RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals continue a six-game homestand with the second of a three-game series against their National League Central Division rivals, the Milwaukee Brewers. The Brewers won the opening game last night 2-1 in 10 innings. St. Louis rallied to tie the game in the bottom of the 9th to send it to extra innings. Following this series, the Cardinals will host the Arizona Diamondbacks for three games (April 22-24). The Cardinals play 19 of their first 28 games against teams who made the 2023 Postseason.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals open today in 5th place in the National League Central, 4.0 games behind first place Milwaukee (12-6) and 1.5 games behind Cincinnati for 4th place. Only three of the Cardinals first 37 games are against divisional opponents. Prior to this season, the fewest divisional games for St. Louis through the first 37 games was six in 1996. - *Elias Sports Bureau*

“YOU TAKE TWO STEPS FORWARD, I TAKE TWO STEPS BACK”: The Cardinals have lost their last two games, however, that marks their longest losing streak of the season, done three previous times. On the other hand, the ‘Birds have not won more than two games in a row either and have been locked at a .500 record six times, most recently at 9-9 at the end of the day on April 16. The last time St. Louis won three or more games in a row was Sept. 3-6, 2023 (3 games), while the last time they dropped three or more in a row was Sept. 27-29, 2023.

TRIFECTA INJECTOR: The Cardinals snapped their franchise record with five straight games with three runs scored. Overall this season, St. Louis has scored exactly three runs in nine games and three or fewer in 14 (2nd-most in MLB to the White Sox with 15). The good news is today’s starting pitcher **Miles Mikolas** is 57-12 when receiving three or more runs of support and 69-16 when even receiving two runs of support as a starter.

DAY GAMES: St. Louis is 2-7 in day games this season, while the Brewers are tied for the Major League best winning percentage at 7-2 (.778) under the sun. The Cardinals are scheduled to play 29 home day games this season and 34 on the road.

GIVES ME THE WILLIES: **Willson Contreras** has reached base safely in a career-high 24 straight games dating back to Sept. 6, 2023, as he passed **Christian Yelich** (10-day Injured List) for MLB’s longest active on-base streak. Contreras is also riding a career-best 12-game hitting streak since April 1 (.357/.471/.643, 15-42), 2nd longest active in MLB behind **Marcell Ozuna** (17).

NOLAN KEEPS ROLLIN’: **Nolan Arenado** singled in his 3rd plate appearance last night and has now reached base safely in 18 consecutive games since March 30, tied for the 4th-longest active on-base streak in Major League Baseball. Arenado has improved his batting average from .000 (0-7) heading into the 3rd game of the season to his current .293 BA entering April 20.

GHOST-BUSTER: Cardinals relief pitcher **Ryan Helsley** suffered the loss last night and has two losses on the season, both in games that went extra innings. Unfortunately, both losses were perpetrated by Major League Baseball’s “Ghost Runner” rule where a runner is placed on second base in extra innings. Since his first appearance of the season in Los Angeles (3/30), in which he allowed two runs, Helsley has not allowed another run without a free base-runner granted due to a rule, in his last eight non-extra inning game appearances (7-for-7 Sv., 3 H, 0 BB, 10 K).

I LOVE BEER!: The Cardinals own the most wins against the Brewers (239-190, .557) since St. Louis and Milwaukee began regular season play in 1997, and since the Seattle Pilots joined MLB as an expansion team in 1969, only the Minnesota Twins (255-240, .515) have more wins over Pilots/Brewers than St. Louis.

MILWAUKEE CONNECTIONS

Ryan Helsley made his MLB debut on April 16, 2019 at Milwaukee...his first strikeout victim was **Ryan Braun** (swinging) that night.

Willson Contreras’ younger brother, **William**, is also a catcher for the Brewers.

Devin Williams was born in nearby Florissant, Mo...was 1st Team Rawlings/Perfect Game Pre-season High School All-American at Hazelwood West High School in 2013...committed to the Univ. of Missouri before drafted by Milwaukee in the 2nd round in 2013.

Joe Ross’ older brother **Tyson Ross**, pitched in nine games for the Cardinals in 2018.

Hall of Famer **Ted Simmons** played five seasons with Milwaukee (1981-85), where he was a two-time AL All-Star and faced off against St. Louis in the 1982 World Series...traded to Milwaukee with **Rollie Fingers** and **Pete Vuckovich** in exchange for **David Green**, **Sixto Lezcano**, **Dave LaPoint** and **Lary Sorensen**.

