RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals and Colorado Rockies play the second game of a four-game weekend series tonight at Busch Stadium as the Redbirds continue their seven-game, eight-day homestand ... The division-rival Pittsburgh Pirates visit St. Louis for three games beginning on Tuesday ... St. Louis went 1-for-7 with runners in scoring position while stranding 11 on base in last night's 3-2 defeat to the Rockies, ending a five-game winning streak at Busch.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals enter today in 4th place in the National League Central, 6.5 games behind first place Milwaukee and a half game back in NL Wild Card race ... Since Mother's Day(May 12-present), the Cardinals sport MLB's 4th-best winning pct. (.636, 14-8).

TAP THE ROCKIES: The Cardinals .738 home win pct. (45-16) vs. the Rockies is its best against any opponent since Busch III opened in 2006 ... St. Louis has defeated the Rockies in 19 of its last 23 home games (May 18, 2016-present) and is 36-9 (.800) at Busch Stadium III vs. the Rockies in their last 45 meetings since Sept. 30, 2010 ... The Cardinals have won the season series vs. the Rock Pile in 22 of 30 seasons since Colorado joined MLB as an expansion team in 1993. **WILD, WILD WEST:** Since 2019 vs. the National League West, the Cardinals are 47-23 (.671) at Busch Stadium, but just 29-45 on the road.

WHAT IS IT GOOD FOR: Six Major League shortstops lead their respective teams in *Baseball Reference's* Wins Above Replacement: Orioles **Gunner Henderson** (4.3), Royals **Bobby Witt Jr.** (3.8), Dodgers **Mookie Betts** (3.7), Rockies **Ezequiel Tovar** (2.2), Cardinals **Masyn Winn** (2.1), and Mets **Francisco Lindor** (1.6).

CLOSE CALLS: Forty-three of the Cardinals 61 games (70.5%) have been decided by three runs or fewer, tied with the Cubs for 2nd-most in MLB this season behind the Mets (45).

- St. Louis has the 3rd-lowest average margin of victory (2.48) in MLB ahead of the White Sox (2.47) and Rays (2.32) - *Elias*
- The Cardinals are 9-7 in one-run games, 7-8 in two-run games, and 7-5 in three-run games

BRONCO: With three strikeouts tonight, **Lance Lynn** would reach 979 for his Cardinals career (2011-17, '24) and tie **Jesse Haines** (1920-37) for 7th all-time in Cardinals history ... Lynn is currently 10 strikeouts shy of tying **Matt Morris** (986) for 6th.

GOLD-RUSH: **Paul Goldschmidt** has reached base safely in 23 consecutive games (May 11-present) tied for MLB's 4th-longest active on-base streak and two shy of the Cardinals mark for this season held by **Nolan Arenado** (25) ... Goldy's career-long is 46 games (April 22-June 10, 2022), while his active 23-gamer is currently tied for the 6th-longest of his career.

WE GOT A PLANE TO CATCH: The Cardinals have incurred only four pitch clock violations (all by pitchers) this season, 2nd-fewest in the National League to the Rockies (2; 1 batter & 1 pitcher).

THE PEN IS MIGHTIER: St. Louis is 25-2 (.926) when leading after 7 innings and a perfect 26-0 when leading after eight, one of five MLB teams (Guardians, Dodgers, Twins, & Mariners) with a 1.000 win percentage when leading after eight innings.

- The Cardinals are 17-1 this season when the trio of **JoJo Romero**, **Andrew Kittredge**, and **Ryan Helsley** all pitch in the same game ... Their only blemish was May 4 vs. the Chicago White Sox.
- RHP **Ryan Helsley**, who leads MLB in saves (20) and ranks 2nd in games finished (25), has converted 20 consecutive save opportunities, MLB's longest active successful save streak and the 7th-longest in franchise history (**Alex Reyes** holds the record with 24 successful saves in a row from 2016-21).

COLORADO CONNECTIONS

Nolan Arenado played eight seasons with Colorado (2013-20), where he was a five-time NL All-Star and the winner of four Silver Sluggers, eight Gold Gloves, and four Platinum Gloves...originally selected by Colorado in the 2nd round of the 2009 Draft...Acquired by St. Louis with cash in exchange for **Austin Gomber**, **Elehuris Montero**, **Tony Locey**, **Mateo Gil** and **Jake Sommers**.

Nolan Arenado's cousin, **Josh Fuentes**, played three seasons with the Rockies (2019-21) and college baseball at Missouri Baptist University (2014) in St. Louis.

Daniel Descalso played two seasons with Colorado (2015-16).

Kyle Leahy was born in and resides in Boulder, Colo...graduated from Erie (Colo.) High School, where was selected to play at the Colorado High School Futures Game at Coors Field...played college baseball at Colorado Mesa University in Grand Junction (2016-18).

Austin Gomber pitched parts of two seasons with St. Louis (2018, '20)...originally selected by the Cardinals in the 4th round of the 2014 MLB Draft...shared Cardinals Co-Minor League Pitchers of the Year honors with **Alex Reyes** in 2015.

Elehuris Montero signed with St. Louis as an international free agent (Aug. 29, 2014)...played five minor leagues seasons in the Cardinals minor league organization (2015-19).

Dakota Hudson pitched six seasons and the 2019 Postseason (2018-23) with St. Louis, where he made his MLB debut...selected by the Cardinals in the 1st round (#34) of the 2016 MLB Draft.

