THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
MAY 22
2021-RHP Lance McCullers Jr. strikes out four batters in the 1st inning in a start against the Rangers in Arlington...he fans Nathaniel Lowe, Adolis Garcia, Joey Gallo and Khris Davis consecutively in the frame, with Gallo reaching safely on a wild pitch...McCullers becomes the fifth Astros pitcher since the year 2000 to record four strikeouts in an inning and the first since RHP Ken Giles did so in 2016

TODAY'S GAME: The Astros and Cubs will begin their 3-game series this afternoon at Wrigley Field...RHP Spencer Arrighetti (5-1) will take the mound for the Astros as he takes on RHP Jameson Taillon (2-3)...**Houston Area Connection:** Both of today's starters grew up in the Greater Houston area...Arrighetti is a 2018 graduate of Cinco Ranch High School (Katy, TX) while Taillon is a 2010 graduate of The Woodlands High School (Woodlands, TX).

IN THE DAYTIME: Today is the 2nd of 4 consecutive scheduled day games for the Astros...Wednesday's series finale at MIN had a 12:40 p.m. start and all 3 games this weekend at Wrigley Field will begin at 1:20 p.m...the last time that the Astros have played 4 consecutive day games was April 2-6 of last season (source: Elias).

ROADIES: Today is the 3rd game (1-2 thus far) of a 10-game, 3-city road trip for HOU...HOU went 1-2 at MIN on the 1st stop of the trip...after this series in CHC, they travel back to Texas for a 4-game series vs. the Rangers at Globe Life Field (Mon.-Thurs).

VS. THE CUBBIES: The Astros took 2 of 3 vs. the Cubs in the only series between the two clubs last season (June 27-29 at Daikin Park)...the Astros last visit to Wrigley Field was a 3-game series in April of 2024 (3-gm sweep by CHC)...the Astros are 7-5 in their last 4 series vs. the Cubs (since 2019)...**All-Time:** The Astros are 385-338 all-time vs. the Cubbies...Their 385 wins vs. them are their 2nd-most vs. any opponent (404-455 vs. CIN)...**First Game Ever:** The very first official game of the Houston franchise was vs. the Cubs...on April 10, 1962, the Colt .45s defeated the Cubs, 11-2, at Colt Stadium, behind a CG win by **LHP Bobby Shantz**.

RARE VISIT TO WRIGLEY: The current series marks just the 2nd visit to Wrigley Field for the Astros since 2013...the 2013 season is when the Astros were moved to the American League.

SPENCER'S GIFTS: Since making his season debut on April 15, **RHP Spencer Arrighetti** has been one of the top starters in the Majors...for the season, he is 5-1 in just 6 starts with a 1.50 ERA (6ER/36IP) and a miniscule .176 opp. avg...since April 15, he is T-1st in the AL in wins...**Model of Consistency:** Arrighetti has allowed 1 ER or less in 5 of his 6 starts and 2 ER or less in all 6 starts...**Last Start:** Arrighetti took a no-hitter into the 8th inning in his last start on May 15 vs. TEX, which ended in a 2-0 win (7.1 IP, 1 H, 0 R).

WEDNESDAY'S RECAP: The Astros were defeated by the Twins, 4-1, in Wednesday's rubber match of their 3-game series at Target Field...**RHP Mike Burrows** (2-6) took the loss (6 IP, 4 ER)...**Cam Smith** went 2x3...the Astros offense was held to just 5 singles.

RECENT STROS: The Astros are 3-3 in their last 6 games and 4-4 in their last 8 games.

FOR STARTERS: The Astros 3 starters scheduled for this series have a combined ERA of 2.55 (29ER/102.1IP) with 100 K's in 102.1 IP (Arrighetti-1.50), Teng-2.61, Lambert-3.57).

APPLE TV: Wayne Randazzo, Dontrelle Willis and Heidi Watney will call the action for today's Apple TV telecast.

ROSTER MOVES: The Astros have selected **RHP Alimber Santa** (#72) from Triple A Sugar Land...the Astros optioned **RHP Jayden Murray** to Triple A Sugar Land following Wednesday's game...lastly, **RHP Cody Bolton** cleared waivers and was outrighted to Triple A Sugar Land yesterday.

