RAY REPORT-The Rays open a nine-game, 11-day homestand vs. Boston (3 to play)
Kansas City (3 to play) and Oakland (3 to play) tonight at Tropicana FieldTampa Bay is
in the midst of a 13-game stretch featuring matchups exclusively vs. AL East opponents
(6-4 thus far), which began with a three-game series vs. the Yankees from May 10-12
(1-2)the 13-game stretch ends Wednesday, bookending seven matchups between the
Rays and Red Sox over a span of 10 daysfollowing this series vs. Boston, Tampa Bay will
enjoy four off-days over the next 15 days.

Tampa Bay turned a season-high three double plays in yesterday's defeat at Toronto, its most since turning three on Aug. 16, 2023 at San Francisco.

The Rays are 22-4 vs. the Red Sox at Tropicana Field since June 23, 2021, outscoring Boston, 130-78 (+52), during that stretch...Tampa Bay won a franchise-best 13 straight home games vs. Boston from April 23, 2022-April 13, 2023, tied for the fifth-longest home winning streak by any club vs. Boston since 1901: Minnesota Twins (17G, Aug. 4, 1964-May 7, 1966), Cleveland Indians (16G, June 21, 1920-July 13, 1921), Washington Senators (15G, April 26, 1926-May 30-G2, 1927) and St. Louis Browns (14G, Sept. 12, 1926-G2-June 11, 1928).

After beginning the season 1-8 in series openers, the Rays are 5-1 since...the 1-8 record was tied with Arizona and Chicago-AL for the second worst in MLB behind Miami (0-9)...Tampa Bay's 5-1 mark since is tied for the best in the majors with Houston, New York-AL and Philadelphia (all 5-1).

With a win tonight, the Rays can move to a season-high-tying three games over .500.

RECENT TRANSACTIONS—Prior to tonight's game, Tampa Bay reinstated INF Brandon Lowe (right oblique strain) from the 10-day IL and added LHP Richard Lovelady to the active roster...RHP Zach Eflin was placed on the 15-day IL (retro May 19) with lower back inflammation and RHP Manuel Rodríguez was optioned to Triple-A Durham.

Last appearing with the Rays on April 7 at Colorado, Lowe made six rehab appearances with Durham, batting .235 (4-for-17) with 2 HR and 8 RBI.

Lovelady, 28, was acquired from Chicago-NL on May 18 in exchange for minor leaguer LHP Jeff Belge...in seven relief appearances with the Cubs this season, he went 0-1 with a 7.94 ERA (5.2IP, 5ER)...also made 10 appearances for Triple-A lowa, posting a 5.84 ERA (12.1IP, 8ER) with 20 SO.

INSIDE THE NUMBERS—Boston pitchers throw cutters 20.9 pct. of the time, the highest usage rate in the majors, ahead of Tampa Bay (17.4%), New York-AL (15.4%) and Baltimore (14.5%)...as a club, the Rays are batting .307 on cutters, the fourth-best clip in the majors behind Arizona (.359), Baltimore (.340) and Pittsburgh (.310)...the .307 batting average marks the Rays highest on any pitch, with their next closest being .271 vs. sinkers.

Boston starter Tanner Houck utilizes his slider 43.3 pct. of the time, limiting opponents to a .191 (18-for-94) AVG with 32 SO on the offering...in their May 15 matchup at Fenway Park, the Rays went 2-for-12 (.167) with 2 SO vs. his slider.

ALL EYES ON ISAAC—Isaac Paredes has reached base safely in a career-high 18 consecutive games, slashing .375/.474/.578 (24-for-64) with 4 2B, 3 HR and 10 RBI, drawing nearly as many walks (11) as strikeouts (12) during the run...entering play today, drawing nearly as many walks (11) as strikeouts (12) during the run...entering play today, it marks the longest active streak in the AL and tied for third longest in the majors, trailing SD Luis Arraez (23G) and SF LaMonte Wade Jr. (19G)...it marks the longest streak by a Ray since Yandy Díaz (22G) from April 27-May 28, 2023.

Since the streak began on April 28, Paredes ranks among AL leaders in on-base pct. (2nd), batting average (3rd), OPS (3rd, 1.052), walks (T5th) and hits (7th).

He leads the AL in batting average since April 14, hitting .342 (38-for-111) over 30 games...he entered that stretch hitting .235 (12-for-51) through his first 14 contests.

Paredes has also reached base safely in 22 straight home games since March 30...it marks the longest active home on-base streak in the majors and the longest by a Ray since Randy Arozarena (33G. April 12-June 24, 2023).

