TODAY'S TILT...the Mariners continue a 7-game road trip with the last of 3 games against the Chicago White Sox (1-1)...the Mariners will travel to Houston for a 4-game series (5/11-5/14) following today's finale in Chicago...today's game against the Sox will be televised and streamed live on **Mariners TV** with **Aaron Goldsmith** and **Angie Mentink** on the call with **Brad Adam** serving as field reporter...the game will also be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Rick Rizzs** and **Gary Hill Jr.** on the call.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners dropped last night's contest to the White Sox by a 6-1 score, after beating the Sox, 12-8, in Friday night's opener.

- **Happy Mother's Day** - The Mariners are 24-22 all-time on Mother's Day.
- **Rubber Soul** - The Mariners head into today's rubber match against the White Sox with a 3-2 record in rubber matches this season.
- **Day 'n' Nite** - Seattle is 10-4 (.714) in day games this season, 3rd-best record in MLB...Seattle is 9-17 (.346) at night this year, 2nd-worst record in the Majors and better than only Detroit (.269/7-19).
- **At This Rate...** - Since the start of the 2023 season, the Mariners have yet to lose a series against the White Sox in Chicago...over that span the Mariners are 8-3 at Rate Field.
- **Minor Move** - Yesterday, outfielder Rhylan Thomas was claimed off waivers by the Houston Astros... Thomas was designated for assignment by Seattle on May 3.
- **Monday Programming Note** - Tomorrow night's series opener in Houston will be televised live on **Mariners TV**, and also on FS1, with Eric Collins and Eric Karros on the call.

AGAINST THE WHITE SOX. HE'S NAYLZ...first baseman **Josh Naylor** has appeared in 57 career games against the White Sox, batting .357 (75x210) with 39 runs, 20 doubles, 12 homers, 45 RBI, 13 walks and 5-for-5 in stolen bases...Naylor has a .397 on-base percentage, slugging .624 with a 1.021 OPS in 227 plate appearances...his .624 slugging percentage is 5th-highest against the White Sox (min. 200 PA) in MLB history, trailing a quartet of inner-circle Hall of Famers: Babe Ruth (.681 SLG), Lou Gehrig (.660), Jimmie Foxx (.628) and Jim Thome (.626).

SPEAKING OF NAYLOR...**Josh Naylor** enters Sunday with an 8-game hitting streak (5/1-c)...over his last 18 games (4/17-c), he is batting .386 (27x70) with 8 runs, 3 doubles, 3 home runs, 13 RBI, 6 walks and 7 stolen bases, getting on base at a .429 clip, slugging .557 with a .986 OPS...Naylor entered play on April 17 with a .118/.193/.197/.390 slash line, and comes into play today at .247/.306/.370/.676, raising his OPS nearly 300 points over an 18-game span.

WALTER VS. WHITE SOX...in 6 career starts against the White Sox, **Logan Gilbert** is 2-0 with a 1.80 ERA (6 ER, 30.0 IP) with 33 strikeouts and 6 walks...Gilbert will have faced the South Siders at least once in each of his 6 career seasons after toeing the rubber this afternoon.

DOING WHAT WE DO BEST...the Mariners pitching staff **leads the Majors** in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.42) this season, ranking ahead of the next-closest Dodgers (3.12)...Seattle pitchers have accumulated 335 strikeouts and just 98 walks through the first 40 games of the season...Mariners pitching has also allowed the fewest walks in the league by a sizable margin, with the Dodgers again ranking next-closest with 112 walks allowed...the Mariners have ranked either #1 or #2 in the Majors in strikeout-to-walk ratio in each of the last 3 full seasons: #2 in 2023, #1 in 2024, and #2 in 2025...in total since 2023, Seattle leads MLB with a 3.45 SO/BB clip, ranking ahead of the next-closest Phillies (3.21).

MY KIND OF TOWN...Mariners radio broadcaster **Rick Rizzs** will join Aaron and Angie in the Mariners TV booth this afternoon in the 3rd and 4th innings...Rizzs announced his plans to retire at the end of the 2026 season...the Blue Island, Illinois native is a 1975 graduate of Southern Illinois University-Carbondale...he is set to call his last game in his home state of Illinois this afternoon...Rizzs also appeared on **MLB Network** prior to last night's game.