THERE IS A SANTA: **RHP Alimber Santa** has been outstanding for Triple A Sugar Land this season...in his 18 relief appearances, Santa is 4-2 with a 1.42 ERA (3ER/19IP), allowing just 10 hits in his 19.0 innings of work for a .159 opp. avg...he had not allowed a run in his last 6 app. (5.2 IP).

PEN PALS: As a group, the Astros bullpen has had decent run of success recently...since May 8, they have a combined ERA of 3.48 (16ER/41.1IP)...individually, several relievers are currently pitching well:
-RHP Bryan Abreu: 0.00 ERA in last 6 outings (6 IP, 0 R).
-AJ Blubaugh: 2.18 ERA in last 8 outings (12.1 IP, 3 ER).
-LHP Bryan King: 1.74 ERA in last 9 outings (10.1 IP, 2 ER)
-LHP Steven Okert: 1.29 ERA in last 7 outings (7.0 IP, 1 ER)... has 7 K's in his last 3.1 IP (3 app).

AIR YORDAN: **Yordan Alvarez** is batting .309 with 11 doubles, 15 HR, 31 RBI and a 1.017 OPS (.412 OBP/.605 SLG)...in the AL, he ranks first in total bases (112), 2nd in OPS and SLG, 3rd in OBP, T-4th in HR and 5th in batting avg.

TAPPING FOR SUCCESS: Astros and Twins batters are tied for the Major League lead in successful ABS challenges with 31...the Astros batters are 31-for-53 (58%) in their challenges while Twins batters are 31-for-67 (46%) in their challenges...individually, **Jose Altuve** is tied for 2nd in the Majors with 9 successful challenges (9-for-13, 69%).

EE-SOCK: Wednesday night's HR for **Isaac Paredes** was #97 in his career...he needs 3 more HR to become the 4th MLB player born in Mexico to reach 100 career HR.

ROAD WARRIORS: The Astros have been one of the AL's top hitting teams on the road in 2026...entering today's game, HOU leads the AL in road batting avg. (.267) and OBP (.336) while ranking 2nd in SLG (.412) and OPS (.749).

BRYAN'S SONG: After a slow start to his season, **RHP Bryan Abreu** has not allowed a run in his last 6 outings, covering 6.0 IP (3 H, 0 R, 3 BB, 5 SO)...in his last 8 appearances, Abreu has posted a 1.12 ERA (1ER/8.0IP) with 9 K's.

THE BIG OH: **LHP Steven Okert** punched out all 3 batters that he faced last night, giving him 7 K's in his last 3.1 IP (3 app)...he has not allowed a run in his last 5 app. (5.1 IP).

ON THE LEADER BOARD: As a club, the Astros currently rank T-2nd in the AL in hits (422), 3rd in batting avg. (.246) and SLG (.404) and 5th in OPS (.725).

WALKER, TEXAS HAMMER: **1B Christian Walker** has been one of the top hitting 1st basemen in the AL this season, ranking among all AL leaders in several offensive categories...he is 2nd on the club in HR (11) and T-1st in RBI (31)...among the AL leaders, Walker ranks T-8th in RBI (31), T-10th in HR (11), 9th in total bases (90) and 11th in SLG (.489).

LAST START, MAY 15 vs. TEX: Was spectacular in his latest start vs. the Rangers...carried a no-hit bid through 7.1 innings prior to allowing a single, throwing 102 pitches (62 strikes)...finished his night after 7.1 scoreless innings, allowing just 1 hit with 4 walks and 5 strikeouts...was the longest no-hit bid by an Astros pitcher since a no-hit bid of 8.2 innings by **LHP Framber Valdez** on Aug. 6, 2024 at TEX...was Arrighetti's longest career no-hit bid and his longest since tossing 7.0 no-hit innings on Aug. 28, 2024 at PHI...the last time the Astros pitching staff allowed 1 hit was on March 29, 2025 vs. NYY, where Arrighetti (6.0IP, H, R, 2BB, 5K) was also on the mound...has logged a quality start in 3 of his 6 starts this season...has worked at least 5.0 innings in each of his 6 starts this year, marking the longest such streak by an Astros this season.

