WORDS ON THE BIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals & Milwaukee Brewers open a three-game series this afternoon in their first series meeting of the season at American Family Field...the Cardinals and Cincinnati Reds battled Mother Nature this past weekend, playing a day/night doubleheader on Saturday that was sandwiched between rainouts on both Friday and Sunday...the Cardinals split their Saturday twinbill, winning the opener 8-1 before falling 7-6 in 11 innings in the nightcap...the Cardinals completed a 3-3 homestand (2-1 vs. KC, 1-2 vs. PIT) last Thursday with a 6-2 loss and have gone 2-3 over their last five games... St. Louis is 13-13 at home and 16-9 in road games this season - the 4th most road wins in the NL behind ATL (19), LAD (18) and WSH (17).

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis enters today in 2nd place in the NL Central, 1.5 games behind first place Milwaukee and 1.0 game in front of 3rd place Chicago...St. Louis is 15-9 since April 27 (4th-best in NL) and has 29 wins through the first 51 games of a season for the first time since the 2022 Redbirds also started 29-22 and won the NL Central Division with a 93-69 mark.

CARDINALS ON MEMORIAL DAY: The Cardinals are 25-25 all-time on Memorial Day (10-13 on the road) since it became an official holiday in 1971 ... the Redbirds have gone 2-2 against the Brew Crew (1-2 at American Family Field: 2018-L, 2016-W, & 2009-L) on Memorial Day ...teams throughout Major League Baseball will observe a National Moment of Remembrance at 3:00 p.m. local time today or prior to the National Anthem... In addition, team uniforms will display a red poppy with "Lest We Forget" language to honor the service men & women that our Nation has lost.

CENTRAL CROWNS: Aside from the COVID-shortened 2020 season, the Cardinals & Brewers have held the NL Central title since 2018 with the Brewers winning in 2018, 2021, 2023, 2024 & 2025 and the Cardinals winning in 2019 & 2022.

THE GREAT INDOORS: After rainouts on Friday and Sunday in Cincinnati, the Redbirds may very well welcome a visit to American Family Field where weather should not complicate matters. In Cardinals franchise history, they own a 461-472 record when playing in retractable roof or domed stadiums and went 4-2 earlier this year on a trip thru Houston (3-0) & Miami (1-2). Including this week's games, the Cardinals have six games in Milwaukee, three in Arizona and three in Toronto remaining this season at retractable roof venues.

THIRD TIME'S A CHARM: The Cardinal have out scored their opposition 29-8 in the 3rd inning and they've hit 10 HR's in the 3rd inning, their most of any inning...the Cardinals (10), Dodgers (14) and Phillies (11) are the lone NL teams to have hit 10+ HR's in the 3rd inning this season.

RUNNING REDBIRDS: The Redbirds baserunning has kept the pressure on this season with the Cardinals advancing from 1st to 3rd/home 42 times, 2nd most in the majors with the Detroit Tigers (47)...the team has had the NL's fewest outs on the basepaths (6) trailing only Texas (3) in MLB...Cardinals baserunners have the majors highest pct. (52 pct) of bases taken.

MILWAUKEE CONNECTIONS

Riley O'Brien's grandfather **Johnny O'Brien** was drafted by the NBA's Milwaukee Hawks in 1953, but instead chose to play baseball.

Bryan Torres originally signed with Milwaukee as a non-drafted free agent in 2015 and played parts of five minor league seasons in the Brewers minor league system (2015-19)...played two seasons for the Milwaukee Milkmen of the American Association (2022-23), where he was back-to-back Independent League Batting Champion (.374 and .370).

Matthew Liberatore earned his first MLB win on May 28, 2022 vs. Milwaukee at Busch Stadium.

Nolan Gorman hit his first MLB home run on May 28, 2022 vs. Milwaukee with a 1st-inning solo shot off **Adrian Houser** at Busch Stadium.

Andre Pallante struck out **Christian Yelich** (April 15, 2022 at Milwaukee) for his first career strikeout, and **Matt Svanson** fanned **Isaac Collins** for his first strikeout (April 27, 2025 at St. Louis).