PEN PALS—The Rays bullpen has turned in an AL-leading 1.64 ERA (60.1IP, 11ER) since May 3, trailing only the Dodgers (1.41) in all of MLB...they entered that stretch with an MLB-worst 5.55 ERA through their first 32 games, dropping that mark to 4.26 entering tonight's game...they allowed only 2 ER during their seven-game road trip, posting a 0.71 ERA (25.1IP, 2ER).

Riding an 11.0 scoreless inning streak, **LHP Garrett Cleavinger** has not allowed an earned run in 17 consecutive outings since April 6, tied for the third-longest active streak in MLB behind NYY **Clay Holmes** (20G) and PHI **Matt Strahm** (18G). **RHP Jason Adam** is 2-0 with a 0.51 ERA (17.2IP, 1ER) over his last 18 games. **RHP Pete Fairbanks** has retired all 12 BF across four scoreless appearances since

returning from the 15-day IL on May 11, recording 6 SO.

CLOSE SHAVES—Each of Tampa Bay's last seven games have been decided by three runs or fewer, tied with New York-AL for the third-longest active streak in the majors behind Philadelphia (24G) and Houston (7G)...the Rays had a season-high eight straight games

decided by three runs or fewer from May 3-11.

The Rays have played in 26 games decided by two runs or fewer, tied for the AL lead and tied for third most in the majors behind Chicago-NL/Milwaukee (both 27G)...Tampa Bay is 18-8 (.692) in those contests, the second-best winning pct. in the majors behind Philadelphia (14-5/.737).

<u>DOWN ON THE FARM</u>—Earlier today, it was announced that Montgomery **SS Carson** Williams and Bowling Green **1B Tre' Morgan** were both named Player of the Week in

Williams and Bowling Green 1B 1re Morgan were both named Player of the vycek in their respective leagues.

*Williams, rated by MLB.com as the No. 16 overall prospect in baseball, hit .444 (8-for-18) with 3 2B, 1 3B, 3 HR, 6 RBI and 5 BB vs. 3 SO in five games...Williams ranks among all of Double-A in XBH (1st, 21), runs (1st, 34), OPS (2nd, 1.057), AVG (3rd, .346), SLG (3rd, .631), total bases (3rd, 82), hits (T4th, 45) and doubles (T5th, 12).

*Morgan, rated by MLB.com as the Rays No. 13 prospect, hit .529 (9-for-17) with 5 2B, 5 RBI, 4 BB and 1 SB over five games, while not striking out in 23 PA.

SOX IN ST. PETE—Tampa Bay and Boston begin a three-game set tonight at Tropicana

Field...the two clubs met last week in Boston, with Tampa Bay taking three of four...the Red Sox return to Tropicana Field for a three-game series from Sept. 17-19 before the clubs close out the 2024 campaign with a three-game set in Boston from Sept. 27-29.

Brandon Lowe is a 56-for-175 (.320) hitter with 9 2B, 1 3B, 18 HR and 43 RBI in 53 career games opposite the Red Sox...he has hit safely in six of his last seven vs. Boston at Tropicana Field, going 8-for-23 (.348) with 1 2B, 5 HR and 11 RBI.

- Boston 1B Dom Smith was signed to a minor league contract by the Rays last month on April 1...he hit .263 with 3 2B, 2 HR and 11 RBI in 21 games for Triple-A Durham before joining the Red Sox.
- Tampa Bay **RHP Zack Littell** was claimed off waivers by the Rays from the Red Sox on May 12, 2023.
- Rays LHP Jeffrey Springs was acquired from the Red Sox on Feb. 17, 2021...Springs, currently rehabbing from Tommy John surgery, grew up a Red Sox fan and enjoyed watching Pedro Martínez and Jason Varitek.
- Red Sox INF **Vaughn Grissom** was born in Orlando, FL and attended Hagerty High School in Oviedo, FL.
- Wade Boggs, who was inducted into Tampa Bay's inaugural Hall of Fame class in 2023, hit .338 with 422 2B, 47 3B and 85 HR in 11 seasons with Boston (1982-92).
- Boston RHP Kutter Crawford was born in Okeechobee, FL, roughly 140 miles from St. Petersburg... after graduating from Okeechobee High School, he spent two seasons at Indian River State College (2015-16) before transferring to Florida Gulf Coast University in 2017.
- On April 13, 2023, the Rays improved to 13-0 with a 9-3 win vs. Boston, tying the 1982 Braves and 1987 Brewers for the longest season-opening winning streak in the modern era (since 1900) and marking the longest winning and marking the longest winning streak at any point in a season in franchise history.