BIG THUNDER ROARS...on Friday, **Luke Raley** went 2-for-5 with a grand slam and a 3-run home run, his 3rd career multi-homer game and first since April 30, 2023 at the White Sox with Tampa Bay...he drove in a career-high 7 RBI and became the first Mariners player with a grand slam and 3-run homer in the same game since Nelson Cruz on July 23, 2016 at Toronto...after battling through an 0-for-20 stretch, Raley is 4-for-11 (.364) with 3 runs, 3 home runs, 10 RBI and 1 walk over his last 13 plate appearances.

DUO OF DEBUTS...on Friday night, left-handed reliever **Josh Simpson** made his Mariners debut...last night, fellow southpaw reliever **José Suarez** made his first appearance in a Seattle uniform, tossing 2.0 innings...13 different players have made their Mariners debut so far in 2026.

FERRER HAS NO FEAR...left-hander **José A. Ferrer** is tied for 3rd in the Majors with 20 appearances out of the bullpen this season...he's recorded 2 saves with a 1.89 ERA (4 ER, 19.0 IP), tallying 16 strikeouts compared to just 3 walks...the 26-year old appeared in all 3 of Seattle's games against the Braves from May 4-6, tossing 1.0+ scoreless inning in each game while recording a hold on May 4 and his second save of the year in his most recent appearance on May 6.

MOVING UP THE LEADERBOARD...with his next home run, **Cal Raleigh** will surpass "Mr. Mariner" Alvin Davis for 7th on the Mariners all-time home runs list...Cal and Alvin are currently tied at 160 home runs, with Nelson Cruz (163 HR with Seattle) next up on the list at 6th place in franchise history.

AS YOU MAY KNOW...**Julio Rodríguez** went 2-for-3 with a walk in last night's game...it marked the 200th multi-hit game of Julio's career, but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...Julio is the 17th player in Mariners history to record at least 200 multi-hit games with Seattle, and just the 3rd player to reach 200 multi-hit games at age 25-or-younger?...Julio joins Ken Griffey Jr. (291 before turning 26) and Alex Rodriguez (277) as the only Mariners to reach 200 games with 2+ hits before turning 26-years-old.

ON THIS DATE IN MARINERS HISTORY - MAY 10

- **1989 - Mark Langston** had a perfect game through six innings. Langston had a no-hitter through eight innings. In what he would call "my toughest loss ever" Langston lost a perfect game, a no-hitter, a shutout, and a win in the span of three innings.
- **2015 - Félix Hernández** recorded his 2,000th career strikeout and improved to a career-best 6-0 in a 4-3 win over Oakland... The Mariners swept the A's for the first time since Aug 1-3, 2011...Hernandez becomes 4th youngest player to record 2,000 career strikeouts...Hernandez has won 7-straight decisions dating back to last season, going 7-0, 1.67 ERA with 57 strikeouts over that stretch...He also recorded his 131st win, passing Randy Johnson on the Mariners all-time wins list.

ABOUT LOGAN GILBERT...

- Gilbert, 29, is making his 9th start of the season and 1st against the White Sox...it is the 155th start of his career and 7th career start against Chicago-AL.
• Selected by Seattle in the 1st round (14th overall) of the 2018 MLB First-Year Player Draft; signed by Mariners scout Rob Mummau on June 16, 2018.
• Spent 3 seasons at Stetson (FL) University, 2016-18...in 2017, was ASUN Pitcher of the Year and ASUN 1st-Team All-Conference.
• Named the 2022 and the 2024 Mariners Most Valuable Pitcher by the Seattle Chapter of the BBWAA.
• Named to his 1st All-Star team in 2024.

LAST TIME OUT...

earned a win to start off the new month on May 4 vs. Atlanta...logged 6.0 innings, allowing 4 runs on 6 hits (4 HR) and 2 walks while striking out 4 batters...he threw 89 pitches and 59 strikes...marks his 109th outing with 2-or-fewer walks over 5.0+ IP...is the 3rd most such games in Mariners history behind Félix Hernández (271) and Jamie Moyer (240) and is the most in the AL since 2021.

THE ROAD SO FAR...

will be making his 3rd road start of the season...has recorded quality starts in 5 of his last 8 road games...his 37 starts with 6+ strikeouts and 2-or-fewer walks in away games since 2021 ranks T-5th in MLB...owned a 10.34 K/9 in away games in 2025 to rank T-9th in MLB (min. 50.0 IP)...owns 441 career strikeouts in away games ranking 6th most in Mariners history and leading AL starting pitchers since 2021...his 1.138 career WHIP on the road ranks 2nd (min. 30 GS), trailing only Bryan Woo (1.105).

