The Brewers are 18-5 in the first game of a series this season, including 11 consecutive series-opening wins.

The Dynamic Duo

For the first time ever, two Brewers earned Player of the Week honors in the same week as **Jackson Chourio** and **Jacob Misorowski** were named NL Co-Players of the Week for the period of June 8-14....the news was announced yesterday.

That's a Fact, Jack!

Jackson Chourio is on a 7-game hitting streak in which he is batting .457 (16-for-35, 5hr, 10rbi)....he has a .459 OBP/.943 SLG/1.402 OPS during the streak....Chourio is batting .394 (26-for-66, 8hr, 21rbi) over his last 15 games....during this stretch, he has a .438 OBP/.818 SLG/1.257 OPS.

It's Trevor Time!

Trevor Megill, who had a 14.40 ERA, over his first 6 appearances of the season (5ip, 8er), has a 1.80 ERA in his last 20 outings (20ip, 4er) while holding opponents to a .181 batting average (13-for-72, 4bb, 29k).

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is the fourth game (2-1) of a 6-game, 7-day homestand against Philadelphia (2-1) and Cleveland (3g)....after this homestand, the team takes a 6-game trip to Atlanta (3g) and Cincinnati (3g)....the Brewers return to American Family Field for a 7-game homestand against Chicago-NL (3g) and Cincinnati (4g) from 6/26-7/2.

IN THE TRAINER'S ROOM: RHP Coleman Crow (right forearm), LHP Brian Fitzpatrick (left elbow), LHP DL Hall (left pectoral), RHP Logan Henderson (back), LHP Jared Koenig (left elbow), OF Brandon Lockridge (right knee), RHP Quinn Priester (right thoracic outlet), RHP Carlos Rodriguez (right shoulder), RHP Brandon Woodruff (right shoulder), LHP Rob Zastryzny (left trapezius) and LHP Angel Zerpa (left forearm) are on the injured list....Fitzpatrick, Priester and Zerpa are on the 60-day IL.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy (393g, 233-160, .593) is in his third season as Brewers manager....he was voted NL Manager of the Year in 2024 and 2025....he is one of four managers ever to win Manager of the Year in consecutive seasons, joining the Braves' Bobby Cox (2004-05), Rays' Kevin Cash (2020-21) and Guardians' Stephen Vogt (2024-25)....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell....he signed a multi-year contract extension on 2/20/26.

COACHES: Returning from the 2025 staff is offense & strategy coordinator **Jason Lane** (11th season/1st in current role), pitching coordinator **Jim Henderson** (5th season/1st in current role), field coordinator **Néstor Corredor** (4th season/3rd in current role), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (8th season), bullpen coach **Charlie Greene** (3rd season), lead hitting coach **Eric Theisen** (2nd season/1st in current role) and third base coach **Matt Erickson** (3rd season/1st in current role)....assistant pitching coach **Juan Sandoval**, hitting coach **Guillermo Martinez**, hitting coach **Daniel Vogelbach** and first base coach **Spencer Allen** are all in their first seasons on the coaching staff.

IN THE STANDINGS (82 days): The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each spot in the NL Central standings: **FIRST:** 44, **SECOND:** 10, **THIRD:** 8, **FOURTH:** 13, **FIFTH:** 7....the Brewers are currently in first place, leading the second-place Cardinals by 4.5 games.

AT HOME: The Brewers are 23-14 at home, going 8-3-1 in series play....the team has a pair of season-high 5-game winning streaks coming from 4/30-5/12 and 5/25-6/2.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 20-12 on the road, going 7-3-1 in series play....the team is 12-4 in its last 16 road games and had a season-high 5-game winning streak from 5/31-6/8.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 22 replay challenges this season, going 16-6....their last challenge (lost) came on 6/8 at Athletics as an out call at first base involving Brice Turang was confirmed.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have qualified for the postseason seven times in the last eight seasons and three seasons in a row....the team was just two games away from making the postseason in nine straight seasons (2017-25), missing out in both 2017 and 2022 by a single game....Milwaukee has won the NL Central in four of the last five seasons and three seasons in a row.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last eight full seasons (2017-25)....this does not include the shortened 2020 season....the Brewers have 806 wins since 2017, which ranks fourth in the majors behind the Dodgers (899), Astros (839) and Yankees (831).

GASSER AT A GLANCE: Robert Gasser, 27, will be making his fifth start of the season.....Gasser last started last Tuesday in Las Vegas against the Athletics and took a 7-5 loss (5ip, 8h, 6r, 6er, 2bb, 7k, 4hr, 93 pitches).....the team is 0-4 in his starts.....he does not have a quality start.....opponents are batting .267 (20-for-75, 6hr).....he is also 0-0 with a 3.38 ERA in 7 starts this season at Triple-A Nashville (26.2ip, 27h, 12r, 10er, 8bb, 38k, 1hr).....Gasser was acquired from San Diego with three others on 8/1/22 as part of the trade for LHP Josh Hader.....he was selected by the Padres in Competitive Balance Round B of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft from the University of Houston.....he also attended the University of New Mexico in addition to San Joaquin Delta College.

LAST SEASON: Gasser spent most of the season on the 60-day injured list as he recovered from "Tommy John" surgery.....he was reinstated on August 30 and optioned to Triple-A Nashville.....he went 3-2 with a 2.25 ERA in 10 games/6 starts with the Sounds (including his rehab assignment).....he was recalled by the Brewers on September 21 and made 2 starts, coming in losses on 9/21 at St. Louis and 9/27 vs. Cincinnati.....he also made 2 postseason appearances, both coming in relief.

CAREER: Is 2-5 with a 3.98 ERA in 11 starts with Milwaukee (52ip, 53h, 29r, 23er, 14bb, 40k, 9hr).....made his Major League debut in 2024.....Gasser underwent "Tommy John" surgery on 6/24/24, performed by Dr. Keith Meister.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 2-3 with a 2.38 ERA in 7 starts (34ip, 9er).....is 0-2 with a 4.82 ERA in 2 starts this season (9.1ip, 5er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 0-2 with a 7.00 ERA in 4 starts (18ip, 14er).....is 0-1 with a 8.00 ERA in 2 starts this season (9ip, 8er).

CAREER vs. GUARDIANS: Gasser has not faced Cleveland.

ODDS & ENDS: Gasser graduated from Oak Ridge (CA) High School.....his father, Jim, was also a pitcher who was drafted by Milwaukee (1984) and San Francisco (1986) but did not sign due to injury.....Gasser enjoys fishing and golf.
