**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The St. Louis Cardinals and division-rival Milwaukee Brewers play the second game of three-game weekend series tonight at American Family Field ... St. Louis is 0-4 so far on its six-game "Seattle Pilots" road trip through Seattle (0-3) and Milwaukee (0-1).

**WHAT'S BREWING:** The Cardinals and Brewers face off five more times over the next nine days, while nine of the Cardinals final 14 games are against divisional opponents ahead of them in the standings.

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** St. Louis enters today in 4th place in the NL Central, 18.0 games behind first place Milwaukee, and 4.0 games behind New York for the final Wild Card position ... The Cardinals play the toughest remaining strength of schedule, with combined .557 winning pct. against the Brewers (5g), Reds (3g), Giants (3g), and Cubs (3g). - *Elias*

**WINN ENDS SEASON ON THE INJURED LIST:** Prior to tonight's game, St. Louis recalled INF **José Fermín** from Memphis (AAA) and placed SS **Masyn Winn** on the 10-Day Injured List with a torn meniscus in his right knee, ending his season ... Defensive highlights and significant rankings from Winn's season are detailed below.

- The 23-year-old co-leads all of Major League Baseball in Outs Above Average (22) with **Bobby Witt Jr.**, which is also the highest total by any Cardinal in the *Statcast* era (2016-present).
- Winn leads MLB shortstops in Fielding Percentage (.9940), and paces all National League shortstops in Runs Prevented (16), Defensive Runs Above Average (20.2), and Range Factor/Game (3.86).
- Winn's three errors (501 total chances) match 1990 Oriole **Cal Ripken Jr.** (680 total chances) and 2000 Indian **Omar Vizquel** (648 total chances) for the fewest by a Major League shortstop in a full season since 1974 (*minimum 500 total chances and 125 games*).
- His .9940 fielding pct. (1,107.2 innings) is the best ever by a Cardinals shortstop, and ranks as the 4th-highest all-time among MLB shortstops with 1,100+ innings to 1990 Oriole **Cal Ripken Jr.** (.9956), 2000 Indian **Omar Vizquel** (.9954), and 2000 Royal **Rey Sánchez** (.9941) ... Hall of Famer **Ozzie Smith's** three highest single-season fielding percentages were .987 both in 1987 and 1991, and .985 in 1992 (all Gold Glove Award-winning years).
- Since 1957, eight MLB shortstops have won Rawlings Gold Gloves while playing fewer than 1,100 innings at shortstop, most recently by Colorado's **Troy Tulowitzki** (1,065 in 2010) ... **Ozzie Smith** (1,065.1) also won in 1984 for St. Louis.

**SATURDAY IN THE PARK:** St. Louis is 14-7 on Saturdays this season (8-2 on the road), their most successful day of the week ... Their .800 Saturday winning pct. on the road currently stands as their best ever in the Divisional Era. **DID YOU KNOW:** St. Louis has won 12 of its last 15 Saturday games at American Family Field since 2013.

**REHABBING REDBIRD:** Platinum Glover 3B **Nolan Arenado**, who has been sidelined for 38 games since August 1 with a right shoulder strain, has gone a combined 1-for-10 in three games during his injury rehab assignment with Springfield (AA) ... Arenado played his first two games at designated hitter and then six innings at third base last night.

**FANTASTIC FINISHES:** St. Louis needs a 10-4 finish to end with a winning mark, above .500 ... The Cardinals have had winning marks in 25 of their past 31 seasons since joining the NL Central Division in 1994 and in 23 of their 25 seasons played since 2000 ... The last time St. Louis posted two losing seasons over a three-year span was 1997 (73-89) and 1999 (75-86).

**THE LEFTORIUM:** Four of MLB's top nine leaders in batting average among left-handed hitters play in tonight's game: **Sal Frelick** (.294, 1st), **Brice Turang** (.289, 3rd), **Alec Bursleson** (.283, 5th) and **Brendan Donovan** (.279, 8th).

