**THE TWINS:** Have gone 2-2 through four games on their six-game, seven-day homestand, going 2-1 vs. Boston earlier in the week, followed by a loss to Cincinnati last night...Minnesota will continue the series and homestand today with the second of three against the Reds then play the finale tomorrow afternoon...Twins will enjoy an off-day on Monday before beginning a six-game roadtrip with stops at Citi Field (Tuesday-Thursday) to play the Mets and Tropicana Field (next weekend) to play the Rays.  
 ☞ Twins have won four of their last six, eight of their last 11 and 10 of their last 15.

**TWINS ONE HIT FROM THE MONEY:** The Twins lost to the Reds last night at Target Field by a score of 2-1, suffering their second one-run loss this season, the other being Opening Day at Baltimore (1-2)...Joe Ryan (2-2) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing two runs (1 earned) on three hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and six strikeouts...Ryan's only runs allowed came on a Eugenio Suárez two-run single in the fourth inning...the offense recorded just five hits, two from Josh Bell...all five of the Twins' hits were singles...last night marked the first time this season that the Twins lost a game in which they out-hit their opponent (7-1).  
 ☞ The attendance was 31,220, the second-highest for the Twins this season (36,042 for home opener).

**BATTLE OF THE WISHBONE Cs:** Minnesota and Cincinnati are playing each other for the 41st, 42nd and 43rd times in their history this weekend...the Twins are 19-22 all-time against the Reds, going 8-12 in Cincinnati (7-7 at Great American Ball Park and 1-5 at Cinergy Field) and 11-10 in Minnesota (4-8 at Target Field and 7-2 at the Metrodome).  
 ☞ Derek Shelton has a career managerial record of 37-42 against the Reds, his most wins vs. any opponent.  
 ☞ Josh Bell has hit safely in 10 of his last 11 vs. Cincinnati, hitting .326 (14-for-43) with four doubles, six home runs, 11 RBI, an .837 slugging percentage and a 1.207 OPS in that span.  
 ☞ Victor Caratini is hitting .353 (12-for-34) with a .994 OPS in his last 11 games vs. the Reds.  
 ☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .321 (9-for-28) with five home runs, six RBI, an .893 slugging percentage and a 1.299 OPS in eight career games vs. the Reds.  
 ☞ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .324 (12-for-37) with three home runs, nine RBI, six walks, a .419 on-base percentage, a .622 slugging percentage and a 1.040 OPS in 12 career games vs. Cincy.

**KEEP AUSTIN WEIRD:** Austin Martin has reached base safely in 12 of his 13 starts this season...the only start in which he did not reach came on April 2 at Kansas City (0-for-3)...he currently leads the club with 13 walks...he has posted a .500 on-base percentage, which leads all of baseball among players with a minimum of 50 plate appearances...only player in baseball to reach in half their plate appearances (13 hits, 13 walks, 56 plate appearances).  
 ☞ Dating back to September 4, 2025, he is hitting .311 (37-for-119) with eight doubles, nine RBI, 21 runs scored, 23 walks and a .432 on-base percentage...in that span against lefties, he is hitting .333 (19-for-57) with a .443 on-base percentage and an .899 OPS.

**FULL PLATES:** Twins have scored 104 runs on the season over 20 games, for an average of 5.2 runs-per-game...that figure ranks seventh in baseball and third in the AL, trailing Los Angeles (5.4) and Houston (5.3).

**THE LEFTORIUM:** Minnesota is facing a left-handed starter for the 13th time in 21 games...they have gone 5-7 against left-handed starters this season...their five wins were April 2 at Kansas City vs. Kris Bubic (5-1), April 7 vs. Detroit against Tarik Skubal (4-2), April 8 vs. Detroit against Framer Valdez (8-6), April 11 at Toronto vs. Eric Lauer (7-4) and April 13 vs. Boston against Garrett Crochet (13-6).  
 ☞ The 12 lefty starters are the most any team has faced this season.  
 ☞ Since July 5, 2025, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .375 (30-for-80) with a .480 on-base percentage and a .992 OPS vs. left-handed pitching...since that date, his batting average ranks fourth in all of baseball (min. 80 PA)...his OPS ranks 10th.  
 ☞ Austin Martin is hitting .333 (10-for-30) with 10 walks, a .500 on-base percentage and a 1.000 OPS vs. left-handed pitching this season...in his career vs. lefties, he is slashing .296/.393/.414 (.808 OPS).

