RAYS REPORT—The Rays continue the third and final leg of their last road trip before the All-Star break tonight at Fenway Park, going 2-5 so far against the Twins (1-2), Tigers (1-2) and Red Sox (0-1, three to play)...have lost five of seven and nine of their last 13 games on the heels of an MLB-best 25-9 stretch (May 20–June 26)...are still 28-18 in their last 46 games since May 20, fourth in MLB behind the Blue Jays (32-15), Brewers (30-15) and Astros (30-16), and 41-30 in their last 71 contests since starting 9-14...are 3-5-1 in their last nine series after going 7-1-1 in their previous nine (May 9–June 8)...have dropped four straight series for the first time since June 18–July 4, 2024 (six straight)...are third in the AL East, 4.5 GB the first-place Blue Jays and 2.5 GB the Yankees...have been in second or third for the last 47 days...on the season, they have spent two days in first, 37 in second, 32 in third, 30 in fourth and four in fifth...are looking to enter the All-Star break occupying one of the division's top two spots for the first time since 2023 (first) and fifth time in the last six seasons since 2019 (no ASG in 2020)—they were second in 2022, 2021 and 2019...however, the Rays need to win tonight in order to avoid falling to fourth for the first time since entering play on May 24 (25-26).

- ★ The Rays staked out a 3-1 lead last night thanks to homers by **Ha-Seong Kim** (solo) and **Junior Caminero** (two-run), but fell, 4-3, after the Red Sox rallied for three runs in the 7th inning...they have held a multi-run lead in five of their six losses in July, and their four blown saves this month are tied with the Blue Jays for the most in the majors.
- ★ Four of the Rays six losses this month have come by one run, tied with the Guardians and Pirates for the most in MLB...their 16 one-run defeats this season are tied for fourth in the AL behind the White Sox (21), Red Sox (19) and Yankees (18).
- ★ The Rays have homered 65 times in their last 46 games since May 21, tied with the Yankees for second most in the AL behind the Angels (67HR)...they entered that stretch with 40 HR in their first 48 games, tied for fourth fewest in the majors.
- ★ Tampa Bay starters have yielded three runs or fewer in all nine outings in July, tossing six quality starts, and have gone 7-2 with a 3.25 ERA (97.0IP, 35ER) in their last 18 starts...on the year, the rotation leads the AL with 46 quality starts.
- ★ The Rays have scored first in only two of eight and three of their last 11 games...they are 3-10 in their last 13 games when their opponent scores first.
- ★ Tampa Bay is 22-19 (.537) on the road, second in the majors behind Detroit (27-20/.574)...having played the most home games (53) and fewest road games (41) to this point, 10 of 16, 22 of 31 and 28 of its next 42 games will come on the road.
- ★ Tonight, the Rays will be opposed by a rookie starter for the 17th time, splitting the previous 16 matchups (8-8) but winning six of the last eight on the heels of a 2-6 start...rookies have a 7-24 ERA (27.1IP, 22ER) in their last seven starts vs. the Rays.

RECENT TRANSACTIONS—Earlier today, the Rays placed **INF Brandon Lowe** (left oblique tightness) on the 10-day IL and recalled **INF Curtis Mead** from Triple-A Durham...this marks Mead's second stint with the Rays this season, joining Opening Day–July 3.

SHINING STARS—Today, MLB announced RHP **Drew Rasmussen** has earned his first career All-Star selection, replacing the injured LAA **Yusei Kikuchi**...he is the first Rays right-handed starter to qualify for the Midsummer Classic since **Charlie Morton** in 2019...Rasmussen is the Rays fourth All-Star selection, joining **Jonathan Aranda**, **Junior Caminero** and **Brandon Lowe**...it marks the fourth time in franchise history the Rays have had four or more All-Stars, joining 2023 (Arozarena/Diaz/Franco/McClanahan), 2010 (Crawford/Longoria/Price/Soriano) and 2009 (Bartlett/Crawford/Longoria/Pena/Zobrist)...the Rays are one of eight teams with four or more All-Stars this season, joining the Dodgers (5), Tigers (5), Astros (4), Mariners (4), Mets (4), Padres (4) and Yankees (4).

