## PITTSBURGH PIRATES (29-43) vs. CHICAGO CUBS (43-28)

June 15, 2025 - Wrigley Field - Chicago, IL - 1:20 CDT - Game #73/Road #35

RHP Mitch Keller (1-9, 4.15 ERA) vs. RHP Colin Rea (4-2, 3.92 ERA)

**THE PIRATES:** have lost two of the first three games on this seven-game trip...Will have an off day tomorrow before playing three games in Detroit (Tuesday-Thursday) to wrap up the trip...Are 14-10 over their last 24 games (since May 20 vs. Cincinnati)...Went 6-3 on their recent homestand against Houston (1-2), Philadelphia (3-0) and Miami (2-1) from June 3-11...Are 17-17 since Don Kelly took over as manager on May 8 (are 9-9 in one-run games since Kelly was named manager).

**WHAT'S AT STAKE:** With a win this afternoon, the Pirates would split this four-game series here at Wrigley Field...Pittsburgh is 2-8-0 in road series so far this season, with the only series wins coming at Los Angeles-AL (April 22-24) and at Arizona (May 26-28).

**FOUR YOUR INFORMATION:** The Pirates are 1-1-1 in their first three four-game series of this season heading into the deciding game of this four-game set in Chicago...Pittsburgh dropped three of four in its season-opening series from March 27-30 at Miami, won three of four vs. Washington from April 14-17 at PNC Park and split four games vs. Milwaukee from May 22-25 in Pittsburgh...The Pirates' two other four-game series this season will come from August 7-10 vs. Cincinnati and from August 25-28 at St. Louis.

**MOTOWN THROWDOWN:** Pittsburgh will head to Comerica Park for a three-game series against Detroit from Tuesday-Thursday (the Pirates will welcome the Tigers to PNC Park from July 21-23)...Pittsburgh, which has played in Detroit in all but one season since 2012 (did not in 2020), has not lost a series in the Motor City since being swept in a two-game set from August 13-14, 2014.

**FROM THE ASHES:** Braxton Ashcraft pitched 2.0 perfect innings on Saturday at Wrigley Field...Ashcraft, who made his Major League debut on May 26 at Arizona, has tossed multiple scoreless innings in four of his first six Major League outings...The 25-year-old Ashcraft is 1-0 with a 0.93 ERA (9.2ip/1er) and a .152 (5-for-33) batting average against to begin his career in the big leagues.

**THE BEAR FACTS:** Andrew McCutchen went 2-for-4 with a solo home run on Saturday in Chicago...In 202 career games against the Cubs, he's batting .278 (206-for-741) with 32 home runs and 111 RBI...McCutchen has hit safely in seven of his last eight games (since June 7 vs. Philadelphia), going 11-for-32 (.344) with four extra-base hits and seven RBI during that span.

**MASTERFUL MIKE:** Mike Burrows allowed one run while striking out eight Cubs batters (didn't issue a walk) over 5.1 innings of work on Saturday...Burrows became the eighth Pirates rookie since at least 1901 to have an outing of 5.1-plus innings, one or zero runs allowed, zero walks issued and eight-plus strikeouts, along with Paul Skenes (2024), Jared Jones (2024), Nick Kingham (2018), Don Robinson (1978), Woodie Fryman (1966), Hank Robinson (1912) and Marty O'Toole (1911)...Saturday afternoon also marked Burrows' second outing of 5.1-plus innings, one or zero runs allowed, zero walks issued and six-plus strikeouts (also June 4 vs. Houston)...Burrows, Robinson (three times in 1978) and Fryman (twice in 1966) are the only Pittsburgh rookie pitchers since at least 1901 to have multiple-such outings.

**RELIABLE ROTATION:** Pittsburgh starters have pitched at least 5.1 innings while allowing one or zero runs 24 times this season (including Saturday), tied with Philadelphia for the second-most starts in MLB (Detroit, 25, ranks first)...The Pirates' 3.52 rotation ERA (398.2ip/156er) is the sixth-lowest in all of MLB.