**MAJORITY RULES:** Twins need victories today and tomorrow to earn their fourth series win and fourth in a row...they have gone 3-3-0 in series play (series results in the right margin)...they have gone 2-1-0 at home and 1-2-0 on the road.  
 ☞ Twins have lost each of their last two series' vs. the Reds, dropping two of three at Great American Ball Park in 2025 and two of three at Target Field in 2024...their last series win over Cincy was September 18-20, 2023, taking two of three.

**THIS AND THAT:**  
 ☞ In nine home games, Byron Buxton is hitting .308 (12-for-39) with two doubles, three home runs, 12 runs scored and a .990 OPS.  
 ☞ Twins rank second in baseball in average with runners in scoring position at .306 (49-for-160).  
 ☞ Twins hitters rank fourth in the AL in walk percentage on the season at 11.5%.  
 ☞ Twins lead baseball in ABS challenges at 63, nine in front of second-place Colorado (54)...they have gone 15 of 32 on the hitting side and 21 of 31 on the fielding side.  
 ☞ Twins have seen 4.01 pitches-per-plate appearance this season, fifth-most in the AL and sixth-most in baseball.  
 ☞ Twins have driven in 34 runs with the bases loaded this season, the most in baseball, the next closest being Los Angeles-AL with 28.  
 ☞ Minnesota ranks fourth in baseball in home runs (26), trailing Los Angeles-NL (35), Los Angeles-AL (34) and Atlanta (28).

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS (AND NICK CAGE) HISTORY:** In 2018, the Twins played the second of a two-game series vs. Cleveland at Hiram Bithorn Stadium in San Juan, Puerto Rico...Bayamón, Puerto Rico native José Berrios made the start for the Twins, pitching 7.0 shutout innings with three hits allowed, no walks and five strikeouts...the game went 16 innings, and lasted 5 hours and 13 minutes...the Guayama, Puerto Rico native Eddie Rosario started the bottom of the 16th with a single then came around to score on a Ryan LaMarre walk-off single.  
 ☞ Prior to that game, former Twins infielder Eduardo Escobar introduced himself to actor Nicolas Cage who was having lunch on the patio at the team hotel; Cage was on the island filming an upcoming movie called *Primal*...Escobar told Cage that he was a fan and watched several of his movies to help him learn English...Cage then put his hands together, bowed and exclaimed, "Thank You, Escobar"...some of Escy's favorites were *The Rock* and *Face/Off*.

- Bradley will make his fifth start of the season and second start at home this afternoon vs. the Reds.
- Today will be Taj's second career start against the Reds, his first came on April 18, 2023 at Cincinnati during his rookie season...in that start, Bradley earned his second career win, going 5.1 scoreless innings, while allowing just three hits, with one walk and nine strikeouts.
- In his last outing on April 12 at Toronto, Bradley earned his third win of the season and third straight, dating back to April 2 at Kansas City...Taj pitched 5.0 innings of one-run ball, allowing five hits, with four walks and seven strikeouts.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Last Sunday (April 12) in Toronto, Taj picked up his third win of the season, going 5.0 innings and allowing one run on five hits, with four walks and seven strikeouts in an 8-2 Twins win...the win moved his win-streak to three which is his longest since a four game win-streak from 9/21/24-4/11/25.

- In what feels like a season of career-highs, Bradley set another one in Toronto, by throwing 106 pitches in his start...bested his previous high of 104 pitches which he had done three times, most recently in his April 7 start against Detroit.
- Taj's four walks were a season-high and the most he has had in a start since June 13 of last season at New York-NL.
- With the win, Bradley moved to 3-2 all-time against the Blue Jays with a 4.34 ERA (29.0 IP, 14 ER), nine walks and 30 strikeouts...in his last five appearances (three starts) against Toronto, is now 3-0 with a 2.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 4 ER), seven walks, 19 strikeouts and a 1.33 WHIP.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Bradley went toe-to-toe with Tarik Skubal on April 7, getting the best of the two-time reigning Cy-Young winner and the Tigers in a 4-2 Twins victory; Bradley earned the win with a final line of 6.1 innings pitched with six hits allowed, no walks and 10 strikeouts...Bradley's 10 strikeouts were his most in a start as a Twin and most in a game since June 1, 2025 at Houston when he played for Tampa Bay.

**WHERE HE STACKS UP:** Heading into his fifth start today, here is a look at where Taj ranks in a few statistical categories amongst qualified AL and MLB pitchers.

**WORKHORSE:** Through his first four starts, Taj leads all of Major League Baseball in pitches thrown per game with 100.5...he has earned the right to throw 100 plus pitches in each of his last three outings, the longest stretch of games throwing 100 or more pitches in his career (previous high: 2 consecutive games, done twice, most recently April 23 and April 29, 2025).

