BIRD WATCHING: The St. Louis Cardinals continue an eight-game homestand into the All-Star Break against first place teams in the National League Central (Milwaukee) and East (Atlanta). The Cardinals play the middle of a three-game series with the Atlanta Braves tonight. Following tomorrow afternoon's game, the Cardinals will head into the All-Star Break and resume play in Arizona on Friday.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis enters play in 3rd place in the National League Central, 10.0 games behind first place Milwaukee, and 2.5 games behind 2nd place Chicago. The 'Birds are 6-6 into a stretch of 14 games over 13 days without an off day leading into the All-Star Break (June 30-July 12), all against teams currently in playoff position (2-1 at Braves; 2-1 at Cubs; 5 vs. Brewers 1-4; and 3 vs. Braves 1-0).

BLAME IT ON THE RAIN: Last night's game saw more time allocated to rain delays (2:44) than the actual time of game (2:23). By the time the final out was recorded at 12:32 AM Central time, only one game remained on the Major League slate, the Pacific Time Zone contest between Colorado at San Francisco.

HERRERA JOINS NATIONAL LEAGUE ALL-STARS: The Cardinals added another player to the National League All-Star team yesterday as **Iván Herrera** was selected to replace **Shohei Ohtani** at designated hitter due to injury. Herrera joins manager **Oliver Marmol**, OF **Jordan Walker** and RHP **Riley O'Brien**. The last time the Cardinals sent four to the All-Star Game was 2022 in Los Angeles (**Nolan Arenado**, **Paul Goldschmidt**, **Ryan Helsley**, **Miles Mikolas** & **Albert Pujols**). The Cardinals went on to win the National League Central that season.

TWO FOR WON: Thanks to **Jimmy Crooks'** game-winning home run in the bottom of the 8th inning last night, the Cardinals won their 4th game this season scoring two runs or fewer. Last season, the Cardinals had six wins scoring two runs or fewer. Crooks's home run gave the Cardinals their 16th win in one-run games, T-3rd most in the National League behind Philadelphia (19) and Los Angeles (17).

CARDINALS SELECT CONDON WITH FIRST ROUND PICK: The St. Louis Cardinals selected OF **Trevor Condon** with the 13th overall pick in the 2026 Major League Baseball draft. The left-handed batting Condon (5'11, 178 lb.) played high school baseball at Etowah HS in Woodstock, Ga., where he batted .504 with 9 HR, 42 RBI, 17 doubles and 15 stolen bases through 36 games. He helped Etowah to the Georgia Class 6A State Championship and was named 2025-26 Gatorade Georgia State Player of the Year. With grades of 70-run, 60-hit and 60-field, his common comps include **Pete Crow-Armstrong** and **Lenny Dykstra**.

LIB-BING IT UP: Tonight's starting pitcher **Matthew Liberatore** has fared well in 3-of-4 career starts vs. Atlanta, holding the Braves to one run or less including two scoreless starts (7/7/22 - 4.0 IP at ATL & 6/26/24 - 6.0 IP at STL). In his last start vs. Atlanta on June 30, Liberatore struck out nine in a 5-3 Cardinals win at Truist Park.

A BRAVE NEW WORLD: With a win today, the Cardinals would win the season series against the Braves for the first time since 2024 and the second time during **Oliver Marmol's** managerial tenure. The Cardinals and Giants are the only two teams with a winning record at home and on the road against the first place Braves this season.

WALK-AND-ROLL: **Jordan Walker** extended his on-base streak to 16 games, matching his season-high. Walker's 16 game streak is two shy of his career-best of 18 set during his rookie season from June 5-29, 2023. This marks the 3rd on-base streak of 15 or more games this season by Walker, joining Baltimore's **Taylor Ward** as the only two players with three or more on-base streaks of 15 games this season.

Chip Caray previously served as the play-by-play voice of the Braves for 20 seasons on Bally Sports South and Bally Sports Southeast (2010-22), TBS and Peachtree TV (2005-2009) and on TBS and the Atlanta Braves Radio Network (1991-1992)..... his father, **Skip Caray**, was part of Braves broadcasts from 1978-2008.

Jordan Walker was born in Stone Mountain, Ga... Graduated from Decatur (Ga.) High School, where he was a 2019 and 2020 Gatorade High School Player of the Year.

George Soriano spent three weeks this offseason with Atlanta; was claimed by the Braves off waivers from Baltimore (Jan. 9, 2026) and then claimed by Washington off waivers (Jan. 30, 2026).

