

BALTIMORE ORIOLES (51-61) vs PHILADELPHIA PHILLIES (63-48)

LHP Cade Povich (2-5, 5.15 ERA) vs LHP Jesús Luzardo (9-5, 4.31 ERA)

- GAME #111 RECAP:** On ESPN's Sunday Night Baseball, the Phillies shut out the Tigers, 2-0, as they took another series in front of 41,569 at CBP ... Starter Cristopher Sánchez (W, 10-3) tossed 8.0 scoreless innings and permitted only 5 hits with 6 strikeouts against 1 walk ... On a night that featured incredible plays on defense by both clubs, the Phillies scratched across a run in the 2<sup>nd</sup> on a Max Kepler RBI groundout before Kyle Schwarber launched a homer onto Ashburn Alley in the 8<sup>th</sup> to make it 2-0 ... Jhoan Duran was summoned for the 9<sup>th</sup> and retired the side in order for his 2<sup>nd</sup> save in as many chances for the Phils.
- A COMBINED MADDUX:** Last night, **Cristopher Sánchez** (8.0 IP, 0 R, 84 pitches) and **Jhoan Duran** (1.0 IP, 0 R, 12 pitches) combined for a 9.0-inning shutout on 96 pitches ... It marked the 15<sup>th</sup> "Maddux" for the Phillies since pitch tracking began in 1988 and first since **Ranger Suárez** had one on 9/25/21 vs PIT (9.0 IP, 0 R, 97 pitches) ... It marked the first combined "Maddux" for the Phillies since at least 1988 and the first in MLB since ATL on 9/27/24 vs KC (Max Fried, 8.2 IP/98 pitches and Raisel Iglesias, 0.1 IP, 1 pitch) ... *A Maddux is considered a 9.0-inning shutout on less than 100 pitches.*
- START THE MVP TALK:** Last night, **Kyle Schwarber** hit his 38<sup>th</sup> home run of the season and he is now tied for the National League lead in homers with **Shohei Ohtani** ... Schwarber is tied for the MLB lead in RBI with 88 (also Cal Raleigh) and he leads Ohtani, who has 73 RBI, by 15 ... Schwarber has a 15.0% walk rate which is higher than Ohtani's 14.0%, he has a .405 wOBA to Ohtani's .407, a 161 wRC+ to Ohtani's 165, and a 1.010 OPS with RISP compared to Ohtani's .946 ... Over his last 162 games (since exactly one year ago on 8/4/24), Schwarber has 114 runs, 28 doubles, a triple, 54 home runs, 129 RBI, 100 walks and a .932 OPS in 725 plate appearances ... Over the last calendar year, Schwarber's ranks in the NL: 1<sup>st</sup> in walks & RBI, 2<sup>nd</sup> in HR, OPS & extra-base hits and 4<sup>th</sup> in runs.
- WHAT'S LEFT TO SAY?:** In 89 plate appearances against left-handed **relievers** this year, **Kyle Schwarber** is slashing .324/.438/.797 with 10 home runs ... Last night, with his 10<sup>th</sup> home run off a left-handed reliever, Schwarber joined **Barry Bonds** and **Ken Griffey Jr.** as the only 3 left-handed hitters with 10+ home runs against left-handed relievers in a single season in the Divisional Era (since 1969) – Bonds had 11 in 2002 and Griffey had 10 in both 1994 and 1996 ... Overall this year, against all LHP (SP and RP), Schwarber is slashing .272/.392/.639 with a 1.032 OPS and 15 home runs.
- BOBBY D'S BASEBALL CAMP:** The Phillies infield has 13 Outs Above Average combined this year which among all 30 infields in baseball, ranks 6<sup>th</sup> ... Since 2023, the Phillies infield has been credited with 33 Outs Above Average which ranks 8<sup>th</sup> in baseball ... Over the previous 3 years (2020-22), Philadelphia's infield ranked 27<sup>th</sup> in MLB with -37 Outs Above Average (+70 OAA swing from 2020-22 to 2023-25) ... This season, **Trea Turner** has 12 OAA which ranks T-9<sup>th</sup> among all players in baseball (98<sup>th</sup> percentile) and would equal his career best, set in 2018 with WSH.
