MANAGER: Pat Murphy is in his second season as Brewers manager.....Murphy was voted 2024 NL Manager of the Year after guiding the team to a 93-69 record and the NL Central division championship....he became the first manager in franchise history (in either league) to earn the honor.....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026

COACHES: Returning from the 2024 coaching staff is associate manager Rickie Weeks (2nd season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (3rd season/2nd in current role), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (7th season), assistant pitching & strategy coach Jim Henderson (4th season/2nd in current role), bullpen coach Charlie Greene (2nd season), hitting coach Connor Dawson (4th season), assistant coach Daniel de Mondesert (2nd season), infield coach Matt Erickson (2nd season) and third base coach Jason Lane (10th season/5th in current role)....first base coach Julio Borbón, lead hitting coach Al LeBoeuf and hitting coach Eric Theisen are all in their first seasons on the coaching staff.

2024 IN REVIEW: The Brewers went 93-69 and finished in first place in the NL Central, 10.0 games ahead of the Cardinals and Cubs.....they tied the Padres for the fourth-best record in baseball behind the Dodgers (98-64). Phillies (95-67) and Yankees (94-68)... the Brewers lost to the Mets, 2 games to 1, in the NL Wild Card Series in Milwaukee.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have made the postseason six times over the last seven seasons (missed in 2022) and have won the NL Central in four of the last seven seasons, three of the last four, and two straight.....the Brewers are one of just five teams to qualify for the postseason in at least six of the last seven seasons....they are joined by the Astros (7), Braves (7), Dodgers (7) and Yankees (6).

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons (2017-24).....this does not include the shortened 2020 season.....the Brewers have 670 wins since 2017, which ranks sixth in the majors and third in the National League.....the team was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in eight consecutive seasons, missing out by just a game in both 2017 and 2022.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: #35 - RHP ELVIN RODRÍGUEZ (1gs, 0-1, 9.00)

RODRÍGUEZ AT A GLANCE: Elvin Rodríguez, 27, will be making his second start of the season.....Rodríguez made his Brewers debut in a start on Monday vs. Kansas City and took an 11-1 loss (4ip, 6h, 4r, 4er, 1bb, 3k, 1hr, 64 pitches).....he signed as a free agent on Jan. 17.....he is signed through the 2025 season with a club option for 2026.

LAST SEASON: Rodríguez pitched last season with the Tokyo Yakult Swallows in the Central League of Nippon Professional Baseball, where he went 1-1 with a 1.80 ERA and 1 save in 32 games/1 start while posting a 1.16 WHIP.....he went to Japan in July 2023 after pitching parts of two seasons in the Major Leagues with Detroit (7g/5gs in 2022) and Tampa Bay (1g in 2023).

<u>CAREER</u>: Is 0-5 with a 9.49 ERA in 9 games/6 starts (37ip, 39er).....has pitched parts of three Major League seasons with Detroit (2022), Tampa Bay (2023) and Milwaukee (2025).....Rodríguez, a native of San Cristobal in the Dominican Republic, was originally signed by the Angels as a non-drafted free agent on 7/4/14.....he was traded to the Tigers on 9/15/17 as the player to be named in the deal for OF Justin Upton.....he joined the Rays via free agency on 1/11/23.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: His only career appearance in Milwaukee came in his last outing.

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 0-3 with an 11.09 ERA in 4 games/3 starts (18.2ip, 23er).

CAREER vs. REDS: Rodríguez has never faced the Cincinnati, Ohio Reds.
