THE TWINS: The Twins opened their 66th season with a loss in Baltimore on Thursday afternoon, followed by a win yesterday...today, they will play the three-game series finale at Camden Yards...after the game, the Twins will travel to Kansas City to play a three-game series against the Royals at Kauffman Stadium from Monday-Thursday (off-day Tuesday)... following this trip, Minnesota will open its 17th season at Target Field with a three-game weekend series against the Tampa Bay Rays, followed by a four-game series against the Detroit Tigers, next Monday-Thursday.
 ☞ Twins went 7-5 in rubber games in 2025...final rubber game win was September 25, 2025 at Texas.
 ☞ Twins are going for their second victory today...they didn't get their second win of 2025 until their sixth game, on April 2 at Chicago-AL...they began last season in St. Louis and were swept in three games to start 2025.

BRADLEY AND BULLPEN > BALTIMORE: The Twins beat the Orioles yesterday by a score of 4-1, evening the series at 1-1...Taj Bradley was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on three hits in 4.1 innings pitched, with three walks and nine strikeouts... Anthony Banda (0.2 IP), Kody Funderburk (0.2 IP), Eric Orze (1.1 IP), Justin Topa (1.0 IP) and Cole Sands (1.0) combined to pitch 4.2 scoreless innings of relief with seven strikeouts...the offense recorded four hits, highlighted by a Royce Lewis two-run homer in the fifth inning... Minnesota went 1-for-1 with runners in scoring position after going 1-for-12 with RISP on Opening Day.

BIRD BALL: The Twins and Orioles are playing each other today for the third of six games in 2026...Twins will host the O's for three games at Target Field from August 10-12.
 ☞ Twins are now 7-1 vs. Baltimore in their last eight (since the start of 2025) after going 0-10 head-to-head prior to this stretch (from July 2, 2023-September 29, 2024).
 ☞ Since 2018, the Twins have hit 73 home runs in 46 games against the Orioles, their second-most vs. any opponent outside of the AL Central (77 vs. SEA)...37 have been hit at Camden.
 ☞ Josh Bell is hitting .322 (28-for-87) with seven home runs, 18 RBI, a .586 slugging percentage and a .944 OPS in 24 career games vs. the Orioles...he has hit safely in 12 of his last 15 vs. the O's...he has homered in five of his last 11 vs. the O's...he has reached base safely via hit or walk in eight of his last nine at Camden Yards.
 ☞ Victor Caratini is hitting .333 (12-for-36) with six walks, eight RBI, a .422 on-base percentage and an .867 OPS in 14 career games vs. Baltimore.

GETTING OBER THE HUMP: Bailey Ober is looking to reverse his recent opening starts performance today...since 2024, he has gone 0-2, 36.00 (4.0 IP, 16 ER) with 17 hits allowed, five home runs, four walks and four strikeouts in two starts to open his season (2024 at Kansas City and 2025 at St. Louis)...despite that, he has gone 26-24, 4.16 ERA (469.1 IP, 217 ER) with a .237 opponent batting average in 84 starts since the start of 2023...below are his AL rankings in a few categories in that span (minimum of 450.0 innings pitched):

BAILEY 'O'-BER: Bailey Ober is 1-1, 2.60 ERA (26.7 IP, 8 ER) with seven walks, 26 strikeouts and a .206 opponent batting average in five career starts against the Orioles...in two career starts at Oriole Park, he has gone 1-0, 2.31 ERA (11.2 IP, 3 ER) with just four hits allowed, three walks and 11 strikeouts...since 2023, his 2.60 ERA vs. the Orioles ranks third in baseball (minimum of 25.0 IP), trailing George Kirby (2.50) and Gerrit Cole (2.51).
 ☞ Ober's 2.60 career ERA against Baltimore is his third lowest against AL teams, only trailing Boston (1.57) and the Athletics (1.73).

WINNER TAKE ALL: Twins are seeking their first series win of the season today...they went 18-32-2 in series play last season, going 11-13-2 at home and 7-19-0 on the road...Minnesota finished the season going 1-7-0 in their final eight series, their only win coming September 23-25 at Texas, taking two of three from the Rangers during their final roadtrip.
 ☞ Twins are seeking their third consecutive series win over the Orioles, which would mark their longest stretch head-to-head in series play over Baltimore since taking five-straight series from the Orioles from March of 2018-May of 2021.

INTERSTATES FULL OF BUCK TRUCKS: Byron Buxton has posted a 1.176 OPS over his last 13 road games, dating back to August 27, including eight home runs, 13 RBI and an .843 slugging percentage in that span...since that date, he leads baseball in road homers and slugging percentage, second in OPS and tied for 11th in RBI — minimum of 50 road plate appearances.

PUNCHING UP AND PUNCHING OUT: Twins pitchers have struck out 24 batters through two games, 16 from starters (Joe Ryan - 7 and Taj Bradley - 9) and eight from the bullpen...24 strikeouts are tied for the third-most in Twins history through the club's first two games...the only three times in which Twins pitchers struck out as many batters was 26 in 2021, 26 in 2019 and 24 in 2018.
 ☞ 16 strikeouts from Ryan and Bradley are the most combined from the starters since 2021, when José Berrios (12) and Kenta Maeda (5) opened with 17 against the Brewers.
 ☞ The 24 strikeouts rank tied for 12th in baseball, but the staff's 12.71 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings pitched ranks third, trailing Toronto (15.75) and Milwaukee (15.50).
 ☞ The 16 strikeouts from starters ranks tied for eighth in baseball, but the starters' 14.90 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings pitched ranks second, trailing Toronto (18.26).