Jake Woodford was selected by St. Louis in Competitive Balance Round A (39th overall) of the 2015 MLB draft and pitched in 80 games (18 starts) for the Cardinals from 2020-23.

Cardinals Special Asst. to the President of Baseball Ops & 2026 Cardinals Hall of Fame inductee **Yadier Molina** hit his first MLB home run on Sept. 23, 2004 at Milwaukee off **Matt Wise**.

Jacob Misiorowski played college baseball at Crowder College in Neosho, Mo...made MLB debut vs. St. Louis (June 12, 2025 at Am. Fam.).

William Contreras's older brother, **Wilson Contreras**, played in 344 games for St. Louis from 2023-25.

Brewers Lead Hitting Coach **Eric Theisen** played college baseball at Illinois State Univ. (2005-08).

Stubby Clapp was a coach for Team Canada in the 2023 WBC with Brewers Major League Pitching Coordinator **Jim Henderson** on the pitching staff.

Brewers Baseball Ops Special Asst. and Domestic/International Scouting **Rickie Weeks** made his MLB debut on Sept. 15, 2003 at St. Louis.

Steve Dillard, father of Brewers broadcaster **Tim Dillard**, was hitting coach for the Single-A Quad Cities Swing/River Bandits from 2006-07 and hitting coach for the High-A Palm Beach Cardinals in 2007...later piloted Quad Cities in 2008-09, where he managed infielder **Oliver Marmol**.

KMOX broadcaster **Matt Pauley** hosted Brewers pre- and post-game shows for parts of six seasons (2017-22)...was radio play-by-play voice of the Univ. of Wisconsin-GB women's basketball team.

Brewers Sr. Special Assistant to the President and GM **Carlos Villanueva** pitched in 35 games for the Cardinals in 2015.

Trevor Megill was originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign to return to Loyola Marymount Univ.

Ramon Urias's younger brother, **Luis Urias**, played in 330 games for Milwaukee from 2020-23.

Cardinals broadcaster **Ricky Horton** made five starts for the Denver Zephyrs (AAA-Brewers) in 1990.

Cardinals broadcaster **Mark Sweeney** played two seasons in Milwaukee (2000-01).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played in 73 games for Milwaukee in 2010.

Brewers broadcaster **Jeff Levering** previously worked three seasons (2010-12) as broadcaster for the Springfield Cardinals (AA).

Hall of Famer **Ted Simmons** played five seasons with Milwaukee (1981-85), where he was a two-time AL All-Star and faced off against St. Louis in the 1982 World Series...traded to Milwaukee with **Rollie Fingers** & **Pete Vuckovich** for **David Green**, **Sixto Lezcano**, **Dave LaPoint** & **Lary Sorensen**.

2026 Cardinals Hall of Fame inductee **Bill Sherdel** pitched in 53 games in 1916-17 for the Milwaukee Brewers of the American Association.

Cardinals Dir. of Medical Ops/Head Athletic Trainer **Adam Olsen** is a native of Green Bay...graduated from the University of Wisconsin-Madison.

TODAY'S GAME:

- 26-year-old Opening Day southpaw starting pitcher makes his team-leading 11th start of the season. Today's game marks his 131st career Major League appearance and his 64th career start.
- Sports a lifetime 4-0 with a 1.26 ERA (28.2 IP) and 31 strikeouts in 11 appearances (four starts) against the Brewers. The 1.26 ERA is lowest among active pitchers with 25.0+ IP.
- Did not face the Brewers during their first series at Busch Stadium (May 5-7).
- Tied for the Major League lead with three pick-offs; most pick-offs by a Cardinals pitcher since **Lance Lynn** (4, 2015) and by a southpaw since **Mark Mulder** (5, 2005).
- Sports a 2-2 record, but the Cardinals are 7-3 in his 10 starts this season.
- The Cardinals are 16-15 in his 31 career starts at Busch Stadium, where he has gone 11-10 with a 4.11 ERA (153.1 IP/70vER) with 10 quality starts.
- Allowed one run in four starts and two runs or fewer in five starts.