Turner Ward played parts of three seasons (1994-96) with the Brewers.

Ricky Horton made five starts for the Denver Zephyrs (AAA) in the Brewers organization in 1990.

Trevor Megill was originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign to return to Loyola Marymount Univ.

Steve Dillard, father of Brewers broadcaster **Tim Dillard**, was hitting coach for the Single-A Quad Cities Swing/River Bandits from 2006-07 and hitting coach for the High-A Palm Beach Cardinals in 2007...later piloted Quad Cities in 2008-09, where he managed infielder **Oliver Marmol**.

Brewers broadcaster **Jeff Levering** previously worked three seasons (2010-12) as broadcaster for the Springfield Cardinals (AA).

KMOX broadcaster **Matt Pauley** hosted Brewers pre- and postgame shows for parts of six seasons (2017-22)...was radio play-by-play voice of the Univ. of Wisconsin-Green Bay women’s basketball team.

TODAY'S GAME

- The Cardinals' Opening Day starter for 2024 makes his team-leading 5th start of the season and his 155th career (183rd appearance).
- Is facing the Brewers for the 17th time career (16th start) and with a win tonight, would join **Lance Lynn** (11) and **Kyle Hendricks** as lone active pitchers with 10+ career wins over the Brewers.
- Brings a 1.16 career WHIP vs. NL Central clubs into today's game, ranking 3rd among active pitchers (min. 400 IP) behind **Max Scherzer** (0.97) and **Clayton Kershaw** (1.05).
- Loss last Sun. (4/14) at ARI dropped his career won-loss record to .500 (55-55).
- Is 23-23 in his 71 starts at Busch Stadium as a Cardinal, with 42 Quality Starts. The Cardinals are 40-31 in those games.
- Entering his 7th season (was injured in 2020) with the Cardinals in 2024. Is currently ranked 2nd among active Cardinals pitchers in career innings pitched (854.2), wins (51), strikeouts (626) and games started (144) for St. Louis; trailing only **Lance Lynn** in all categories.
- Led Major League Baseball with 35 starts in 2023, becoming the first pitcher to record 35 starts in a season since **Jhoulys Chacin** (35) in 2018 with Milwaukee. Was the first Cardinals pitcher since **Chris Carpenter** had 35 in 2009 to do so.
- Hasn't committed an error since August 2, 2018 vs. COL. Is one of two pitchers (**Erick Fedde**) with 100+ total chances and zero errors since Aug 3, 2018. Ranks 8th among MLB pitchers in fielding pct. (.988) since 2018 (min. 100 TC).

LAST TIME OUT

- Was hit up for 5 runs by Arizona in their 5th, and suffered a 5-0 defeat last Sun. (4/14) at Chase Field. It was his 33rd career start with St. Louis of receiving zero runs of support.

2024

- Notched his 1st win of the season, besting the Padres and **Yu Darvish** by a 5-2 score on April 2 at PETCO Park. It was his 1st win in San Diego since May 10, 2018, and marked the 6th quality start among seven career starts against his former team.
- Was 2-0 with a 2.14 ERA in five Grapefruit League starts this spring. He led the staff in IP (21.0) and starts (5) and co-led in wins (2) and strikeouts (15).

CAREER

- Two-time National League All-Star (2018 and 2022). Did not appear in the 2022 contest at Dodger Stadium and chose to miss the 2018 game in Washington D.C. to be with his wife as they welcomed twins.
- St. Louis is 80-65 (.552) in his 145 career outings (144 starts) since joining the organization (2018-present).
- Has registered 32 or more starts in every season in which he was not injured or sidelined by COVID-19 protocols.
- Since joining St. Louis in 2018, Mikolas trails only **Clayton Kershaw** (67.6%) for the 2nd-highest percentage of first pitch strikes in MLB with 67.1%.

- Led Major League Baseball with 35 starts, becoming the first pitcher to record 35 starts in a season since **Jhoulys Chacin** (35) in 2018 with Milwaukee and the first Cardinals pitcher since **Chris Carpenter** had 35 in 2009.
- Was his 4th season with 32 or more starts. One of four MLB pitchers with 32 or more starts in four seasons since 2018 (**Jose Berrios & Aaron Nola - 5; Gerrit Cole 4**).
- Started the final game of the season vs. CIN (10/1) becoming the first Cardinals pitcher to start on both Opening Day and the season finale since **Adam Wainwright** in 2016.