John Mozeliak began his baseball career with the Rockies...initially served as a left-handed batting practice pitcher in 1993 and worked in a variety of positions in the home clubhouse and in baseball operations...joined St. Louis as an assistant in scouting operations following the 1995 season...graduated from Fairview High School in Boulder, Colo., where he was a first baseman and pitcher...graduated from University of Colorado at Boulder.

Rockies MLB.com **Thomas Harding** covered the Memphis Redbirds (AAA) for two seasons for the Commercial Appeal (1998-99)...mentored recent Cardinals MLB.com writer **Anne Rogers**.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Holliday** was originally selected by Colorado in the 7th round of the 1998 MLB Draft...played parts of six seasons for the Rockies (2004-08, '18) where he was a three-time All-Star and appeared in the 2007 World Series.

Daniel Bard made 10 appearances for Springfield (AA) in 2017.

Rockies Special Assistant to the GM **Clint Hurdle** played in 78 games for St. Louis in 1986.

Cardinals Asst. GM & Scouting Director **Randy Flores** pitched in 82 games in three seasons (2002, '09-10) over two stints with Colorado.

St. Louis Post-Dispatch columnist **Benjamin Hochman** previously worked as a sports writer and columnist for the Denver Post (2007-15).

St. Louis Post-Dispatch reporter **Derrick Goold** is originally from Boulder, Colo...attended Centaurus High School in Lafayette, Colo...worked as a staff writer for the Rocky Mountain News (2000-01).

Rockies Communications Coordinator **Kevin Collins** previously served as the 2015 Media Relations Intern for the Memphis Redbirds (AAA).

Rockies Digital Comm. Manager **Nora Farrell** previously worked in communications and social media for St. Louis for part of seven seasons (2016-22).

Rockies VP Ticket Sales, Operations & Services **Sue Ann McClaren** worked 15 seasons (1978-92) in the Cardinals sales department before joining the Rockies in 1992.

NL Ranks: Lowest Run Support Average (3.08, 2nd), Most Pitches/IP (17.4, 3rd), Unearned Runs (12, 1st*)

- Makes his 13th start of the season and the 330th of his career (354th appearance).
- Has come away with losing decisions in 3 of his last 5 starts (3.16 ERA) since May 10, receiving one or zero runs of support in all three defeats.
- The Cardinals have lost five of his last seven starts (April 28-present) after having won four of the first five to begin the season.
- Needs three strikeouts to reach 979 for his Cardinals career and tie **Jesse Haines** (1920-37) for 7th all-time in franchise history. Newest Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Morris** (1997-2005) ranks 6th with 986 strikeouts.
- Has thrown Fastballs (4-seam, 2-seam, or cutter) for 919 of his 1,066 total pitches (86.2%) this season, highest percentage of fastballs thrown among MLB starting pitchers. Only **Nestor Cortes** (955 of 1,207, 79.1%) has thrown more fastballs than Lynn.
- In the *Baseball Savant* database (2008-present), Lynn has thrown the 3rd-most fastballs (27,3448) of any Major League pitcher behind **Justin Verlander** (27,576) and **Jon Lester** (32,520).
- St. Louis has played extra innings in four of his 13 starts this year
- Ranks T-1st among NL starters with seven no-decisions in his 13 starts.
- Is 37 strikeouts shy of 2,000 for his career and 49.2 innings from 2,000.
- Ranks T-5th in MLB with team-leading with nine batters faced with the bases loaded, and leads MLB pitchers with 6 strikeouts.
- Recorded his 1,000th strikeout in National League play on May 10 at Milwaukee after fanning Brice Turang (swinging) to lead off the 1st inning.

LAST TIME OUT

- Allowed four unearned runs in 4.0 innings in the Cardinals 5-4 win in 10 innings over the Phillies at Citizens Bank Park on Sunday. St. Louis made a season-high three errors, committed by shortstop Masyn Winn, catcher Ivan Herrera, and Lynn himself

BUSCH STADIUM III (2006-PRESENT)

- Has never pitched at Busch Std. III as a visitor. Before the 2024 Home Opener (April 4), his last appearance in St. Louis was Sept. 28, 2017 vs. the Cubs (ND, 5.0 IP, 1 R, 5 K).
- Trails **Adam Wainwright** and ranks 2nd in Busch Stadium III history in starts (82), innings pitched (509.2), strikeouts (473), and wins (41).

CAREER

- Member of the 2011 Cardinals World Series Championship team and the 2013 National League Champions.
- Two-time All-Star with the National League (2012, DNP) and the American League (2021). Pitched a scoreless inning at Coors Field in 2021 in relief of pitcher **Shohei Ohtani**. Current teammates **Kyle Gibson** and **Andrew Kittredge** also pitched for the A.L. in that game.
- Placed in Top 10 in the AL Cy Young Award voting in 2019 (5th), 2020 (6th) & 2021 (3rd).
- Has returned to his original drafting/signing team (1st round, 2008) for the first time since 2017 after pitching for the Twins (2018), Yankees (2018), Rangers (2019-20), White Sox (2021-23) and Dodgers (2023).
- Was teammates with current Cardinals manager **Oliver Marmol** in Single-A Quad Cities (2008) and High-A Palm Beach (2009).
- Ranks 2nd behind only **Adam Wainwright** (29) with 24 postseason pitching appearances among Cardinals. Has five postseason wins as a member of the Cardinals, T-3rd in franchise history behind **Chris Carpenter** (10) and **Bob Gibson** (7).
