**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The St. Louis Cardinals return home for a six-game homestand into the All-Star Break against the Washington Nationals (July 8-10) and Atlanta Braves (July 11-13) ... The Cardinals finished 4-5 on their recent nine-game, three-city road trip through Cleveland (3-0), Pittsburgh (0-3), and Chicago Cubs (1-2) that featured four nationally-televised games (Apple TV+, Roku, and ESPN).

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** St. Louis entered today in 3rd place in the NL Central, 6.5 games behind first place Chicago and 3.0 games behind Milwaukee ... St. Louis is 1.5 games behind San Francisco for the 3rd Wild Card position.

**NATIONAL NEWS:** Since relocating from Montreal to the Nation’s Capital and re-branding as the Nationals in 2005, the Cardinals .595 win pct. (75-51) against “Natitude” is the 2nd-highest in MLB among annual opponents behind the Dodgers (77-44, .636) ... St. Louis has won four straight over D.C. (July 28, 2024-present), with the last five-game win streak coming Sept. 4, 2018-May 1, 2019.

**GIMME A BREAK:** The Cardinals are scheduled to play 97 games this season before the All-Star break, tied for the most in franchise history behind only the 1969 Cardinals (49-48 record) from April 8-July 19.

**IT’S ALWAYS SONNY IN ST. LOUIS:** The Cardinals are 9-1 in **Sonny Gray**’s 10 starts at Busch Stadium this season ... The nine Cardinals team wins share the MLB lead in starts by a singular pitcher with Detroit (**Tarik Skubal**), Toronto (**Chris Bassitt**), New York Mets (**David Petersen**) and Philadelphia (**Zack Wheeler**) ... Gray’s 14 total victories at Busch since joining St. Louis (2024-2025) are 3rd-most at home in the majors behind Skubal at Comercia Park (18) and Wheeler at Citizens Bank Park (16).

**DONNIE ALL-STAR:** Second baseman **Brendan Donovan** was voted by his peers onto the National League roster as a reserve for the 95th Midsummer Classic at Truist Park in Atlanta ... Representing the Cardinals with his first career All-Star nod, the 28-year-old Donovan:

- joins **Tommy Herr** (1985) and **Matt Carpenter** (2013) as three recent Cardinals second basemen chosen for the All-Star Game;
- is the first Cardinals All-Star drafted in the 7th round or later since RHP **Trevor Rosenthal** (21st Rd.) in 2015 and first position player since 1B/OF **Allen Craig** (8th Rd.) and **Matt Carpenter** (13th Rd.) in 2013.
- is the 3rd German-born MLB All-Star with 1983 Braves 2B **Glenn Hubbard** (Hahn, GER) and former 2011 Cardinals World Series champion and 2009 Tigers RHP **Edwin Jackson** (Neu-Ulm, GER) ... Donovan was born in Würzburg, GER.

**CARDINALS, KMOX & APPLE PIE:** KMOX (104.1 FM and 1120 AM) will remain the flagship home of St. Louis Cardinals baseball, continuing a multi-year extension of its broadcast partnership of providing play-by-play coverage of all regular, postseason and select Spring Training games ... Play-by-play coverage is highlighted by veteran announcers **John Rooney**, **Ricky Horton**, and **Mike Claiborne** ... This year marks KMOX’s 15th consecutive season as the flagship station and 68th year overall.

**FEELING A DRAFT:** The Cardinals hold the 5th selection in the 2025 MLB Draft, which takes place from the Coca-Cola Roxy in The Battery Atlanta (July 13-14) ... Day One features the first 105 selections (Rounds 1-3) and begins at 5:00 p.m. CT on ESPN and MLB Network ... Day Two on Monday includes Rounds 4-20 and begins at 10:30 a.m. CT.