IN GOOD COMPANY: Is the 17th pitcher in Astros history to post an ERA of 1.50 or lower through their first 6 starts of the year and is the 1st to do so since **RHP Hunter Brown** (1.22 ERA) in 2025...prior to Brown, the last to do so was **RHP Justin Verlander** (1.36 ERA) in 2018.

SPAGHETTI DAY: The 3rd-year starter has dominated in his Major League action this season, going 5-1 in 6 starts with a 1.50 ERA (6ER/36IP), while fanning 35 in 36.0 innings and allowing a .176 (22x125) opponent average...leads the Astros with 5 wins on the young season...all this came after he began the season at Triple A Sugar Land (recalled on April 15).

VS. CHC: Will be making his 2nd career start against the Cubs...his last start against CHC came his rookie season on April 24, 2024 at Wrigley Field, in his third career start in the Majors...allowed 4 runs on 7 hits and 2 walks in 3.2 innings, while striking out 7 batters (90 pitches-58 strikes)...received the loss in a 4-3 Astros defeat...after a rocky 1st inning where he gave up the only runs Chicago would score, he retired 7 of the next 9 batters before a pair of singles and a walk ended his day.

SINCE HIS RECALL: Since making his season debut on April 15, Arrighetti ranks T-1st among MLB pitchers in wins (5)...in the AL over that span, he also ranks 2nd in opponent batting average (.176) and 5th in ERA (1.50).

SAVANT SAYS: Ranks in the 99th percentile in extension (7.4) and 86th percentile in hard-hit percentage (31.5)...also ranks in the 90th percentile in fastball run value (5).

RACKING UP K'S: Has 35 strikeouts in his 36.0 innings pitched this season, which included a 10-strikeout game in his season debut on April 15 vs. COL...his 10 strikeouts are the most strikeouts in a game by an Astros pitcher this season and marked his 5th career game with 10+ strikeouts (last: 11 strikeouts on Aug. 11, 2024 at PHI).

STRIKEOUT PACE: His 237 career strikeouts are tied for 3rd-most through a player's first 42 career appearances in Astros history, trailing only **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** (271) and **RHP Bud Norris** (238), while being tied with **RHP Tom Griffin**.

ABOUT ARRIGHETTI: Grew up in Albuquerque, N.M., but moved to the Houston suburb of Katy for high school and attended Cinco Ranch High School, located approximately 30 miles from Daikin Park...was selected by the Astros in the 6th round of the 2021 MLB First-Year Player Draft from UL-Lafayette and was routinely ranked as one of the club's top pitching prospects in ascent through the minors...was named the Astros 2023 Minor League Pitcher of the Year.

LAST APPEARANCE (5/19 at MIN): Earned his 3rd save of the season Tuesday night at MIN after he tossed 0.1 of a scoreless inning, entering the game with two outs and one man on in the 9th inning (9 pitches-5 strikes).

TIDES TURNING: Has gone 2-0-2 through 6 consecutive scoreless appearances (6 IP), dating back to May 3, also posting a .158 opponent average (3x19) and 1.00 WHIP over that span...prior to this streak, posted a 12.54 ERA (13ER/9.1IP) in his first 11 games of the season...his 6-appearance scoreless streak is the longest active streak (in terms of games) among Astros pitchers.

ALL-TIME ASTRO RANKINGS: With his outing on April 24 vs. NYY, he reached 338.0 career innings, passing **RHP Octavio Dotel** for the 10th-most innings by a reliever in Astros history...ranks 7th all-time in appearances (334) among relievers in Astros history, and is closing in on **RHP Ryan Pressly** (342) for 6th on that all-time list...also among Astros relievers, he ranks 4th all-time in strikeouts (469).

DAIKIN PARK RANKINGS: Reached 179.2 career innings pitched at Daikin Park with his outing on May 16 vs TEX, surpassing **RHP Ryan Pressly** (179.1) for 4th-most by a reliever in the venue's history...his 244 career strikeouts at Daikin Park are also 3 away from matching **RHP Octavio Dotel** (247) for the 2nd-most by a reliever in the venue's history.

VS. THE CUBS: Has posted a 1.93 ERA (1ER/4.2IP) with 8 strikeouts and a .176 opponent average (3x17) in 3 career appearances vs. the Cubs.
