THE GIANTS: The Giants look to salvage a game in the series with a win in today's series finale vs. the Diamondbacks.

- ▶ SF lost its fourth game of the season via a walk-off last night, which is tied for third-most in MLB and for the most in the NL with Pittsburgh.
- ▶ The Giants are in the middle of a stretch where they play 20 of 26 games on the road (started May 11 and goes until June 7)... the Giants are 10-17 (.370) over their first 27 games away from Oracle Park (22nd in MLB).
- ▶ The Giants are 4-5 on the first nine games of this current 10-game road trip to Los Angeles-NL (2-2), West Sacramento (2-1) and Arizona (0-2).
- ▶ The Giants are 6-4 in road games in the state of California (Padres, Dodgers, A's) compared to 4-13 vs. all out-of-state hosts (Orioles, Reds, Nationals, Phillies, Rays, D-Backs).

TODAY'S STARTER: RHP Tyler Mahle draws the start in today's series finale...he received the loss in his last start (May 15 at ATH), allowing five runs on 10 hits (one homer) and a walk while striking out six.

- ▶ Mahle has a 6.00 ERA (14er, 21.0ip) and 22 strikeouts over his last four starts.
- ▶ Today will be Mahle's sixth career start vs. the Diamondbacks (last facing them in 2022)... Mahle is 0-1 with a 1.80 ERA (6er, 30.0ip), 40 strikeouts and a 0.87 WHIP...the 1.80 ERA is his best against any team.
- ▶ Mahle's two most-used pitches are his four-seamer (47.1% usage rate) and his splitter (24.8% usage rate)...the pitches have a combined -6 run value...Arizona has an .801 OPS vs. four-seamers (eighth in MLB) and an .353 OPS vs. splitters this season (27th in MLB).

HOMER HAPPY: IF Rafael Devers and **IF Willy Adames** hit back-to-back homers as part of the Giants' three-run 2nd inning last night...it was SF's second back-to-back homer sequence of the season (other: **OF Harrison Bader** and **C Eric Haase** on May 12 at LAD).

- ▶ SF has now homered at least once in 14 of its last 15 games (dating to the first game of the last homestand on May 4 vs. San Diego) and hit 21 homers total during that stretch... SF's 21 home runs since May 4 are the fourth-most in the Majors over that span.
- ▶ However, entering today, the Giants' 40 home runs overall this year are tied with TB for fourth-fewest in MLB...only Milwaukee (33), Boston (35) and Miami (39) have fewer.

WILLY DO IT: IF Willy Adames has homered in both games this series...he is slashing .400/.442/.625 with five extra-base hits, nine RBI and a 1.067 OPS over his last 10 games.

- ▶ After entering this series with a career-long 29-game homerless streak, Adames has a chance to homer in three straight games with a big fly today...the last Giant with a homer in three straight games was **IF Rafael Devers** with a three-game streak August 31-September 2, 2025.

CARELESS RISP-ER: The Giants went 0-for-8 with runners in scoring position last night... SF is batting .175 (10x57) with a .450 OPS with RISP over its last seven games...in three of those games, SF has gone hitless with seven or more at-bats in the game with RISP.

- ▶ The Giants have a .659 OPS with RISP this season, which is 28th in MLB.

PITCHER'S BEST FRIEND: The Giants turned four double plays last night, extending their MLB lead to 55 on the season (second is St. Louis with 50).

- ▶ The last time SF turned four or more double plays in a game was on June 21, 2023 vs. San Diego...the last time SF turned four or more double plays in a loss was July 1, 2015 vs. Miami (five double plays).

WHAT'S NEXT: The Giants will finally head back home to SF following today's game... following an off day tomorrow, SF will first host the White Sox for three games Friday-Sunday before facing the Diamondbacks again for three games (Monday-Wednesday).

- ▶ SF is 3-9 (.250) in Interleague games this season, which is the lowest interleague winning percentage in MLB in 2026.
- ▶ The Giants lost their three-game series at the White Sox last season 2-1.

WELCOME TO SF: Is in the midst of his 10th season in the Majors and his first in a Giants uniform...the 31-year-old inked a one-year deal with SF on January 5.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his fifth loss of the season last Friday at vs. A's at Sutter Health Park...allowed a season-high 10 hits over 5.0 innings of work and gave up five runs (one HR) with a walk and six strikeouts in the start.

VS. ARIZONA: Will face the Diamondbacks for the sixth time in his career and first since 2022...Mahle has a miniscule 1.80 ERA (6er, 30.0ip) in his five starts vs. AZ, striking out 40 batters (12.00 K/9ip) and holding opponents to a .154 clip (16x104)...despite his success, the right-hander is still looking for his first career win vs. the club (0-1).

DESERT WARRIOR: Mahle has been pitched exceptionally well here at Chase Field...in two career starts here in AZ, the righty has tossed 13.0 shutout innings with a total of three hits (.071 BAA), four walks and 18 strikeouts...in his last time out against the Dbacks on June 14, 2022, Mahle threw 9.0 scoreless innings with just three hits, no walks and matched a career-best 12 strikeouts.