TONIGHT'S START—The right-hander will make his third start of the season tonight, including his second at Tropicana Field...opened the season on the 15-day IL (right pectoral strain) before making his 2024 debut on May 10 vs. NYY...suffered the injury while warming up for his scheduled spring start on March 12 at BAL...has allowed two runs or fewer in each of his first two outings.

LAST TIME OUT—Making his first road start of the campaign, Bradley earned the win on May 15 at Fenway Park (W, 5.0IP, 4H, 2ER, BB, 6SO, HR)...allowed a 1st-inning sac-fly to **Connor Wong** before retiring each of his next 7 BF ahead of **Wilyer Abreu's** solo homer in the 4th...loaded the bases with two outs in the 5th, but escaped by fanning Abreu to conclude the outing...through his first two starts, he has faced only seven batters with RISP, holding them to a 1-for-5 clip.

SOX TALK—Bradley has earned the win in each of his first three career starts opposite Boston, including his most recent outing on May 15 at Fenway Park...his MLB debut came on April 12, 2023 against the Red Sox at Tropicana Field...in that contest, he yielded 3 ER over 5.0 IP, guiding the Rays to their 12th straight victory to open the season...it marked only the second time in the modern era (since 1900) a team on a winning streak of 10+ games had a rookie make their first career start, joining ATL **Mike McQueen** in 1969...the 8 SO were second most in a Rays pitcher's debut, trailing only **Wade Dayis** (9SO) on Sept. 6. 2009 vs. DET.

Bradley is 4-3 with a 4.80 ERA (45.0IP, 24ER) over eight career starts against AL East opponents...the Rays are 4-4 in those outings.

KING OF THE K—Bradley has recorded 141 SO in his first 23 career starts, third most in any pitcher's first 23 starts after joining the Rays, trailing Charlie Morton (165, 2019) and Drew Smyly (154, 2014-16)...Morton (174) also holds the mark through 23 starts, followed by Smyly (162) and Tyler Glasnow (149SO)...Bradley's 141 SO are the most by a Ray in his first 22 career starts.

career starts.

In 2023, Bradley posted a 28.4 pct. strikeout rate, the highest mark by a rookie in Rays history (min. 300BF), surpassing Shane McClanahan's 27.3 pct. in 2021.

ASSET PROTECTION—Bradley has not had a stolen base attempted against him in 25 career games (23GS)...among pitchers to debut since 1951 (when CS were officially calculated in the NL), the 23-start stretch is tied with Tyler Alexander (2019-21) for the second-longest career-opening streak in the majors, trailing only KC Yordano Ventura (29GS, 2013-14).

DEEP ARSENAL—Opposing hitters are a combined 3-for-21 (.143) with 8 SO and no extra-base hits on Bradley's secondary pitches (cutter, split finger, curveball)...this includes a 1-for-8 (.125) clip on his cutter, a pitch that he recorded a .312 (29-for-93) opp. average on as a rookie.

FIRST THINGS FIRST—Through his first two starts, Bradley has limited opponents to a 1-for-16 (.063) clip with 7 of his 13 SO the first time through the lineup...opposing hitters are 6-for-16 (.375) the second time through and 1-for-7 (.143) the third time.

LONG BALL WOES—Bradley's 23 HR allowed as a starter are the most through a pitcher's first 23 career starts in franchise history, surpassing Roberto Hernández (22, 2013)...last season, from his April 12 debut through June 15, his 0.84 HR/9.0 IP was the 12th-lowest mark in the AL (min. 40.0IP)...from that point on, his 2.77 HR/9.0 IP was second highest in the majors (min. 50.0IP) behind MIN Joe Ryan (2.79).

2023 RECAP—After entering the season ranked as the Rays No. 1 prospect and the No. 16 prospect in the majors (MLB.com), Bradley went 5-8 with a 5.56 ERA over 22 games (21GS) in his first MLB season...had four stints with the Rays: April 11-13, April 18-25, May 18–July 31, and Sept. 3–end of the season...he was the youngest pitcher in the majors to make 20+ starts, becoming the third pitcher (4th instance) in Rays history to make 20+ starts in an age 22 or younger season, joining Scott Kazmir (32GS, 2005; 24GS, 2006) and Joe Kennedy (20GS, 2001).

He went 5-3 with a 3.86 ERA (49.0IP, 21ER) in his first 10 starts, a

He went 5-3 with a 3.86 ERA (49.0IP, 21ER) in his first 10 starts, a stretch that culminated in his first quality start on June 21 vs. BAL.
Over his final 13 appearances (11GS), he went 0-5 with a 7.11 ERA (55.2IP, 44ER), allowing a .271 (62-for-229) opp. average with 18 HR.
