METSCELLANEOUS: The Mets earned a 3-2 win over the Yankees on Saturday... The Mets are going for their 10th series win of the season and their sixth of the road...New York is in a stretch where they play 18 of 21 games in the state of New York (5-3)...The Mets are in the midst of a six-game road trip (1-1)...They begin in The Bronx (1-1) before shipping up to Boston for a three-game set.

STOP THE STREAK: The Mets snapped a brief two-game losing streak...The Mets have yet to lose three games in a row...Below is a chart of the longest streaks to start a season by the Mets without losing three in a row, courtesy of *Elias*.

SUBWAY SERIES: The Mets are 1-1 in the Subway Series this year...They went 4-0 in the Subway Series in 2024...The Mets earned their second series sweep against the Yankees in franchise history, also accomplished in 2013 (4-0)...In 2023, the Mets went 2-2 against the Yankees, splitting the series in The Bronx and in Queens...The Amazin's are 67-81 vs. the Yankees all-time during the regular season...The Mets are 115-151-2 vs. the Yankees combined in the regular season, World Series, Spring Training, 2020 Summer Camp, Mayor's Trophy Games, Mayor's Challenge Games and the Big Apple Series.

ON THE MARK: On June 25, 2024 at Citi Field, Mark Vientos became the 12th player in franchise history to record a multi-homer game in the Subway Series, joining Pete Alonso, Francisco Lindor, José Reyes Jason Bay, Carlos Delgado, David Wright, Carlos Beltrán, Cliff Floyd, Ty Wigginton, Kaz Matsui and Richard Hidalgo... He hit safely in each of his first seven career games vs. the Yankees, which is a franchise record.

ED, EDD AND EDDY: Edwin Diaz earned his 10th save of the season yesterday... He has not allowed an earned run over his last eight games, recording four saves and allowing four hits, two walks and 11 strikeouts...He has not allowed a hit over last four appearances.

THEY'RE OUT OF OUR LEAGUE: The Mets will play American League teams in nine of their next 12 games (1-1)...This year marked the first time in franchise history that the Mets open their home and road schedule against an Interleague Opponent...The Mets are 8-6 in Interleague Play this season...The team went 24-22 in Interleague Play last year...Overall, New York owns a 286-282 record in Interleague play.

INTERGALACTIC: Pete Alonso has hit a franchise-record 59 home runs in Interleague Play...His 59 home runs are the eighth-most all-time...It is tied for third among active players with Manny Machado...Only Aaron Judge (69) and Kyle Shwarber (63) have hit more.

INVADER NIMS: Brandon Nimmo has reached base in nine straght games, recording a hit in eight of those contests...He is batting .303 (10-33) in that span with four doubles, one home run, two walks, one steal, four RBI with a .361 OBP and a .515 SLG...He is slashing .253/.321/.526 with seven home runs and 19 RBI in 24 road games...This compares to a .197/.247/.296 slashline with one homer and eight RBI in 20 games at Citi Field.

23 AND ME: The Mets have won the last 23 games in which Francisco Lindor has homered...The streak that goes back to July 9, 2024 is the longest streak in team history...Prior to Lindor's streak, the longest was 21 straight wins when George Foster homered between July 3, 1985, and June 29, 1986...The next-longest active streak by any major leaguer is Boston's Ceddanne Rafaela at 17 straight wins... Courtesy of Stats Perform.

LINSANITY: Francisco Lindor has safely reached base in 19 of his last 20 games... In his last 29 games dating back to April 16, has a .319/.393/.555 slashline with 20 runs, four doubles, eight home runs, 22 RBI and 10 walks...Lindor has hit six lead-off homers as a member of the Mets...That is tied with Mookie Wilson for the seventh-most in team history...Michael Conforto is next with seven leadoff homers.

PITCHING IN: The Mets lead the majors with a 2.87 ERA and are fifth with 414 strikeouts...They are tied for fifth with five shutouts...New York's starting staff has posted an NL-best 2.84 ERA this year...The bullpen ranks third in the majors with a 2.92 ERA.

OUCH: The Mets have been plunked 26 times this year, which is the most in the major leagues...New York was hit 107 times last season, the second-most in the majors and the most in the Senior Circuit...Pete Alonso owns the franchise record, having been hit by 90 pitches in his career...Brandon Nimmo is second with 81, followed by Jeff McNeil at 77 HBP.

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched on May 12 vs. Pittsburgh and did not record a decision despite allowing two earned runs over 6.0+ innings (5 H, 3 BB, 7 K, HR)...Marked his second consecutive quality start and his fourth of the season...He threw at least 100 pitches in back-to-back outings for the fifth time in his career and for the first time since 6/17 and 6/24/24.

ON A ROLL: Over eight starts this season, has gone 2-2 with a 3.05 ERA (15 ER/44.1 IP), 16 walks and 43 strikeouts...The Mets are 6-2 in his starts this season...Has pitched 5.0 innings or more in seven of his eight starts and in each of his last six starts...His six such games mark the second-longest streak of his career (10 GS with 5.0+ innings from 7/11-9/3/24)...Has allowed three earned runs or less in each of his eight starts this season and in each of his last nine starts dating back to September 29, 2024 (the second-longest such streak in his career)...His longest such streak came in an 11-start span from 6/20-9/9/22...Among Major League pitchers this season (min. 40.0 IP), his 55.8 groundball percentage is the seventh-best (fifth in NL)...Since the start of last season, Peterson has allowed three runs or fewer in 24 of his 29 starts, going 12-5 with a 2.94 ERA (54 ER/165.1 IP), 62 walks and 144 strikeouts...Since 2024, has allowed just two runs in the first inning, tied with Reese Olson for the fewest in the majors during that span (min. 20 GS)...The Mets are 21-8 in those games.

