RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals continue their homestand by welcoming the visiting Colorado Rockies to St. Louis for a three-game weekend series at Busch Stadium ... The Cardinals began their homestand with a four-game series split with the New York Mets ... St. Louis is in the midst of playing 14 of 17 at home that sandwiched a three-game sweep of the Pirates at PNC Park.

STL FLY: The Cardinals enter play today in 1st place in the NL Central, 1.0 game ahead of Milwaukee (17-15) and a half back of San Francisco (18-13) for the NL's best record ... St. Louis has a +15 run differential (5th in NL and tops in NL Central).

TAP THE ROCKIES: St. Louis' .735 home win pct. (37-13) vs. the Rockies is its best against any opponent since Busch Stadium III opened in 2006 ... The Cardinals have defeated Colorado in six straight home games, 12 of their last 13 (May 18, 2016-present) and are 29-6 (.829 win pct.) at Busch vs. the Rock Pile over their last 35 meetings (since Sept. 30, 2010) ... From 2013-19 during Nolan Arenado's tenure with the Rockies, St. Louis was 20-4 (.833) at home vs. Colorado.

HOME SWEET HOME VS. WILD, WILD WEST: The Cardinals are playing an NL West opponent for the first time since 2019, where they went 18-15 in 33 games. At Busch, the Cardinals decimated their Western opponents with a 14-4 (.778) record while outscoring them 101-54; including four-game sweeps of LA and Colorado. (The Cardinals were 4-11 on the road against their Western rivals).

2014 DRAFT REUNION: Tonight's starting pitching matchup features a pair of 2014 Cardinals draft selections that was headed by then Scouting Director Dan Kantrovitz ... Prep right-hander Jack Flaherty was selected 34th overall in the first round (compensation awarded to St. Louis for Carlos Beltrán signing with the Yankees) while college southpaw Austin Gomber was selected in the 4th round ... Three other selections, all pitchers, from the 2014 St. Louis draft have made it to the Majors: RHP Luke Weaver (27th overall); RHP Trevor Megill (3rd rd., unsigned), and RHP Daniel Ponce de Leon (9th Rd.).

FORMER CARDS VS. ST. LOUIS: 2015 Minor League co-Pitcher of the Year (w/ Alex Reyes) and former Cardinals left-hander Austin Gomber makes his first start against St. Louis tonight against Cardinals 2017 Minor League Pitcher of the Year Jack Flaherty. Prior to tonight, recent initial career starts by a former Cardinal against St. Louis include Seattle's Mike Leake (ND) in 2019, Miami's Sandy Alcantara (L) in 2019, Minnesota's Lance Lynn (L) in 2018, Chicago Cubs' John Lackey (W), and Atlanta's Shelby Miller (L) in 2015 (chart right).

GOLDI-ROCKS: In seven games vs. Colorado in 2019 after moving to a new division, Paul Goldschmidt slashed .417/.481/.667 (9-23) with a home run, three doubles and 1.148 OPS ... Among all-time leaders against the Rockies, Goldschmidt ranks 1st in extra base hits (70), T1st in doubles (41), and T2nd in RBI (105) and homers (24).

HEY A REY: Alex Reyes has opened the season by converting his first nine saves (2nd in NL) while not allowing a run in 15.1 innings (15 appearances) ... Among Cardinals to start the season with scoreless streaks of 15.0 innings as a reliever (no starts), Reyes's scoreless streak is the 4th-longest behind Ernie White (17.1 in 1942, entire season total as a RP), Edward Mujica (17.0 from 8/1-9/9/2012), and Mike Matthews (15.1 from 4/2-5/10/2001). NO Ks LAST SEVEN DAYS: Nolan Arenado has not struck out in his last 32 plate appearances (Bot 4, 4/29-present), MLB's longest active streak among non-pitchers ... Arenado has started at third for the Cardinals in each of the first 33 games this season, tied with El Toro High School teammate and Oakland third sacker Matt Chapman for most among MLB third basemen in 2021. The last Cardinal to start at third in the first 33 games was Todd Zeile (first 35 of 1993).

WHY SO SERIOUS: Jack Flaherty leads all of Major League baseball in run support (49), run support per 9 IP (12.8) and wins (5) as the Cardinals have won each of his first six starts this season ... The last time St. Louis won the first six games of a starter's season was in 2015 when Michael Wacha began his season 7-0 and the Cardinals won his first nine starts (April 11-May 24).

COLORADO CONNECTIONS

Nolan Arenado played eight seasons with Colorado (2013-20), where he was a five-time NL All-Star and the winner of four Silver Sluggers, eight Gold Gloves, and four Platinum Gloves... originally selected by Colorado in the 2nd round of the 2009 Draft...Acquired by St. Louis with cash in exchange for LHP Austin Gomber, INF Elehuris Montero, RHP Tony Locey, INF Mateo Gil and RHP Jake Sommers.

Paul DeJong made his MLB debut at Colorado (May 28, 2017)...became the 9th Cardinal in history to homer in his first MLB at-bat, a pinch-hit 9th inning solo home run off Greg Holland.

Harrison Bader (July 25, 2017 at Busch Stadium) made his MLB debut against the Rockies...Doubled off Jake McGee (July 25, 2017).

Cardinals Asst. GM & Scouting Director Randy Flores pitched in 82 games in three seasons (2002, '09-10) over two stints with Colorado.

