BIRD WATCHING: The St. Louis Cardinals and division-rival Milwaukee Brewers play the finale of a season-ending three-game series today at American Family Field ... St. Louis is 1-4 on its season-ending six-game road trip through Pittsburgh (1-2) and Milwaukee (0-2) ... St. Louis finishes the season in 4th place in the National League Central.

THAT’S A WRAP: The Cardinals are 72-61-1 all-time on the final day of the regular season (27-29-0 on the road) since 1892 ... Today marks the 5th regular season that the Cardinals have ended against the Brewers (2-2), but first time in Milwaukee:

PLAYERS USED: Fifty different players have appeared for the Cardinals this season, 6th-fewest in Major League Baseball (Giants lead with 71 players) ... 11 Cardinals have been active for every game:

- Sixteen rookies suited up during the season, including 13 MLB debuts that matched the 1997, 2020, and 2022 squads for most by St. Louis in the Expansion Era (1961-present) ... Only the Blue Jays (14), White Sox (15), Twins (15), and Giants (17) have had more Major League debuts this season.

GAMES THAT MATTER: Since 2011 Opening Day, St. Louis will have played 2,455 out of a possible 2,488 regular season games (98.7%) during which they still maintained playoff aspirations and had not yet been eliminated.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: **Jordan Walker** makes his first career start at leadoff today, and at 6-foot-6, trails only 6-foot-7 **José Martínez** as the 2nd-tallest Cardinals leadoff batter in franchise history ... Cafecito's lone start at leadoff was Aug. 21, 2018 at LA Dodgers (1-for-4 with a single).

STEAK RIBEYE: **Alec Burleson** enters the final day of the regular season with a career-high and MLB-leading 116 RBI, three ahead of Baltimore's **Pete Alonso** (113).

- The last Cardinal to lead MLB in RBI was 1971 NL MVP 3B **Joe Torre** in (137) ... Only one Cards left-handed batter has led the Majors in runs batted in - that being **Enos Slaughter** (130 in 1946) - *Elias*
- Burly's 116 RBI are most by a Cards left-handed batter since OF **Stan Musial** (126 in 1954), while his 113 RBI while playing 1B are the most by a Cards LH batting 1B since **Johnny Mize** (130 in 1940) ... Burleson's 63 RBI on the road are the most by a Cardinals left-handed batter since OF **Stan Musial** (64 in 1954).

¡FELIZ CUMPLEAÑOS! Happy 25th birthday to Cardinals reliever **Luis Gastelum** ... others celebrating today include former pitcher **Vicente Padilla** (49), former Cardinals second baseman **Bo Hart** (50), Hall of Fame third baseman **Mike Schmidt** (77).

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (Sept. 27, 1998): On the final day of the regular season, 1B **Mark McGwire** hits his 69th and 70th home runs of the season against **Mike Thurman** and **Carl Pavano** of the Montreal Expos in a 6-3 Cardinals victory at Busch Stadium II.

MILWAUKEE CONNECTIONS

Riley O'Brien's grandfather **Johnny O'Brien** was drafted by the NBA's Milwaukee Hawks in 1953, but instead chose to play baseball.

Bryan Torres originally signed with Milwaukee as a non-drafted free agent in 2015 and played parts of five minor league seasons in the Brewers minor league system (2015-19)...played two seasons for the Milwaukee Milkmen of the American Association (2022-23), where he was back-to-back Independent League Batting Champion (.374 and .370).

Dustin May (21 starts in 2026) and **JoJo Romero** (216 app. from 2022-26) pitched for St. Louis before Milwaukee acquired both in a trade Aug. 3 for **Alexander Frias** and **Josiah Ragsdale**.

Luis Gastelum (July 8 at Busch Stadium) and **Brycen Mautz** (May 25 at Am. Fam. Field) made their MLB debuts vs. Milwaukee this season.

Jacob Misiorowski played college baseball at Crowder College in Neosho, Mo...made MLB debut vs. St. Louis (June 12, 2025 at Am. Fam.).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played in 73 games for Milwaukee in 2010.

Brewers broadcaster **Jeff Levering** previously worked three seasons (2010-12) as broadcaster for the Springfield Cardinals (AA).

Luis Lara made his MLB debut on July 7, 2026 at St. Louis in the 2nd game of a doubleheader.

Brewers Baseball Ops Special Asst. and Domestic/International Scouting **Rickie Weeks** made his MLB debut on Sept. 15, 2003 at St. Louis.

William Contreras's older brother, **Willson Contreras**, played in 344 games for St. Louis from 2023-25.

Steve Dillard, father of Brewers broadcaster **Tim Dillard**, was hitting coach for the Single-A Quad Cities Swing/River Bandits from 2006-07 and hitting coach for the High-A Palm Beach Cardinals in 2007...later piloted Quad Cities in 2008-09, where he managed infielder **Oliver Marmol**.

Brewers Lead Hitting Coach **Eric Theisen** played college baseball at Illinois State Univ. (2005-08).

Cardinals broadcaster **Mark Sweeney** played two seasons in Milwaukee (2000-01), and **Ricky Horton** made five starts for the Denver Zephyrs (AAA-Brewers) in 1990.