ROAD WARRIOR: Has made three road outings this season, each being quality starts...He has combined to go 1-2 with a 3.00 ERA (6 ER/18.0 IP), seven walks and 20 strikeouts in those three starts...In 15 road starts since his start to the 2024 season, Peterson has gone 7-3 with a 2.68 ERA (27 ER/90.2 IP), 33 walks and 70 strikeouts...He has recorded quality starts in 11 of those games, including eight of his last 10 (since August 3, 2024)...Allowed two runs or less in 14 of those 15 road outings...The Mets are 10-5 in Peterson's away outings in this span.

SOUTHPAW STRIKEOUTS: Peterson has recorded 507 career strikeouts, which ranks 12th all-time among franchise southpaws...Tom Glavine is next on the list with 516....With his sixth strikeout on May 6 at Arizona, Peterson reached the 500-strikeout milestone...He became the 13th Mets southpaw to reach the milestone and the first since Steven Matz (recorded his 500th strikeout on 9/11/19)...He reached the milestone in his 108th game (106th start) which is the seventh-fewest games with the club (Sid Fernandez - 82G/81GS, Al Leiter - 85GS, Johan Santana - 89GS, Jon Matlack - 93G/90GS, Matz - 100G/98GS and Jon Niese - 105G/104GS)...He also became the sixth lefty to be drafted or first signed by the Mets to accomplish the feat, joining Jerry Koosman, Matlack, Matz, Tug McGraw and Niese.

TO THE LEFT TO THE LEFT: This season, Peterson has held lefties to a .206 batting average (7-34)...Among qualified southpaws facing left-handed hitters this season, he is first in groundball percentage (70.8), eighth in opponents' SLG (.235, fifth in NL) and 11th in opponents' OPS (.525, ninth in NL)...In his career, he has posted a .230 opponents' batting average against lefties (101-439).

VS. YANKEES/AL EAST: Will be making his third appearance (second start) against the Yankees tonight...The Mets are 3-0 against the Bronx Bombers when Peterson has pitched...His start will mark his first time pitching at Yankee Stadium since August 28, 2020 where he allowed three earned runs over 4.0 innings (4 H, 3 BB, 3 K)...Has made just one start against AL East opponents this season, allowing one earned run over 4.2 innings on April 6 vs. Toronto (3 H, 5 BB, 3 K, HP)...Over his last seven outings (six starts) against the AL East (since 7/23/23), has gone 1-1 with a 2.67 ERA (9 ER/30.1 IP), 17 walks and 35 strikeouts...Has allowed just two home runs in those games, posting a 0.59 HR/9.0 IP ratio.

ELECTRIC SLIDE: David Peterson has used his slider 17.4% of the time this season...Of his 43 strikeouts, 22 have come using this pitch...67% of his pitches with the slider have been thrown for strikes this year.

QUALITY CONTROL: Peterson has recorded 16 quality starts since the start of last season, with 14 of them coming in his last 24 games (since July 1)...Recorded four quality starts in eight total outings this season...From July 1, 2024 to now, his 14 quality starts are tied for the eighth-most in the majors (tied for third in NL).

APPLE PICKING: Peterson has recorded 16 career pickoffs (one this season), tied with Bobby Ojeda for the eighth-most by a Mets pitcher...He trails only Ron Darling (41), Jerry Koosman (36), Dwight Gooden (32), Al Leiter (28), Jon Matlack (24), Mike Scott (20), Sid Fernandez (18)...Courtesy of *OPTA*...Since his Major League debut in 2020, he has the highest net bases prevented (27) according to Baseball Savant (a sum of advances prevented and outs added assigned to the pitcher)...Chris Flexen and José Berrios are next on the list with 20.

THREE AND UNDER: With a 2.90 ERA (39 ER/121.0 IP) last season, Peterson became the 10th left-hander in franchise history to record an ERA of 3.00-or-under while making at least 20 starts...He is the first Mets southpaw to accomplish the feat since Johan Santana's 2.98 ERA (66 ER/199.0 IP) over 29 starts in 2010.

CAREER NOTES: Made his third career Opening Day roster (also: 2021 and 2023)...Started the 2024 season on the 60-day Injured List after undergoing left hip surgery in the offseason...Over parts of five major league seasons with the Mets, the southpaw has gone 30-26 with a 3.99

ERA (221 ER/498.1 IP), 213 walks and 507 strikeouts in 109 games (93 starts)...Was drafted by the Mets in the first round (20th overall) of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Oregon.

- On May 17 at the Yankees, retired each of his five batters faced in relief (1.2 IP, K)...Also stranded two inherited runners in the sixth inning...Has stranded 11 of his 13 inherited runners this season (15.4%), which is the sixth-best percentage among Major League relievers and second-best in the National League (min. 10 IR)...Trails only teammate Max Kranick (12.5%).
- Earned his second win of the season on May 12 against the Pirates after tossing the ninth inning (1.0 IP, 2 H, R).
- Entered in the seventh inning on May 7 at Arizona and stranded a runner while picking up the final two outs (0.2 IP, K).
- Has not allowed an earned run over his last eight appearances (10.1 IP, since April 27)...In that span, has allowed just two hits to 37 batters faced (.063 opponents' BA, 2 BB, 10 K).

- Has recorded a 1.14 ERA (3 ER/23.2 IP) in 18 games as a reliever this season...Among National League relievers this season, is fourth in WHIP (0.72), fifth in ERA, and 10th in innings pitched and opponents' OPS (.486).
- In 11 road games this season, he has posted a 0.61 ERA (ER/14.2 IP) with one save, four holds, and 13 strikeouts...Is scoreless in 10 of those games.
- Has been scoreless over 9.1 innings against Interleague opponents this season, holding batters to a .071 average (2-28).