TWINS MiLB PLAYERS OF THE TWO-DAYS WEEK: Twins have named Triple-A Saints infielder Kaelen Culpepper and left-handed pitcher Connor Prielipp as the clubs' minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.
 ☞ Culpepper, 23, made his Triple-A debut on Friday night and went 3-for-5 with one RBI at Indianapolis...he followed with a 1-for-4 day yesterday, hitting his first homer of the season...he also walked once yesterday and drove in three runs.
 ☞ Prielipp, 25, was the Saints' Opening Day starter on Friday night, allowing one run on one hit in 4.0 innings pitched, with two walks and five strikeouts, leading St. Paul to a 4-2 victory in Indianapolis.

IT'S TIME FOR THE PERK-'O'-LATOR: Twins.TV analyst Glen Perkins made his second and third career appearances in this ballpark on September 23-24, 2006, pitching 0.2 innings in the first game and 0.0 IP with one hit allowed in the second game...Perk earned his second-to-last career win at Camden Yards on August 23, 2015 in a Twins 4-3 12-inning victory...he pitched the 11th inning as the Twins took the lead, then proven closer Tommy Milone saved the game in the 12th.

- ⌘ In his career, he holds a 1-1 record against the Orioles, with a 2.60 ERA (27.2 IP, 8 ER), seven walks, 26 strikeouts and a .206 (21-for-102) opponent batting average.
- ⌘ Ober is looking to collect a win in his season debut for the first time since April 2023, when he pitched 5.2 innings of one run ball with four strikeouts against the Washington Nationals.

SPRING TRAINING RECAP: Ober made four starts in spring training, going 0-1 with a 4.15 ERA (13.0 IP, 6 ER), six walks and six strikeouts.
 ⌘ Made spring debut on March 6, after spending first few weeks of spring working on mechanics.
 ⌘ In 13.0 spring innings had a 1.77 WHIP and .327 BAA.

2025 SEASON RECAP: Made 27 starts in the 2025 season, going 6-9 with a 5.10 ERA (146.1 IP, 83 ER), 31 walks and 120 strikeouts.
 ⌘ Finished second on Twins staff in starts (27), innings pitched (146.1), quality starts (8) and strikeouts (120).
 ⌘ Pitched 6.0 scoreless innings with two hits allowed and one walk in final start on September 25 at Texas...also recorded his 600th career strikeout, fanning Joc Pederson in the first inning.
 ⌘ Battled discomfort in left hip for majority of season, after starting to feel it in spring training...eventually on July 2, went on 15-day Injured List, his first time on IL in three seasons (2022).

CAREER VS. BALTIMORE: Ober has made five career starts against the Orioles, going 1-1 with a 2.60 ERA (27.2 IP, 8 ER), seven walks, 26 strikeouts and a .206 (21-for-102) BAA.
 ⌘ In 2025, faced Baltimore in back to back starts on May 8 and May 14 (game 1)...did not factor into the decision in either game, both Twins wins...had a combined 3.72 ERA (9.2 IP, 4 ER) with four walks and nine strikeouts across the two starts.
 ⌘ Ober's 2.60 career ERA against Baltimore is his third lowest against AL teams, only trailing Boston (1.57) and the Athletics (1.73).

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In five MLB seasons, all with the Twins, Ober has gone 16-15 with a 4.18 ERA (314.0 IP, 146 ER), 75 walks, 310 strikeouts, a .238 BAA and a .728 OPS against in 59 starts at home compared to 15-15 with a 3.97 ERA (303.2 IP, 134 ER), 58 walks, 294 strikeouts, a .240 BAA and a .700 OPS against in 56 road starts.
 ⌘ In 2025, went 2-6 at home with a 5.12 ERA (82.2 IP, 47 ER), 18 walks, 70 strikeouts and a .783 OPS against in 15 starts, compared to 4-3 on the road with a 5.09 ERA (63.2 IP, 36 ER), 13 walks, 50 strikeouts and a .837 OPS against in 12 starts.
 ⌘ Allowed 17 of his 30 home runs at Target Field in 2025.
 ⌘ In his last three road starts in 2025, Ober went 2-0 with a 2.76 ERA (16.1 IP, 5 ER), 1.10 WHIP, 1.10 BB/9, and a .719 OPS against...the Twins won all three games he pitched.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: In 2025, left-handed hitters slashed .274/.312/.481 (85-for-310), while righties hit .275/.315/.509 (74-for-269).
 ⌘ Lefties posted an average exit velocity of 87.2 mph and a hard-hit percentage of 31.0, compared to righties 91.6 mph and 49.0 percent.
 ⌘ Ober generated a 34.0 chase percentage against left-handed hitters and a 33.6 chase percentage against right-handed hitters...his combined 33.8 chase percentage ranked in the 94th percentile among all MLB pitchers.

WALK THIS WAY: Per Baseball Savant, Bailey owned just a 5.0 walk percentage last season, ranking in baseball's 93rd percentile...ranked first on the Twins pitching staff, followed by Joe Ryan (5.7), Pablo López (6.4) and Cole Sands (6.4).

THE ARSENAL: Ober used a six-pitch mix in 2025, per Baseball Savant...threw a 4-seamer 35.9% of the time, the lowest of his career...primarily used his sweeper and sinker against right-handed batters, while favoring his curveball and changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

⌘ His 7.3 foot extension ranked in baseball's 97th percentile...he ranked in the bottom one percent in breaking run value (-16) and bottom seventh percentile in pitching run value (-17).
 ⌘ His 33.8 chase percentage last season ranked first on the Twins pitching staff, followed by Pablo López (32.1) and Zebby Matthews (30.2).
 ⌘ Among pitchers who threw at least 300 sliders, Bailey had the highest opponent batting average (.321), second-highest slugging percentage (.606), 16th-highest hard hit percentage (43.2) and fourth-lowest strikeout percentage (12.6).
