FINAL DESTINATION: The American League best Detroit Tigers arrived months ago in Denver on the heels of four wins in their last five games and tonight begin a weather-delayed three-game set at Coors Field, the third and final destination of their season long 11-day, 10-game, three-city trip that began with Houston (1-2) and the Los Angeles Angels (3-1) ... due to last night's postponement, the clubs will play a traditional doubleheader tomorrow to conclude this now 24-hour-ish series.

- The Tigers have had two days off since their 13-1 shellacking of the Angels on Sunday, securing their eighth series win out of 11 series this season ... Trey Sweeney set career highs with four hits and six RBI while Kerry Carpenter recorded his first-career five RBI game as part of a 4-for-6 effort, his third-career four-hit game, with a two-run double and three-run homer.
- This road trip touches the Central, Pacific and Mountain time zones and is bookended by a pair of Eastern time zone series in Detroit ... this marks the first time in Tigers history that they will play four consecutive series in each of the four different time zones in the continental U.S.
- After this series, the Tigers will return home for a two-team, six-game homestand starting Friday with the first of three games this weekend against the Texas Rangers and concluding next week with three games against the Boston Red Sox (Monday-Wednesday).

THIS IS ON THE RECORD: The Tigers have now awoken three times in Denver with the best record in the A.L. and at 22-13, they have their best record through 35 games to start a season in 11 years when they began 23-12 in 2014 en route to their most-recent A.L. Central title.

- The Tigers have gone 22-10, a .688 winning percentage, in their last 32 games starting March 31 since enduring a three-game sweep to start the season at Dodger Stadium ... their 22-10 record starting March 31 is the best record in all of baseball in that span.

HE'S JUST THE PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Riley Greene soars into this series as the reigning American League Player of the Week after he batted .464 (13-for-28) with four homers and eight RBI in seven games last week, recording at least one hit in every game ... Greene made major league history on Friday in Los Angeles when he became the first player to ever hit two home runs in the ninth inning of a game ... this is the first weekly honor of Greene's career and the first by a Tiger since Keider Montero in September of last season and the first position player since Miguel Cabrera in 2022.

HOMER HAPPY ROAD WARRIORS: The Tigers have homered in all seven games of this road trip thus far, crushing 20 bombs along the way ... the Tigers have hit 20 homers in a seven-game stretch for the first time since September 14-20, 2004.

- The Tigers have homered in seven-consecutive road games (all part of the same road trip) for the first time since July 19-25, 2024 ... overall right now, the Tigers have homered in eight straight road games, their longest road streak since a 17-game run last June 29-August 7.

WHAT A TRIO: Spencer Torkelson (10 homers, matching his 2024 total), Riley Greene (eight homers) and Kerry Carpenter (eight homers) are one of only four trios of teammates with eight or more home runs this season, joining New York's Aaron Judge (12), Trent Grisham (9) and Ben Rice (8); Los Angeles' Shohei Ohtani (10), Teoscar Hernandez (9) and Tommy Edman (8); and Chicago's Kyle Tucker (9), Pete Crow-Armstrong (9) and Carson Kelly (8).

WHAT A TREY: With six RBI on Sunday, Trey Sweeney became just the fourth Tigers shortstop in franchise history to record six RBI in a single game, joining Carlos Guillen, (August 21, 2004 vs. Seattle), Chris Gomez (May 17, 1994 at Toronto) and Dick McAuliffe (May 10, 1963 vs. Cleveland).

HE MANAGES JUST FINE: Tigers Manager A.J. Hinch enters tonight's game with 899 career wins as a manager, one shy of becoming the 75th skipper in major league history to reach 900 victories ... Hinch will be one of five active managers to reach the mark, a list that includes Colorado's Bud Black, who ranks fourth among active managers and 47th overall with 1,192 wins.