**HOT START:** Bradley is currently off to the best start of his career, here is how his numbers through four starts this year compare to his numbers through four starts in the first three years of his career.

**CAREER VS. CINCINNATI:** Bradley has faced Cincinnati one time in his career, on April 18, 2023...it was Taj's second career big league start and first career road start...in that start, he picked up the win in a dazzling 5.1 scoreless inning performance in which he gave up just three hits while walking one and striking out nine.

- AGAINST THE NL CENTRAL:** Taj owns a career record of 2-2 with a 2.20 ERA (28.2 IP, 7 ER) in five starts against NL Central foes...his 2.20 ERA against the division is his lowest against any division in baseball (2nd: AL Central, 3.63 career ERA).

**INTERLEAGUE NUMBERS:** Taj will be making his 21st career start against a National League opponent this afternoon...in his first 20 starts he holds a 5-7 record with a 5.17 ERA (102.2 IP, 59 ER), 36 walks, 112 strikeouts, a 1.31 WHIP and a .251 (99-for-395) BAA.

- HOME/ROAD SPLITS AGAINST NL:** Has made an even 10 starts at home and on the road against the NL, at home is 4-3 with a 5.02 ERA (52.0 IP, 29 ER), 17 walks, 61 strikeouts, a 1.17 WHIP and a .229 (44-for-192) BAA compared to a 1-4 record with a 5.33 ERA (50.2 IP, 30 ER), 19 walks, 51 strikeouts, a 1.46 WHIP and a .271 (55-for-203) BAA.

**CAREER HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** Over the course of his career, Bradley is 12-15 with a 4.99 ERA (200.1 IP, 111 ER), 64 walks, 228 strikeouts and a 1.26 WHIP in 38 career home starts compared to 10-12 with a 4.35 ERA (206.2 IP, 100 ER), 86 walks, 211 strikeouts and a 1.33 WHIP in 41 road appearances (39 starts).

- SO FAR IN 2026:** This year, he owns a 1-0 record with a 1.42 ERA (6.1 IP, 1 ER), zero walks and 10 strikeouts in one home start compared to a 2-0 record with a 1.17 ERA (15.1 IP, 2 ER), eight walks and 19 strikeouts in three road starts.

- CAREER AT TARGET FIELD:** In seven career games (all starts) at Target Field, Bradley is 1-1 with a 5.40 ERA (36.2 IP, 22 ER), 13 walks, 42 strikeouts, six homers allowed and an .831 OPS against.

**LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** This season, left-handed hitters have slashed .227/.277/.295 (10-for-44) with three doubles, three walks and 18 strikeouts against Bradley, while righties are hitting .231/.348/.256 (9-for-39) with one double, five walks and 11 strikeouts.

**THE ARSENAL:** So far this season, Bradley has used a four-pitch mix, throwing his four seamer and curveball very evenly between righties and lefties, while deploying his split finger predominantly to lefties and cutter mostly to righties...here are his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant.

- LET'S KEEP TALKING ABOUT THE SPLIT:** Bradley's split finger has been dynamite to start the season and is quickly becoming one of the best pitches in all of baseball, here are some of his ranks on the pitch in comparison with other splits in baseball (all min. 10 plate appearances): Run Value - 3 (3rd), SLG - .100 (3rd), wOBA - .090 (3rd), xwOBA - .151 (3rd), BAA - .100 (5th), Whiff % - 45.0 (7th) and K% - 40.0 (10th).

- THE HEATER PLAYS TOO:** Taj has thrown his four-seamer 191 times this season and has a run value of three on the pitch, which is tied with Cody Laweryson for the team lead and is tied for 14th league wide (min. 10 plate appearances).

**CAREER NOTES**

- Made six starts for Twins to end his season, from August 24-September 24, going 0-2, 6.61 ERA (31.1 IP, 23 ER) with 12 walks and 32 strikeouts.
- Acquired by the Minnesota Twins from Tampa Bay on July 31 in exchange for RHP Griffin Jax.
- In 2025, made the Rays Opening rotation for the first time as the team's third starter... posted a 4.61 ERA (111.1 IP, 57 ER) with 44 walks and 95 strikeouts over 21 starts.
- In 2024, went 8-11 with a 4.11 ERA (138.0 IP, 63 ER) and 154 Ks over 25 starts with the Rays...set career highs in nearly every major category while leading the club in strikeouts, wins and quality starts (7-1st, 10).
