NATIONALS NEWS

SERIES BUSINESS

The Washington Nationals square off against the Seattle Mariners in the third game of this three-game weekend series on Sunday afternoon...Washington has won eight of its last 12 games against Seattle dating back to Aug. 24, 2022 and overall, the Nationals are 21-9 (.700) against the Mariners since 2005.

- Washington beat Seattle, 8-3, on Saturday behind a go-ahead two-run homer by **Luis Garcia Jr.** in the fifth inning and a three-hit, two-RBI effort from **CJ Abrams**.
- With a win today, the Nationals will have won three straight series and nine of their last 10 series since May 12.
- The Nationals have a 25-19 (.568) record since April 25 and have won 10 of 15 series over this stretch.
- The Nationals are 10-9 (.526) at home dating back to May 3...This comes after starting the season with a 3-12 (.200) record at Nationals Park.

VOTE FOR OUR ALL-STARS

All-Star voting is now open and **CJ Abrams** and **James Wood** have placed themselves among the best players in Major League Baseball and the National League...See charts to the right for position specific rankings.

- Wood is hitting .340/.452/.583 with four doubles, seven homers, 15 RBI, 20 walks, six stolen bases and 28 runs in his last 27 games.
- Abrams is 7-for-20 (.350) with a homer, five RBI, one stolen base and five runs over his last five games.

DAYLEN'S DAYS

Daylen Life is 14-for-41 (.341) with two triples, one homer, eight RBI, one hit by pitch, four walks, three stolen bases and six runs scored over his last 11 games since June 1...He has just five strikeouts in 46 plate appearances (10.9%).

- On the season, he ranks among NL outfielders in triples (T2nd, 3), doubles (T4th, 15) and hits (T6th, 15).

CORNER BATS

Since May 22, Washington's corner infielders **Luis Garcia Jr.** (6 HR, 21 RBI), **Curtis Mead** (6 HR, 13 RBI) and **Jorbit Vivas** (1 HR, 4 RBI) lead Major League Baseball with 13 home runs and are tied for the MLB lead with 36 RBI.

- Luis Garcia Jr.** is slugging .615 with three doubles, a triple, six home runs and 21 RBI since May 22...He is 5-for-16 (.313) with two doubles and two homers in his last five games.
- Curtis Mead** is slugging .536 with two doubles, six homers and 13 RBI since May 22.

THE OPENER

Today will be the 14th game of the season in which the Nationals have used an opener... **PJ Poulin** (8th GS today), **Richard Lovelady** (5 GS), and **Paxton Schultz** (1 GS) have combined to pitch to a 2.55 ERA (5 ER/17.2 IP) in the previous 13 instances...The opener has produced a scoreless start in nine of the 13 games so far.

- Between starters and openers, nine different pitchers have thrown the first pitch of a game for the Nationals this season.

ACE OF BASES

Nasim Nuñez leads Major League Baseball with 25 stolen bases and as a club, Washington ranks second in the league with 72 stolen bases behind the Miami Marlins (81).

- The Nationals have stolen 14 consecutive bases without being caught and have been caught just twice in 26 attempts since May 22.

FRAME JOB

Bobby Wilson's catchers rank tied for third in Major League Baseball with five Catcher Framing Runs (**Drew Millas** - 3, **Keibert Ruiz** - 2), according to Baseball Savant..."Catcher Framing Runs converts strikes to runs saved on a .125 run/strike basis, and includes park and pitcher adjustments. To qualify, a catcher must receive 6 called pitches per team game."

- The Nationals are one of just two teams (also Blue Jays) with two catchers in the top 13 in the league...Drew Millas is 10th and Keibert Ruiz is 13th.
- For comparison, Washington's catchers ranked 30th in MLB with -18 Catcher Framing Runs in 2025.

SAVES ON SAVES

The Washington Nationals have had nine separate pitchers record at least one save this season, tied for the second-most in Major League Baseball with the Cincinnati Reds and behind the Minnesota Twins (11) and the second-most in Nationals history (2005-pres.) behind the 2017 Nationals (11).

- Gus Varland** (5), **Richard Lovelady** (4), **Clayton Beeter** (4), **PJ Poulin** (2), **Orlando Ribalta** (2), **Andrew Alvarez** (1), **Brad Lord** (1), **Mitchell Parker** (1) and **Paxton Schultz** (1) have all recorded saves this year.

FARM REPORT

WILLITS WOWS FOR WILMINGTON

Wilmington shortstop **Eli Willits** has launched four home runs in his first four games since being promoted to High-A Wilmington...He recorded his first multi-homer game of the season on June 10, his second game with the Blue Rocks...He's hitting .377/.484/.753 with seven doubles, two triples, six homers, 24 RBI, 14 walks and nine stolen bases in his last 15 games between Single-A Fredericksburg and Wilmington.

- Is 1-2 with a 2.20 ERA (4 ER/16.1 IP) in four career Postseason games (three starts).
- Spent three seasons in Nippon Professional Baseball, pitching for the Yomiuri Giants from 2015-17.
- Participated in the 2018 All-Star Game at Nationals Park.