- FACE THE NATION:** Last night, the Phillies improved to 4-0 on ESPN's Sunday Night Baseball this season as they have wins at CHI on 4/27, at CLE on 5/11, vs NYM on 6/22 and vs DET on 8/3 – Philadelphia's 4-0 record on SNB is the best in baseball this year (next: SD, 3-0) ... In 37.0 innings pitched, the Phillies staff (both SP and RP) have allowed only 2 ER (0.49 ERA) ... In those 4 games, the starting rotation (Nola, Wheeler, Luzardo, Sánchez) has covered 28.2 innings and allowed only 1 ER (0.31 ERA) ... With Sánchez's 8.0 scoreless last night, the Phillies starting staff will carry a 26.2-inning scoreless streak into their final SNB game this season when they are scheduled to play ATL on 8/31 at CBP ... Kyle Schwarber's home run last night was his 4<sup>th</sup> in 4 games on SNB this season.
- ARMS RACE:** Using FanGraphs WAR, the Phillies have 4 of the top 9 pitchers in the National League in their rotation: **RHP Zack Wheeler** ranks 2<sup>nd</sup> at 3.9, **LHP Cristopher Sánchez** ranks 3<sup>rd</sup> at 3.8, **LHP Jesús Luzardo** ranks T-6<sup>th</sup> at 3.2 and **LHP Ranger Suárez** ranks T-9<sup>th</sup> at 2.8 ... The Phillies rotation leads MLB in fWAR at 14.0 – TEX ranks 2<sup>nd</sup> at 11.3 and CIN is the closest NL team at 11.0.
- THE ELECTRIC FACTORY:** Since last season, the Phillies are 89-46 with an MLB-best .659 winning percentage in their home ballpark (next: LAD, 87-49/.640 at Dodger Stadium) ... Over this stretch, the Phils have played 44 series at CBP and have lost only 8 of them (30-8-6 series record in South Philly since 2024) ... The Phillies are averaging 41,813 in attendance per game at CBP this year which is 4<sup>th</sup> in MLB, behind LAD (50,192), NYY (42,719) and SD (42,529) ... Of the 55 games at CBP this year, 29 have been sellouts (including 5 of the last 6) and 46 have been over 40,000, including each of the last 28.
- GRAND OPENING, GRAND CLOSING:** Last night, **Jhoan Duran** threw a 99.7 MPH splinker – considered a splitter by Statcast, Duran owns 350 of the fastest splitters in baseball going back to 2008 with his fastest clocking in at 101.9 in 2023 (over 25,000 splitters thrown in MLB since 2008) ... He topped out last night at 103.3 MPH with his fastball which is the fastest pitch ever recorded by a Phillies pitcher since at least 2008 and probably ever ... On Wednesday, the Phillies acquired Duran from the Minnesota Twins ... He has appeared in 51 games for the Twins and Phillies this season and has posted a 1.93 ERA (11 ER, 51.1 IP) with 54 strikeouts against 18 walks while holding the 212 batters he has faced to a .212/.288/.249 slash line (.536 OPS) ... He has a 65.2 percent ground ball rate that is 2<sup>nd</sup>-best among the 199 pitchers in MLB that have at least 50.0 innings pitched this season ... Duran has surrendered only one home run this year and his rate of 0.18 home runs per 9.0 innings pitched ranks 2<sup>nd</sup> in baseball among that same group of 199 pitchers ... Under club control through 2027, Duran has successfully converted 76 of his 85 career save opportunities ... Among pitchers in MLB history with at least 75 saves, his 89.4 save % ranks third behind **Eric Gagné** (91.7%) and **John Smoltz** (91.1%).
- AMERICA'S TEAM:** Tonight, the Phillies will set an MLB record as they play their 16<sup>th</sup> consecutive Interleague game (previous MLB record was 15 straight, done hundreds of times by other clubs) ... Coming out of the break, the Phillies will face an AL team in each of their first 7 series – 21 straight games – and will not play another NL club until Aug. 11 when they face the Reds in Cincinnati.
- TAKE A BOW, THOMS:** Since his first game as manager on June 3, 2022, **Rob Thomson** (313 wins, .573 win %) have the Phillies T-3<sup>rd</sup> in wins and winning percentage among all clubs in MLB (with HOU), trailing only LAD (340 wins, .622 win %) and ATL (316 wins, .581 win %) ... His .573 career winning percentage ranks 1<sup>st</sup> in Phillies history, 24<sup>th</sup> all time among MLB managers (min. 315 G) and 3<sup>rd</sup> among active managers, behind only Dave Roberts (.623) & Aaron Boone (.580).