LAST TIME OUT (Monday, May 19 vs. Pittsburgh): ND, W, 9-6 (10); 4.2 IP, 7 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 2 BB, 9 SO; 77 pitches).

- Struck out a career-high 9 batters vs. PIT.
- Exited after an RBI single by Oneil Cruz with two outs in the 5th inning.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

SLAMMED: Took the loss in Sacramento (5/13) allowing his first career grand slam (**Nic Kurtz**) in a 4-3 loss, coming during an inning where he threw a career-high 43 pitches.

FRIAR FRYER: Earned his 2nd straight win holding the Padres (5/7) to one run over 6.0 innings in a 2-1 come-from-behind win at Petco Park. Recorded his 300th career strikeout fanning **Nick Castellanos** in the 5th inning.

HR DERBY: Surrendered a career-high 3 HR's in 3.1 IP vs. SEA (4/25) as the two teams combined for 33 hits and 8 HR's in 11-9 Mariners win.

SPACE DUST: Worked a season high 6.0 IP, allowing just one run on three hits, taking a ND in the Cardinals 7-5 extra inning win on 4/19 at HOU to complete the series sweep of the Astros.

FIRST TO 100: Threw a career high 105 pitches in 9-3 loss vs. CLE on 4/13 in 5.0 IP; He was the first Cardinals pitcher to reach the 100 pitch plateau.

NO FOOLING: Held the Mets to one run in his second start on April Fools Day, a day after **Andre Pallante** and company shut out New York. Retired the first 12 Mets batters (first time a Cardinal vs. NYM since 1968) and carried a no-hitter through 4.2 innings, longest of his career.

LIBBY'S LID-LIFTER: Made his 1st career Opening Day start and received a no decision vs. TB (3/26) despite pitching 5.0 innings and allowing just one run. Cardinals rallied for a 9-7 win (he exited with game tied 1-1).

LEFTY LIFT-OFFS: Made his 1st career Opening Day start on 3/26 vs. TB, becoming the 1st Cardinals lefty to start on Opening Day since **Donovan Osborne** (4/5/99) vs. MIL - the same year that Libby was born. He became one of just 16 LHP's to make the Opening Day start for the Cardinals since 1901 (MLB).

CAREER:

- Chose to switch to uniform No. 32 prior to 2026 season in honor of Hall of Fame left-handed pitcher **Sandy Koufax**, whom he grew up admiring.
- Was acquired by the Cardinals from the Rays in a four-player trade in 2020 that included Randy Arozarena, with a compensation pick that netted the Cardinals RHP **Tink Hence**.
- Is a career 15-23 with a 4.84 ERA (304.2 IP) in his 63 career starts opposed to 3-3 with a 3.89 ERA (81.0 IP) in 67 career relief appearances.
- Has limited left-handed batters to a .255/.312/.393 (98-384) with a .705 OPS average over his Major League career.
- 2021 Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Year, his first season of play in the Cardinals organization.

LIBERATORE vs. MILWAUKEE:

- His 1st career MLB win came in his May 28, 2023 start against Milwaukee.
- Lifetime 4-0 with a 1.26 ERA (28.2 IP) and 31 strikeouts in 11 appearances (four starts) against the Brewers.
- Did not face the Brewers during their first series at Busch Stadium (May 5-7).
- Of pitchers with 25.0+ career innings vs. MIL, his 1.26 ERA ranks tops among actives and 10th-lowest all-time.**
- This marks his first start at American Family Field after three relief appearances (0-0, 4.91 ERA, 3.2 IP).
- Has won each of his four career starts vs. the Brew Crew - all at Busch Stadium (0.86 ERA).
- In 28.2 career innings and 119 total batters faced, has not allowed a home run to Milwaukee.
- Has only allowed two earned runs in eight career appearances (4 starts) vs. the Brewers at Busch Stadium (4-0, 0.72 ERA, 25.0 IP, 27 K).
- Had identical starts vs. MIL on 5/17/23 at Busch Stadium and his 1st career start (5/28/22) against the Brewers.
