RAY REPORT—The Rays continue their brief three-game road trip against the Marlins (1-0, two to play) today at loanDepot park...own the best record in the majors since April 22 at 25-12 (.676), just ahead of the Braves (27-13/.675)...have owned the AL's best record for each of the last 28 days (May 9-pres.), including eight consecutive days leading the majors from May 18-25...are 9-2-1 in their last 12 sets since April 24, going 11-2 in series openers over that span...have a 1.5-game lead in the AL East and have spent 34 days leading the division, 25 in second, six in third, four in fourth, and three in fifth.

- ★ The Rays reeled in the Marlins with a 6-0 victory last night in Miami, their largest shutout win since Aug. 25, 2025 at CLE (9-0)...marked their fourth shutout win of the season and their first in the Citrus Series since May 17, 2025 at MIA (4-0).
- ★ The pitching staff combined to allow a season-low two hits and one walk in the contest, the fewest baserunners allowed by the Rays since **Zack Littell**, **Edwin Uceta**, and **Garrett Cleavinger** combined to allow one baserunner (1H) on Sept. 19, 2024 vs. BOS.
- ★ **Drew Rasmussen** strung together 7.0 scoreless frames with one hit allowed...he retired 21 of the 22 batters he faced, including each of the last 17 hitters (see more in "Catch Of The Day" note below).
- ★ **Junior Caminero** reached base five times in last night's contest (1 1B, 2 2B, 2 BB), his second time this season turning the trick...he is one of three players to do so twice in 2026, joining AZ Nolan **Arenado** and ATH **Nick Kurtz** (see more in "La Máxima En Miami" note below).
- ★ They improved to 26-7 (.788) when scoring first this season, third best in the majors behind the Rangers (26-7/.788) and Dodgers (29-7/.806).
- ★ The Rays have claimed at least a season split of the Citrus Series, their eighth straight season (2019-pres.) winning or splitting the season set...they won six straight season series between 2019-24 before splitting in 2025 (3-3).
- ★ With a win today, the Rays would improve to 13-7-1 in series play, including 4-1-1 in their last six road sets.

CATCH OF THE DAY—**Drew Rasmussen** spun 7.0 scoreless innings last night with one hit allowed, no walks allowed, and a season-high nine strikeouts...along with April 12 vs. NYY (6.0IP, 1BR), he has gone 5.0 innings or more with one or zero baserunners allowed twice this season...he became the 17th pitcher in the modern era (since 1900) to turn the trick twice in a single season, and no pitcher has done so three times in a single campaign...since the right-hander debuted for the Rays on June 19, 2021 at SEA, he has five such starts, most in MLB over that timeframe and two ahead of the next closest arms (**Max Scherzer**, **Logan Gilbert**, **Nick Pivetta**)...it marked the fifth start of 7.0 innings or more with one or zero baserunners allowed in team history, and Rasmussen became the only one to accomplish the feat multiple times (see table on the right).

- ★ He became the first Ray to spin 7.0 scoreless innings or more with one or zero hits allowed since **Zack Littell** (also 7.0IP, 1H) on Sept. 19, 2024 vs. BOS, and joined **Chris Archer**, **Matt Garza**, **Jake Odorizzi**, and **Ryan Rupe** as the only pitchers in team history to have multiple such starts in a Rays uniform...no Ray has had three such starts.
- ★ Rasmussen's nine strikeouts were his most since his career-best 10-strikeout outing on Sept. 9, 2022 at NYY.
- ★ Each of his six career starts against the Marlins have come as a member of the Rays...in those six outings, he is 4-0 with a 2.04 ERA (35.1IP, 8ER) and 30 strikeouts...since the Marlins joined the major leagues in 1993, his 2.04 ERA is the fourth lowest among all AL starting pitchers (min. 20.0IP)...he trails only TB **Chris Archer** (1.80), BOS **Brayan Bello** (1.80), and NYY/BOS **David Cone** (1.80).

LA MÁXIMA EN MIAMI—**Junior Caminero** went 3-for-3 with 2 2B, 2 BB, and 3 R last night and he has reached base safely in 21 of 33 PA (.636 OBP) over his last seven games...he has reached base at a .448 clip since the beginning of May, second in the majors behind ATL **Nick Kurtz** (.451), after entering the month with a .328 on-base pct....has hit safely in 16 of his last 17 contests (May 16-pres.) and his .526 on-base pct. leads the majors over that span and is the best 17-game, single-season span by a Ray since **Yandy Diaz** reached at a .533 clip between Sept. 2-20, 2025.

