**HERE'S THE STORY:** The D-backs are facing the Giants for the second time this season...dropped a 2-game set at Chase Field on May 25-26...last season, made 2 trips to the Bay Area (1-6).

- ♦ **Alex Young** is making his first start of the season, first start since Sept. 23, 2020 vs. Rangers, 23rd career start and fifth career start vs. Giants (fourth in the Bay Area).
  - Was drafted by the D-backs on June 8, 2015, the same day he served as TCU's starting pitcher in the 2015 NCAA Super Regional vs. Texas A&M.
  - In 4 starts vs. Giants, is 2-2 with a 4.35 ERA (10 ER in 20.2 IP), .265 opponent average, 5 walks and 14 strikeouts.
  - In 3 starts @ Giants, is 2-1 with a 2.87 ERA (5 ER in 15.2 IP), .230 opponent average, 3 walks and 12 strikeouts... last Sept. 6, tossed 5.1 innings with 3 runs allowed.

- ♦ **Ketel Marte** has hit safely in 4 of his last 6 road games (.360, 9-for-25) and 11 of 17 road games this season (.354, 23-for-65).

**SLICK NICK:** **Nick Ahmed** is error-free in 40 of his last 41 games (1 error) for a 99.4 fielding pct., second best among shortstops since April 27 (min. 15 G) behind Kevin Newman/PIT/1.000 and ahead of Xander Bogaerts/BOS/99.3, Miguel Rojas/MIA/98.8, Francisco Lindor/NYM/98.8 and Carlos Correa/HOU/98.6.

- ♦ For the season, Ahmed's 98.0 fielding pct. is eighth in the Majors.

**RUNNERS ON BASE:** The D-backs, in their last 4 games with runners on base, are hitting .283 (17-for-60) with 13 runs scored.

**HITTERS COUNTS:** The D-backs in hitters counts (1-0, 2-0, 3-0, 2-1, 3-1) over 12 games since June 1 are hitting .349 (29-for-83) with 6 doubles, 4 homers, 11 RBI and 12 walks (0 strikeouts).

- ♦ In even counts (0-0, 1-1, 3-2), over the last 12 games since June 1, the D-backs are hitting .297 (30-for-101) with 9 doubles, 5 home runs, 16 RBI and 19 walks (14 strikeouts).

**ON TOP SINCE MAY 25:** **Pavin Smith** leads the Majors with a .369 average since May 25 followed by Charlie Blackmon/COL/.368, Starling Marte/MIA/.368, Nick Castellanos/CIN/.360, Tyler O'Neill/STL/.354, Jean Segura/PHI/.345, Jonathan Villar/NYM/.340 and **Ketel Marte/.338**.

- AT A GLANCE:** Is in his third season with the D-backs.
- D-backs' second-round pick in the 2015 draft out of TCU (signed by: George Swain).
  - Selected by the Rangers in the 32nd round of the 2012 draft but did not sign.

**WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:** Is making his first start since Sept. 23, 2020 vs. Rangers.

- Threw a season-high 57 pitches on June 8 @ A's.

**LAST START:** Did not factor in the decision on Sept. 23, 2020 vs. Rangers (3 ER in 5.0 IP).

- VS. GIANTS:** Has gone 2-3 with a 5.14 ERA (12 ER in 21.0 IP) in 5 games (4 starts).
- Allowed 2 runs in 0.1 IP in lone appearance this season... surrendered solo home runs to Austin Slater and Jason Vosler.
  - Is 2-1 with a 2.87 ERA (5 ER in 15.2 IP) in 3 starts @ AT&T Park.

**AS A STARTER:** Is 7-9 with a 4.49 ERA (54 ER in 108.1 IP) in 22 career starts.

**TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE:** Opponents are 2-for-26 (.077) on his curveball this season and 16-for-136 (.118) for his career.

- ♦ Since 2019, boasts the lowest SLG (.162) and second-lowest AVG (.118) in MLB off curveballs [min. 400 pitches].

**I'VE GOT A SINKING FEELING:** Is throwing a sinker 23.4 pct. of the time (.190 AVG), compared to 12.9 pct. in 2020 (.458 AVG).

**THE CHASE IS ON:** Boasts a career best 32.6 pct. chase pct., up from 30.2 in 2020...the 32.6 pct. ranks in the 89th percentile in the Majors.

- The jersey's colors bring forward the Sonoran desert sand and utilize the term “Serpientes” – a Spanish translation of snakes -- winding across the chest...the uniform patches feature Arizona's state flag and a nod to Phoenix's moniker, The Valley of the Sun.

**KETEL AT HOME IN THE BAY:** **Ketel Marte**, in 28 career games @ Giants, is hitting .315 (34-for-108)/.965 OPS with 13 doubles, 1 triple, 5 homers, 15 RBI and 9 walks.

- ♦ In his last start, June 11 vs. Angels, worked 5.0 innings with 3 runs allowed.