**KING KONNOR:** Konnor Griffin went 3-for-4 with a solo home run, two RBI, a walk, two stolen bases and four runs scored in High-A Greensboro's 10-7 win at Rome on Saturday...The 19-year-old Griffin, who was promoted to Greensboro from Low-A Bradenton on Tuesday, is batting .435 (10-for-23) with four doubles, a home run, five RBI, two walks, five stolen bases and nine runs scored through his first five games with the Grasshoppers...Pittsburgh's first-round selection from the 2024 First-Year Player Draft is tied for the lead among all full-season minor leaguers with 80 hits (he ranks third with a .348 average).

Aaron's seventh-inning slam pushed Milwaukee's lead to 8-2 before Clemente sparked a seven-run eighth inning for Pittsburgh with his grand slam. Bill Mazeroski went 2-for-4 with a two-run triple in the victory.

HOW ACQUIRED: Selected in the second round of the 2014 Draft.

**STARTING OFF:** The 29-year-old Keller is in his seventh Major League season...He signed a five-year contract extension through the 2028 season on February 23, 2024... He earned Opening Day honors in both 2023 and 2024, which made him the first Pirate to do so since Francisco Liriano started three straight season openers from 2014-16... He was selected by the Pirates in the second round of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Keller allowed three runs over 6.0 innings on Tuesday vs. Miami, losing a 3-2 decision...He’s lost nine straight decisions since earning a win in his season debut on March 28 at Miami...He’s the first Pirates starter to lose nine straight decisions since JT Brubaker (also nine) from June 8-August 18, 2021....The last Pittsburgh pitcher to lose at least 10 consecutive decisions was Jose DeLeon (11 straight losses, 1985).

**AGAINST THE CUBS:** Keller will make his 14th career appearance (13th start) against Chicago (NL) and his first of 2025 this afternoon...He faced the Cubs twice in 2024, winning a 3-2 decision (6.0ip/2r) on May 19 at Wrigley Field and losing an 18-8 decision (4.0ip/3r) on August 26 at PNC Park...Keller is 3-2 with a 5.19 ERA (26.0ip/15er) across his six career appearances (five starts) right here at Wrigley Field.

**ON THE ROAD:** Keller has a 3.19 ERA (31.0ip/11er) in five road starts this season...His last came on May 30 at San Diego, when he allowed three runs in 6.0 innings of work.

**K IS FOR KELLER:** Keller enters the action today with 752 strikeouts, 18th-most in Pirates history...Howie Camnitz ranks 17th with 806 (Bob Friend ranks first with 1682).

**CENTRAL PERK:** Keller will make his fifth start of the season within the NL Central... He has a 1.78 ERA (25.1ip/5er) over his first four starts...Keller’s only road start came on May 7 at St. Louis, when he allowed three runs in 6.0 innings (lost a 5-0 decision).

**IN NEED OF SUPPORT:** The Pirates have scored one or zero runs while Keller was in the game in nine of his first 14 starts to begin the season...Keller’s 2.08 average runs of support while in the game are the fewest among all qualified Major League pitchers.

**THE 700 CLUB:** With his strikeout of St. Louis’ Pedro Pagés in the seventh inning of his start on April 9, Keller notched his 700th career strikeout...Per the Elias Sports Bureau, he became the fastest pitcher in club history to reach 700 strikeouts with Pittsburgh by innings (718.1)...The previous record was held by Bob Veale (740.0 innings)...Per Elias, he also became the third-fastest pitcher in team history to reach the 700-strikeout mark with Pittsburgh by games (136), behind only Gerrit Cole (126) and Veale (135).

**AS A PIRATE:** The Pirates selected Keller in the second round of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft out of Xavier High School in Cedar Rapids, Iowa...He was rated by Baseball America as Pittsburgh’s No. 1 prospect in each season from 2018-20...He was also recognized by the same publication as a top-100 prospect in the game from 2017-20.

**SIGN HERE, PLEASE:** The Pirates signed Keller to a five-year contract extension through 2028 on February 23, 2024...He became the third member of the current team to sign a long-term contract extension, joining Ke’Bryan Hayes and Bryan Reynolds.