CENTRAL CASTING: When it comes to run differential in the A.L. Central, the Tigers at +63 have a +54 edge on the next closest team in their division, the fourth-place Minnesota Twins, who are +9 this season ... the Tigers have a +79 edge on second-place Cleveland, who checks in at -16, a +58 edge on Kansas City, who is at +5, and a +91 edge on Chicago, who is at -28.

THIS DIFFERENCE ISN'T NEGLIGIBLE: The Tigers begin the day with the best record in the A.L. on the strength of a +63 overall run differential this year, the best mark in all of baseball, just ahead of the Yankees and Cubs (+60) ... the Mariners (+30) are a distance away in third place ... the Dodgers (+44) are a distance away for third-best in the majors.

POP, POP, FIZZ, FIZZ: The Tigers bullpen has combined to post a 2.57 ERA (33 ER/115.2 IP) this season, the lowest relief ERA in the American League and the third-lowest mark in all of baseball, behind only San Diego (2.34) and San Francisco (2.39).

AND FINALLY: The Tigers have gone from first-to-third base on a single 30 times this season, tied with Houston for the most occurrences by any team in the majors.

- Went 2-0 over his first five starts, with Detroit winning all five games in which he started. Has yet to allow more than three earned runs in a start this year.
- Earned his first Major League win against the Twins on April 12, 2025, allowing two hits and one walk while striking out two over 6.0 scoreless innings.
- Entered the 2025 season ranked as MLB's No. 5 overall prospect and the top prospect in the Tigers' system according to *MLB Pipeline*.
- Earned a spot on the Opening Day roster for the first time in his career after going 1-1 with a 3.86 ERA in five Spring Training starts.
- Was promoted to the Majors near the end of the 2024 season and pitched in two regular season games with the Tigers, working 4.0 scoreless innings with one hit allowed, one walk and two strikeouts.
- Made his Major League debut on Sept. 25 vs. Tampa Bay last year, closing out Detroit's win with a scoreless ninth inning.
- At 22 years and 64 days old, was Detroit's fourth-youngest pitcher to appear in a postseason game (Oct. 2), trailing only Joel Zumaya (2006), Fred Hutchinson (1940) and Ralph Works (1909).

- Placed on the 15-day injured list on April 18 with right ankle inflammation...activated by Detroit on May 3.
- Made his first career Opening Day roster in 2025
- Pitched in 46 games (12 starts) for the Tigers in 2024, finishing with a 4-5 record, 3.59 ERA (27ER/67.2IP) and 69 strikeouts...set career-best marks in strikeouts, wins, holds (6), opponent batting average (.224), slugging percentage (.354) and OPS (.664).
- Started on Sept. 13 and 14 vs. Baltimore last season, becoming the first Tigers pitcher to start back-to-back team games, which were on consecutive days, since George Uhle on Aug. 4-5, 1929.
- Pitched in six games during the playoffs, combining for a 0-1 record, two saves, 1.50 ERA (1ER/6.0IP) and six strikeouts.
- Made his postseason debut on Oct. 1 at Houston, walking one in a scoreless two-thirds of an inning to pick up the save...according to the Elias Sports Bureau, he became the first pitcher in franchise history to record a save in his first career playoff game.
- Started his postseason career with 5.1 no-hit innings with two walks and six strikeouts in his first four outings.

- Earned a spot on his first career Opening Day roster after a standout spring camp, during which he didn't allow a single earned run over 10.2 innings (nine games) of relief...went 1-0, surrendering seven hits and three walks while striking out nine
- Appeared in 21 games (three starts) for the Tigers in 2024, posting a 1-1 record with a 1.84 ERA (6ER/29.1IP), six walks and 23 strikeouts...also made 34 appearances with Triple-A Toledo last year, going 1-2 with one save, a 5.17 ERA (27ER/47.0IP) and 53 strikeouts.
- Made his first career Major League start on Aug. 8 at Seattle...according to the Elias Sports Bureau, became the first Tigers pitcher to finish and then start consecutive games since Steve Sparks, who finished the July 26, 2000, game vs. Tampa Bay and started on July 27, 2000, at Texas.