SEND HELP!: Mahle has a total of 11 runs of support through his nine starts this season...his 2.12 run support average is third-lowest in MLB (min. five starts), while his 11 runs of support are second-fewest among pitchers with at least 40.0 innings pitched this season, ahead only of CLE's Tanner Bibee (eight).

FIRST THINGS FIRST: Is throwing the first pitch of an at-bat for a strike just 52.2% of the time...his 52.2% first pitch strike rate this season is the lowest of his career and ranks as the second lowest in MLB (min. 30ip) behind LAA's Walbert Ureña (48.6%).

WORKING THE COUNT: Mahle has been successful when he sets the tone with a strike...when he gets ahead of the count 0-1, opponents are hitting just .182 with a .513 OPS...after he falls behind 1-0, however, opponents are hitting .338 with a .997 OPS.

EARLY BIRD: Despite his low first-strike rate, opponents are still 9-for-14 (.643) with a triple and two home runs against Mahle on the first pitch of an at-bat.

PUT IT IN REVERSE: Has been putting some reverse splits this season, with right handers slashing .330/.416/.545 off him while lefties are .245/.301/.415...lefties, however, are 8-for-their-last-21 off him.

HOMEBODY: Has been pitching much better at home this season...in five starts at Oracle Park, the righty has a 3.62 ERA (11er, 27.1ip), .233 BAA and .695 opponents' OPS...in four starts away from home, he is 0-3 with a 8.38 ERA (18er, 19.1ip), .354 opposing average and 1.017 OPS...last season, Mahle had a 0.84 ERA in 10 starts at home and 4.36 ERA in six road starts.

BANANA SPLIT: Batters are hitting .279 (17x61) with 17 strikeouts off his secondary pitch, his split finger, which Mahle throws 24.8% of the time (-4 run value)...last year, Mahle's splitter was his most valuable pitch, accumulating a +5 run value...he used the pitch 27.7% of the time last year, with opponents hitting just .196 off his split-finger with 25 strikeouts (24.0% whiff rate).

NOT SO FAST: Over his last five starts, opponents are 8-for-42 (.190) with 14 strikeouts in at-bats ending with his four-seamer...overall, Mahle is throwing his four-seam fastball 47.1% of the time this year, averaging 92.3 mph with batters hitting .279 off the pitch...last year, he held batters to a .209 (27x147) clip with the pitch with 10 total XBH.

WILD GOOSE CHASE: Has a 26.8% chase rate this season, his lowest since averaging a career-low 26.0% in 2021...Mahle's 21.6% whiff rate is currently the lowest of his career.

HOT AND COLD: Has alternated good and bad starts this season and hasn't found much consistency yet early in the year...in odd-numbered starts (#1, #3, #5, #7, #9) this season, he's combined to post a 2.33 ERA (7er, 27.0ip) with 27 strikeouts and a .243 batting average against...in the other four outings (#2, #4, #6, #8), he's gone 0-3 with a 10.07 ERA (22er, 19.2ip), a 1.98 WHIP, .342 BAA and eight homers.

TREVOR McDONALD RHP

2026 RECORD: 2-0, 2.37 ERA

- ▶ Kicks off SF's homestand Friday night against the White Sox and is making his fourth start
- ▶ Stymied the A's over 6.2 innings last Saturday in Sacramento, allowing one run on five hits with five strikeouts and a walk to earn the win in SF's 6-4 victory.
- ▶ In his brief MLB career (seven games, five starts) since 2024, McDonald has allowed eight earned runs in 37.0 innings (1.95 ERA), struck out 32 and walked only six... SF is 5-0 in his five career starts.

(bohr-RUCK-ee)

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Split Finger, Sweeper

Last Game: 5/18 at AZ; 2.0ip, 2h, k (22 pitches)

- ▶ Has now allowed a run over his last four games (6.1ip).
- ▶ Has allowed runs in seven of his 18 appearances (3.93 ERA)... however, he's 1-0 with a 2.08 ERA (3er, 13.0ip) in his last 12 games.
- ▶ Lefties are 5-for-33 (.152) with four walks and nine strikeouts vs. him...has held lefties to a .179 clip (72-for-402) in his MLB career.
- ▶ Righties are 14-for-35 (.400) with six XBH (two HRs) this year.
- ▶ Signed a Major League contract with the Giants on March 21 after opting out of his minor league deal with the White Sox on March 20...was in camp with Chicago-AL as an NRI.

#34 JT BRUBAKER ▶ RHP

(BROO-baker)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Cutter, Changeup

Last Game: 5/18 at AZ; 1.2ip, 3h, 2r, er, k (29 pitches)

- ▶ In his last seven outings, he has a 5.40 ERA (6er, 10.0ip) and .317 BAA (13x41)...in nine games prior, he had a 2.38 ERA (3er, 11.1ip) and .250 BAA (10x40).
- ▶ Has a 0.75 ERA (1er, 12.0ip) in nine road games...has a 7.71 ERA (8er, 9.1ip) in seven games at Oracle Park.
- ▶ Issued at least one walk in nine of 16 contests (5.06 BB/9.0ip).
- ▶ Right-handers are 14-for-49 (.286) with five XBHs off him while lefties are 9-for-32 (.281).

