Sonny Gray's** pitching coach at Vanderbilt Univ.

Sonny Gray pitched three seasons with Cincinnati (2019-21)...named a 2019 NL All-Star.

Riley O'Brien made his MLB debut with Cincinnati (Sept. 28, 2021 at Guaranteed Rate Field).

Reds Bullpen Coach **Matt Tracy** was born in St. Louis...graduated from Christian Brothers College HS.

Hall of Famer **Scott Rolen** played his final four seasons with the Reds (2009-12)...won the 2010 Gold Glove and was a two-time All-Star (2010-11).

Cardinals FanDuel TV broadcaster **Mark Sweeney** played outfield for both the Cardinals (1995-97) and Reds (1999).

Garrett Hampson played in nine games for the Reds this season before being designated for assignment and claimed by St. Louis.

Julio Rangel served as Bullpen Coach for the Reds in 2019.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Vince Coleman** played in 33 games for Cincinnati in 1996.

Reds Senior Advisor to the GM **Cam Bonifay** played two minor league seasons with the Cardinals...worked for St Louis as a professional scout and special assistant.

Reds broadcaster **Jeff Brantley** pitched in 48 games for St. Louis in 1998.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played 13 games for the Reds in his final season (2010).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Julián Javier** played in 44 games for the Reds during his final 1972 season.

Reds President of Baseball Ops **Nick Krall** previously interned for the New Jersey Cardinals of the NY Penn League (SS).

Reds Senior Advisor to the GM **Eric Davis** played two seasons (1999-2000) for St. Louis.

Reds Special Assistant to the GM **John Morris** played five seasons for St. Louis (1986-90).

Cardinals Principal Owner and Chief Executive Office **William DeWitt Jr.** was a prior owner of the Reds and shareholder of the Cincinnati Bengals...his father, **William O. DeWitt**, was a sole owner of the Reds from 1961-67.

Reds CEO **Robert Castellini**, Chairman **W. Joseph Williams Jr.** and Vice Chairman **Thomas Williams** were Cardinals investors from 1995-2006...interests were sold as a condition of their acquisition of a controlling ownership stake of the Reds.

TODAY'S GAME:

- Making his 27th start of the season and his 57th career start (165th career appearance). Has established new single-season highs in starts (26), quality starts (8), and innings pitched (139.0).
- Has lost his last five straight starts and Cardinals are 1-11 in his last 12 starts. The loss streak is the longest of his career and by a Cardinals pitcher since **Adam Wainwright** dropped 7 straight in 2023 (7/29-9/7) before winning his final two starts for 200 career wins.
- Trying to avoid being the 1st Cardinals pitcher to suffer six losses in August since **Bill Doak** (1-7) in August 1917; last in MLB was Spenser Watkins (0-6) in 2021 for Baltimore.
- Struck out his 300th career batter in his start at MIA on 8/20 (Xavier Edwards).
- Has allowed a home run in a career-high five straight games.
- Received two runs of support in his last two starts following three straight with zero runs support..
- His 3.95 runs support average ranks as the 5th-lowest in the National League. Has received 1 or less in 14 starts and 9 scoreless.**
- St. Louis is 9-3 in starts in which Pallante has received 2 or more runs of support, with losses coming vs. KC (6/3), at MIA (8/20) and vs. PIT (8/26)
- Since returning to the Cardinals starting rotation on May 26, 2024, ranks 2nd in wins (14) and strikeouts (183), and 3rd in qualifying ERA (4.60).
- Since his 2022 MLB debut, boasts the highest ground ball percentage (64.3%) in MLB (min. 400 innings pitched).
- As a starting pitcher (304.2 IP), Pallante's 60.7 groundball pct. is the 7th-best in MLB since the stat has been tracked since 1987 (min. 290.0 IP as starter).**
- Has allowed home runs in 16-of-26 starts this season and his 19 HR allowed more than doubles his total (8) for last season.
- Has had 40 total chances in the field, ranking 3rd among MLB pitchers behind Atlanta's **Spencer Schwellenbach** (41) and New York's **Max Fried** (44)..

LAST TIME OUT (Tuesday, Aug. 26 vs. Pittsburgh Pirates): Lost his 5th straight start, allowing a season-high 8 runs (7 ER) over 5.0 innings in an 8-3 loss.

2025 NOTES:

- His ERA has increased every month this season (3.60--4.23--4.34--4.91--5.16--9.82).
- Made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for the 4th time (2022-25).
- Carried a no-hitter thru 5.0 IP vs. Miami (7/28) in a 7-1 win, as he tossed 7.0 IP of scoreless ball, allowing just one hit (6th inning single). Snapped a four-game losing skid.
- Received a no-decision in a 1-0 Cardinals loss at Pittsburgh (July 1) as he exited after 7.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball, his lowest hit total in a start in his career. Ran his scoreless inning streak vs. PIT to 17.0 innings.
- His 2.28 run support average in April was MLB's 6th-lowest & 2nd among Cards starters to Miles Mikolas (1.90 - 3rd in MLB) for the month.
- Yielded a pair of singles over 6.0+ shutout frames in 6-1 win over the Reds on 6/20; exited with a runner on first in the 7th inning and St. Louis leading 1-0. Improved to 6-2 over the Reds in his career.
- Allowed a pair of runs over a season-high 7.1 innings for 4-2 win over Washington at Nationals Park on 5/10. Also fanned a season-best seven while walking none. Yielded 2-run HR to Dylan Crews as his final batter faced in the 7th inning.

PALLANTE vs. CINCINNATI:

- Making his 3rd start of the season vs. CIN and 8th career start (17th app.). Has a 6-2 record with a 1.93 ERA over his career.
- Of active pitchers with 50.0 or more innings vs. the Reds, his 1.93 ERA ranks 2nd only to Max Scherzer (1.67 - 64.2 IP); 8th in the Expansion Era (since 1961).**
- Returned to the Cardinals rotation on May 26, 2024 at Great American Ballpark and hurled 6.0 scoreless innings of three-hit ball in a 5-3 win.
- Has registered a decision in all 7 career starts vs. CIN (5-2, 2.09 ERA, 38.2 IP, 32 K).
- Has allowed just one career HR (Jose Trevino on 4/28/25 at CIN) when pitching against the Reds among his 217 batters faced.**
- His 6 career wins, 51.1 IP and 40 strikeouts vs. CIN are his most against any team
