RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals conclude their seven-game homestand tonight with the finale of a four-game series with the divisional-rival Chicago Cubs ... The Cardinals opened their homestand by taking two of three from Giants, as tonight represents the final game of 12 straight against San Francisco (4-2) and Chicago (3-2) over four consecutive series sandwiched around the All-Star Break ... St. Louis has won or split five of their last six series since June 28 (11-7 record) ... The Cardinals are at .500 for the 15th time this season, and begin today in 3rd place in the NL Central, 7.5 games behind Milwaukee.

GOLDY'S 16-GAME HIT STREAK: Paul Goldschmidt's season-best 16-game hitting streak (.379, 25-66) since June 30 is the longest active in Major League Baseball and the longest by a Cardinal since Yadier Molina's 16-gamer from April 9-29, 2019 ... Goldy's current 16-game hit streak is the 3rd-longest of his career, behind a 17-gamer (2012) and 26-gamer (2013-14) ... The last Cardinal to log a hitting streak longer than 16 games was David Freese (20, May 17-June 11, 2013) and the last Cardinals first baseman to record a 17-game hitting streak was Albert Pujols (June 18-July 5, 2005).

WE'RE GOING STREAKING: Kwang Hyun Kim is carrying a career-best 21.0 scoreless innings streak into tonight's game, which is the 2nd longest active streak in NL, trailing only the Cubs Andrew Chafin (24.1) ... KK's 21.0 IP scoreless streak is the longest by a Cardinals lefty starter since John Tudor had a 23.0 scoreless innings streak Aug. 5, 1988-April 18, 1990 and the 3rd longest by a Korean-born pitcher, trailing Chan Ho Park (33.0 IP) and Hyun Jin Ryu (32.0 IP).

Tonight is the 49th time a Cardinal has made a start on his birthday and first since Adam Wainwright (Aug. 30, 2020 vs. Cleveland) ... 23 times in history a Cardinal has recorded a win on his birthday (last: Wainwright) ... Kim joins Wild Bill Hallahan (August 4, 1935 vs. Pirates) as the only two Cardinals to start on their 33rd birthdays (since 1901) ... Tonight is the 4th time in MLB history for a South Korean-born pitcher to start on their birthday: Chan Ho Park (2001 LAD & 2006 SD) and Jae Weong Seo (2007 TB) ... KK is the 5th Cardinal to start vs. the Cubs on his birthday and first since 36-year-old Jake Westbrook (1.0 IP) on the final day of the 2013 regular season (Sept. 29, 2013).

10 YEARS FOR GOLDY: Congrats to Paul Goldschmidt for reaching 10,000 years of Major League service time today ... Since making his MLB debut on Aug. 1, 2011 with the Diamondbacks, the 8th round pick from Texas State University has made six NL All-Star teams while earning three Gold Gloves and four Silver Sluggers.

Yadier Molina: Yadi is one double from reaching 396 in his career and tying Hall of Famer and Cubs great Gabby Hartnett (1922-41) for 5th all-time among primary catchers in MLB history ... Molina is four hits shy of reaching 2,073 and tying Albert Pujols (2001-11) for 4th all-time in Cardinals history ... Molina's game-winning single last night was the 233rd hit of his career vs. Chicago, passing Joey Votto among active opponents ... Molina's 11 game-winning RBI this season rank T-2nd in the NL and match his single-season career high (2017) ... Yadi now has eight career walk-off hits and nine walk-off RBI (2016 HBP), not including his walk-off RBI sacrifice fly in the 2019 NLDS vs. Atlanta.

PITCHERS PROGRESSING: Daniel Ponce de Leon (right shoulder discomfort) is scheduled to begin an injury rehab assignment with Memphis (AAA) tonight, throwing 1.0 innings at Louisville (AAA-Reds) ... Miles Mikolas (right forearm tightness) is scheduled to throw approximately 60 pitches in a rehab start for Memphis on Saturday at Louisville.

MLB DRAFT SIGNINGS: The Cardinals announced that they have agreed to terms with the following 2021 MLB Draft selections: OF Ryan Holgate (CB-B, Arizona); RHP Austin Love (3rd, UNC); LHP Hayes Heinecke (13th, Wofford); RHP Andre Granillo (14th, UC-Riverside); and the following non-drafted free agents: RHP Ryan Loutos (WashU-STL); 3B/OF Noah Mendlinger (Georgia College); RHP Bryan Pope (California Baptist); C Wade Stauss (Southeast Missouri State) ... 16 of 21 total draft picks have signed before the August 1 deadline.

Harrison Bader: Harrison Bader has multiple hits in three straight and in five of his last seven games, while hitting safely in 12 of his last 14 games and reaching base safely in nine of his last 14 plate appearances.

CLOSE CALLS: St. Louis is 23-17 (.575) in games decided by two-runs or fewer this season, 2nd-best in the National League behind Cincinnati (25-18, .581) ... Four of the last five Cardinals games and eight overall in July have been decided by two runs (5-3).

BIRD SEED: The St. Louis rotation is 3-1 with a 1.77 ERA (8 ER/40.2 IP), 34 strikeouts, and six walks in the last seven starts ... The Cardinals are 12-5 in their last 17 home games (+13 run differential) ... Paul Goldschmidt ranks among active MLB leaders vs. the Cubs in career OPS (.994, 3rd), slugging (.592, 3rd), batting average (.313, 4th) and OBP (.412, 4th).

CHICAGO CONNECTIONS

Matt Carpenter (June 11, 2011 at Busch), Tyler O'Neill (April 19, 2018 at Wrigley), Andrew Knizner (June 2, 2019 at Busch), Tommy Edman (June 8, 2019 at Wrigley), and Johan Oviedo (Aug. 19, 2020-2 at Wrigley) made MLB debuts against the Cubs.