#93 MATT GAGE ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Splitter

Last Game: 5/19 at ARI; BS, 0.0ip, h, r, er, hr (2 pitches)

- ▶ Allowed a walk-off home run to Ketel Marte last night.
- ▶ Gage's 24 appearances this year are tied for second-most in MLB.
- ▶ Has surrendered five runs (four ER) in 19.1ip this year (1.86 ERA).
- ▶ Lefties are just 2-for-23 (.087) against him this season, and 19-for-106 in his career (.179).
- ▶ His 25.9% hard hit rate ranks in the top 3% of MLB.
- ▶ His 14.1% walk rate is in the bottom 10% of MLB (11 BBs in 19.1ip).
- ▶ He's the first wearer of #93 in SF Giants history...#93 is the highest player-worn uniform number in SF-era history, passing No. 87 (worn by RHP Dan Otero in 2012).
- ▶ Originally was a 10th-round pick of the Giants in 2014 before his career journey brought him back to SF last season.

#31 SAM HENTGES ▶ LHP

(HENT-chiss)

Pitch Arsenal: Curveball, 4-Seam FB, Slider, Sinker

Last Game: 5/17 at ATH; 1.0ip, 2k (10 pitches)

- ▶ Has made four appearances with SF, logging 3.1-scoreless innings, allowing just one hit and three walks with five strikeouts.
- ▶ Is returning to the Majors for the first time since July 10, 2024.
- ▶ Missed the entire 2025 season while recovering from left shoulder surgery, performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache in Los Angeles on September 18, 2024...also developed some right knee soreness during his rehab and underwent arthroscopic surgery in August 2025.
- ▶ Returned from rehab and reinstated from the 15-day IL Sunday.
- ▶ In 10 rehab games between Single-A San Jose and Triple-A Sacramento, the lefty had a 1.93 ERA (2er, 9.1ip) with six walks and eight strikeouts.
- ▶ Signed one-year deal with SF on December 3, 2025.

#45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

(kill-EE-en)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 5/19 at ARI; 1.1ip, 2h, 3r, 2er, k (25 pitches)

- ▶ Last 6 games: 6.1ip, 5h, 6r, 5er, 2hr, 4bb, 6k (7.11 ERA)...had a 0.64 ERA (1er, 14.0ip) with a .111 BAA and 16 K's in 13 games prior.
- ▶ Owns a 25.6% strikeout rate and .164 BAA (12x73) this season.
- ▶ Has a 5.06 BB/9ip...his 14.6% BB rate ranks in the bottom 7% of MLB.
- ▶ Left-handed batters are 7-for-42 (.167) with no XBH against him while right-handers are 5-for-31 (.161) with two homers.
- ▶ Returned to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite this past offseason...dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of 2025 with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4 Seam FB, Sinker, Changeup

Last Game: 5/19 at ARI; 0.1ip, 3bb (21 pitches)

- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on Saturday after missing 14 games with a low back strain...has allowed two runs on five walks in 1.0ip, covering his two appearances since returning.
- ▶ Had not allowed a run in his last eight appearances prior to injury dating back to April 8 vs. Philadelphia (8.1ip, 2h, 0r, 0er, 4bb, 13k).
- ▶ Right-handers are 4-for-25 (.160) off him with two doubles.
- ▶ Has not allowed a homer in his last 57.2 innings dating to August 14, 2024, the second-longest active homerless streak in MLB.

#63 JOEL PEGUERO ▶ RHP

(jo-EL peh-GAIR-oh)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Changeup

Last Game: 5/17 at ATH; 1.0ip (12 pitches)

- ▶ Activated on May 5 after 10 rehab games with Triple-A Sacramento...missed SF's first 35 games while recovering from a left hamstring strain that also held him out of most of Spring Training.
- ▶ Has tossed 6.1 innings since returning from the IL, allowing two runs (one earned) on two hits in six games so far (1.42 ERA).
- ▶ Batters are 1-for-12 with a single off his sinker thus far, which he's thrown 43.6% of the time...he threw it 34.3% of the time in his stint w/SF last season.
- ▶ Made his MLB debut in 2025 with SF after signing with the org. prior to the season on an MiLB contract...posted a 3-1 record with a 2.42 ERA (6er, 22.1ip), 17 strikeouts and a 1.03 WHIP over 17 games.
- ▶ His sinker averaged 99.8 mph and his four-seamer 99.9 mph last season...his slider averaged 91.6 mph and accounted for 12 of his 15 strikeouts.

#67 KEATON WINN ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, 2-Seam FB, Splitter, Slider

Last Game: 5/19 at ARI; 1.0ip, bb, k (14 pitches)

- ▶ Has posted a 1.13 ERA (2er, 16.0ip) with a 0.69 WHIP over his last 16 games.
- ▶ Leads SF with 10 holds, which is tied for the third-most in MLB.
- ▶ 17 of his 21 appearances this year have been scoreless (2.21 ERA).
- ▶ Opponents are just 10-for-67 (.149) off him this year.
- ▶ Batters are just 5-for-38 (.132) with 14 K's off his splitter.