LEFTY SPLITS...

ranks 6th in K/9 (11.0) against left-handed batters in the AL in 2026 (min 15.0 IP)...ranks 1st in strikeouts (468), T-9th (.220) in opponent batting average, 5th in K% (27.6) and 5th in WHIP (1.08) against lefty batters among AL pitchers since 2021 (min. 200.0 IP).

HEY BATTER BATTER SWING...

his 103 swing and misses in 2026 are the 5th most in the AL while his 2,012 career swing and misses rank 5th in MLB since 2021...owns a 43.7 career whiff rate on his splitter, ranking 3rd among pitchers with 1000 splitters thrown since 2021.

QUALITY CONTROL...

has thrown a quality start with 1-or-fewer walks issued in 57 career games (last: 4/12 vs. HOU), the 5th-most such games in MLB since 2021, just trailing rotation-mate George Kirby...his 26 quality starts without a walk are 6th-most in MLB since 2021.

IN COMMAND...

his 15 outings with 7+ strikeouts and 1-or-fewer walks are tied for the lead in most such games since 2024 with Garrett Crochet-BOS...among all-time starting pitchers with over 900 strikeouts, he ranks 6th in K/BB (4.85)...ranks 9th in the AL in 2026 with a 5.4 BB% (min. 40.0 IP)...is 1-of-3 pitchers to have finished the season in the top-10 in the AL in K/BB multiple times in the last 3 seasons (23,25) alongside Bryan Woo (24,25) and Tarik Skubal (24,25).

AMONG THE LEAGUE...

his 927 strikeouts since 2021 lead the American League while his 879.1 innings pitched are 3rd most and his 154 starts are 2nd in the AL across that span.

KEEPING COOPERSTOWN COMPANY...

ranks 12th in WHIP (1.070) all-time among starting pitchers in MLB that have recorded over 900 strikeouts, trailing Hall of Famer's Moredcai Brown's 1.066 and Walter Johnson's 1.061 WHIP. his base runners allowed per 9 innings (9.92) ranks 10th among all-time starting pitchers with 900+ strikeouts (min. 100 GS), behind Walter Johnson (9.84) and just ahead of Pedro Martinez (9.94).

WHERE IT RANKS...

his 11.9 K/9 last season is the 4th-best mark among starters in a single season in Mariners history (trailing Randy Johnson's 1995, '97, '98 seasons) while his 9.488 career K/9 is 3rd-best in franchise history (min. 500 IP), trailing James Paxton's 9.545 and Randy Johnson's 10.585 career K/9 mark...his 4.853 K/BB ranks 2nd in franchise history only behind George Kirby (6.286).

IN STRIKING DISTANCE...

with his 155th start tonight, he moves up the rankings to tie for 39th most games played among pitchers in Mariners history (min 500.0 IP)...with 4.1 innings of work in tonight's outing, he will eclipse Hisashi Iwakuma's 883.2 IP for the Mariners to rank 12th most in Mariners history (min 500.0 IP)...with a win, becomes the 7th Mariners pitcher to log 50 wins in their first 155 games with the Franchise...among these Mariners pitchers, his .568 win-loss% would be the 4th best behind Jamie Moyer (.664), Freddy García (.626), and Félix Hernández (.582).

AMONG THE GREATS...

his 3.61 career ERA (353 ER, 879.1 IP) is tied with Luis Castillo for the 6th-best among starters in Mariners history (min. 500 IP), trailing Randy Johnson, Félix Hernández, Hisashi Iwakuma, and James Paxton who each hold a 3.42 career ERA, and George Kirby (3.54)...his 927 career strikeouts are 6th-most in Mariners history, behind Mike Moore's 937 strikeouts...he also ranks 1st in WHIP (1.070).

150 FOR THE M'S...

made his 150th career start with the Mariners on April 12 vs. Houston Astros...he is the 7th pitcher to make 150 starts in a Mariners uniform...his 909 strikeouts rank second among Mariners pitchers' first 150 career starts, only behind Mark Langston (916 K)...ranks 9th in wins with 48 over a players' first 150 games pitched with the Mariners.