Rockies manager Bud Black previously managed Miles Mikolas (2012-13) while in San Diego, where he made his MLB debut under Black.

Dom Núñez and Cardinals 2016 1st rounder Dylan Carlson were teammates at Elk Grove (Calif.) High School in 2013.

Austin Gomber pitched parts of two seasons with St. Louis (2018, '20)...originally selected by the Cardinals in the 4th round of the 2014 MLB Draft...Shared Cardinals Co-Minor League Pitchers of the Year honors with Alex Reyes in 2015.

Josh Fuentes and Nolan Arenado are first cousins... played college baseball at Missouri Baptist University (2014) in St. Louis.

Matt Adams played parts of last seven seasons in a Cardinals uniform (2012-18), including 26 Postseason games (2013-14)...originally selected by St. Louis in the 23rd round of the 2009 MLB Draft...later traded by St. Louis with cash to Atlanta for infielder Juan Ypez (May 20, 2017).

Daniel Bard made 10 appearances for Springfield (AA) in 2017...was UNC teammates with Andrew Miller...played travel ball for Mike Shildt and attended Shildt's On Deck baseball academy.

Cardinals President of Baseball Operations John Mozeliak began his baseball career with the Rockies...initially served as a left-handed batting practice pitcher in 1993 and worked in a variety of positions in the home clubhouse and in baseball operations...joined St. Louis as an assistant in scouting operations following the 1995 season... graduated from Fairview High School in Boulder, Colo., where he was a first baseman and pitcher... graduated from University of Colorado at Boulder.

St. Louis Post-Dispatch reporter Derrick Goold is originally from Boulder, Colo...attended Centaurus High School in Lafayette, Colo...worked as a staff writer for the Rocky Mountain News (2000-01).

St. Louis Post-Dispatch columnist writer Benjamin Hochman previously worked as a sports writer and columnist for the Denver Post (2007-15).

Bally Sports Midwest reporter Erica Weston is a Highlands Ranch, CO native...attended Colorado State University.

Rockies VP of Communications & Marketing Jill Campbell is a St. Louis native.

TONIGHT'S GAME

- Makes his team-leading 7th start of the 2021 season (82nd career) and his first against Colorado since 2019.
- Had a MLB-leading 5 wins and the Cardinals have won in each of his first six starts.
- The last time St. Louis won the first six games of a starter's season was in 2015 when Michael Wacha began his season 7-0 and the Cardinals won his first nine starts (April 11-May 24).
- St. Louis sports a 42-40 overall record in Flaherty's 82 career starts. In his first 51 starts from his MLB debut (9/1/2017) until the 2019 All-Star Break, St. Louis went 21-30 (.412). In his last 30 starts (July 16, 2019-present), St. Louis is 21-9 (.762).
- Is 1-0, 1.50 ERA (12.0 IP/2 ER) in his two starts at home this season, allowing just six hits and no walks.
- Is 6.0 IP shy of matching his season total of 40.1 IP from the 2020 shortened season.
- Leads all of MLB in run support (49) and run support per 9 IP (12.8) this season.
- In 81 career starts, is 27-7 when receiving 2+ runs of support, 21-1 when receiving 3+ runs, and 19-0 with 4+ runs of support. Has received 2 runs of support or fewer in 50 of 80 (62.5%) career starts. (see chart at right).

LAST TIME OUT

- Posted his Major League-leading 5th win last Sat. (5/1) at PIT with a 12-5 victory, striking out a season-high 9 batters.
- Cardinals improved to 6-0 in his games started, scoring 11+ runs for the 4th time in his six starts to begin 2021.

- Threw a season-high 7.0 innings, allowing just one run on three hits while earning his second win of the season against the Reds.
- Became the first National League pitcher to reach four wins when he allowed just one run over 7.0 innings in a 5-2 win over the Reds at Busch Stadium on 4/25.
- Out-dueled Stephen Strasburg and improved to 2-0 behind a 14-run outburst as he held the Nationals to one run on three hits on 4/13 vs. Washington.
- Made his second consecutive Opening Day start (2020-21) on April 1 at Cincinnati, becoming the 5th Cardinal in history to make multiple Opening Day starts before turning age 26 (after 1901), joining Joe Magrane (3), Dizzy Dean (3), Lee Meadows (2), and Johnny Lush (2).
- Joined Chicago White Sox's Lucas Giolito and Atlanta Braves' Max Fried as Opening Day starters who graduated from Harvard-Westlake School in Los Angeles, Calif.

CAREER

- Sports the 4th-lowest career ERA (2.71) at Busch Stadium III (minimum 200.0 innings pitched).
- Has handled 63 total chances in 67 consecutive games without an error since 6/17/18 vs. CHI when he last made a miscue in the field.
- Has struck out 515 batters over his first 82 career games, the most ever by a Cardinal and 15th-most in MLB history (since 1901).

2020 SEASON

- Had a streak of 22 consecutive regular season starts holding his opposition to three runs or less snapped at MIL (9/15), when he surrendered a career-high nine runs. The 22-game streak was the longest in Cardinals history out-distancing Bob Gibson (19) in 1968 and Lance Lynn (19) in 2014. It came up nine games short of the MLB record by a non-opener held by the Mets' Jacob deGrom (31).
- Held his opposition to three runs or less in eight of his nine starts.