Kyle Leahy's uncle, **Thomas Leahy**, pitched in the Braves minor league organization (1991-93).

Blaze Jordan and **Austin Riley** graduated from DeSoto Central (Miss.) High School.

Austin Riley made his MLB debut vs. the Cardinals (May 19, 2019 at Truist Park).

Riley O'Brien's grandfather, **Johnny O'Brien**, was drafted by NBA's Milwaukee Hawks, who later became the St. Louis Hawks, and are now the Atlanta Hawks.

Cards.TV Director **Tom Mee** was selected by Atlanta in the 12th round of the 1977 MLB Draft...played two minor league seasons in the Braves system (1977-78) and was teammates with **Brian Snitker**.

As compensation for **Marcell Ozuna** signing with Atlanta in 2020, St. Louis selected **Alec Burleson** in the 2nd round of the 2020 MLB draft.

JoJo Romero (Aug. 21, 2020 at Truist) and **Jon Jay** (April 26, 2010 at Busch III) made their MLB debuts vs. the Braves.

Dylan Dodd pitched three seasons (2019-21) at Southeast Missouri State University and one season with the Hannibal (Mo.) Hoots of the Collegiate Summer Prospect League.

Hall of Fame Manager **Joe Torre** played for & managed both the Cardinals (1969-74 & 1990-95) and Braves (1966-68 & 1982-84)...traded to St. Louis from Atlanta for **Orlando Cepeda** (Mar. 17, 1969).

Drake Baldwin played college baseball at Missouri State University (2020-22).

Stubby Clapp played the 2003 season for the Richmond Braves (AAA-Braves).

Braves Pitching Coach **Jeremy Hefner** pitched his final professional season (2016) in the Cardinals minor league organization.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Al Hrabosky** pitched his final three MLB seasons with Atlanta (1980-82).

Braves Asst. Hitting Coach **Darnell Coles** played in 63 games for the Cardinals in 2000.

Hall of Fame catcher **Ted Simmons** played his final three seasons with Atlanta (1986-88).

Cardinals Communications Gameday Associates Supervisor **Jacob Mayer** was a 2015 Media Relations Trainee for Gwinnett (AAA).

Braves Baseball Communications Trainees **Jo Ganzer** (2024-25) and **Mark Reed III** (2024) previously worked as a Cardinals Communications Gameday Associates.

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- The 26-year-old Cardinals Opening Day starter makes his team-leading 19th start of the season tonight. It marks his 139th career Major League appearance and his 72nd career start.
- Since May 1, ranks 1st among Cardinals pitchers & 6th among NL southpaws with 63 strikeouts. He ranks 4th among NL qualifying LHP's with his 9.89 K/9 IP rate over that period among NL port-siders.
- Tied for 3rd in the National League with three pick-offs; most by a Cardinals pitcher since **Lance Lynn** (4 in 2015) and by a southpaw since **Mark Mulder** (5 in 2005).
- Is the first Cardinals lefty since **Jamie Garcia** (during 2011 season) to post 20 career wins as a Cardinal. His next win ties **Cowboy Jones** (1899-1901) and **Gene Packard** (1917-18) for 38th all-time among Cardinals left-handed pitchers.
- According to *Baseball Savant*, Libby's curveball spin ranks in the 96th percentile. Opponents are hitting .200 (7-35) off his curevall this season.
- Sports a 4-6 record, but the Cardinals are 11-7 in his 18 starts this season, including a 6-3 mark in starts at Busch Stadium
- The Cardinals are 18-16 in his 34 career starts at Busch Stadium, where he has gone 12-11 with a 4.22 ERA (168.1 IP/79 ER) with 10 quality starts (all 10 starts with 6.0 IP or more).

LAST TIME OUT (Sunday, July 5 at Atlanta): L, 6-4; 5.0 IP, 4 H, 4 R, 3 ER, 2 BB, 3 SO, 0 HR - 78 pitches

- Came away with a loss after yielding four runs (three earned) on four hits in 5.0 innings in last week's loss at Wrigley Field.
- Exited in the bottom of the 6th with no outs and two runners on with the Cardinals leading 3-2. Opened the frame with a walk and single.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

JUST PEACHY: Fanned 9 batters, one shy of his career high, in a 5-3 win at Truist Park to earn his 20th career win on 6/30 at ATL.

SUNDAY FUNDAY: Had his deepest start (5.1 IP) since a 6.0 inning effort on 5/7 at SD and led the Cardinals to a series win over the Cubs on NBC Sunday Night Baseball in his 5-1 win vs Chicago on 5/31.

