#STLFLY: The St. Louis Cardinals and San Diego Padres continue with the second game of a three-game weekend series at Busch Stadium tonight ... After tomorrow's finale, the Cardinals embark on their final road trip of the season, a seven-day, eight-game road swing through division-rivals Milwaukee and Chicago ... St. Louis began today in 2nd place in the NL Central, 12.5 games behind Milwaukee, but holding a 1.0 game edge over Cincinnati for the 2nd NL Wild Card.

WILD CARDS: Winners of six in a row and eight of their last nine (Sept. 8-present), the Cardinals are now a season-high eight games above .500 for the 4th time this season and first time since May 29 (30-22 record) ... St. Louis has gone 8-3 in their current 13-game stretch against NL Wild Card contending clubs: Dodgers (2-2), Reds (2-1), Mets (3-0) and Padres (1-0).

YOU'RE STILL HERE?: Adam Wainwright took the mound July 16, 2016 when the Cardinals celebrated their 2006 World Series 10-year anniversary and spun a complete game, three-hit gem in a 5-0 win over Miami ... **SPECIAL K:** Wainwright is three strikeouts shy of 2,000 in his career and becoming the 85th all-time to do so, the 9th active pitcher, and the 2nd Cardinal joining **Bob Gibson** (3,117) ... **DAD???:** According to *Elias*, Wainwright, **Max Scherzer**, and **Johnny Cueto** are the only three pitchers in MLB history to strike out both **Fernando Tatis** and **Fernando Tatis Jr.** ... Six other active Major League pitchers have fanned a father/son combination: **Cole Hamels** struck out **Eric Young** and **Eric Young Jr.**, while **Josh Tomlin**, **David Price**, **Zack Greinke**, **Aroldis Chapman**, and **Darren O'Day** fanned both **Vladimir Guerrero** and **Vladimir Guerrero Jr.**

DYLAN DINGERS: According to *Elias*, **Dylan Carlson** last night became the:

- 1st Cardinals rookie in franchise history (54th rookie in MLB history) with multiple grand slams in a season (also April 7 at Miami)
- 1st Cardinal to homer from both sides of the plate in the same game since **Carlos Beltrán** (June 15, 2013 at Miami), the 18th MLB rookie in the Expansion Era to do so and first since Texas's **Jonah Heim** (July 31)
- 5th rookie switch-hitter in MLB history with two grand slams in a season and first since Atlanta's **Brooks Conrod** (2010)
- 4th Cardinals switch-hitter with multiple grand slams in a season, joining **Ted Simmons** (1972 & 1975) and **Terry Pendleton** (1985)
- 4th MLB rookie this season and 1st Cardinals rookie in franchise history to hit two homers in a game, one of which was a grand slam, joining Minnesota's **Ryan Jeffers** (July 28), White Sox's **Seby Zavala** (3 HR, July 31), and Houston's **Jacob Meyers** (August 14)

TOMMY TWO BAGS: San Diego native **Tommy Edman** and Detroit's **Jeimer Candelario** share the MLB lead in doubles (40), while Edman became the first MLB player with 40+ doubles, 10+ homers, and 25+ stolen bases since 1918 (Betts, Lindor, Merrifield & Story) and only the 3rd Cardinal with **Edgar Renteria** (47-13-34 in 2003) and **Ray Lankford** (40-20-42 in 1992) ... Edman is also the 9th switch-hitting Cardinal with 40+ doubles and first since **Félix José** (40 in 1991).

DOWN THE STRETCH THEY COME: The Cardinals have begun their final 20-game stretch to close out the regular season, starting 4-0 vs. New York (3-0) and San Diego (1-0) ... St. Louis' best 20-game finishes to a season include a 17-3 mark (1942), 16-4 finishes (2002, 1930) and 15-5 surges (2013, 2011, 2001).

AND NOW DEEP THOUGHTS: St. Louis has gone yard in nine straight since Sept. 8, matching a season-high (Aug. 25-Sept. 3) ... **Nolan Arenado** (32), **Paul Goldschmidt** (26), and **Tyler O'Neill** (27) are seeking to become just the second Cardinals trio to each hit 30+ homers in the same season since the 2004 MV3 of **Albert Pujols** (46), **Jim Edmonds** (42), and **Scott Rolen** (32).

RBI GUY: With his team-high 99 RBI, **Nolan Arenado** is seeking to become the first Cardinal with 100 RBI since **Matt Holliday** (102 in 2012) and first Cardinals third baseman since **Scott Rolen** (124 in 2004) ... Arenado's next RBI gives him six seasons of 30+ HR and 100+ RBI (2015-19, '21), most of any Major Leaguer (**JD Martinez**-4, **Anthony Rizzo**-3, **Jose Abreu**-3, **Khris Davis**-3, and **Nelson Cruz**-3).

SAN DIEGO CONNECTIONS

Tommy Edman was born in and resides in San Diego...graduated from La Jolla Country Day School, where he was a National Merit Scholar.