- ★ On Wednesday, it was announced **Junior Caminero** will be the AL's starting third baseman, replacing **CLE Jose Ramirez**...Caminero will be 22 years, 10 days old when the All-Star Game takes place on July 15 in Atlanta, which would make him the third-youngest third baseman to start the Midsummer Classic since the contest's inception in 1933, older than only the Milwaukee Braves **Eddie Mathews** in 1953 (21.274) and **CLE Buddy Lewis** in 1938 (21.330).
- ★ Caminero is also set to become the fourth Ray to participate in the T-Mobile Home Run Derby, joining Arozarena (2023), **Carlos Peña** (2009) and **Evan Longoria** (2008).

NO REGULAR JOE—**Joe Boyle** is expected to handle bulk innings in relief this evening behind starter **Drew Rasmussen**...in two major league appearances (1GS) with the Rays spanning 10.0 IP, he has held opponents to a 2-for-33 (.061) clip and has not allowed an earned run, striking out 14 of his 37 batters faced (37.8%)...he is the third pitcher in club history to record 10.0 IP or more without yielding an earned run over his first two appearances with the Rays, joining **Alex Colomé** (2013, 10.0IP) and **Doug Waechter** (2003, 11.1IP)...since 1967, Boyle is one of three major league pitchers to record 10.0 IP or more while allowing 0 ER and two hits or fewer in his first two starts with a franchise, joining **TEX A.J. Alexy** in 2021 (11.0IP, 2H) and **DET Eric King** in 1986 (11.1IP, 2H).

CHAN YOU BELIEVE IT?—**Chandler Simpson** extended his career-best hitting streak to 14 games last night, surpassing **Rocco Baldelli** (March 31–April 16, 2003) and **Delmon Young** (June 15-28, 2007) for the longest streak by a rookie in franchise history...he is batting .392 (20-for-51) with 1 2B, 1 3B, 3 RBI, 3 BB and 7 SB during the streak, which is the second-longest active run in MLB behind **NYC Cody Bellinger** (15G)...it ties the second-longest streak by any rookie this season behind **ATH Jacob Wilson** (15G, March 27–April 12).

- ★ Despite appearing in only 50 of the Rays 93 games, he has already stolen 26 bases, one shy of the Rays rookie record for a full season set by Baldelli in 2003 (27SB)...his 26 SB rank second in the AL behind teammate **Jose Caballero** (31SB).
- ★ Caballero and Simpson are looking to become the ninth set of teammates in the expansion era (since 1961) to rank first and second in their league (AL/NL) in steals at the All-Star break, including the fourth AL duo...the last teammates to turn the trick in either league were **KC Tom Goodwin** (26SB) and **KC Vince Coleman** (21SB) in 1995, according to Stats Perform.

GO, JONNY, GO—**Jonathan Aranda** is 11-for-25 (.440) with 3 2B, 1 HR and 4 RBI during a six-game hitting streak, raising his average to .326, fourth best in the majors...he could become the fourth hitter in Rays history to enter the All-Star break with a .320 average or better (min. 250AB)...Aranda would join **Fred McGriff** in 2001 (.330), **Yandy Diaz** in 2023 (.323) and **Carl Crawford** in 2010 (.321)...with a .401 on-base pct. (3rd in MLB), he could also become the fourth Ray (5x) with a .400 or better OBP in the first half (min. 250PA), joining **Ben Zobrist** in 2009 (.414), McGriff in 1999 (.412) and Diaz in both 2023 (.408) and 2022 (.407).

- ★ Aranda is 1 RBI shy of becoming the fourth Ray to collect 50 RBI—**Junior Caminero** (59), Diaz (52) and **Brandon Lowe** (50) have already reached the mark...it would mark the first time in club history four players had 50 RBI before the All-Star break.

20-20 VISION—With 19 doubles and 23 homers, **Junior Caminero** needs one double to become the first player in franchise history to record 20 doubles and 20 homers before the All-Star break...only seven players in the majors have accomplished the feat so far this season, including four AL hitters: **NYC Aaron Judge** (22 2B, 34HR), **DET Riley Greene** (21/22), **DET Spencer Torkelson** (20/21) and **LAA Taylor Ward** (20/21)...since 1901, five have turned the trick at age 22 or younger: **ATL Ozzie Albies** in 2018 (29/20), **WSH Bryce Harper** in 2015 (21/26), **LAA Mike Trout** in 2014 (26/22), **STL Albert Pujols** in 2002 (25/21) and **CIN Johnny Bench** in 1970 (23/28).

