Brewers relievers have a 1.62 ERA over the last 11 games (39ip, 7er)....the bullpen has tossed 14.1 consecutive scoreless innings.

A Slice of Devin

Devin Williams has posted a sterling 1.63 ERA this season (27.2ip, 5er)..... he surrendered 4 runs without retiring a batter in his lone blown save on 6/13 at Minnesota....without that outing, his ERA drops to 0.33 (27.2ip, 1er).

It's Milner Time!

Hoby Milner is unscored upon in each of his last 16 appearances (13.1ip) to lower his ERA from 4.50 to 2.59.

Rebel Yeli

Since June 6, **Christian Yelich** has hit .355 (27-for-76) with 2 HR and 11 RBI in 20 games while he has produced a .443 OBP/.579 SLG/1.022 OPS

MANAGER: Craig Counsell - the longest-tenured active manager in the National League and third in the majors - is in his ninth season as Brewers manager (657-593) and eighth full season.....he has the most wins (657) and games managed (1,250) of any manager in franchise history.....Counsell was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing Ron Roenicke.....he is signed through the 2023 season.

COACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (3rd season), hitting coach Connor Dawson (2nd season), bullpen coach **Jim Henderson** (2nd season), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (5th season), third base coach Jason Lane (8th season, 3rd as 3B coach), associate pitching, catching and strategy coach Walker McKinven (4th season), bench coach Pat Murphy (8th season) and hitting coach Ozzie Timmons (2nd season) all returned from the 2022 staff.....Néstor Corredor, who was bullpen catcher (2021-22), is now a coach.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 16 replay challenges this season, going 7-9.....their last challenge (lost) came on 6/25 at Cleveland as an out call at first base on a pickoff attempt of Blake Perkins stood.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: #37 - RHP ADRIAN HOUSER (9g, 7gs, 2-2, 4.02)

HOUSER AT A GLANCE: Adrian Houser, 30, will be making his 10th appearance and eighth start of the season.....he last pitched last Friday at Cleveland in his second straight relief appearance (1ip, 2h, 0r, 0bb, 1k, 19 pitches).....the team is 4-3 in his starts.....he has 2 quality starts.....opponents are batting .297 (49-for-165, 3hr).....Houser began the season on the 15-day injured list with a right groin strain.....he was sent to Triple-A Nashville on rehab assignment on April 14, where he made 4 starts.....he was acquired from Houston, along with LHP Josh Hader, OF Brett Phillips and OF Domingo Santana, in exchange for OF Carlos Gómez, RHP Mike Fiers and International Signing Bonus Slot #76 on 7/30/15.

LAST SEASON: Houser went 6-10 with a 4.73 ERA in 22 games/21 starts last season.....the team went 9-12 in his starts.....he made 6 quality starts.....opponents batted .258..... he posted a 2.98 ERA over his first 8 starts of the season (42.1ip, 14er) and a 6.17 ERA over his last 13 starts (58.1ip, 40er).....he was on the 15-day injured list from 7/1-8/23 with a right flexor strain and from 9/28 through the remainder of the season with a right groin strain.

CAREER: Is 25-31 with a 3.98 ERA in 115 games/83 starts [468.1ip, 207er].....is in his seventh Major League season, all with the Brewers [2015, 2018-23].....has gone 20-31 with a 4.31 ERA as a starter [407ip, 195er] and 5-0 with a 1.76 ERA in relief [61.1ip, 12er].....underwent "Tommy John" surgery on his right elbow on 7/21/16.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 9-15 with a 3.56 ERA in 58 games/40 starts (230ip, 91er)....is 1-1 with a 4.67 ERA in 4 games/3 starts this season (17.1ip, 9er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 16-16 with a 4.38 ERA in 57 games/43 starts (238.1ip, 116er)....is 1-1 with a 3.52 ERA in 5 games/4 starts this season (23ip, 9er).