- ★ Last night's game was his first at loanDepot park since March 15 vs. USA with the Dominican Republic at the 2026 World Baseball Classic...this calendar year, he is slashing .435/.519/.957 (10-for-23) with 3 2B, 3 HR, 7 RBI, 3 BB, 8 R, 1 HBP, and a 1.476 OPS in seven games at the ballpark, six of which came at the WBC.
- ★ The MLB leader in average bat speed (79.9 mph), he paces the AL with 76 batted balls hit at 100 mph or faster, tied for second in the majors (also: ATL **Michael Harris II**) behind ATL **Matt Olson** (78), and is pacing for 205, which would break Diaz's Statcast era (since 2015) club record established last season (200)...he would join Diaz, ATL **Ronald Acuña Jr.** (2023), LAD **Shohei Ohtani** (2024-25), and TOR **Vladimir Guerrero Jr.** (2024, 2021-22) as the only players to record 200 such batted balls under Statcast.
- ★ He has a .394/.522/.702 (41-for-104) slash line against fastballs this season, going 9-for-11 against fastballs since May 30...over that timeframe, he has swung at 17 fastballs with no whiff, putting 11 of them in play...those pitches have averaged 95.1 mph with an average exit velocity of 100.4 mph.

ALL ABOUT THAT BASE—**Yandy Diaz** is slashing .351/.429/.676 (26-for-74) with 6 2B, 6 HR, 16 RBI, and a 1.104 OPS during a season-high 19-game on-base streak, the second-longest active run in MLB (see table on the right) and his longest since a 27-game run from June 3-July 4, 2025...is the fifth-longest streak of his career, two games shy of a pair of 21-game streaks between April 27-May 28, 2023 and July 24-Aug. 16, 2020...since the current streak began on May 12, only two players in the majors have better OPS's than Diaz: LAD **Shohei Ohtani** (1.225) and HOU **Yordan Alvarez** (1.133).

- ★ In each of the 19 games, Diaz has served as the designated hitter, the fifth-longest on-base streak in games as a DH in team history and the longest since his own 31-game streak between June 3-July 21, 2025...he is three games shy of **Ji-Man Choi**'s 22-game stretch from Aug. 9-Sept. 12, 2018, which is the fourth-longest streak by a Rays DH.
- ★ He has reached base safely in each of his 18 career games at loanDepot park, batting .371 (26-for-70) with 6 2B, 9 RBI, and an .878 OPS...it ties **Adrian González** (2012-18) for the second-longest career-opening streak since the venue opened in 2012, trailing **Willson Contreras** (20G, 2016-25, active streak)...min. 70 AB, he owns the second-highest average in the ballpark's history behind **Justin Turner** (.415).

KEEP CALM AND PITCH ON—The Rays pitching staff turned in their fourth shutout of the season last night on the heels of a nine-game span over which they allowed 8.0 runs per game...they held a 6.38 ERA (90.1IP, 64ER) in a 10-game span between May 24-June 3 compared to a 2.37 ERA (235.1IP, 62ER) over their prior 26 games from April 22-May 22...the bullpen has worked 4.0 innings or more in five of the last six and eight of the last 10 games...since the calendar turned to May, the Rays have had the fourth-most innings pitched by relievers in the AL behind only the Tigers (136.2), Blue Jays (135.2), and Twins (129.2).

- ★ Today's probable starter, **Shane McClanahan**, takes the mound looking for his 40th career win, which would tie **Jeremy Hellickson**, **Jeff Niemann**, **Jake Odorizzi**, and **Ryan Yarbrough** for seventh most in franchise history...he would join **James Shields** (43) and **David Price** (41) as the only pitchers in franchise history to reach the mark within their first four big league seasons.

WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT—The Rays have tallied 95 walks in their last 20 games since May 12, most in the majors, and have recorded an MLB-best 12.0 pct. walk rate in that span...this, compared to 128 walks and an 8.5 pct. walk rate in their first 40 games (Opening Day-May 11), both of which ranked 14th among AL clubs...they have recorded 223 walks through 59 games and are pacing for 602 free passes, which would mark their highest total since a franchise-record 672 walks in 2010.