- ★ Caminero has homered in back-to-back games for the fifth time this season (last: June 21-22), including a career-high three-game streak from April 12-14.

RAYS OF SUNSHINE—**Yandy Diaz** leads MLB with 49 hits since the start of June, and his .360 (49-for-136) in that span is second behind **COL Tyler Freeman** (.394)...**Josh Lowe** is batting .321 (18-for-58) with 4 2B, 2 HR and 7 RBI in his last 15 games...**Danny Jansen** is 8-for-25 (.320) with 3 XBH in his last eight starts...**Jake Mangum** has a hit in 23 of his last 27 games (with a PA), hitting .337 (35-for-104) with 7 XBH, 15 RBI and an .811 OPS...in four games since returning from the injured list, **Ha-Seong Kim** is 5-for-15 (.333) with 1 2B and 1 HR.

BEANTOWN SHOWDOWN—The Rays and Red Sox continue the third of four series in 2025 this evening, with the two clubs separated by 1.5 games in the AL East standings...the Rays have lost each of the first two series (April 14-16 in Tampa & June 10-12 at Fenway Park), their first time dropping back-to-back series against Boston since May 22–Aug. 19, 2018...the Rays series loss here last month halted a four-series winning streak at Fenway Park, which tied the longest in franchise history (also: April 27, 2019–Aug. 12, 2020)...they are 11-3-1 in this venue since 2019—from 1998–2018, they went 18-38-5...the Rays have won 11 of their last 16 games at Fenway but are 6-10 in their last 16 meetings with the Red Sox overall.

TONIGHT'S START—Drew Rasmussen will make his 19th start of the campaign and first against the Red Sox...marks his 69th start (118G) of his career and fifth (9G) against Boston...has a three-game winning streak across his last four road starts (May 17–pres.)...min. 75.0 IP, ranks among AL leaders in WHIP (8th, .101), opp. OPS (11th, .610) and opp. average (12th, .216/69-for-320)...reached 400.0 career innings in his last start on July 6 at MIN...signed a two-year contract extension through 2026 with a club option for 2027 on Jan. 7, 2025.

LAST TIME OUT—He worked only two innings and threw 32 pitches in his shortest start of the year on July 6 at MIN in a 7-5 win (ND, 2.OIP, 3H, R, 2SO, HR)...allowed a lead-off home run to **Byron Buxton**, his first since April 14, 2023 vs. TOR (**George Springer**)...he scattered two more hits across the remainder of his outing and escaped with the lone run allowed...was the first Rays starter to throw 32 pitches or fewer in a start since he did so as an opener on Sept. 14, 2024 at CLE.

- ✦ It marked just the third time in 18 starts this season he failed to complete five innings, joining May 6 vs. PHI (4.1IP) and June 30 vs. ATH (3.OIP).

DIAMOND CITY—Rasmussen has made eight career appearances (4GS) against the Red Sox, with his last coming as a relief apperance on Sept. 28, 2024 at BOS (2.OIP, 2H, 2SO)...across his career against the Red Sox, he is 1-1 with a 2.88 ERA (25.OIP, 8ER) and .229 (22-for-96) opp. average...he has started two of his three outings at Fenway Park and has gone 1-0 in those three games with a 1.64 ERA (11.OIP, 2ER) and a .220 (9-for-41) opp. average...he has allowed one or zero runs in each road appearance...his last start against the Red Sox came on July 14, 2022 at Tropicana Field (6.OIP, 4H, 3R, BB, 5SO, HR), and his last start at Fenway came on Sept. 7, 2021 (W, 5.OIP, 6H, R, 2SO).

- ✦ He is 1-2 with a 1.59 ERA (17.OIP, 3ER) in three starts vs. AL East clubs this season, holding opponents to a 11-for-57 (.193) clip...he has allowed two runs or fewer in each of these starts.
- ✦ In 33 career apperances (23GS) against the AL East, Rasmussen is 7-7 witha 2.32 ERA (136.OIP, 35ER) and 113 strikeouts to 36 walks.

