#### TODAY'S GAME:

- Is Game 2 (1-0) of a 3-game series vs Joanna Schimmel's Cubs and the fifth game (3-1) of a 7-day, 6-game road trip that includes a 2-1 series victory vs the Royals at Kauffman Stadium.
- Following tomorrow's game, the Reds will return home to Great American Ball Park for a 6-game homestand vs the Brewers (6/2-6/4) and Diamondbacks (6/6-6/8).
- The Reds are coming off a brief 3-game homestand vs Chc (1-2).

**SERIES NOTES:** The Reds and **Cubs** are meeting for the second time in 2025... **Chc** won 2 of 3g last weekend in **Cincinnati**...the teams will square off again at **Wrigley Field** 8/4-8/6 before wrapping up the season series 9/18-9/21 at **Great American Ball Park**.

- The Reds have led each game of the season series by 4 or more runs (4-0 & 6-2 on <u>5/23</u>, lost 13-6; 6-1 on <u>5/24</u>, won 6-4; 8-3 on <u>5/25</u>, lost 11-8; 6-0 <u>yesterday</u>, won 6-2).
- · Cin went 8-5 last season vs Chc, and won 3 of the 4 series.
- The Reds are 190-187 vs Chc since 2003 and 87-105 since 2014.
- Cin is 467-498 (.484) all-time at Wrigley Field, having the third-most wins among all Cubs opponents at the Friendly Confines (StL 480-549, Pit 477-542).
- The Redlegs are 98-87 all-time vs the Cubs at Great American Ball Park, having won 20 of the last 34g there against their division rival.

- Enters today's game with 41 hits on the road (ranks T3rd in majors).

- 8 of his 11 HR this season have either tied the game or put Cin ahead.
- His next homer will be the 50th of his career...at <u>23 years</u>, <u>140 days</u> today, would be the fifth-youngest Red to reach that mark (**Adam Dunn**: 23 years, 154 days in 2003).

REDS BATTING: Through the Reds' first 16 games (3/27-4/13), Cin batters slashed .200/.272/.320 and averaged 3.88 runs per game...in 42 games since then (4/15-5/30), the club ranks third in the majors with a .267 AVG, third with a .342 OBP, fifth with a .772 OPS, sixth with a .430 SLG, seventh by averaging 4.95 runs per game, and first with 82 doubles

 The Reds have scored 6 or more runs in 6 of their last 7 games, including a 5-game streak from 5/23-5/27.

HOME (RUNS) AWAY FROM HOME: The Redlegs are averaging 4.83 runs per game on the road compared to 4.43 runs per game back home in Cincinnati... overall during the Great American Ball Park era (since 2003), the team has averaged 4.60 runs per game at GABP and 4.26 runs per game on the road.

- 5 times in the history of **GABP** has Cin averaged more runs per game on the road than at home (2023, 2013, 2009, 2004, 2003).
- Cin has homered 29 times in 28 games this year at home compared to 29 times in 29 road games.
- 2004 marks the only season during the GABP era in which the Reds hit
  more home runs on the road (102) than at home (92).

## NICK LODOLO LHP #40

2025 Record: 4-4, 3.39

Height/Weight: 6'6"/221 | Bats/Throws: L/L Born: 2/5/98, La Verne, CA | Age: 27

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor in the decision in Sun's (5/25) 11-8 loss vs Chc (5.0ip, 6h, 3r/3er, 2bb, 6k, 1hr, 91TP).

- The Reds were leading 8-3 when he exited the game after the 5th inning...for the first time this season was in line for the win and fell victim to a blown save.
- Collected his 350th career strikeout (Ian Happ, 1st inning)... became the second-fastest Reds pitcher by appearances (58g) to reach the mark since the mound was moved to its current distance in 1893, behind only teammate Hunter Greene (51g. 2022-24).
- Became just the 12th Major Leaguer in the live-ball era (since 1920) with at least 350 strikeouts and 100 walks or fewer through their first 58 career appearances, the first since TB's Shane McClanahan (372k/87bb, 2021-23).

MAY 19 at PIT: Earned the 7-1 win at Pit on 5/19 (6.0ip, 4h, 1r/1er, 1bb, 7k, 89TP).

 Was his sixth quality start of the season and the 23rd of his career...has never had more than 8 quality starts in a Major League season (2022 & 2024).

MAY 3 vs WSH: Suffered the 11-6 loss on 5/3 vs Wsh (5.1ip, 10h, 7r/6er, 2bb, 4k, 1hr, 98TP).

- The 10 hits allowed were a season-high and the most he allowed in a game since 7/31/24 vs Chc (11h).
- Was ahead in the count to just 10 of his 31 batters (32.3%), the lowest percentage of any of his starts in 2025...entered the game having been ahead in the count to 54.5% of his batters (78 of 143) which ranked 11th.

NO-HIT BID IN DENVER: Fired 7.0 shutout innings in the 8-1 win on 4/27 at Col (2h, 1bb, 9k, 1hb, 91TP)...held the Rockies without a hit through 5.2 innings until Jordan Beck hit an infield single in the 6th...Kyle Farmer added an infield single in the 7th...were the only 2 hits Lodolo gave up in the game.

- Was the longest no-hit bid of Lodolo's career and his third career start of at least 7.0 scoreless innings (last: 4/8/23 at Phi, 7.0ip).
- His 9 strikeouts were a season-high and his most since 8/22/24 at Pit (9k).

**PROUD PAPA:** Was activated from the paternity list on 4/15 following the birth of his son, Keaton...started that night at Mia and suffered the 6-3 loss after allowing 3 runs on 7 hits over 5.2 innings (2bb, 4k, 1hr, 99TP).

**WORKING AHEAD:** Has been ahead in the count to 139 of the 268 batters he's faced this season (51.9%; league average is 47.7%).

 Has thrown a first-pitch strike to 70.1% of his batters (league average is 62.8% among Major League starters.

- His 354 career strikeouts are the most by a Cin left-handed pitcher in any span of 58 starts since 1900.
- His just the 12th Major Leaguer in the live-ball era (since 1920) with at least 350 strikeouts and 100 walks or fewer through their first 58 career appearances, the first since TB's Shane McClanahan (372k/87bb, 2021-23).

### NO WALKS TO THE BOTTOM OF THE ORDER:

Has not issued a walk to any of the 73 batters he's faced this year who've batted 7th, 8th, or 9th in the order...he last walked a batter at the bottom of the order on 8/22/24 when he issued a 5th inning free pass to Pit's Jared Triolo, the Pirates' #7 hitter.

- His 7-8-9 batters are slashing .250/.292/.338 this year -

**LEADING OFF AN INNING:** Batters leading off an inning vs Lodolo are slashing .180/.242/.295 this season...since 2023, his .175 opponents batting avg to hitters leading off an inning ranks second among all starting pitchers with at least 39 starts in that span.