- ★ **Junior Caminero** has drawn a walk in five of seven and 11 of his last 16 games, with his 17 walks in the latter span (May 17-pres.) ranking third in the majors to LAA **Mike Trout** (19) and ATH **Nick Kurtz** (18).
- ★ The club's season-long walk rate of 9.7 pct. is on pace to rank as the fifth-best mark in team history...it would be the best since the 2020 Rays recorded a franchise-best 10.75 pct. and the best over a 162-game season since 2010 (10.72%).

SHARKBAIT OO HA HA—The Rays and Marlins are set to conclude the 2026 Citrus Series this weekend...the Rays lead the season series, 3-1, after taking the three-game set at Tropicana Field (2-1) between May 15-17, and have an 87-64 advantage in the all-time series...the Rays have won 11 of 16, 19 of 25, and 31 of their last 39 against the Marlins...Tampa Bay has won 12 of its last 15 series against Miami, including eight straight from May 14, 2019-Aug. 31, 2022...since 2019, the Rays 30-8 (.789) record is the second best by any team against a single opponent (min. 20G) behind the Yankees 36-9 (.800) mark against the Royals.

- ★ The Rays held an all-time record of 46-47 against Miami prior to **Kevin Cash** becoming manager in 2015...under Cash, the club is 41-17 and won a franchise-best nine straight games against the Marlins between July 22, 2018-Sept. 4, 2020.
- ★ Since the start of 2025, **Yandy Diaz** has gone 13-for-37 (.351) with 1 2B, 3 HR, 9 RBI, a .622 slugging pct., and a 1.022 OPS in nine games against the Marlins...he has homered in three of his last five contests against Miami.

TODAY'S START—Shane McClanahan will toe the rubber for his 12th start of the season and sixth on the road...will be making his 86th career start and 40th on the road...missed the last two years after his second Tommy John surgery wiped out his 2024 season and nerve-related issues sidelined him for 2025...selected by the Rays in the Compensatory Round (31st overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of South Florida.

✦ Has gone 5-0 with a 1.22 ERA (37.0IP, 5ER), 35 SO, 8 BB, and a 0.86 WHIP over his last seven starts...the five-decision winning streak is tied for the third longest of his career and is his longest since a career-best eight-decision streak from March 30-May 24, 2023... it is also tied with BOS **Sonny Gray** for the longest active streak in the AL.

✦ Min. 50.0 IP, his 0.33 HR per 9.0 IP ranks second in the AL to NYY **Max Fried** (0.15) and sixth in the majors...has allowed 1 HR in his last eight starts spanning 41.1 IP.

✦ Leads the AL and ranks sixth in the majors with a .184 (37-for-201) opp. average (min. 50.0IP).

LAST TIME OUT—Picked up his sixth win of the season after firing 5.0 innings of one-run ball, giving up four hits while striking out three batters in a 5-2 win on May 31 vs. LAA...his lone blemish came on a wild pitch in the 2nd inning, allowing **Jose Siri** to score...he retired the next 10 of 11 batters faced.

✦ Marked his seventh consecutive start of 5.0 innings or more, surrendering one or zero earned runs in six of those seven outings.

✦ Has reached six wins before June for the second time in his career, matching his 2023 season, when he went 8-1 over the same span.

✦ After issuing 11 walks over this first three starts (March 31-April 14), he has permitted only eight over his last eight outings (April 19-pres.) with 40 strikeouts...recorded 3.43 walks per 9.0 IP over his first three starts compared to 1.74 in his last eight outings.

FISH TALES—The 29-year-old southpaw will make his third career start against Miami today...he is 2-0 with a 0.82 ERA (11.0IP, ER), 3 BB, 12 SO, a 1.18 WHIP, and a .256 (10-for-39) opp. AVG in his previous two starts...today marks his first career start at loanDepot Park.

✦ Last took the mound against Miami on May 24, 2022 at Tropicana Field, recording his fifth quality start of the season after spinning 6.0 scoreless innings, allowing four hits and two walks against nine strikeouts in the win...was the third of a franchise-record 13 consecutive quality starts for McClanahan that season (May 11-July 26, 2022).