K-CLUB: Libby notched single-game career highs for strikeouts in consecutive starts when he fanned 9 on 5/19 vs. PIT and then he bettered that with 10 K's on Memorial Day (5/25) at MIL; He and Brewers starter Jacob Misorowski (12) combined for 22 strikeouts in the 5/25 game.

LIBBY & LEFTY: Recorded 38 strikeouts in May, the most by a Cardinals lefty in the month of May since Hall of Famer **Steve "Lefty" Carlton** fanned 52 in May, 1970.

SLAMMED: Took the loss in Sacramento (5/13) allowing his first career grand slam (Nic Kurtz) in a 4-3 loss, coming during an inning where he threw a career-high 43 pitches.

FRIAR FRYER: Earned his 2nd straight win holding the Padres (5/7) to one run over 6.0 innings in a 2-1 come-from-behind win at Petco Park. Recorded his 300th career strikeout fanning Nick Castellanos in the 5th inning.

HR DERBY: Surrendered a career-high 3 HR's in 3.1 IP vs. SEA (4/25) as the two teams combined for 33 hits and 8 HR's in 11-9 Mariners win. Also allowed 3 HR's in his 6/13 start vs. the Twins at Target Field.

SPACE DUST: Worked a season high 6.0 IP, allowing just one run on three hits, taking a ND in the Cardinals 7-5 extra inning win on 4/19 at HOU to complete the series sweep of the Astros.

FIRST TO 100: Threw a career high 105 pitches in 9-3 loss vs. CLE on 4/13 in 5.0 IP; He was the first Cardinals pitcher to reach the 100 pitch plateau.

NO FOOLING: Held the Mets to one run in his second start on April Fools Day, a day after **Andre Pallante** and company shut out New York. Retired the first 12 Mets batters (first time a Cardinal vs. NYM since 1968) and carried a no-hitter through 4.2 innings, longest of his career.

LIBBY'S LID-LIFTER: Made his 1st career Opening Day start and received a no decision vs. TB (3/26) despite pitching 5.0 innings and allowing just one run. Cardinals rallied for a 9-7 win (he exited with game tied 1-1).

LEFTY LIFT-OFFS: Made his 1st career Opening Day start on 3/26 vs. TB, becoming the 1st Cardinals lefty to start on Opening Day since **Donovan Osborne** (4/5/99) vs. MIL - the same year that Libby was born. He became one of just 16 LHP's to make the Opening Day start for the Cardinals since 1901 (MLB).

CAREER:

- Chose to switch to uniform No. 32 prior to 2026 season in honor of Hall of Fame left-handed pitcher **Sandy Koufax**, whom he grew up admiring.
- Was acquired by the Cardinals from the Rays in a four-player trade in 2020 that included Randy Arozarena, with a compensation pick that netted the Cardinals RHP **Tink Hence**.
- Is a career 17-27 with a 4.99 ERA (340.2 IP) in his 71 career starts opposed to 3-3 with a 3.89 ERA (81.0 IP) in 67 career relief appearances.
- 2021 Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Year, his first season of play in the Cardinals organization.

LIBERATORE vs. ATLANTA:

- Is making his 5th career start (6th app.) vs. the Braves, going 2-1 with a 3.26 ERA (19.1 IP)
- Career 1-1 with a 6.00 ERA (9.0 IP) in a pair of starts at Busch Stadium, but is 1-0 with a 0.87 ERA (10.1 IP) in three games (two starts) at Truist Park.
- Did not allow a run in his first 11.1 career IP vs. ATL, a streak that was snapped in his July 11, 2025 meeting with the Braves when he allowed three 1st inning runs in a start at Busch Stadium. The 11.1 scoreless innings streak to begin a career against the Braves was the 4th-longest by a Cardinal in the Expansion Era (1961) behind Joe Hoerner (14.1), Reggie Cleveland (13.0) and Carlos Martinez (12.2).
- Struck out eight batters over 6.0 scoreless innings in June 26, 2024 start at Busch Stadium; allowed two hits and a walk in a 4-1 win.

LAST START vs. BRAVES (June 30, 2026 at Truist Park): W, 5-3; 5.0 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 4 BB, 9 SO, 1 HR - 98 pitches

- His June 30 win at ATL was the 20th of his career as he became the 1st Cardinals lefty since **Jamie Garcia** (during 2011 season) to post his 20th career win as a Cardinal.