**LAST START:** 7/29 at CWS: W, 7.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, BB, 4 SO, 90 pitches (62 strikes) ... The Phillies defeated the White Sox, 6-3, in Chicago ... Luzardo worked out of a bases loaded jam in the first inning and then proceeded only give up one hit the rest of the day ... Luzardo collected 7 groundouts, 12 flyouts and 6 whiffs

**TONIGHT'S START:**

- Start Your Engines: Luzardo's last start marked his 4<sup>th</sup> scoreless outing of the season and his 3<sup>rd</sup> of 7.0 IP ranks T-4<sup>th</sup> in MLB ... He has 10 outings of 6.0+ IP this season while allowing 1 or no ER, which is tied for the 5<sup>th</sup> most of such starts in the majors ... Among others, Luzardo is tied with Zack Wheeler and Cristopher Sánchez with 10 starts of 6.0+ IP and 1 or fewer ER this season ... It is the 1<sup>st</sup> time the Phillies have had 3 pitchers with 10 such starts in a single season since 2011, when Cliff Lee (16), Roy Halladay (14) and Cole Hamels (12) all did so ... It is the 2<sup>nd</sup> most of such starts he's had in any season of his career, behind only 2023 when he had 12**
- Strike 'Em Out: Luzardo's 140 SO are the 7<sup>th</sup> most in the National League** ... Luzardo recorded his 100<sup>th</sup> strikeout of the season in his start on 6/22 and it is the 3<sup>rd</sup> season of his career with 100+ SO ... Luzardo notched his 4<sup>th</sup> game with 10+ SO this season in his start on 6/11 vs CHI ... **He is the first Phillie to record 4 double-digit SO games in their first 14 starts with the club since Steve Carlton in 1972** ... Last season, 3 pitchers accomplished this in the majors, Blake Snell with SF, Tyler Glasnow with LAD and Garrett Crochet with CWS ... It was the 11<sup>th</sup> double-digit strikeout game of his career ... All 10 of his strikeouts came out on swings and misses, which is tied for the most of such strikeouts in a single game (previously done 4 other times) ... **In his start on 6/11, he became the 1<sup>st</sup> Phillies LHP with 10+ SO and no walks in a game since Drew Smyly on 9/25/19** ... He struck out 10 batters in back-to-back starts from 5/20-25 for the 2<sup>nd</sup> time in his career and the first time in the same season (other:10/2/21-4/12/22) ... **He is 1 of only 9 ML pitchers this year to have consecutive games with 10+ SO, along with Chase Burns, Cole Ragans, Tarik Skubal (twice), Chris Sale (twice), Garrett Crochet, Spencer Schwellenbach, Framber Valdez and Zack Wheeler**
- Control the Controllables:** Luzardo's 2.98 FIP ranks 6<sup>th</sup> in the NL, behind Paul Skenes (2.40), Logan Webb (2.64), **Cristopher Sanchez (2.82), Zack Wheeler (2.86)**, and Yoshinobu Yamamoto (2.90)
- WARlord:** Luzardo has 3.2 fWAR, which ranks T-6<sup>th</sup> among NL pitchers... It is currently the 2<sup>nd</sup> most fWAR of any season in his career, behind 3.8 in 2023 (32 starts)
