THE TWINS: Have gone 3-1 through four games on their current seven-game homestand, going 2-1 vs. Boston over the weekend, followed by a victory over Seattle last night...tonight, the Iwins will play the second of four against the Mariners...after Thursday afternoon's series finale with Seattle, Minnesota will travel to Toronto for a short roadtrip with three at the Rogers Centre over the weekend.

◆ Since April 22, the Twins lead baseball in wins (13-1), ahead of the Dodgers (11-2) and Phillies (11-3).

♠ Twins have gone 7-1 in their last eight home games after starting the season 2-6 in their first eight at Target Field.

BACK IN THE W COLUMN: The Twins beat the Mariners last night at Target Field by a score of 3-1...Simeon Woods Richardson was the starter but did not factor into the decision, pitching 6.0 shutout innings, with one hit allowed, one walk and a career-high eight strikeouts...Griffin Jax, Jhoan Duran and Caleb Thielbar all pitched in relief as the Twins staff held Mariners batters to just three hits, the fewest for Twins pitchers in 2024...the offense recorded just five hits, two apiece from Max Kepler and Carlos Correa, who each doubled twice...the game was played in two hours and nine minutes, the fastest game for Minnesota this season.

Twins became the sixth AL team to reach the 20-win mark last night.

TWINS AND Ms: The Twins and Mariners are playing each other for the second of seven games this season...after this series, Minnesota will travel to Seattle for three games from June 28-30.
₱ The Twins are 8-5 in their last 13 vs. Seattle, dating back to April 10, 2022.
₱ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .324 (12-for-37) with five walks, a .419 on-base percentage, a .459 slugging percentage and an .878 OPS in 13 career games against Seattle.
₱ Carlos Correa has 111 career hits and 111 games played against the Mariners, both his most vs. any opponent...his 111 hits are sixth-most among actives and his 111 games are tied for sixth-most.

♣ Correa ranks in the 99th percentile in baseball in sweet spot percentage (50.0%), in the 97th percentile in walk percentage (16.2%), in the 92nd percentile in xwOBA (.391) and in the 85th percentile in expected batting average (.288).