HOME(S) AWAY FROM HOME—Rasmussen has earned the win in three of his last four road starts...prior to his last start, he had won three straight road starts, matching the longest streak of his career (also: Sept. 7-29, 2021) and marking the second-longest streak by a Rays pitcher this season behind **Zack Littell's** four-start run from April 27–May 31...the Rays are 5-1 this season when he starts away from Steinbrenner Field, and he holds a 3-0 record with a 3.21 ERA (28.OIP, 10ER) and 24 strikeouts in those games.

- ✦ His runs allowed on the road this season by outing: 1, 4, 0, 4, 0, 1.

RASON A ROLL—Of his last 10 starts, five have been scoreless, and he has allowed two runs or fewer in eight of them...Rasmussen is 6-1 with a 2.37 ERA (49.1IP, 13ER) and 0.97 WHIP in that span, holding opponents to a .213/.267/.316 (37-for-174) line with 41 strikeouts...over that stretch (since May 17), he has the fifth-best WHIP and ERA in the AL (min. 45.OIP).

SLUG STOPPER—Rasmussen has allowed only seven extra-base hits across his last eight starts(3 2B, 4HR) holding opponents to a .333 slugging pct. in that span...min 75.0 IP, his .338 opp. slugging pct. on the season ranks 13th in the AL...he has recorded eight starts of 5.0 IP or more with no extra-base hits allowed, tied with DET **Tarik Skubal** for the most in the majors.

FROZE HIM—Rasmussen is tied with TOR **José Berríos** for sixth in the majors with 33 called strikeouts behind STL **Sonny Gray** (41), NYY **Will Warren** (41), CLE **Tanner Bibee** (37), SD **Nick Pivetta** (37) and HOU **Hunter Brown** (34)...over his last seven starts, 16 of his 33 strikeouts have been looking...his 18 called strikeouts on sinkers are tied with TOR **Chris Bassitt** and Bibbee for the AL lead—it also ties the fourth-most called strikeouts on any individual pitch in the Junior Circuit, trailing only four-seam fastballs belonging to DET **Jack Flaherty** (23), TOR **Kevin Gausman** (21) and Warren (20).

HEAT CHECK—Rasmussen throws fastballs (cutter, sinker, four-seamer) 89.1 pct. of the time, the third-highest rate among major league starters (min. 500 pitches thrown in starts)...among all pitchers with 500 or more pitches thrown this season, only NYY **Tim Hill** 95.6%) and BOS **Kenley Jansen** (91.1%) have a higher usage rate on heaters than Rasmussen.

- ✦ Opponents are hitting .214 (64-for-299) against his fastballs in 2025, including a .172 (16-for-93) clip against his cutter.

GOING STREAKING—Rasmussen's 23.0 scoreless inning streak from May 17–June 3 was tied for the fifth-longest single-season run in club history, trailing runs by **J.P. Howell** (27.1IP, 2012), **Alex Cobb** (24.2IP, 2014), **Kevin Kelly** (24.1, 2024) and **Taj Bradley** (24.OIP, 2024)...only Cobb's and Bradley's streaks came as starting pitchers...Rasmussen tallied five scoreless innings or more in a franchise-record four consecutive starts during the streak.

BEST OF THE BEST—Min. 305.0 IP, Rasmussen's 2.74 ERA (367.2IP, 112ER) since debuting with the Rays on June 19, 2021 ranks second in the majors behind NYY **Max Fried** (2.64)...under the same parameter, he also leads the AL in opp. slugging pct. (.324 and opp. OPS (.590), is second in WHIP (1.03) behind DET **Tarik Skubal** (0.97), second in opp. on-base pct. (.266) behind Skubal (.255), and ninth in opp. average (.218).

- ✦ Rasmussen (2.93 ERA/400.OIP, 130ER) is one of 12 active major league pitchers with 400.0 IP or more and an ERA of 3.00 or better in his career...he is one of seven to accomplish the feat while starting in at least half of his appearances.
- ✦ Rasmussen did not yield an extra-base hit in 21.2 IP from March 31–April 24...per Stats Perform, his streak with 0 XBH was the longest by a starting pitcher to begin a season in Rays history, and tied for second longest by any Rays pitcher with **Kyle Farnsworth** (21.2IP) in 2012, trailing only **J.P. Feyerisen** (24.1IP) in 2016...it marks the fourth-longest streak by a Rays starter at any point in a season.
