<b>BEAT THE METS</b>	
The Washington Nationals beat the visiting New York Mets, 8-4, on Tuesday night behind home runs from <b>CJ Abrams</b> (three-run) and <b>Jacob Young</b> (two-run) and strong pitching performances from <b>Zack Littell</b> (5.0 IP, 5 H, 2 ER, 3 SO) and <b>Andrew Alvarez</b> (1st career save, 4.0 IP, 2 H, BB, 5 SO).	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Nationals are 8-3 (.727) against the Mets since Aug. 20, 2025</li> <li>With a win today, Washington will have won four consecutive series over New York since Aug. 19-21, 2025, including a victory earlier this season at Citi Field, April 28-30...With last night's win, the Nationals have now won or split their last four home series against the Mets since July 1-4, 2024.</li> </ul>	
<b>ROSTER MOVES</b>	
The Nationals returned right-handed pitcher Clayton Beeter from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 15-day Injured List on Thursday...Washington optioned left-handed pitcher PJ Poulin to Triple-A Rochester on Wednesday.	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Beeter made two rehab appearances for Triple-A Rochester...He allowed just one hit and struck out two in 2.0 scoreless innings.</li> </ul>	
<b>WINNING WAYS</b>	
The Nationals have won six of nine, nine of 14, 10 of 16 and 14 of 23 games since April 25...They have won five of their last seven series and have won seven of their last 10 home games after starting the season 3-12 through their first 15 home games.	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>In the 14 wins, the pitching staff has recorded a 2.86 ERA and a .214 opponents' average with 130 strikeouts and 37 walks in 129.0 innings pitched.</li> <li>The Nationals are in a stretch of 16 straight games without a day off that started on May 12 at Cincinnati...Washington's next day off is scheduled for May 28 at home...The Nationals are 6-3 during this stretch so far.</li> <li>Washington's 25 wins are the most through 50 games for any Nationals club since the 2018 Nationals were 28-22 (.560) through their first 50 games.</li> </ul>	
<b>PRETTY OFFENSIVE</b>	
The Nationals lead Major League Baseball with 5.58 runs per game and with 279 runs scored this season...The 279 runs are the most by any Nationals team through 50 games in team history (2005-pres.) ahead of the 2017 Nationals who scored 277 runs in that span.	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Washington has scored 42 runs in the first inning, the most in Major League Baseball.</li> <li>The Nationals lead Major League Baseball with 103 runs in the seventh inning or later.</li> <li>Washington has scored at least five runs 30 times this season, the most in Major League Baseball.</li> </ul>	
<b>BACKSTOP BAT</b>	
<b>Keibert Ruiz</b> has hit safely in six of his last seven games, going 11-for-26 (.423) with six doubles, three homers, 13 RBI, one walk, one stolen base and seven runs scored...He is in the midst of a six-game hitting streak along the way.	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>On the season, Ruiz ranks second among all Major League catchers with 11 doubles and among all catchers (min. 95 PA) in isolated power (.250) and slugging percentage (.500).</li> </ul>	
<b>OUT OF THIS WORLD</b>	
<b>CJ Abrams</b> ranks among National League hitters in RBI (T1st, 42), wRC+ (6th, 157), OPS (7th, .928), wOBA (7th, .401), on-base percentage (7th, .389), hits (T7th, 54), slugging percentage (8th, .539), batting average (9th, .300), and extra-base hits (T9th, 22).	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>He is hitting .337/.398/.566 with eight doubles, a triple, three homers, 21 RBI, eight walks, one hit by pitch, two stolen bases and 17 runs in his last 21 games...He's reached safely in nine straight games.</li> </ul>	
<b>GOOD WOOD</b>	
<b>James Wood</b> is 8-for-19 (.421) with a double, homer, five RBI, two walks and five runs scored in his last four games.	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>He leads MLB with an average exit velo of 96.4 MPH ahead of <b>O'Neil Cruz</b> (96.0).</li> <li>Wood is one of four players in Major League Baseball with more than one batted ball greater than 116.0 MPH this season with <b>Yordan Alvarez</b> (2), <b>Junior Caminero</b> (2) and <b>O'Neil Cruz</b> (2).</li> <li>Wood's 31 barrels (at least 98 MPH exit velo/26 degree launch angle) are the most in MLB ahead of <b>Kyle Schwarber</b> (28) and his 60 batted balls over 100 MPH are tied for the most in MLB with <b>Michael Harris II</b> (60).</li> </ul>	
<b>BULL PENNING</b>	
Over the last two games, Washington's bullpen has struck out nine batters, issued one walk and has held opposing batters to a .154 average (4-for-26)...Notable performances include:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Andrew Alvarez</b> recorded his first career save on May 20 vs. New York (4.0 IP, 2 H, 2 ER, HR, BB 5 SO).</li> <li><b>Brad Lord</b> has not issued a walk in his last four outings while striking out 10 batters over this stretch...On the season, he's recorded 4.33 strikeout-to-walk ratio (26 SO/6 BB).</li> <li><b>Richard Lovelady</b> is 1-1 with three saves, three holds and a 1.46 ERA (2 ER/12.1 I) and 13 strikeouts in his last 12 outings...He's posted a 2.03 ERA in 13 games with the Nationals.</li> <li><b>Orlando Ribalta</b> has allowed just one hit (1-for-13) with four strikeouts and zero walks over his last four outings, all scoreless (4.0 IP).</li> </ul>