**Andre Granillo** (June 12, 2025 at Am Fam Field) made his MLB debuts vs. the Brewers.

**Erick Fedde** made 30 starts for St. Louis over parts of two seasons (2024-25)...acquired at the 2024 MLB Trade Deadline from the White Sox as part of three-team trade with the Dodgers.

**José Quintana** made one postseason and 12 regular season starts for the Cardinals in 2022...acquired at the 2022 MLB Trade Deadline with **Chris Stratton** from Pittsburgh in exchange for **Johan Oviedo** and **Malcom Nuñez**.

Late Brewers broadcaster **Bob Uecker** played two seasons (1964-65) with St. Louis...won the 1964 World Series...traded by Milwaukee Braves to St. Louis for **Jimmie Coker** & **Gary Kolb** (Apr. 9, 1964).

**Steve Dillard**, father of Brewers broadcaster **Tim Lillard**, was hitting coach for the Single-A Quad Cities Swing/River Bandits from 2006-07 and hitting coach for the High-A Palm Beach Cardinals in 2007...later piloted Quad Cities in 2008-09, where he managed infielder **Oliver Marmol**.

**Willson Contreras's** younger brother, **William**, is a catcher for the Brewers.

**Caleb Durbin** played college baseball at Washington University in St. Louis (2019-21).

**Riley O'Brien's** grandfather **Johnny O'Brien** was drafted by the NBA's Milwaukee Hawks in 1953, but instead chose to play baseball.

**Jacob Misorowski** played college baseball at Crowder College in Neosho, Mo...made MLB debut vs. St. Louis (June 12, 2025 at Am. Fam.).

**Trevor Megill** was originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign to return to Loyola Marymount Univ.

Brewers broadcaster **Jeff Levering** previously worked three seasons (2010-12) as broadcaster for the Springfield Cardinals (AA).

Brewers Media Relations Intern **Owen Buescher** previously worked as a 2024 Cardinals Communications Gameday Associate...graduated from Belleville (Ill.) West High School and Univ. of Missouri.

**A.J. Pierzynski** played 30 games for St. Louis in 2014, where he was teammates with current Cardinals coaches **Jon Jay** and **Daniel Descalso**.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played in 73 games for Milwaukee in 2010.

**Ricky Horton** made five starts for the Denver Zephyrs (AAA-Brewers) in 1990.

KMOX broadcaster **Matt Pauley** hosted Brewers pre- and postgame shows for parts of six seasons (2017-22)...was radio play-by-play voice of the Univ. of Wisconsin-Green Bay women's basketball team.

Hall of Famer **Ted Simmons** played five seasons with Milwaukee (1981-85), where he was a two-time AL All-Star and faced off against St. Louis in the 1982 World Series...traded to Milwaukee with **Rollie Fingers** & **Pete Vuckovich** for **David Green**, **Sixto Lezcano**, **Dave LaPoint** & **Lary Sorensen**.

Cardinals broadcaster **Mark Sweeney** played two seasons in Milwaukee (2000-01).