Paul DeJong graduated from Antioch (Ill.) Comm. High School...played college baseball at Illinois State University (2013-15) while majoring in biochemistry and pre-medicine.

Tommy Edman (junior) and Nico Hoerner (freshman) were teammates at Stanford Univ. in 2016.

Mike Maddux's younger brother, Greg Maddux, was a Hall of Fame pitcher for Chicago for parts of 10 seasons (1986-92, '04-06).

Jason Heyward played 2015 with St. Louis...traded by Atlanta with Jordan Walden to St. Louis for Tyrell Jenkins and Shelby Miller (Nov. 17, 2014).

As back-to-back compensation picks for the departures of John Lackey and Jason Heyward signing with Chicago in 2016, Dylan Carlson (No. 33) and Dakota Hudson (No. 34) were selected by St. Louis in Compensation Round A of the first round of the 2016 MLB draft.

Patrick Wisdom played in 32 games for St. Louis during 2018 MLB debut season...originally selected by the Cardinals in the Supp. 1st round (No. 52) of the 2012 MLB Draft, as compensation for Octavio Dotel signing with Detroit...traded by St. Louis to Texas for Drew Robinson (Dec. 11, 2018).

Rafael Ortega was claimed off waivers by St. Louis in 2014 and played two seasons (2014-15) in the Cardinals minor league organization.

Cubs Coach Mike Borzello played four seasons (1991-94) in the Cardinals minor league system...originally selected by St. Louis in 1991.

Cardinals VP/General Manager Michael Girsch is a Chicago native...graduated from the University of Notre Dame and the University of Chicago.

Cubs VP of Scouting Dan Kantrovitz previously served as the Cardinals Scouting Director (2012-14)...was also a Cardinals 25th round draft pick out of Brown University in 2001...took his first job in MLB as the Cardinals Scouting Coord. (2004).

TONIGHT'S GAME

- Celebrating his 33rd birthday today as he makes his 17th start of the season and 24th career Major League start (25th app.).
- Is carrying a career-best 21.0 scoreless innings streak into tonight's game after blanking the SF Giants for 7.0 IP on 7/5, the Cubs for 6.0 IP on 7/10 & the Giants for 6.0 IP last Sat. (7/17). His scoreless streak is the 2nd longest active streak in MLB, trailing only the Cubs Andrew Chafin (24.1).
- His 21.0 IP scoreless streak is the longest by a Cardinals lefty starter since John Tudor had a 23.0 scoreless innings streak 8/5/88-4/18/90. It's the 3rd longest by a Korean-born MLB pitcher, trailing Chan Ho Park (33.0 IP) and Hyun Jin Ryu (32.0 IP).
- Leads MLB in ERA (0.00) for July and has a 0.45 ERA (20.0 IP/1 ER) the past two July's, which also lead the majors (min. 20.0 IP).
- His 2.87 ERA ranks 5th in MLB & 3rd in NL among lefty pitchers with 75.0+ IP.
- Has held the opposition to one or zero runs in 6 of his last 7 starts, posting a 1.64 ERA (38.1 IP/7 ER) in that 7-game span and a 0.79 mark in the six games w/1 or less runs.
- Walked a total of 10 batters in his last six starts after walking a career-high 5 on 6/15.
- Has not allowed XBH to last 94 batters faced since Kevin Newman 2B on 6/25 vs. PIT.
- Holding opponents to a .175 batting average with runners in scoring position, ranking 3rd among National League pitchers; teammates John Gant (.123-1st) & Adam Wainwright (.180-4th) are also in the top-10.
- Set to make his 8th start since returning from 10-day IL (lower back stiffness) that had sidelined him for eight games after departing his 6/4 start vs. CIN following just 3.0 IP.
- The Cardinals won each of his first five starts to begin 2021, but then dropped four straight before winning again on 6/15. They're 15-8 overall (.652 win pct.) in his 23 career appearances from 2020-21.
- Owns a 5-1 mark & 2.21 ERA (57.0 IP/14 ER) in 12 career appearances at Busch Std.

LAST TIME OUT

- With his family in attendance for the 1st time, blanked the Giants for 6.0 IP in a 3-1 win last Sat. (7/17), stretching his scoreless innings string to a team season-high 21.0 innings.

2021 SEASON

- Has made 7 career day starts, going 2-2, 2.62 ERA (34.1 IP/10 ER), allowing just one HR, that coming off the bat of the D-Backs Ketel Marte on 5/30/21 at ARI.
- Provided his 2nd-straight scoreless outing (6.0) in Cardinals 6-0 win at Wrigley Field on 7/10. Also contributed a sac. bunt and infield single in his 2nd-straight road win.
- Blanked the Giants for 7.0 innings in a matchup with All-Star Kevin Gausman on 7/5 at SF and came away with a 5-3 win. It was his 1st road win of 2021.
- Snapped a career-high five-game losing streak in 6/30 start vs. ARI. Was 1-for-1 with a two-RBI double and a sac bunt, becoming the first Cardinals left-handed pitcher with 2 RBI since Austin Gomber in 2018.
- Spent time on IL (lower back) for a 2nd time this season from June 5-15, missing 8 games. He'd also spent time on the IL after missing time in Spring Training and the first 17 games of the season with back ailment.
- Started 2nd game of double-header on 6/20 at ATL and allowed just one run (Acuna HR) and three hits in 4.0 IP, but Cardinals lost 1-0 for his 5th-straight defeat.