Paul Goldschmidt's cousin, **Dan Dallas**, was selected by the Padres in the 7th round of the 2016 MLB Draft...played four minor league seasons in the Padres minor league organization (2016-19).

Tommy Pham played parts of five seasons in St. Louis (2014-18)...selected by the Cardinals in the 16th round of the 2006 MLB draft...traded by St. Louis to Tampa Bay with international bonus money for **Genesis Cabrera**, **Roel Ramirez**, and **Justin Williams** (July 31, 2018).

In 2014, the Padres won the rights to negotiate with **Kwang Hyun Kim** when he was posted by the KBO's SK Wyverns during the previous posting system that awarded rights to the highest blind bidder...sides were unable to reach an agreement and Kim returned to the KBO.

Mike Maddux pitched parts of two years with San Diego (1991-92)...signed by the Padres (March 31, 1991)...later traded to the Mets for **Mike Freitas** and **Roger Mason** (Dec. 17, 1992).

Matt Carpenter (2006-09) and **Jake Arrieta** (2006-07) were college teammates at Texas Christian University...Arrieta was born in nearby Farmington, Mo...Arrieta was a groomsman in Carpenter's 2011 wedding.

Fernando Tatis, father of Padres infielder, **Fernando Tatis Jr.**, played three seasons with St. Louis (1998-2000)...is famously remembered for hitting two grand slams in one inning (April 23, 1999 at Los Angeles), both off of **Chan Ho Park**.

Padres Bullpen Catcher/Coaching Asst. **Peter Summerville's** brother, **Andrew**, was selected by St. Louis in the 12th round of the 2017 MLB draft...pitched two minor league seasons in the Cardinals organizations.

TONIGHT’S GAME

- Making team-high 30th start of 2021 & 423rd career appearance (356th career start).
- The 2021 Cy Young/MVP candidate makes his 4th start/appearance since turning 40, as the team celebrates the 10th anniversary of its 2011 World Series Championship.
- Adam took to the mound July 16, 2016 when the Cardinals celebrated their 2006 World Series Champs 10-year anniversary & spun a CG 3-hit gem in a 5-0 win over Miami.
- Has won a season-best 5-straight games and is just three strikeouts shy of 2,000 career.
- Adam is the 3rd-oldest active player (40.019) in the National League (4th in MLB), while Yadier Molina (39.067) is the 4th-oldest. Rich Hill (41.191) and former Cardinal Albert Pujols (41.245) are older.
- Enters tonight’s game with a 2.88 ERA (T7th in NL) and is seeking to become the oldest pitcher to finish a season with an qualifying ERA under 3.00 since Bartolo Colon (40 yrs.) did so in 2013 with Oakland (2.65 ERA). *Elias*
- Adam’s 20 quality starts (3rd in NL) are the most by a Cardinals pitcher at age 40+ since Grover “Pete” Alexander, who was 40 years old in 1927, compiled 22 starts of 6+ innings and no more than 3 ER. *Elias*
- Grover Alexander is the only other Cardinals pitcher age 40+ to win 16 games (16-9 in 1928 at age 41; 21-10 in 1927 at age 40) and he’s also the only one to haved posted a qualifying season ERA (2.52 in 1927) lower then Adam’s current 2.88 mark.
- Waino is looking to be the team’s first 17-game winner since Miles Mikolas (18-4) in 2018. His current 2.88 ERA is the team’s best since Jack Flaherty’s 2.75 mark in 2019.
- He and Yadier Molina will make their 303rd career start as batterymates tonight, 4th all-time (since records were kept in 1908) in Major League history. The pair are four games behind the Chicago White Sox duo Red Faber and Ray Schalk (306) for third place. Wainwright’s next most frequent battery mate is Tony Cruz (17).
- Won National League Pitcher for the Month for August, his 3rd career (June 2013 and Sept. 2014). Went 4-1 with a 1.43 ERA and 36 strikeouts in six starts, leading the NL in wins, innings pitched (44.0) and WHIP (0.80).
- Is three strikeouts shy of 2,000 in his career. Would make him the 85th all-time to do so, the 9th active pitcher, and the 2nd Cardinal joining Bob Gibson (3,117).
- St. Louis has won 15 of his last 18 starts & is 10-2 in his 12 starts since the All-Star break. His 9 wins and 84.2 IP since the All-Star break lead all of MLB.
- Has thrown 7.0 or more innings in 16 starts this season, tying Zack Wheeler (PHI) for most in MLB. Threw 7.0 or more innings in five straight starts from July 21-Aug. 11.
- Is 90-45 in career games following a Cardinals loss, including 8-2 in 12 starts this year.

LAST TIME OUT

- Matched up against fellow 40+ year-old Rich Hill in a 7-0 win vs. the Mets on Mon. (9/13) at Citi Field as he posted a season-high 5th straight win. It was his 6th start of the season allowing no runs and his 12th straight start going 6.0+ IP.