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- The Cardinals Opening Day starter makes his 30th start of the season (338th career appearance/328th start). It's his 58th career start for St. Louis.
- Marks his 5th season with 30 or more starts and first since 2023 with Minnesota. Will become 1-of-29 pitchers with 5 seasons with 30 or more starts since 2014 joining teammate Miles Mikolas and retired Cardinal Adam Wainwright.
- Ranks 7th among active pitchers with 327 starts.
- Ranks 109th in career strikeouts with 1,903; passing **Josh Beckett** with 1,901 in his last start. Needs five strikeouts to pass Jerry Reuss (1969-90) at 1,907 for 108th.
- Became the 9th-active pitcher with 1,900 career innings in his last start.
- Is the first Cardinal with back-to-back 10-win seasons since **Adam Wainwright** (2021-22).
- Has a 9-5 record with a 4.04 ERA (13 HR) in 19 home starts, but 4-3 with a 5.24 ERA (10 HR) in 10 road starts.
- **Boasts the highest strikeout percentage on the Sweeper (49.7) of those with 100 or more batters faced.**
- **The Cardinals are 20-9 in Gray's 29 starts this season. Tied for 4th for most team wins for any pitcher.**
- **St. Louis is 14-5 in his 19 home starts this season, most wins by a home team record for any starting pitcher in MLB this season.** Bassitt (TOR), Skubal (DET) and C. Sanchez (PHI) are tied for 2nd with 12.
- Sonny's 18 wins at home since joining St. Louis (2024-25) tie **Carlos Rodon** for 2nd-most in MLB to **Tarik Skubal (19)**.
- Leads the Cardinals staff in percentage of Swings That Miss (26.4%) - 9th-best in the NL.
- Has 20 career double-digit strikeout games, including three since May 19. Since his career began in 2013, ranks T-28th among his peers in 10+ K games.
- Issued one-or-fewer walks in MLB-leading 21-of-29 starts this season; St. Louis is 15-6 in those games.
- Has six scoreless starts of 6.0 innings or more, tied for 6th-most in MLB. Tigers LHP Tarik Skubal (12) leads the list.
- Is one of 11 pitchers in Busch Stadium III history with 200+ strikeouts (261 K). **Kyle Lohse** ranks 9th with 297 strikeouts.
- 23 of his 165 hits allowed in 2025 have been homers and **38 of his 87 runs (43.6%) allowed this season have come via home run.**
- Over past two seasons since joining St. Louis (2024-25), ranks among MLB leaders in strikeouts (3826th) and wins (26, T-7th).
- St. Louis is 37-20 (.649) in his 57 starts with the club since joining in 2024; His record stands at 26-17 while wearing the Birds on the Bat.

**LAST TIME OUT (Sunday, Sept. 7 vs. San Francisco):** Walked a season-high four batters, but held his opposition to two hits and three runs in a 4-3 win. Struck out six batters passing Josh Beckett for 109th all-time in strikeouts and surpassed 1,900 career innings.

2025:

- Surpassed Josh Beckett for 109th all-time now with 1,903 strikeouts.
- Has two starts holding the opposition to one hit this season (8/4 at LAD 7.0 IP & 6/27 at CLE 9.0 IP).
- Authored a one-hit complete-game shutout masterpiece at CLE (6/27) striking out a season-high 11 Guardians on only 89 pitches in the 5-0 Cardinals win. His only blemish was a two-out Nolan Jones single in the bottom of the 5th inning.
- *Marked Gray's 5th career shutout and first since July 28, 2015 at Los Angeles Dodgers. It was the 11th time a Cardinal threw a one-hitter, one batter over the minimum since 1901, and first since **Jordan Montgomery** at Wrigley Field on Aug, 22, 2022.*
- *Since pitch counts were accurately kept in 1988, Gray joined **David Cone**'s perfect game (July 18, 1999) as the only two pitchers to throw shutouts of one hit or fewer with 10+ strikeouts in 89 pitches or fewer.*
- His 19 starts before the All-Star Break tied his single-season most (2014).

GRAY vs. MILWAUKEE

- Is 4-6 with a 3.64 ERA in 18 career starts vs. the Brewers since 2016. Has yet to earn a win as a member of the Cardinals (last: 8/26/21 w/CIN).
- Has a 3-3 record with a 4.04 ERA in nine career starts at American Family Field.
- Made two starts vs. MIL in 2025, earned a no decision in a Cardinals win at Busch Stadium in April (4/26) and suffered a 6-0 loss in Milwaukee (6-12).
- Took the loss at Busch Stadium on 4/21/24, a 2-0 defeat to the Brewers, when he struck out a season-high 12; Allowed three straight two-out singles in the 7th inning accounting for the two runs.
- Has held N.L. Central opponents to one earned run or less in 5-of-8 starts this season; 2-of-other-3 starts vs. Milwaukee. Received 1 run or less of support in all three losses.