- St. Louis has 21 overall selections over the two-day period, including four picks on Day One: #5 (1st round), #55 (2nd round), #72 (Competitive Balance Round B), and #89 (3rd round).
- Last season, St. Louis drafted INF **JJ Wetherholt** with the 7th overall pick from West Virginia, while this season’s 5th overall is the franchise’s highest since **J.D. Drew** (#5 in 1998) and marks the first time in franchise history having consecutive top 10 selections.

**WETHERHOLT TO MEMPHIS:** The Cardinals announced that SS/2B **JJ Wetherholt** has been promoted to Memphis (AAA) after slashing .300/.425/.466 with 22 extra-base hits, 34 RBI, & 14 stolen bases in his first 62 games with Springfield (AA) this year, leading the Texas League in OBP and OPS (.892) ... Wetherholt is the first Cards minor leaguer to reach Triple-A or higher within a calendar year of being drafted since RHP **Michael Wacha** in 2013 and first position player since 3B **Brett Wallace** in 2009.

#### WASHINGTON CONNECTIONS

**Alec Burleson** made his MLB debut vs. the Nationals (Sept. 8, 2022 at Busch).

**Erick Fedde** pitched parts of six seasons with Washington (2017-22)...was a member of the 2019 World Series Championship squad, but did not make the postseason roster (traveled with the team on Taxi Squad)...selected by the Nationals in the 1st round (#18) in the 2014 MLB Draft.

**Garrett Hampson** was originally selected by Washington in the 26th round of the 2013 MLB Draft, but did not sign to attend Cal State Long Beach.

FanDuel Sports Midwest reporter **Alexa Datt** was born in Durwood, Md...graduated from the University of Maryland...previously worked at NBC Sports Mid-Atlantic.

**Josh Bell**’s sister, **Joy**, is a communications professor at Webster University in St. Louis.

**Paul DeJong** was selected by St. Louis in the 4th round of the 2015 MLB Draft...played parts of his first seven seasons with the Cardinals (2017-23)... finished 2nd in the 2017 NL Rookie of the Year voting and was a 2019 NL All-Star.

**Jackson Rutledge** was born in Fenton, Mo... graduated from Rockwood Summit High School in Fenton.

Nationals broadcaster **Bob Carpenter** worked 10 seasons with the Cardinals in radio and TV before joining Washington...graduated from McBride (Mo.) High School...his sister, **Judy Carpenter-Barada**, previously was Cards Dir. of MLB Admin.

Nationals interim manager **Miguel Cairo** played parts of four seasons in St. Louis (2001-03, ’07).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Vince Coleman** made his MLB debut vs. Montreal (Apr. 18, 1985 at Busch II).

Nationals Hitting Coach **Darnell Coles** played in 63 games for the Cardinals in 1995.

Cardinals broadcaster **Ricky Horton** played college baseball at the Univ. of Virginia (1978-80).

Nationals Social Media Marketing Dir. **Matt Turer** previously worked for the Springfield Cardinals (AA).

Nationals broadcaster **Charlie Slowes** worked three years at KMOX in St. Louis (1984-86).

Nationals Communications Manager **Daniel Kurish** was born in St. Louis.

