PITTSBURGH PIRATES (37-60) vs. SAN FRANCISCO GIANTS (61-36)

July 24, 2021 at Oracle Park, San Francisco, CA -- GAME #96/ROAD #50

RHP WIL CROWE (1-5, 6.12 ERA) vs. RHP KEVIN GAUSMAN (9-3, 1.84 ERA)

THE PIRATES... snapped their four-game losing streak with last night's 6-3 win in San Francisco...Have lost four of their last five games after winning three straight and four-of-five...Have gone 8-7 in their last 15 games after losing six in a row...Have scored a season-high 11 runs twice; 7/5 vs. Atlanta and 6/18 vs. Cleveland...Have won a season-high three straight games on four occasions.

CENTER OF ATTENTION: All-Star outfielder **Bryan Reynolds** connected off Johnny Cueto last night for his team-leading 18th home run - 17 of which have come while playing center field...Reynolds leads all National league center fielders with 17 home runs and has hit the second-most in the Majors behind Texas' Adolis Garcia (18)...Since becoming the everyday center fielder on April 22, Reynolds' 87 hits from that position are tops in the N.L. and second in MLB behind Mullins (92).

GOING THAT EXTRA MILE: The Pirates have collected at least one extra-base hit in a season-high 19 consecutive games...**Bryan Reynolds** enters today's action with 40 extra-base hits, fourth-best among National League outfielders behind Nick Castellanos (47), Ronald Acuna, Jr. (44) and Mookie Betts (41) and eighth-best overall among all N.L. players.

PLAYING THE FIELD: Dating back to the action on May 9, the Pirates have made the fewest amount of errors in Major League Baseball...In that time, the Bucco defense has committed 24 errors in 65 games and 2257 total chances (.989 fielding pct).

THE OTHER BEDNAR: Bucco righthander **David Bednar** leads all National League rookie relief pitchers in appearances (43) and trails only Kansas City's Jake Brentz (46) among all big league rookies...Bednar has made nine straight scoreless outings (9.0ip) and has been scored upon just once in his last 15 appearances (14.0ip/1er).

ON THE MEND: Bucco lefthander **Steven Brault**, currently rehabbing a left lat strain at Triple-A Indianapolis, pitched 4.0 perfect innings in his start last night vs. Toledo while striking out six...In two rehab starts with Indy and one with Bradenton, Brault has given up three hits and one run in 8.2 innings of work while punching out 11 batters.

BUCS BY THE BAY: Dating back to the 2011 season, the Pirates have gone 6-2-1 in their last nine series played at Oracle Park in San Francisco...The Bucs have gone 13-5 here since 2015 and 18-8 in their last 26 games, dating back to April 15, 2012...Over the last 10 seasons, Pittsburgh's 18-10 (.643) record at Oracle Park is the best among all visiting teams.

PIRATES AT THE PLATE: The Bucs are hitting .300 (88-for-293) in their last eight games and their .293 batting average since the 4th of July is the second-highest in all of MLB behind Washington (.294)...The Pirates also rank third among all Major League teams with a .276 batting average during the month of July, trailing only the Nationals (.281) and Angels (.278).

STEADY AT SHORT: **Kevin Newman** leads all Major League shortstops with a .996 fielding percentage, having made just one error in 283 total chances...He began this season with 76 consecutive errorless games, a National League record to start a season and a club record for a shortstop at any point in a season.

STRATTON HIS STUFF: Originally selected by San Francisco in the first round of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft (20th pick overall), **Chris Stratton** led all National League relief pitchers in innings pitched (30.0) last season...He picked up the win Friday night and enters today's action ranked third among all Major League relievers with 51.1ip...Dating back to May 1, Stratton has gone 2-0 with a 1.42 ERA (38.0ip/6er) and 35 strikeouts in his 29 appearances.

THE HIT MAN: All-Star second baseman **Adam Frazier** leads all Major League players with 123 hits and his .326 batting average ranks second in the National League behind Nick Castellanos (.329)...Frazier has gone 20-for-56 (.357) in his last 14 games is hitting .344 (88-for-256) in his last 66 games, dating back to May 8.

THE PITTSBURGH STEALER: **Gregory Polanco** has been successful in all 11 of his stolen base attempts this season...He leads the National League with the most attempts without being caught...The Pirates single season "record" for most stolen base attempts without being caught is held by **Miguel Dilone** (12 in 1977).

ROAD WARRIORS: Bucco All-Stars **Bryan Reynolds** (.333) and **Adam Frazier** (.323) rank first and second respectively in road batting average among N.L. hitters (min: 170 AB)...Frazier is hitting .352 (19-for-54) in his last 15 games played on the road and Reynolds has hit safely in 25 of his last 27 road games, going 39-for-109 (.358) with six homers and 21 RBI.

THE MEN BEHIND THE MASK: **Jacob Stallings** and **Michael Perez** have combined to produce 52 RBI this season; that's tied with the White Sox for the second-most RBI among all catchers in MLB, trailing only Tampa Bay (57)...Stallings has 40 RBI from the catcher's position this season; second behind Yadier Molina among N.L. backstops and fourth-most among all big league catchers behind Kansas City's Salvador Perez (42), Oakland's Sean Murphy (42) and Molina (41).

THE BIG NOGOWSKI: **John Nogowski** connected off Taylor Widener for his first big league home run Tuesday night...Nogo has hit safely in 10 of his 14 games with the Pirates (21-for-54, .389)...His 21 hits since making his Pirates debut on 7/5 are tied with Freddie Freeman for the second-most in the Majors behind LAA's David Fletcher (28)...Nogowski's .389 batting average in July is the third-best in the big leagues behind Fletcher (.425) and Freeman (.422).

July 24, 1901: In a baseball rarity, the Pirates scored in every inning while defeating the Reds 11-2. Ginger Beaumont led the way offensively, going 4-for-5 with a triple, two RBI and two stolen bases. Claude Ritchey had two triples and Honus Wagner went 2-for-4 with three RBI and a stolen base, his 32nd of the season. Pitcher Jesse Tannehill threw a complete game and went 2-for-4 at the plate.

JT BRUBAKER: The 27-year-old righthander will be making his 18th start of the season tomorrow...His last start was a no-decision in Sunday's 7-6 last at bat loss to the Mets at PNC Park (3.2ip/6h/4r/4er/3bb/5so). ...Has lost five straight decisions and six of his last seven after his victory on 5/11 vs. Cincinnati...Has given up 15 runs (six home runs) in his last three starts (14.2ip)...Is 1-5 in nine starts on the road this season; has lost his last five decisions after winning his lone road start this year on 4/16 at Milwaukee...Went 1-3 with a 4.94 ERA (47.1ip/26er) in 11 games (nine starts) with the Pirates in 2020 and ranked second among National League rookies in strikeouts (48)...Made his Major League debut on 7/26 at St. Louis and pitched 2.0 scoreless innings of relief.

VS. SAN FRANCISCO: Brubaker has never faced the Giants.