✦ His 0.82 ERA (11.0IP, ER) against the Marlins is his lowest vs. any opponent (min. 10.0IP)...Miami is also one of 10 clubs McClanahan has appeared against and not recorded a loss, joining BAL (7-0), KC (1-0), LAA (2-0), NYM (1-0), SD (1-0), SEA (1-0), SF (1-0), STL (1-0), TEX (1-0), and WSH (1-0).

✦ In five career starts against NL East opponents, McClanahan owns a 4-0 record with a 3.55 ERA (25.1IP, 10ER), 29 strikeouts, and a .271 (26-for-96) opp. average.

MASTERPIECE OF A MONTH—During May, McClanahan went 4-0 with a 1.41 ERA (32.0IP, 5ER) across six starts, the lowest ERA among AL pitchers (min. 30.0IP), while also ranking among AL starters in WHIP (4th, 0.84), opp. on-base pct. (5th, .231), and run support average (6th, 7.03).

✦ Was one of three MLB starters and the lone AL starter to post four starts or more of 5.0 scoreless innings or more in May, alongside MIL **Jacob Misiorowski** (5GS) and PHI **Cristopher Sánchez** (5GS).

✦ McClanahan's 1.41 ERA (32.0IP, 5ER) in May joined teammate **Nick Martinez** (1.52ERA/29.2IP, 5ER) as the only Rays duo in franchise history to turn in a 1.55 ERA or lower during May (min. 25.0IP).

✦ Posted the fourth-lowest May ERA in franchise history by a traditional starter (min. 30.0IP), trailing **Rich Hill** (0.78ERA, 2021), **Scott Kazmir** (1.15ERA, 2008), and **Jeremy Hellickson** (1.36ERA, 2011).

✦ The southpaw has posted his best career numbers in May, going 13-1 with a 1.84 ERA (122.2IP, 25ER) and 134 strikeouts...his 13 wins in the month are nearly double his next-highest total in any month, with seven victories in both April and June...McClanahan's career 1.84 ERA (122.1IP, 25ER) in May is the lowest by a traditional starter (min. 50.0IP) in franchise history...since 2021, his 13 wins in May are tied for the sixth most in the majors.

RISE AND SHANE—In six daytime starts this year, McClanahan is 3-1 with a 2.15 ERA (29.1IP, 7ER) and 27 strikeouts...for his career, is 19-6 with a 2.91 ERA (191.2IP, 62ER) and 218 strikeouts across 35 daytime starts...his 19 daytime wins since 2021 are tied for the ninth most among AL pitchers with SEA **Luis Castillo** and rank third among AL left-handers, trailing DET **Tarik Skubal** (27) and DET **Framber Valdez** (26).

UP AND AWAY—Through five road starts, McClanahan is 1-2 with a 2.96 ERA (24.1IP, 8ER) and a .178 opp. average (16-for-90)...among AL lefties (min. 30.0IP), his road opp. average ranks third behind only BOS **Payton Tolle** (.121) and BOS **Jovani Moran** (.172), while his ERA ranks eighth.

SUPPORTING OUR STARTER—McClanahan has received three runs of support or more in 44 of his 85 career appearances...in those 44 outings, he holds a 34-1 record, 2.74 ERA (246.1IP, 75ER), .212 (194-for-915) opp. average, 1.07 WHIP, and 271 strikeouts to 69 walks...in games where he receives three runs of support or more, the Rays are 40-4 and have won 20 of the last 21.

✦ Since his rookie season in 2021, McClanahan has the fourth-best run support average (5.42) among AL southpaws (min. 250.0IP), behind NYY **Max Fried** (6.69), CLE **Logan Allen** (5.68), and NYY **Carlos Rodón** (5.65).

THE ACE OF K'S—He has recorded four strikeouts or more in nine of his 11 starts this year...his 509 career strikeouts are ninth most in franchise history, 20 shy of eighth-ranked **Tyler Glasnow** (526SO)...he ranks fourth among Tampa Bay left-handers behind **David Price** (1,065SO), **Scott Kazmir** (874SO), and **Blake Snell** (648SO).

✦ With three strikeouts on May 25 at BAL, McClanahan reached 50 strikeouts through his first 10 starts to a season for the fourth season in a row (2021-23, 2026)...the last Ray to collect 50 strikeouts or more in his first 10 starts was **Shane Baz** in 2025, fanning 52 in that span.