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- The Cardinals Opening Day starter is set to make his 18th start of the season (325th career appearance/316th start).
- Cardinals are 9-1 in his 10 home starts (only loss vs. NYM 5/2). Tied with the Tigers (Skubal), Blue Jays (Bassitt), Mets (Peterson) and Phillies (Wheeler) for team home wins in starts by a singular pitcher this season.**
- Has not allowed a home run over his last 5 home starts (30.1 IP), last was Pete Alonso on May 2.
- Leads the Cardinals staff in percentage of Swings That Miss (26.7%)
- Since joining the Cardinals in 2024, ranks 10th in Major League Baseball with 310 strikeouts.
- Has 20 career double-digit strikeout games, including three since May 19. Since his career began in 2013, ranks 28th among his peers in 10+ K games.
- Is 5-1 with a 2.76 ERA (4 HR) in 10 home starts and 3-2 with a 4.57 ERA (6 HR) in seven road starts.
- Issued one-or-fewer walks in 13-of-17 starts this season; Cardinals are 10-3 in those games.
- Has six scoreless starts of 6.0 innings or more, 2nd-most in MLB behind Detroit's LHP Tarik Skubal (8)**
- The Cardinals are 13-4 in his 17 starts this season, with two of his defeats coming in starts against the Mets.
- Sonny's 14 wins at home the past two seasons (2024-2025) are 3rd-most in the majors behind **Tarik Skubal** (18) and **Zack Wheeler** (16). He is 5-1 and St. Louis is 9-1 in his Home starts this season.
- Is one of 11 pitchers in Busch Stadium III history with 200+ strikeouts (208 K). **Trevor Rosenthal** ranks 10th with 244 strikeouts.
- 10 of his 90 hits allowed in 2025 have been homers and **17 of his 41 runs (41%) allowed this season have come via HR's.**
- His 10 HR's allowed have surpassed his season total (8) for all of the 2023 season.
- Over past two seasons since joining St. Louis (2024-25), ranks 5th in strikeouts/ 9 IP (10.48) and T-3rd in wins (21) among NL pitchers.
- St. Louis is 30-15 (.667) in his 45 starts with the club since joining in 2024; His record stands at 21-12 while wearing the Birds on the Bat.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Took a 5-0 loss at PIT (7/2) allowing four runs on five hits over 6.1 innings. Entered the 7th inning allowing one run on 64 pitches. Two inherited runners scored.

2025:

- Authored a one-hit complete-game shutout masterpiece at CLE (6/27) striking out a season-high 11 Guardians on only 89 pitches in the 5-0 Cardinals win. His only blemish was a two-out Nolan Jones single in the bottom of the 5th inning.
- Marked Gray's 5th career shutout and first since July 28, 2015 at Los Angeles Dodgers. It was the 11th time a Cardinal threw a one-hitter, one batter over the minimum since 1901, and first since **Jordan Montgomery** at Wrigley Field on Aug, 22, 2022.*
- Since pitch counts were accurately kept in 1988, Gray joined **David Cone's** perfect game (July 18, 1999) as the only two pitchers to throw shutouts of one hit or fewer with 10+ strikeouts in 89 pitches or fewer.*
- Gray joined Houston's **Framber Valdez** as the only two pitchers this season with complete games of 89 pitches or fewer. The last Cardinal was **Adam Wainwright** at Pittsburgh with an 88-pitch complete game effort on Aug. 11, 2021*
- Run off a 14.1 scoreless inning streak, 2nd-longest by a Cardinals pitcher this season (May 31-June 12).
- Went four consecutive starts (May 26-June 6) without allowing a HR, his 2nd-longest streak as a Cardinal (5 from May 26-June 17, 2024).
- Was overpowering in his 5/31 start at TEX, fanning 10, including career strikeout #1,800 of Jake Burger for his 10th & final K that day; Matched his season high with 7.0 scoreless IP for the 3rd time, as the Cardinals won, 2-0.

CAREER NOTES:

- Ranks in the Top 10 among active pitchers in wins (119, 7th), games started (315, 9th), innings pitched (1,837.1, 10th), strikeouts (1,831, T-9th) and ERA (3.51, 7th).

GRAY vs. WASHINGTON

- Making his 10th career start vs. the Nationals and 3rd as a member of the Cardinals.
- Is 2-1 with a 5.14 ERA covering 49.0 innings with 42 strikeouts.
- Last win came as a member of the Reds on May 27, 2021 at Nationals Park. Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings of two-hit ball en route to a 3-0 win.
- Allowed five runs in both of his starts vs. WSH as a member of the Cardinals (9.00 ERA) in two no decisions.
- Pitched 5.0 innings or more in 8-of-9 starts vs. the Nationals (4.0 IP w/CIN on 9/24/21).