- Dawn of a New ERA:** Per Elias, he became the 4<sup>th</sup> Phillie (since 1912) to allow 3 or fewer ER in each of their first 11 starts with the franchise, alongside Tommy Greene (15 games), Art Mahaffey (15) and Jose DeJesus (11) ...Per OptaStats, Luzardo joined Randy Johnson as the only other major league LHP since 1913 to go undefeated with a sub-2.00 ERA and a SO/9.0 IP of 10.00 or higher in their first 10 starts of a season ... Luzardo is the 1<sup>st</sup> Phillies pitcher to have an ERA of 2.00 or lower in his first 10 starts with the Phillies since Aaron Horang in 2015 (1.93) and he is the 2<sup>nd</sup> Phillies LHP to ever do so, alongside Woodie Fryman (1.96) ... Luzardo had a 1.73 ERA after his first 6 starts this season ... Since 1973, Ranger Suarez (1.32 in 2024) is the only other Phillies LHP to post a sub-1.75 ERA in their first 6 starts as a Phillie in a season ... Overall, the feat has only been done 9 total times since 1912 and only 7 pitchers total have done so (Steve Carlton, Curt Simmons 4 times, Al Gerheuser, Jack Kraus and Ad Brennan)
- That Winning Feeling:** Luzardo started his season with a career-best 5-game winning streak ... He became the first Phillies LHP to begin their Phillies career with a 5-game win streak since Cliff Lee won his 5 decisions with the club from 7/31-8/24/09
- A Sweeping Success:** Luzardo debuted a Sweeper this season, having never thrown one before ... He's using it 26.7% of the time and has limited opponents to a .179 AVG (.152 xAVG) on the pitch ... His .179 OPP AVG against the pitch is the 9<sup>th</sup> best among ML sweepers (min. .75 PA) ... Luzardo has a 45.1% whiff rate on the pitch which is 7<sup>th</sup> in MLB among all individual pitches thrown at least 400 times this year
- In the Yard: Luzardo had a 39.2 inning homerless streak, which was the longest of his career (previous: 27.2 IP, 9/20/21-4/30/22)** ... Luzardo only surrendered 1 HR in his first 7 starts as a Phillie and none in his starts from 4/4-5/2 ... The last Phillie to allow 1 or no HR in their first 7 starts with the team was Rob Tejeda in 2005 and the last Phillies LHP to do it was Larry McWilliams in 1989
- Bursting at the 4-Seams: Luzardo is averaging 96.4 mph on his 4-seamer, which is the 3<sup>rd</sup>-fastest 4-seamer among ML lefties behind Mason Montgomery (98.7 mph) and Tarik Skubal (97.6 mph) (min. 300 pitches)**
- New Places:** Luzardo was acquired by the Phillies from MIA with C Paul McIntosh for Emaarion Boyd and Starlyn Caba on 12/22/24
- Pitch Usage:** 4-Seamer (35.1%), Sweeper (26.7%), Changeup (18.7%), Slider (10.1%), Sinkers (9.5%)
- vs AL East:** 0-9, 8.32 ERA (53 ER, 57.1 IP) in 13 games (12 starts)

- Is the first player in MLB history born in Peru
- Was selected by WSH in the 3<sup>rd</sup> of the 2016 MLB Draft ... Traded to OAK with RHP Blake Treinen and INF Sheldon Neuse for RHP Ryan Madson and LHP Sean Doolittle on 7/16/17 ... Was traded to MIA for Starling for OF Starling Marte on 7/28/21