TODAY'S START:

- Making his 29th start of the season and his 90th career start (198th career appearance) ... Has recorded three consecutive 20+ start seasons (2024-26) with a career-high 31 starts in 2025.
- Today is the first time in Pallante's career pitching on the final day of the regular season.
- Need 5.2 innings today to match his single-season career high 162.2 IP from last season and 5 strikeouts to tie his career-high 111 SO from last year.
- Has pitched 5.0+ innings in all 13 road starts, the longest such streak by a Cardinals pitcher since **Sonny Gray** (14 from 2024-25).
- Making his 198th career appearance today, tying **Chris Carpenter** (2004-12) for 58th all-time among Cardinals ... Andre has joined **Adam Wainwright** (478 starts), **Carlos Martinez** (274), **Lance Lynn** (206), **Miles Mikolas** (204) and **Chris Carpenter** (198) since 2000 to reach both 195+ career games pitched for St. Louis while also making 90+ starts.
- Missed 15 games from Aug. 18-Sept. 3 due to right elbow inflammation.
- Owens a 9.08 Run Support Average on the road, MLB's 2nd-highest behind WSH's **Cade Cavalli** (10.23) ... Andre's 3.15 RSA at home is 8th-lowest in MLB ... Received 3 runs or fewer in 13 of his 15 Home starts, yet 5 runs or more in 8 of his 13 Road starts.
- Hurled 48.0 consecutive innings without allowing a homer from July 19-Sept. 9, longest by a Cardinal since **Jack Flaherty** (56.1 IP from May 9-July 16, 2023). - *Elias*
- Pallante's 12 wins in his first 22 starts were the most since 2015: **Carlos Martinez** (12-3) and **Michael Wacha** (13-4).
- Andre is the first Cardinal since **Joaquin Andujar** (1983-84) to bounce back from a 15+ loss season and win 10 or more games the very next season; Andujar lost 16 games in 1983 but then produced a 20-win season in 1984 and a 21-win season in 1985.
- Is 7-1 in 13 road starts (St. Louis is 8-5) ... Became the 1st Cardinal with 7+ wins and no losses in any 12-start span on the road during a single season since **Miles Mikolas** (May 16/-Sept. 29, 2018) ... His 7 road wins are T-7th in the NL.
- Leads all current Cardinals pitchers in career starts (89), wins (36), and innings pitched (617.0).
- Began the season with 10 consecutive starts of 5.0+ IP (March 31-May 23), first Cardinal to do so since RHP **Sonny Gray** ran off 10 straight such starts to begin 2024.

LAST TIME OUT (Tuesday, Sept. 22 vs. Pittsburgh at PNC Park): L, 2-0; 6.0 IP, 3 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 2 SO, 0 HR - 89 pitches.

- Made his team-leading 27th start of the season that lasted 5.0 innings or longer (T-7th in NL).
- Suffered his first loss on the road this season as the Cardinals were blanked by the Pirates.

2026 NOTES:

MY BEST FRIEND: Has induced career-high 19 groundball double plays this season (3rd in NL), most since 2024 by **Kyle Gibson** (21).

STAYING GROUNDED: Induced a career-high 16 ground balls in his Sept. 9 start vs. SF, the most by any Cardinal since **Dakota Hudson** had 17 on Sept. 22, 2023 at SD and most by a Cardinal at home since Pallante's career-high 17 on June 29, 2022 vs. Miami. Tied for the 2nd most in a game by any pitcher this season (1st: **Jose Soriano**, 18 on 9/8 at ATH w/TOR).

SLIDE ON IN: Is holding opposing batters to a .213 BA (36-169) with his slider, and 47 of his 106 strikeouts this season have come via the slider. Boasts a 12 Run Value on his slider, 6th-best slider in MLB according to *Baseball Savant* this season.

COUNT ON ME: Has worked at least 5.0 IP in 27 of his 28 starts this season, allowing 2 runs or fewer in 18 of those games.

RIGHT ON: His .243 Opp. BA vs. RHB (62-255) would be the lowest of his career by a -.024 margin, behind his .267 mark (65-243) in 2024.

IF AT FIRST: Has had issues with 1st inning, allowing a .773 OPS, 20 runs and 5 HR in 1st inning ... Batters are hitting .310 (22-71) when contacting the 1st pitch of an at-bat.

CAREER:

- Has made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for five consecutive seasons (2022-26) after arriving at 2022 Spring Training as a non-roster invitee, most among active Cardinals and his first official invite to Major League Spring Training.
- Since his 2022 MLB debut, boasts the highest ground ball pct. (61.9%) in Major League Baseball among pitchers with 500.0+ IP.*** As a starting pitcher (485.1 IP), Pallante's 59.0 career groundball pct. currently is the 9th-highest in MLB since the stat has been tracked since 1987 (min. 485.0 IP as starter).

PALLANTE vs. MILWAUKEE

- Is making his 6th career start and his 18th career appearance against the Brewers.
- Owns a career mark of 0-4, 6.07 ERA against Milwaukee.
 - Sports a 5.73 ERA (22.0 IP) at Busch Stadium in nine games (2 starts).
 - Is 0-2, 6.43 ERA (21.0 IP) at American Family Field in 8 games (3 starts).
- Fanned **Christian Yelich** (April 15, 2022 at Milwaukee) for his first career strikeout.
- His four losses vs. Milwaukee tie his most against any opponent. Has lost both starts vs. the Brewers this season.
- The Cardinals posted wins in 4 of his first 5 career appearances against Milwaukee, but they are just 2-10 in his last 12 games pitched.

LAST START vs. BREWERS (July 9, 2026 at Busch Stadium): L, 8-4; 5.0 IP, 8 H, 6 R, 6 ER, 2 BB, 2 SO, 1 HR, 97 pitches.

- Was hit for six runs over the first three innings en route to an 8-4 Cardinals loss. Tied his season-high in earned runs.
- Surrendered a three-run home run to **Jake Bauers** in the 3rd inning.
